



The Teddy Kennedy mess

Official investigation of the recent Teddy Kennedy mess leads one to the conclusion that the police officials are either stupid or attempting a cover up.

The police, the public, and even the press, seem to have forgotten that a woman lost her life, and that Kennedy is directly responsible.

Senator Mansfield was quoted as stating that "it could happen to anyone." We agree that it could happen to almost anyone, but we would bet that the average citizen, in a similar situation in the same town, would have been treated differently. He would probably be behind bars or at least out on bail under a charge of either criminal negligence or involuntary manslaughter, rather than simply "leaving the scene of an accident." We also believe that if Mr. average citizen had been involved an autopsy would have been performed. formed.

The first meager press reports which appeared on Saturday, including an interview with the Chief of Police, made no mention of any injury to Senator Kennedy. However, a day or two later, it was reported that he suffered a slight concussion and a back injury; and when the Senator appeared at Miss Kopechne's funeral, he was wearing a neck

Senator Kennedy appears to have a very convenient memory. He recalled that he dove repeatedly in an effort to find Miss Kopechne, yet the car was found resting on its top in only eight feet of water with the window on the driver's side open. Under these circumstances, diving as such would not have been required. Kennedy, an excellent swimmer, should have been able to stand on the car, slip down the side, and through the window. Even an inexperienced swimmer should have had no difficulty under these conditions. conditions.

Failing in his own efforts, Kennedy could have summoned help from any one of five cottages located between the scene of the accident and the cottage to which he returned, according to his story, on foot. There might well have been a pocket of air in the car which could have kept the young lady involved alive for a considerable period of time.

The Senator's mind was perfectly clear about the diving, clear about finding his way back to the cottage where the party was being held, and equally clear about climbing into the back seat of a car and being taken to his accommodations in Edgartown. Yet he failed to seek help and failed to report the matter to the police until eight or ten hours after the accident, when he appeared at Police Headquarters with an attorney at his side.

Incidentally it has never been explained how Kennedy got off the island to return to Martha's Vineyard. Since the last ferry had left long before we presume he returned by private boat. Also it is impossible to understand how Kennedy got lost and took the wrong route. It has been reported he had driven this area frequently and was thoroughly familiar with it.

In addition, it is reported that Kennedy and two companions returned to the scene of the accident via the 8:15 a.m. ferry Saturday morning. This was prior to reporting to the police. This adds mystery to the muddle.

Ted Kennedy's integrity has been open to question since the day he was thrown out of Harvard for cheating, and this entire mess reminds us of a line we recall from child-hood:

hood:

"Oh, what a tangled web we weave When first we practice to deceive."

It is doubtful that the American public is going to be satisfied with the hogwash that has been released to date.

The fact that Mr. Kennedy pleaded guilty to the charge of leaving the scene of an accident and was given a suspended two-month jail sentence can only lead all Americans to believe that a major coverup may be in the making.

If there is to be any true justice in this country, a complete investigation of the entire matter is required. And we





Sen. Kennedy's Explanation

As is right in a democracy, each interested person will decide for himself whether Sen. Edward M. Kennedy's nationally televised explanation of his actions in the Chappaquiddick auto tragedy was sufficiently plausible and rational.

Why, for example, did the two men he summoned from the cottage to dive for the missing girl not call the police and seek help? One of them was a lawyer.


Why the next morning, hours after the accident, did he cross back to Chappaquiddick Island and seek to call a family legal adviser from a public telephone? This, again, before calling police.





Dear Senator Kennedy:

An out-of-town trip has prevented me from writing this letter heretofore but the events surrounding your accident at Edgartown demand comment, even if belated. I realize that you personally will never see this letter; that a legion of workers in your office will short-stop this and many other letters long before they reach your desk. A response must nevertheless be made.

Senator, I am one of the "silent millions" of this country who, I'm ashamed to admit, has never written a letter, or otherwise expressed his views, to the President, a congressman or other national and state representatives, or to the minions of the press and television.

But as a result of your accident and the obvious, self-serving whitewash by the prejudiced liberal wing of the press, television news analysts and local judiciary in minimizing, to the point of casualness, your inexcuseable movements following the tragedy and your incredibly selfish decision not to promptly report the mishap, as any conscientious, responsible citizen would, I do not, Senator, intend to stay silent any longer.

