A. LATAMER SHIPPING COMPANY

It has previously been reported that BERNARD B. AZAROW was an officer of the LATAMER SHIPPING COMPANY.

On January 6, 1959, SA examined the records of the Southern District of New York, which reflected that a Federal Tort Claim Number 86-353 had been filed by BERNARD B. AZAROW, plantiff, vs. United States of America as defendant. This claim arose as a result of a collision involving a Cadillac driven by AZAROW and an United States Postal Service truck at 10th Avenue and 39th Street, New York City, on June 2, 1952.

On February 8, 1955, a judgment of \$695.00 plus \$15.77 interest was rendered for the plaintiff by S. J. RYAN, United States District Judge. Two checks were issued for settlement of the judgment as follows: \$204.45 to claimant BERNARD B. AZAROW, care of JOSEPH MASLON, Attorney, 250 West 57th Street, New York City, and \$506.32 to the Treasurer of the United States. \$446.32 for credit to the individual income tax to be credited to the District Director of Internal Revenue, Newark, New Jersey, for the account of BERNARD B. AZAROW and \$60.00 to the Readjustment Benefits Veterans Administration.









On January 12, 1959, Assistant United States Attorney WILLIAM S. LYNCH, Southern District of New York, declined prosecution of the LAMAMER SHIPPING COMPANY and the RCSINA COSTUME COMPANY since investigation disclosed no violations of the Federal Anti-Racketeering statutes nor of the Labor Management Relations Act.

B. ROSINA COSTUME COMPANY

It has been determined that SAM GALANTE, brother of the subject, continues to operate the ROSINA COSTUME COMPANY, 1515 70th Street, Brooklyn, New York.

It was previously reported that the subject was involved in counterfeiting and picked up by the Secret Service in 1950 for questioning.

It has previously been reported that Detective Captain CHRIS GLEITSMANN of the West New York New Jersey Police Department had been involved in the attempted bribery of the New York State Police on behalf of the subject regarding his arrest for speeding in 1956.

The "Newark Evening News" of December 16, 1958, date line Trenton, New Jersey, reflects that the Superior Court is reserving a decision on the state allegation that Judge PAUL H. DUFFY impeded the case against West New York, New Jersey Detective Captain CHRIS GLEITSMANN. Deputy Attorney General CNERLES S. JOELSON claimed DUFFY stripped the key part of the state's case in ruling that GLEITSMANN should be tried on the charge that he used a police telephone and car for private purposes.

DUFFY dismissed a second charge that GLEITSMANN used the car and phone to bribe a New York State Policeman "to free Brooklyn underworld figure CARMINE GALENTE from a jail term."

JOELSON stated the state "wants to assume the burden of proving that GLEITSMANN went to New York to offer a 'fix.' That is misconduct, not this dust in the air about the use of a telephone and car."



JOELSON contended that DUFFY's dismissal of the second count of the indictment was "abuse of discretion."

THOMAS MC NULTY, GLEITSMANN's attorney, contended there was a "substantial prejudice" in the second count of the indictment because of the phrase "illegal and improper" referring to the use of the car and telephone and the phrase that GALANTE is a "known criminal."

Galante reportedly resided in the lower east side of New York City during his childhood and attended public school through the sixth grade. He left school at the age of 15.

On February 10, 1945, Galante reportedly married Elena Ninfa Marulli, who was born in New York City on September 2, 1916. They have one son, James Galante, born January 27, 1946, and two daughters, Camilla Galante, born January 24, 1951, and Angela Galante born November 14, 1952.

Galante's legal residence is said to be 274 Marcy Avenue, Brooklym, New York, but he has not been seen at this location for quite some time. It has also been reported that allegedly residing in this house are Joseph and May Leggio, the latter being a sister of Helen Galante.

In the past Galante reportedly has been employed by the O'Brien Fish Company, 105 South Street, New York City, and the Lubin Artificial Flower Company, 270 West Broadway, New York City. In 1941, he joined the International Longshoremen's Association and worked as a stevedore. He was also said to be employed at one time as a handy man for the General Electro Plating Company and as a helper for the Knickerbecker Trucking Company. In the late 1940's, his employment was believed to be in a pastry shop at 13 Prince Street, New York City.

Galante's last employment was reportedly listed as the vice-president - treasurer of the Rosina Costume Company, 1515 70th Street, Brooklyn, New York. It has also been reported that Galante is connected with the Latamer Shipping Company, 10 East 49th Street, New York City.

In 1930, Galante was arrested for the murder of a New York patrolman, who was trying to protect a payroll from robbery, in Brooklyn, however, he was released for lack of evidence.

