

The subject had also advised that he and his wife had worked on a small farm for a short time, and the last information received from subject was that he was doing some sort of private teaching.

Mr. COHEN advised that VA compensation checks continue to come addressed to the subject at 2020 Walton Avenue, and that he has been holding said checks until such time as he is able to learn the subject's whereabouts and turn said checks over to the subject.

The including of two photographs in a package of \$4,000 might indicate this money was earmarked for these two individuals and the writing on the backs of the photographs could possibly be a parole for a meeting with them by "Wark" or one of his agents. You will recall that during an interview of "Mark" by Agents of this Eureau on July 1, 1957, he was asked concerning the material that was located in his hotel room at the time of his arrest. Our Agents asked "Mark" why he had opened the door to the room when he had so much money in the room. Concerning the money, "Kark" stated he had for years carried fairly large sime of money and no one had ever tried to harm him in any way. As to the other material, "Mark" said that had the FBI called at any other time it would not have found the material in his room. "Mark" said he had brought the material into his room to work on it the night before. He said he :: would not have had the material in his room two hours. later as he would have by then sent it out. Thus, the possibility exists this money had been prepared by "Mark" for delivery to the Cohene or to one of his agents. In view of the above, you may wish to consider the \$4,000 of evidentiary value in this case.

On August 12, 1957, Agents of our New York Office attempted to reinterview and the advised the Agents he would definitely not talk to them without his esterney expens present. You may wish to consider issuing a subposes to bring before a reserve Grand Jury and have him questioned concerning his associations and relations with the subject of this case and with Morris and Long Cohen.

When MORRIS COHEN first came out of the Army, he was not feeling well and lost a good bit of weight.

He studied in MY under the GI Bill of Rights and ultimately became a teacher in the NYC school system.

LONA COHEN was probably in her early 40's at the present time. She described MORRIS COHEN as getting gray hair fast and noted that LONA\_COHEN's hair was a sort of dirty blond.  $\rho$ that LONA COHEN possibly dved her hair to make that LONA COHEN it appear lighter. had had dental work done on her front top teeth and that the job had not been a good one. She described LONA COHEN as the type of individual who were sun glasses and mannish attire. Occasionally, LONA COHEN wore frameless The most significant fact concerning eyeglasses. LONA COHEN (and to others subsequently mentioned) was the fact that LONA COHEN regularly wore slacks the year round.

LONA COHEN spent time in Connecticut on her mother's farm and paid off the bills on the farm.

LONA had received a head injury working in a defense plant during www.II and rather than settle the claim, kept the case open to collect compensation for her injury.


LONA COHEN came from a large Connecticut family who resided possibly in the vicinity of Bridgeport.

LONA COHEN had left her family at the age of 12 or 13, at which time she came to NYC "on her own." She held different jobs, and at one time worked for a wealthy family on Park Avenue or Fifth Avenue, in NYC.

MORRIS COHEN claimed some sort of disability because of Army life and impression that he collected compensation for either frozen feet or snow blindness.

with regard to LONA COHEN and her residence at 178 E. 71st St., NYC, understanding that LONA COHEN had been "put out" of her previous apartment prior to moving to 71st St. address.

LONA COHEN definitely believed in free love and had very loose morals.)

Concerning LONA and MOPRIS! way of life,
they spent very little money and ate

was interviewed at which time

recalled LONA COHEN and identified a photograph of LONA COHEN and MORRIS COHEN, after having viewed app oximately 8 to 10 other photographs having no connection with the COHENS. that LONA COHEN worked in a defense plant somewhere in NYC but never mentioned the name of the plant. He recalled that LONA COHEN and her husband had lived at 178 E. 71st St.. and that approximately one year the COHENS had left

NYC. (It is noted this would place the COHENS! departure in 1950.

that MORRIS COHEN was a school teacher and he noted that LONA COHEN had parents in Connecticut. He described LONA COHEN as a "free thinker," who had funny ideas and who was a pretty heavy drinker.

had never received any mail from the COHENS once they left NYC and they had not indicated to him that they were considering leaving the city in 1950. He said he had no idea where they might have gone.

from her home at approximately 12 years of age, at which time she took an apartment in Greenwich Village, by NYC.

LONA had a "hell of a good time there" and he presumes she met COHEN in this neighborhood,