For the past decade, Senator, a sickness has insiduously spread across this country, resulting in a wave of crime, cynicism, irresponsibility and deviationism, one of the causes for such sickness being the alarming, tragic, national decline in our respect for the principles of law and order. This respect was on the brink, Senator, until your unfortunate affair pushed it over. For much more was at stake here than your career or legacy. Without exception, every adult that I've talked to, Senator, whether in the office, on the street or in the neighborhood knows perfectly well that had it been him who had left that girl's body bobbing around like some innate flotsam in his submerged car for nine hours before notifying the authorities, he would have been properly charged and subsequently imprisoned. The excuse that "it could have happened to anyone" is of course pointless, ridiculous and irrevalent when a breach of law is involved. The quick initial dismissal and writeoff of this strange case only serves to further make a mockery of justice and to strengthen the growing contempt in this count for righteous behavior. 

"The Richmond News Leader" issue dated April 4, 1963, published daily at Richmond, Virginia, stated that this organization is chartered in the State of Virginia as "The George Lincoln Rockwell Party" and that the Virginia Assembly prohibits the use of "Nazi" or "National Socialism" in a Virginia-chartered organization. As of January 1, 1967, the official name of this organization was changed to "National Socialist White People's Party", according to Commander Rockwell.

On August 25, 1967, George Lincoln Rockwell was assassinated in Arlington, Virginia, near the ANP Headquarters Building. The August 28, 1967, issue of the "Northern Virginia Sun", a daily newspaper published at Arlington, Virginia, stated that _______, took command of the Party after Rockwell's assassination.

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DR. JOHN KNOWLES, who was bumped by Strom Thurmond and the AMA as Richard Nixon's prospective science adviser, is plotting his revenge. He kept a diary of the whole seamy episode and will soon publish it as a book to be called "Knowles's Complaint." He also plans to run for statewide office in Massachusetts as a liberal, anti-Nixon Republican on the idea that "arch-reactionaries have taken control of the White House."

FBI DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER has quietly assigned several agents to Martha's Vineyard in an effort to come up with information on Teddy Kennedy. Kennedy's people are furious about this and view it as a continuation of Hoover's vendetta against all the Kennedys.

LAST MONTH 49 MEMBERS of the House voted against the \$1.8 million supplemental military appropriation for Vietnam. Among those who voted against the latest war subsidy were such local non-rebels as Leonard Farbstein and Bert Podell. But Allard Lowenstein, founder of the "Dump LBJ" movement, voted for it. When asked to explain his strange vote, Lowenstein told The Voice: "It was a mistake. I meant to vote against it. I didn't understand what we were voting on."

At the same time he voted for the Vietnam appropriation, Lowenstein was up to his old tricks of attempting to manipulate his former protegos in the student movement. He has been trying to force the group of former Eugene McCarthy activists (Sam Brown, Dave Mixner, David Hawk) who are planning a one-day student moratorium against the war on October 15, to issue a strong statement against "student violence."

"Lowenstein insists," said one student organizer, "that we attack students every time we mention the war. He keeps giving us ultimatums that we do it his way, or not at all."

Since the students have now rejected Lowenstein's guidance, Lowenstein has quietly been trying to undercut them, mostly by turning moderate Congressmen like Republicans Ogden Reid and Bob McClosky of California against the former McCarthy organizers. Many Congressmen regard Lowenstein as their guide to youth politics and now take his word that the moratorium movement is too far out to be legitimate. Says Dave Mixner, who was one of those McCarthy staffers most badly beaten by Chicago police during the Democratic convention and who is personally committed to non-violence: "Lowenstein has been trying to destroy us. He tells everyone we're kooks, when we're just McCarthy-Kennedy people. But because of him, we have to spend more time justifying ourselves than organizing against the war."

THE NEW YORK TIMES is sitting on a potential blockbuster story written by Sidney Zion over a month ago. The story, very long and heavily researched, charges Second Circuit Judge Henry J. Friendly with conflict of interest. Friendly also happens to be a leading contender for Abe Fortas's "Jewish seat" on the Supreme Court. But despite frustrated proddings by Zion, the Times has refused to print the story.

