WHAT CAN WE BUILD (INVEST) IN MY DISTRICT?" THE AMOUNT OF MONEY MENTIONED BY MURTHA THAT WAS AVAILABLE BY THE "OIL PEOPLE" WAS S40-\$50 MILLION.

AFTER RETURNED HOME FROM WASHINGTON, HE RECALLED KNOWING OF A SMALL COAL COMPANY THAT WAS FOR SALE: THE OCEANIC LIGHTING CO. IN BLAIRSVILLE, PÅ. HE THEN TELEPHONED MURTHA THE NEXT DAY, JANUARY 18, 1983, TO FURNISH THE INFORMATION TO HIM. MURTHA THEN SAID TO \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ "HELL, THAT'S TOO SMALL, WE'VE GOT TO HAVE SOMETHING BIGGER THAN THAT."

APART FROM THE ABOVE TWO CONVERSATIONS, ADVISED THAT HE NEVER MENTIONED THE SUBJECT TO MURTHA AGAIN, ALTHOUGH HE HAS SEEN MURTHA TWICE SINCE THEN.

HAS KNOWN MURTHA SINCE 1974, AND ASSISTED HIM IN HIS POLITICAL CAMPAIGN BECAUSE MURTHA IS IN THE COAL CAUCUS.
