Date of transcription 1/11/80

The following is a conversation which was overheard by the writer while he was waiting to chauffeur HOWARD CRIDEN (HC) and JOHN MURTHA (JM) to the Raybern Building, Washington, DC. The conversation took place in the foyer of the Washington townhouse, 4407 W Street, N.W., while the writer was waiting to chauffeur the principals.

The conversation is as follows:

(First part audible)

HC: Tell them to give it to me.

JM: O.K.

HC: I'll take care of you later.

JM: O.K.

HC: But you are going to have to tell them.

JM: O.K.

HC: Lets go back in.

JM: There's two of them, (TONY DE VITO and MEL WEINBERG). If I decide later not to go...