Dear Sir:

After a great deal of thinking I am taking the liberty of writing to you. My name is Mrs. ______, wife of Dr. _____ who at the present is connected with the Hebrew Union College functioning as Councilor of Scholars, Director of Research and Reference Librarian of their famous Library.

My letter concerns Senator Kennedy, Certainly, I need not go into details of the accident that resulted into death of a young woman caused entirely by the irresponsible and immature conduct of the driver who ignored simple and clear road signs that lead to the ferry to which he was supposed to take his companion. If this accident had not occurred the whole world would never have known that Senator Kennedy deliberately had violated simple traffic regulations and taken a road e for some purpose or other e no other person would chose in his right mind, be it, as said before, for a certain purpose. But this is not the point at all. And it is not the point why I am writing to you.

I am writing to you about what developed later. I am asking myself over and over again, how could it happen that this affair was hushed over? Believe me, Mr. Hower, I am not hard at heart, I am not young in years, but I just can't stand still and just say: "I am disgusted" uttered these days by young and old, rich and poor, learned and otherwise. When one asks: "Don't you do anything about it", the categorical answer is: "What can one do, it won't do any good, he is a Kennedy". " I don't remember! I was confused and in shock!". but he remembered well enough to telephone HIS LAWYER and to change his clothes before reporting the accident to the police.

By panicking he sealed his own doom as a leader in the Senate and as a Presidential candidate. To spare his friends and colleagues in the Senate further embarrasment he should vacate the post of Majority Whip voluntarily.

The Feds Are Still Listening To Us Here

The Federal Bureau of Investigation's world of electronics was short circuited in 1965 when hotelmen Carl Cohen, Edward Levinson, Johnny Drew and a host of others located and removed electronic

listening devices in their homes and offices. They couldn't sue the Federal government or the FBI, but the FBI agents, as individuals, were vulnerable.

In Nevada, wiretapping has long been a violation of state law. Still, the FBI was heavily engaged in the listening business on orders from Washington under the doctrine that there is a Cosa Nostra and a Mafia, that it does deal in narcotics, gambling and sundry vicious products, that it is a disgrace and should be eliminated. On balance, what if the taps violate the privacy of a few hundred persons?

In Indiscretion In LV

Peephole journalism isn't our forte. Yet, when an aspirant for the Presidency of the United States visits Las Vegas and conducts himself in a manner so appalling that it reflects on still a

subsequent indiscretion, it should be put on the record. The eyes of the nation will be focused on the inquest in Massachusetts on Sept. 3 into the death on July 18-19 of Mary Jo Kopechne. The voids in the story of Miss Kopechne's death as told by Sen. Edward Kennedy perhaps can be placed in their proper perspective by his activities in Las Vegas.

Nevada Report regrets to be the purveyor of such a sordid tale, yet the circumstances demand it. These are the facts:

"The hotelman was evasive. The detectives persisted and got impatient.

"Well, he's in there, just getting some rest," the hotel official said, pointing to room 1895.

"We're assigned to protect him, so we'll stay here too," the detectives said, meaning an awkward wait in the corridor outside room 1895.

Soon the hotel employee returned with a key to the room directly across the corridor. The detec-

tives went inside, left the door open and made themselves comfortable.

Midnigh Refreshments Delivered

Minutes later, they were alerted to the sound of . footsteps in the corridor. It was a young man in the uniform of a room service clerk. He was carrying a bottle of Scotch and a bottle of Vodka. He knocked on a door of No. 1895. The door was opened by an attractive bosomy blonde, about 25 years old, and a one-time showgirl before the Sands discontinued its chorus line. She took the liquor and ice and gave the clerk \$30.

Sen. Kennedy had a 7 a.m. flight for Springfield, Mo., where he was to be the keynote speaker for an agricultural group. So, the detectives were pounding on the door before 6 a.m. to awaken him. Again, the attractive blonde opened the door, then slammed it immediately. A short time later, a Mexican-American, about 50 years old, also wearing a room service uniform, knocked at the door. The girl opened it, and the room service waiter pushed a table containing a breakfast spread into the room. Sen. Kennedy and the girl sat down to breakfast.

About 10 minutes later, the girl left the room alone. Sen. Kennedy emerged a few minutes later, joined the two detectives and the three returned to the Sahara where he could check out of his room and leave for the airport. There was little conversation - there was nothing to talk about.

