The note contains the following message handprinted on Hyatt House Hotel stationery: (U) ."Nureyev -"I made contact with the agent at M.L.S. and he agreed that we should wait before we attempt to 3689Q01427. (U) "I hope you find the note as you requested I put it here on 7-19. I really don't approve of your hiding place, it ENCLO. It is believed possible that the abbreviation M.L.S. refers to Monterey Language School which is a general term used frequently to refer to the Defense Language Institute - West Coast Branch (DLI), which was formerly known as the U.S. Army Language School at Monterey, California. This installation is located approximately 20 miles from the Hyatt House Hotel in Salinas, California. It is known that the Communist bloc intelligence agencies have in the past expressed an interest in the activities at the school.

570 explained that the Hyatt House chain took over operation of the hotel, formerly known as the Wonder Lodge, in June, 1903 and the date referred to in the message as July 19 would have to refer to the year 1963 as Hyatt House stationery was used. She also pointed out that the period 7-19-63 through 7-21-63 is their most active business period as a nationally known rodeo which is held in Salinas every year took place during that eriod in 1963. Most of the rooms during the period are rented to persons in the area to attend the Room 110 is part of a two room suite and has an adjoining door with Room 108. This can be rented as single units or as a two room suite. These particular rooms, however, are located in a section of the hotel Which is infrequently rented as it is near the highway and located in the building most distant from the hotel office. (U)

The hotel rooms are decorated with heavy hollow plaster plaques which were being repainted during March, 1964. When removed one of the plaques in Room 110 to be repainted, the above described note was found. (4)

was questioned as to who might have had access to the room in addition to persons registered as guests and she suggested that anyone in the following 67C categories might easily gain access to the room: (4)

- (1) Any present or past maid, bellboy, or other employee of the hotel. (U)
- (2) Many keys to the rooms have inadvertently or intentionally been kept by guests and it is highly possible that a previous guest failed to turn in the room key and still has such a key in his possession. Also the hotel has run short on room keys on occasion and allowed guests to use pass keys without specifically being told that they had in their possession a pass key. It would be common knowledge for any guest or employee to realize that the building in question was almost never rented and, therefore, make it possible for a person with a key to go in and out of the room with very little fear of being seen. RUDOLPH NUREYEV is a well known male Russian ballet dancer who defected and has received considerable publicity in the American press regarding his dancing with the Royal Ballet Troop which visited the United States on several occasions. He was the subject of an article which appeared on page 45 of the June 14, 1963 issue of Time magazine. (M)

By communication dated July 8, 1963, the Los Angeles Office advised that RUDOLF NUREYEV had last danced with the Royal Ballet at the Hollywood Bowl, Los Angeles, California, on 7-5-63 and was scheduled to depart separately from other members of the troop for New York. (W)

It is noted that Rudolf Nureyev, is a former Russian ballet dancer who defected to the West on 6-16-61 in Paris, France, and who danced with the Royal Ballet on 7-5-63 in Los Angeles. He did not accompany the troupe when it left for New York but went by himself, route and method of travel not known. Informant was asked if he is familiar with the name RUDOLPH NUREYEV and whether he could furnish any information concerning this individual. It is noted that NUREYEV is a Soviet who was formerly associated with the Kirov Ballet, Leningrad, prior to his defection to the West, at Paris, France, on 5/6/63.

Informant immediately recognized the name of NUREYEV as that of a Soviet defector. He also remembered that NUREYEV was a ballet dancer. He said that somewhere he heard NUREYEV had written a book but informant said he has never seen this book and has not read it. He said that, to his knowledge, no one in the Soviet colony in NY has ever spoken of NUREYEV in his presence. Informant said he could furnish no information relating to NUREYEV's defaction, nor does he have any information reflecting that NUREYEV has, in any way, been connected with espionage activity.

Informant said it is his recollection that NUREYEV "escaped" from the Soviet Union in 1961. He said NUREYEV was not a particularly famous dancer in the Soviet Union.

Information copies are being furnished Las Vegas since that office still has active investigation in this matter.

When incorporating information furnished by into communications suitable for dissemination outside the Bureau, Bureau authority is not necessary when the information can be paraphrased so that the identity of the informant is not jeopardized. When certain specific information is of such a nature as to prohibit dissemination, the Bureau should be advised of the basis for non-dissemination.

Certain information furnished by will be of such a nature as to necessitate a classification above "Confidential", since the disclosure of this information to unauthorized persons could have a detrimental effect upon international relations and the national desense. In all other instances, a classification of "Confidential" will be adequate if the information relates to Soviet nationals and can be adequately paraphrased.

When disseminating information received from no reference should be made to the time (date, month or year) the information was received. This should be set forth administratively.

Suitable paraphrasing of the information to be disseminated, plus concealment of the time of its receipt will materially assist in concealing the identity of the source.

IN VIEW OF THE HIGHLY SENSITIVE POSITION OF EXTREME CAUTION MUST BE EXERCISED IN HANDLING ANY INFORMATION ATTRIBUTED TO THIS SOURCE, AND NO ACTION TAKEN WHICH COULD CONCEIVABLY JEOPARDIZE THE SECURITY OF THE INFORMANT OR REVEAL HIS IDENTITY.
