Reference is made to Memorandum at Charlotte, North Carolina, dated May 1, 1970, captioned as above.

advised that captioned rally commenced 5:30 P.M., on Sunday, May 3, 1970, and continued until 8:30 P.M. that date. The meeting was delayed approximately one hour waiting arrival of the guest speaker. This individual noted that all of the speakers except one were local members of the Black Panther Party referred to as the National Committee to Combat Fascism and the film "Off the Pig" was not shown as it did not arrive in time. According to the official perspaper, the Black Panther Party (GP) was stated in my December, 1966, in Orkland, California, to organize black people so they can take control of the life politics and the destiny of the black community. It was organized by Belley Scale, DPP Chairman, and Huey P. Newton, BPP Minister of Perspace. Hewton was sentenced in 1868 to serve 2 to 15 years after being convicted of manslagether in commentary with the bisling of an Cakland police of ficer.

Included an the introduction to an article appearing in the October 5, 1960, edition of "The Black Panther" is the statement "...we will not dissort from American Government. We will overthrow it."

Jacues of "the Black Panther" regularly contain quotations from the whitings of Chairman Mao Tsertung of the People's Republic of China and feature Mao's statement that "political power gross but of the barrel of a gun."

The national headquarties of the RPP is located at 3106 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, California. Branches have been established at various locations throughout the United States.





In connection with the chapter activities during the month of March, it is noted that on 3/5/70, LARRY LITTLE reported an incident which occurred 3/3/70, indicating that in an eviction process for non-payment of rent, deputies moved a woman's belongings to the street and the brothers returned the belongings and posted armed guards outside the house with the police subsequently withdrawing. (7)

It is noted that the cover and page 2 of "The Black Panther" for 3/28/70 contained an article referring to this but under the name of JOHN E. MOORE, NCCF, Winston-Salem. It is noted full details of this were previously furnished the Bureau and San Francisco. While the article is written in the vein that due to the Panthers action the police were afraid to return and re-evict the people, in truth the rent was paid immediately by a local anti-poverty agency at Winston-Salem, therefore, no confrontation occurred as there was no legal reason for the deputies to return to re-evict the people. 



BLACK PANTHER PARTY, Also Known As Black Panther Party for Self-Defense

According to its official newspaper, the Black Panther Party (BPP) was started during December, 1966, in Oakland, California, to organize black people so they can take control of the life, politics and the destiny of the black community. It was organized by Bobby Seale, BPP Chairman, and Huey P. Newton, BPP Minister of Defense. Newton was sentenced in 1968 to serve 2 to 15 years after being convicted of manslaughter in connection with the killing of an Oakland police of ficer.

The official newspaper, "The Black Panther," which further describes itself as the "Black Community News Service," states that the BPP advocates the use of guns and guerrilla tactics in its revolutionary program to end oppression of the black people. Residents of the black community are urged to arm themselves against the police who are consistently referred to in the publication as "pigs" who should be killed.

"The Black Panther" 1250e of September 7, 1968, contains an editorial by BPP Minister of Education, George Mason Murray, which ends with the following:

"Black men. Black people, colored persons of America, revolt everywhere! Arm yourselves. The only culture worth keeping is a revolutionary culture. Change. Freedom everywhere. Dynamite! Black Power. Use the gun. Kill the pigs everywhere."

Included in the introduction to an article appearing in the October 5, 1968, edition of "The Black Panther" is the statement "...we will not dissent from American Government. We will overthrow it."

Issues of "The Black Panther" regularly contain quotations from the writings of Chairman Mao Tse-tung of the People's Republic of China and feature Mao's statement that "political power grows out of the barrel of a gun."

The national headquarters of the BPP is located at 3106 Shattuck Avenue. Berkeley, California. Branches have been established at various locations throughout the United States.

The talks by RICE and LITTLE were primarily derogatory and ran down the college and instructors for their lack of black identity and black involvement.

It was learned on 2/21/70, approximately 4 carloads of Panthers went to a dance at Winston-Salem, N.C., State University which was a part of black identity week and ROBERT TAYLOR GREER yelled and cursed at people at the dance for their lack of support for the BPP, threatening to forcibly shave some of the Afro hairdos.

Concerning pertinent BPP activities, it is noted that the group at Winston-Salem, N.C., regularly receives approximately 600 copies of BPP newspaper and are observed selling these papers on streets in Winston-Salem, N.C.

The group held their Huey P. Newton Birthday rally on 2/15/70, a complete transcript of which has previously been furnished to the Bureau. Of interest was the fact that no collection was taken for the Huey P. Newton Defense Fund.

### VIOLENT ACTS, CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA

On August 3, 1969, ten (10) members of the group at Charlotte, North Carolina, desiring affiliation with the BPP were driving around in a rented panel truck. They started following a vehicle occupied by four white teenagers at speeds as high as 50 miles per hour approximately six feet from the bumper of the white teenagers' automobile. The white teenagers' automobile stalled and its occupants ran into the yard of a house on Bellhaven Boulevard, at which time the group in the panel truck fired six shots at them without any known provocation. The panel truck continued on down Bellhaven Boulevard for approximately one-half mile, at which time it was wrecked and the occupants ran into the nearby woods. Local authorities arrested the ten individuals, charging all under the common law of "going armed to the terror of the people" and in addition, one was charged with assault with a deadly weapon and speeding too fast for conditions. Located near the truck were two 12 gauge shotguns and two pistols.