The story would never have needed telling had it not been for Mary Jo Kopechne.

Political Twist To Water Pollution

Washington has its Potomac, Cleveland its Cuyahoga and Detroit its Lake Erie all of which have a common denominator - they are cesspools of industrial and household waste. Pollution is closing in on the Vietnam war and crime in the streets as examples of human helplessness.

Nevada, which hoped to be the brilliant American exception, is becoming ever more concerned about the quality of water in Lake Tahoe and Lake Mead. In alarm, the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce turned to the Hughes organization to underwrite

and analysis of the problem in the south.

The task fell on Hughes man John Meier, who prepared a detailed study of the water pollution problem and a solution, which received wide press coverage. It concludes that the water can be useful if it is deposited somewhere other than Lake Mead. But, involved in such a project is the fight through a maze of bureaucratic and political hurdles. Since the pollution of Lake Mead is comparatively recent, it could be cleaned up for a fraction of the cost of a similar project for Lake Erie. The Meier solution involves a self-financing plan since the waste water would be sold for agricultural purposes, and the nitrates and phospates of Las Vegas effluent are the ingredients which make the grass grow green.

What was unforseen with the Meier study was that the young executive would become so embroiled in the matter that he is going to attack it on the political level. Look for Meier to quit the Hughes organization before the end of the year and run for one of the state's highest public offices where he can grappel with air and water pollution at its bureaucratic center. And, it will all be with the blessing of Hughes. I will all be with the

the FBL operated out of its building at 11th and Bridger Streets it had two recording studies and a capability for 200 wiretaps e FBI now occupies quarters in the new Federal building at Bridger Street and Las Vegas Boulevard South, along with 400 telephone wiretap circuits.

Whereas the 1965 wiretapping violated Nevada law, and the FBI agents, had they been caught, could have gone to jail, the 1969 version of this electronic invasion is being done with some semblance of legality. Under provisions of the Omnibus Crime Bill of 1968, wiretapping can be done under an order signed by a Federal judge. Orders apparently are being prepared in Los Angeles, couriered to Las Vegas by Mike DeFeo, a member of the Rackets Division of the Justice Department, and executed by the FBI.

Orders Good 30 Days

The administrative orders must be signed by a Federal judge in the district. In this case, the entire state of Nevada is a single Federal judicial district in which three judges are empowered to sign such orders. The court order to tap a telephone or bug aroom is good for 30 days. It can be renewed for an indefinite number of 30-day periods providing the investigators can show that some progress is being made in their case. But, after the electronic eavesdropping is completed, the investigators must notify the "bugee" within 90 days that they have been listening. There has not been too much conversation by or about those who have been so notified, but they presumably include many prominent local persons and public officials.

District Attorney Bugged

One of them who has not been notified is District Attorney George Franklin, who told NEVADA REPORTER, "I called in an expert and found the private phone in my office was tapped. The tap goes outside the courthouse. They are tapping all public officials for information."

Franklin said that a tap on his telephone line is illegal in that the Crime Control Bill allows bugging only in the event that a person is suspected of committing a crime. Franklin assumes that wiretapping of public officials for "information" is illegal, and if such is the case, felony charges

will be filed and prosecuted.

Franklin is also of the opinion that the eavesdropping is being carried out without the knowledge or cooperation of the Central Telephone Co., which a few years back had to defend itself, along with FBI agents, in a multi-million dollar law suit for illegally invading the privacy of a number of local gamblers.

Phone Company Innocent?

"On a prior murder case," Franklin said, "the telephone company refused to accept a legal court order authorizing a wiretap to trap a suspected. murderer. They said they would rather be in contempt of court than to risk any more civil litigation for "invasion of privacy."

Franklin said he has no objection to any wiretapping providing the provisions of the Federal law are followed - and he's not too concerned about the tap on his private line. He has had no complaints from local persons about their lines being bugged, probably because "they are lawyers, bankers,

businessmen and public officials who would be the . last in the world to suspect it."

How did Franklin, get suspicious of his telephone? "The first mor I got was that there were town, including taps on all of the numerous taps telephones in the rederal courthouse, so I though I'd better have my line checked," Franklin said.

Another employee of the Federal building said his boss in Washington told him a few months ago

that the "bugs were back on."

