





The result of spot surveillances echdusted with reference to the activities of SEM SINGE. The fellowing information was developed on September 2 and 11, 2916 through a serveillance conducted by Special Agents and the writer.

Soulevard, which is the offices of and others at approximately 3:30 P.M. It was ascertained that SIEGEL, VIRGINA HILL and a third party who was unknown but later identified as possibly being drove off in SIEGEL's sar and they were surveilled to the Jules Park Dress Shop at the corner of Beverly Drive and Wilshire Boulevard. Thereafter, these individuals proceeded to Hollywood and subsequently parked in the vicinity of the Gables Apartment, 8250 Fountain Avenue, Hollywood. At that time SIEGEL and VIRGINIA HILL walked to a position near the Gables Apartment and pointed in the direction of one of the floors in the apartment building and thereafter returned to their oar and drove away.

On September 11, 1916, surveillance was again picked up at at 9700 Wilshire Boulevard, where BEN SIEGEL and an individual believed to be left the building and proceeded to a va parking lot in the rear of this office building. was observed to drive away in his dar; however, SIEGEL and the other individual were not seen to depart from the parking lot. Thereafter VIRGINIA HILL was observed in SIEGEL's automobile with another individual in the vicinity of JERRY ROTRUHTID's Barber Shop, Beverly Drive near Milshire Bouleyard. At this time the car and spoke to VIZCINIA HILL and the other individual. Shortly afterwards BEN SIEGEL and an individual thought to be approached the car and these persons engaged in the conversation for approximately one-half hour. BEN SIEGEL, VIRGINIA HILL, and the third individual were surveilled to the Mission Village Motel, 5075 West Washington Boulevard. At this point SIEGEL, HILL and the other individual sat at a table in the coffee shop of the Notel and later SIEGEL and HILL were observed to depart after approximately one and one-half hours. The other individual remained in the Motel. SIEGEL and HILL drove to the apartment, located at 1325 North Gower and it was observed that SIEGEL was in conversation with three women at one time. The identity of the women were not known. SIEGHL then proceeded to 721 North Doheny and the surveillance was discontinued as it appeared that SIEGEL was then proceeding to VIRGINIA HILL's apartment to retire for the evening.

Under pretext Special Agent telephonically ascertained through by the manager of the apartment where VIRGINIA HILL resides that there would be a vacancy in that building beginning October 1, 1946. She further stated that she intended to move into the pent house which was being vacated. It is to be noted that VIRGINIA HILL resides in the pent house at 10814 Wilshire Boulevard.

Subsequent contact with this carrier by Special agent verified the fact that there would be a vacancy in the pent house beginning October 1, 1916 and the earrier has left forwarding address cards with the occupants.

Efforts are being made to determine the new address at which VIRGINIA HILL will move in order to effect complete coverage of that address as HEN SIEGHL undoubtedly will stay with VIRGINIA HILL. It has been noted in the past by surveillance and confidential sources that SIEGHL has been living with HILL.







Dear Bir:

On September 11, 1946 there was developed the first direct connection between BENJAMIN "BUGS" SIEGEL and JACE TRAGNA, when SIEGEL called DRAGNA at the latter's home. At that time SNEGEL mentioned to DRAGNA; the difficulties he was having in connection with the construction of the Flamingo Hotel at Las Vegas, and thereafter the following conversation took place with reference to the new wire service:

How's that business coming along? SIEGEL:

DRAGNA: Well....

I met with that kid about twice since that day you know. SIEGEL:

SIEGEL: Well, we are waiting for what's his name to get the thing in.

They've been stalling them. I talked the other day.

He thinks maybe they will have it in next week.

DRAGNA: Yeah?

SIEGEL: You know what I mean? We didn't get the wire yet.

DRAGNA: I thought you had it in already.

SIEGEL: We are set up already but they told us they won't put the wire in for another couple of months. They are working on them to make them put it in.

DRAGNA: Yeah. Well, what I was going to talk to you about was do you need run-downs over there?

SIEGEL: I won't need anything over there yet, the thing isn't in.
I've got everything.

DRAGNA: Yeah. I don't know.. I wanted to know what kind of service they are getting over there from tracks over here?

SIEGEL: They claim they are getting good service.

DRACNA: Through the California tracks?

SIEGEL: You mean the other people or our people?

DRAGNA: Our people.

SIEGEL: They are supposed to be getting very good service, but if anything comes up and you are not getting anything you can get it from me. You know what I mean?

DRAGNA: Yeah

Apparently if DRAGNA is not able to secure proper conterage at the tracks, SIEGEL will take the information coming in over the CONTINENTAL MEMS SERVICE at Las Vegas and give it to DRAGNA for distribution on the TRANS-AMERICAN wires.

It was further stated that telegrams were reportedly sent from Las Vegas by a veterans organization and labor union to John Small requesting that he withdraw the stop order and allow the work on the hotel to continue. The Los Angeles Division is checking to determine whether these telegrams were actually sent and, if so, the nature of their contents.

Siegel, in a conversation with one of his associates, indicated that he was having another "headache" and when inquired if he was referring to the "thing on the air last night" believed to be the radio broadcast of Drew Pearson, Siegel replied in the affirmative, stating that he did not know who was giving "us the headaches". Siegel further stated that he had spoken to "Back East" and that represents him and that he had instructed that efforts be made to find out "what the H—— it's all about". Upon inquiry, Siegel indicated that he thought "it" would start something, but he did not know and indicated that if they were going to start "Lam going to forget about the whole ED thing".

The Los Angeles Division has further advised that Signi, has reservations to depart via American Airlines from Los Angeles at 10:10 PM, October 3, 1946 for New York where he will arrive at 2:20 PM October 4. Siegel has indicated that he will contact his former wife, Esther Siegel. Siegel's close associate and leg man, left Los Angeles for New York on September 30, 1946, bx and was to register at the Waldorf Astoria on October 1, 1946. He is expected to be in New York about three weeks.






