These amounts were paid by and subsequent contact with has produced unsatisfactory orally and in writing (Enclosed Item No. 10) acknowledged his indebtedness to however, he eventually advised them he simply did not have the money and would not be able to return the \$40,000.00 initial deposit.

and advised they have paid out \$120,000.00 and the total gate for both performances resulted in approximately \$110,000.00. They, therefore, suffered a \$10,000.00 actual loss as opposed to realizing what should have been a \$30,000.00 profit to be shared at settlement.