"There is no excuse for any wiretapping in Las Vegas," Franklin said. "There is no way in the world to involve Hughes, Kerkorian or Del Webb , in organized crime. They'd do much better to do their wiretapping in Chicago, New York, Philadelphia or Los Angeles than in Las Vegas."

: Legality Questioned

The question of wiretapping legality will be debated for years. The United States Supreme Court has already ruled that evidence obtained through the use of listening devices is not admissible in court. Can Congress, through last year's legislation, legalize an act which the courts say is wrong? Many persons in the legal profession say "NO." Some say that only an amendment to the U. S. Constitution can bring the investigative fruits of a wiretap or bug into the court of law as evidence. The answer to this perplexity could well be decided on the trial level by Nevada's Roger D. Foley or Bruce Thompson, the two U.S. District Judges assigned to this state. The final decisions, of course, must come from the U. S. Supreme Court, and the courts are usually three to four years behind the issues.

A Botched Job

Installation of the exotic circuits and listening devices by the FBI wasn't without its lighter side. The Feds.weren't satisfied with the job the Central Telephone Co. provided. So, the FBI tore up the concrete flooring to get at the telephone cable, in order to replace it with a job by their own electronics experts. The job was botched, short circuited, and every telephone in the building was out of service for a few hours. This in itself is interesting in that the telephone company forbids any "do-it-yourself" tampering with its equipment. If you get caught, they'll cut off your services.

DeFeo, the attorney who is drawing up the wiretap court orders, is no stranger to Nevada. He works in the Los Angeles office of the Department of Justice and was a key figure on the prosecution and conviction of Maurice Friedman and T. Warner Richardson, both former Vegas gamblers, in the Friar's Club gin rummy cheating case. DeFeo also spent a number of years in the Las Vegas office. of the U.S. Attorney, and it was during the tenure that Levinson was indicted for "skimming." Levinson retaliated with the bugging suit against the FBI, and for a while, it looked like a standoff.

When Levinson dropped his civil action for damages against the FBI agents and the telephone company, the government dropped its tax evasion charges against him, and Levinson bowed out of Nevada gambling. No one would admitthat a "deal" .: had been made, but the facts defy any other explanation. The result is that business discussions and deals are still being made in moving cars and on street corners. Las Vegas continues to live up to its reputation as the "most bugged city in the nation.




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

THE NEW CHIEF JUSTICE of the United States, Warren C. Burger: told the lawyers of the United States the other day that the American people were "nearing the end of their patience with the American machinery of justice," and the Kennedy case seems to illustrate his point.

First there was no autopsy to determine the cause of the death of Mary Jo Kopechine, who was in the car driven by Sen. Edward Kennedy. when it plunged off the dike bridge on Chappaquiddick Island. Then there was another legal wrangle over whether there should be an official inquiry into the case and whether the body of the dead girl should be exhumed. Finally, an inquiry was ordered without assurance of cross examination of the witnesses, and after an appeal, the inquiry was postponed.

No doubt this is all quite satisfactory and even proper in the eyes of lawyers and judges who run "the machinery of justice," but Kennedy's problem as a politician is not primarily with the courts of Massachusetts but with the court of public opinion, and his decision to seek another postponement in the case is bound to be interpreted as another attempt to use the technicalities of the degal procedure to postpone if not to evade ques-

Nearly 10 years ago, Esther James received a detault judgment against Congressman Adam Clayton Powell because he called her a "bag woman" on a TV program. He probably could have settled this by an apology and a small sum, but he chose to defy the law. As a result, he was held in contempt and the judgment jumped to over \$165,000. Meanwhile, the time of over 15 judges was consumed in trying to answer the questions of law necessary to decide Powell's moves to exploit the technicalities of the judicial system, and the case is still in the courts.



The Dr. Sam Sheppard case also added to the sense of dismay and confusion over the decisions of the courts First, Dr. Sheppard was convicted of murdering his wife in 1954. This was reversed in 1958, not because the evidence of guilt was found insufficient, but because the court held lie had been tried in a "carnival atmosphere." FInally, he was acquitted in a new trial, but why if he was not guilty was he held in jail for years before he was given the new trial?