On December 24. 1930, Galante was wounded by who surprised Galante and three other men in an attempted armed robbery of a truck. Galante was captured by after emptying his gun at the detective, piercing his overcoat several times and hitting him in the thigh. Two small children were also wounded in this shooting.

For this offense he received a twelve years and six months sentence. While in Sing Sing prison in 1931, a psychiatric report described Galante as emotionally dull with a mental age of 14% and an IQ of 90. He was diagnosed as a neuropathic, psychopathic personality. He was paroled on May 1, 1939. While on parole to the New York State Parole authorities, considerable suspicion was aroused concerning the legitimacy of his activities, and efforts were made to determine if he was violating the provisions of his parole. On the evening of January 11, 1943, Galante reported to his parele effice and upon leaving, was put under surveillance. He was observed to enter a Ford sedan, the license number of which was noted by the parole officers. Since they had no vehicle available and no other transportation was immediately available, they were unable to continue their surveillance. Shortly thereafter, at approximately 9:40 p. m. that same evening, Carlo Tresca, editor of an Italian language newspaper, was murdered on Fifth Avenue, by an unidentified assailant who entered a Ford sedan in which two accomplices were believed to be waiting. The following morning, an abandoned Ford sedan was found two blocks from the scene of this murder which the police department believed may have been the vehicle used by the escaped murderers. The license plate of this abandoned venidentical to that license number noted by the parole The license plate of this abandoned vehicle was officers from their surveillance of Galante on the previous night. Galante was taken into custody on January 13, 1943, and held in violation of parole since no evidence could be obtained to directly link Galante with this murder, and since -it was not positive that the abandoned vehicle was the murderers! getaway car, Galante was not prosecuted for this murder. however, returned to Sing Sing for violating the provisions of his parele in that he associated with the ex-convict, Joseph Di Palermo, and that he drove an automobile for approximately six months, such being unauthorized under the terms of his parole. He was returned to prison to serve the remaining portion of his sentence. To date this murder has never been solved although the New York District Attorney's Office and New York police officials are reasonably certain that Galante had some part in the Tresca murder.



In October, 1956, it was reported that a meeting was held at the Arlington Motel, Binghamton, New York, sponsored by Joseph Barbara, who was also host at the well publicized Apalachin meeting in November, 1957. It was determined that

In January, 1958, considerable publicity appeared in the local New York newspapers concerning the probe being conducted by the New Jersey Law Enforcement Council into the activities of racketeers. This investigation brought to light the alleged bribery attempts on behalf of Galante by the West New York, New Jersey Police Department.

Concerning the well publicized Apalachin meeting of November 14, 1957, the January 11, 1958, edition of the "New York Daily Mirror" carried an article captioned, "12 on Lam' in Mafia Probe," which reported the activities of the New York Legislative Watchdog Committee. A portion

of this article related that investigators stated that Galante was among the 60 hoodlums attending the Apalachin meeting at the home of Joseph Barbara at Apalachin, New York. He also had visited there in October, 1956, when he was arrested as a traffic violator.

In the "New York Journal American", dated January 9, 1958, an article appeared stating that a law enforcement official told the "New York Journal American" that Carmine Galante was seen in Havana two days before. He stated that prior to that, Galante was observed in Miami Beach in the company of three well-known gangsters. This official was quoted as saying, "We have every reason to believe that Galante may be planning to move into the operations of Havana's Sans Souci gambling concession."

In the "New York Daily Mirror", dated January 11, 1958, an article appeared in connection with the investigation being conducted by the New York Legistlative Watchdog Committee. It was reported that investigators had said that Galante had been reported to have left the United States for Italy, but that the Interior Ministry at Rome had said an extended check had failed to show his entry.

The "New York Herald Tribune", dated January 8, 1958, carried an article stating that Galante was believed to have fled to Italy, where he could enlist the aid of Lucky Luciano for whom he used to run narcotics in Harlem.

The "New York Times", on January 11, 1958, reported that Galante was reported to have fled from the Apalachin meeting, possibly to Italy, but that Interior Ministry sources in Rome had said an extended check had failed to produce any evidence that he was in that country.

On May 18, 1960, the "New York Times" carried an article captioned "Galante Owns Up". This article related that GALANTE surrendered on May 17, 1960 in Federal Court on a recent narcotics violation. The article went on to state that GALANTE was also indicted in 1958 with VITO GENOVESE and 35 others on a narcotics conspiracy charge. GALANTE became a fugitive and after having been in this status for almost a year, he was arrested by New Jersey State Troopers in June, 1959. He was released on \$100,000 bail and has not yet been tried on the 1958 charges.