On August 16, 1969, at approximately 3:00 a.m., OTIS_BIACKMON, Negro male, owner and operator of the Chick-N-Ribs

Drive-In, and his son observed two members of the group at Charlotte desiring affiliation with the BPP prowling around the restaurant delivery truck. The two were ordered to leave and an argument developed. Approximately one hour later the two individuals, along with an additional group of Negroes, returned to the drive-in. At this time all were dressed in black with black berets. There were a total of thirteen panthers around with various weapons who started shooting at the building containing the Chick-N-Ribs Drive-In, with OTIS BLACKMON and his son OTIS JAMES BLACKMON returning the fire.

During the shoot out OTIS JAMES BLACKMON was shot in the upper arm.

Concerning the BPP members, JAMES MICHAEL BLACK received a minor qunshot wound in the hand and was arrested by the Charlotte Police Department and charged with assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill. VERONICA MAGANS. Negro female, received a stab wound in the stomach with a butcher knife from OTIS BLACKMON when she attempted to enter the restaurant. CHARLES HENRY, SAMPSON, JR. received a minor gunshot wound, however, required no medical treatment. JAMES MICHAEL BLACK and JAMES EDWARD PRATHER were charged with assault by discharging a firearm into an occupied dwelling. Seized from the Panther group were a .22 caliber rifle and a 7 millimeter bolt action rifle. VERONICA HAGANS refused to make any statement as to how she was stabbed or to bring charges against anyone, however, claimed that upon her being released from the hospital she would kill OTIS BLACKMON herself. As of January 5, 1970, this threat has not been carried out.

Negro school at Greensboro. North Carolina. Supporting the food service workers were a number of students and outsiders who considered themselves to be members of the BPP, the leader of which was ERIC PATRICK BROWN. Contributions were being asked from merchants in the area to support the striking workers, however, the owner of Sid's Curb Market. Mr. BAIN, refused to donate. On the afternoon of March 13, 1969, a group of Negro males led by ERIC PATRICK BROWN who, at that time was the area captain for the BPP in Greensboro, ransacked Sid's Curb Market, doing approximately \$1200 damage and stealing \$400 from the cash register. Mr. BAIN was severely beaten, requiring five stitches to close cuts. That morning, at approximately 8:15 a.m., over one hundred students from Dudley High School, instead of going to class, stayed out of school and listened to representatives of the BPP and at approximately noon the group went back to the school and refused to go to class or disperse, at which time tear gas was used. Rock throwing and sniping at police started that night and continued until the next morning. National quard elements were moved in to assist the police. In the early morning hours no police cars could get in the area of A and T due to heavy fire. With the approach of darkness on May 22, 1969, the sniping resumed and information was received that large quantities of guns and ammunition were observed in Scott Hall. Shortly after 1:00 a.m., May 23, 1969, two regular Greensboro police officers and three auxiliary policemen were hit by gunfire from the area of the Student Union Building. On the morning of May 23, 1969, the campus

was cleared by officers of the North Carolina National Guard using armored personnel carrier. Bottles of sulfuric and hydrochloric acid were tied to limbs of trees as booby traps and four operable weapons were found in Scott Hall. One student was killed and one injured during the disruption. have bragged of their participation in the racial disturbance at A and T State University.

### PLANNED ACTS OF VIOLENCE

During January and February, 1969, individuals at Greensboro, North Carolina, who considered themselves to be members of the BFP, discussed creating a disturbance in a Negro area by rock and bottle throwing to draw a large crowd of police cars. One area mentioned was a dead-end street off Laurel Street in Greensboro. After drawing a crowd of police cars, snipers would then shoot the police officers. It is noted that during the disturbance at A and T State University during March, 1969, five police officers were injured in the area of Laurel Street by some snipers.

On February 8, 1969, a white employee of the Thrifty Curb Market, East Market Street, Greensboro, was involved in an altercation with a Negro male. This information was given to the Black Panthers, who had already discussed the fact that all of the white merchants in the Negro section "had to go." The Black Panther group discussed bombing the Thrifty Curb Market on the night of February 10, 1969, but subsequently called this plan off before five of the Panthers went to the Thrifty Curb Market in African regalia. This was to make their presence known and shake up the manager of the market.

During the last week of May, 1969, and other BPP members rode around Greensboro and Winston-Salem, North Carolina. was planning to locate a place in Greensboro in a better class white residential neighborhood

to fire bomb in order to keep up the tension in Greensboro. Their purpose for going to Winston-Salem was the fact that claimed the Panthers needed more guns and he had picked out a hardware store to burglarize. However, no information was received that either plan was carried out.

NEWTON, BPP Minister of Defense. NEWTON is presently serving a sentence of 2 to 15 years on a conviction of manslaughter in connection with the killing of an Oakland police officer.

The official newspaper, "The Black Panther," which further describes itself as the "Black Community News Service" states that the BPP advocates the use of guns and guerilla tactics in its revolutionary program to end oppression of the black people. Residents of the black community are urged to arm themselves against the police who are consistently referred to in the publication as "pigs" who should be killed

"The Black Panther" issue of September 7, 1968 contains an editorial by BPP Minister of Education, GEORGE MASON MURRAY, which ends with the following:

"Black men. Black people, colored persons of America, revolt everywhere: Arm yourselves. The only culture worth keeping is a revolutionary culture. Change. Freedom everywhere. Dynamite: Black Power. Use the gun. Kill the pigs everywhere."

Included in the introduction to an article appearing in the October 5, 1968, edition of "The Black Panther" is the statement, "...we will not dissent from American Government. We will overthrow it."

Issues of "The Black Panther" regularly contain quotations from the writings of Chairman MAO Tse-tung of the People's Republic of China and feature MAO's statement that "political power grows out of the barrel of a gun."