These cases, of course, are all different but each in its own way - and many others like them in recent years - have all contributed to the puboften used not to bring about justice but to evade it. And beyond this, to the widespread feeling that there is one law for the rich who have money; influence and clever lawyers; and another law for the poor who have neither money nor influence.

In fact, it was precisely this feeling that Kennedy was getting special treatment - that he was come up with some answers to the problem of getting off without an autopsy of Mary Jo Kopechne, and without an official inquiry that led to the public outery in the press for court action.



Kennedy and his advisors and the old campaign crews of John and Robert -that is the top brass, were going to the boat races, then have a big
party after it was over. They were having it at a summer home out
around Martha's Vinyard. The home is owned by the late John's
campaign manager. There were fifteen couples invited, and like Dr.
says, the doctor friend of his had to have been there. After the races,
they all left for the house party. Mary Joe and another friend of Teddy's
drove over in Kennedy's car. The real purpose of the party was a
farewell to all who had helped in many campaigns.

The doctor said that Kennedy was thinking of dropping out of the political picture due to cranks--everyday a threat of some kind to him or his family--he was (or is) thinking about political writing--anyway he made phone calls to people high in politics even Robert McNamara.

As the party went on, and the booze in, and everyone full -- Mary Joe became ill and went outside and curled up in the back seat of Kennedy's car. next part is what I heard on the radio many times, that the law was watching him (Kennedy) and the party all day, which was a safety precaution, and at the house a Dept. Sheriff was stationed off to one side just in case of rubbernecks and cranks etc. The Dept. saw a woman get into Kennedy's car, and later Teddy and a woman got in and drove off. This was around 12:30 a.m., this is why it came out in the press and radio that there was three in his car; this was the Depty's report the next day -- are you still with me? I hope this isn't old hatl. Teddy and his lady companion had changed clothes and were going swimming over at a little bay. Well he was driving and full and missed the bridge, his front wheel went off the side and it flipped upside down in four feet of water. He and the gal crawled out, shook up a little but able to walk, and started back to the party, and were almost there when she said her purse was in the car. So they go back to the place and he dove in many times trying to retrieve it. He gave up and they walked back and told everyone what had happened and everyone laughed about what people would say about the purse. He was asked about reporting the car and he said, "to heck with it now". Along in the early morning someone

missed Mary Jo, and the search was on. Kennedy called a friend (in bed) to meet him at a dock with his boat because the ferry didn't operate all night. Kennedy's friend called another fellow and they both went over and brought him back to the mainland. This accounts for the lapse in time. Dr. friend says the biggest mistake he ever made was to go on TV with that big windy and knowing full well that that girl, or anyone else was not in the back seat of his car. Also the doctor said if he, Kennedy would have consulted his mother first, this would never have happened (TV) -- I think I will have to go along with this. I would also plant a Claymore mine on top of her grave.

In Re: Kennedy-Kopechne Case

Please find enclosed a report of the Kennedy-Fitzgerald family which may be of interest to you. I have known this family for more than 50 years, having originally contacted Kennedy's grand uncles in 1920.

It seems that the court officers and others interested in the matter stepped on each other trying to protect the Kennedy millions. It is indeed a pitiful state of affairs in Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

I hope that you are taking necessary steps to correct this infamous case. It is up to the Federal Government to step in and take whatever steps are necessary to correct the shortcomings of the Massachusetts and Pennsylvania courts.

Although Kennedy is elected by the Massachusetts voters, once he goes to Washington, he becomes a federal official and represents not only Massachusetts, but all 50 states of the union, nationally and internationally.

I was greatly surprised at the pitiful attitude taken by Senator Brooke in the matter. He found the moral character of Judge $^{\rm H}$ answorth and Judge Carswell below moral standards, but he could not see anything wrong with the moral standards of Senator Kennedy, his colleague.

It seems to me that the Kennedy millions have been wrecking the with the courts and other offices. The Judge found Kennedy and Kennedy claimed he told the truth at the inquest; therefore, he called the Judge a liar. REPORT: KENNEDY-KOPECHNE CASE

In February, 1922, I had original contact with the Kennedy-Fitzgerald family. While attending a tax audit of Baxter & Whitney, Inc., manufacturers of woodwork and machinery for the Ford Motor Company, whose cars at that time were entirely made of wood, I had dinner at the Hotel Winchendon. At the same time, It appears that the Winchendon Chamber of Commerce had a dinner. The speaker was Mayor Fitzgerald of Boston, the grandfather of Edward Kennedy. After the dinner, I was asked by one of the officials if Mrs. Robba could play the Sweet Adeline song for Mayor Fitzgerald. I told the official to ask Mrs. Robba, that, if she is willing, I have no objections; and she did. After dinner, Mayor Fitzgerald presented her with a bouquet of flowers, which were on the speakers table. Mr. William H. Whitney, President and Treasurer of Baxter & Whitney, Inc., lent us very kindly the use of his automobile to take us back to Worcester where we were staying overnight at the Bankcroft Hotel.

The Second occasion I had to meet Kennedy's relative was at a meeting of the brother of Mayor Fitzgerald, who was Treasurer of the Turner-Tanning Machinery Company of Peabody, Massachusetts. It seems that the Turner-Tanning Machinery Company filed false tax returns for three years in World War I, and since the amount due was over \$200,000, which would be equal to \$1,000,000 today, they were informed by the Collector of Internal Revenue O'Malley that they would have to go to jail for filing false tax returns, since the amount was so enormous. The other brother of Mayor Fitzgerald was a partner of Fitzgerald Stock Brokers of Boston, then located at 7 Park Avenue, the present location of the Federal Reserve Bank in Boston. The one brother was President and the other was Treasurer of the Turner-Tanning Machinery Company. At that time, I was tax manager for the Boston and Worcester offices of Marwick, Mitchell, Peat & Co., which was then the biggest accounting firm in the United States, with 67 offices. I was assigned the case and went to Peabody to look over the situation. I took some data that I required and went to Washington and submitted my case to the Internal Revenue Service. They agreed to consider the matter as long as I could get the data together and submit an intermediate report. On returning to Boston, I went to Peabody and started working on the case to prepare the figures for the Internal Revenue Service. It took me six months to get the data together. After I

had my report ready, I went back to Boston and submitted my report to the IRS. They agreed to accept my report and to complete a final report showing all adjustments. When I came back to Boston, I was informed that the crooked Fitzgeralds had sold the company to the United Machinery Co., Inc., who had offices at the Chamber of Commerce Building at 75 Federal Street, Boston. I was requested to attend a conference with the United Machinery Co., Inc., officials; the President, the Treasurer, and all the legal and tax counsels. I submitted by information and informed them, that I was leaving Washington Sunday night, having made arrangements for a conference with the IRS for Monday morning. I told them that on my return from Washington, I would advise them what steps to take to settle the case. They told me not to wait, but after settling the case with the IRS in Washington to call them up on the telephone in Boston and reverse the charges, that they would wait in the office during their lunch hour, 12 o'clock until 1 p.m. I left for Washington Sunday night and had a conference on Monday morning; and the IRS fully agreed to accept my case and settled the matter on the basis of my report. I called up the United Machinery Co. office at 12:30 p.m. and informed them that the case was settled satisfactorily on the basis of my report; they were greatly satisfiedd You can see from this, that I was instrumental in keeping the Kennedy-Fitzgerald grand uncles out of jail; and I may mention that I did not even get a letter of thanks from those crooks.

The third instance was when Kennedy's father was ambassador in Loudon, England. He bought some liberty ships from the United States for \$100,000 and sold them back to the United States in devious ways for \$3,000,000, making a profit of \$2,900,000. You and I, Mr. Hoover, and all the other citizens of the United States had to make up for the loss of taxes. That is how the Kennedy millions were acquired. The election of Kennedy as President, the brother of Edward Kennedy, as you may realize, was illegal. Since it appears that he was elected by 110,000 votes out of 70,000,000 votes, it seems absurd to me that a re-election was not requested; it appears that the Kennedy millions paid off the Republican Party to keep quiet.

The fourth instance was when Kennedy committed a crime. It seems to my way of looking at it that Mary Jo was pregnant. It was only natural that the parents wanted the Judge to stop the autopsy; they did not want to have their daughter appear as a prostitute. It appears that is exactly what she was.

I enclose a few newspaper clippings which will prove that my contention is right. Even Europe knew about the case; I had received letters from my friends in Vienna; they were surprised how the matter was being taken care of in Massachusetts. A stamped, self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience.






