PIERCE CITY — Honoring Mrs. Lucy Wight of nearby Wen-tworth, a pre-Mother's Day tes-timonial was set by her son Jason in the cemetery her son ba-son could possibly cause some controversy in the nation's song-writing circles.

Imprinted on the monument of Carthage marble are Wight's statements which say that Mrs. Wight is the author and origin of more than twenty lyrics which have become popular in the last

Most of these are listed, by name on the monument and provably the most important is "White Christmas," a song "White Christmas," a song which has had sales in the mil-lions. Origin of many others is claimed for her by her son, in-clud in g "Tumbling Tumble-weeds", "Old Spinning Wheel" and "Pennics from Heaven", emeng the more nonular among the more popular. $\star \star \star$

Mrs. Wight was born Jan. 1, 1894, on what is known as the "Old Crewse Place" at Manes, Mo., and for about all of her 76, years has shown a propensity. for poetry.

First recollection of her First recollection of her-poetical nature, she says, came when as a small girl she showed-her father, Frank, Tarmer, a little poem she had written. "He' called me his little poet," Mrs. Wight said, "and that just about thrilled me to cleath."

thrilled me to death." She then told how the lyrics of "White Christmas" came to be written. "I was writing my" Christmas cards one day," she explained, "when I looked outf the window and saw the snew coming down soft and white. Then the sun came out and the snew glistened in the treatons snow glistened in the treetops. One of the cards I was addressing had a picture of Santa Claus in his sleigh riding over a house-

top. "The words came to me naturally and I wrote them down." Pausing in the work of setting the monument, son Jason added other information. "She had left her mark with other lyrics," he said, "even before those depres-sion days of the 1930s with, for example, 'Paper Doll'. These

lyrics went out sometime before the first copyright date of 1930."

Members of her family did little to encourage her in those early days, Mrs. Wight remem-bers, when they told her it was useless to send the lyrics to pos-sible publishers and that she "would never get a dime for them"

She said she told them the lyries would do no earthly good ly-ing around the house and added 'Maybe they'll make somebody

"They made a lot of people happy," son Jason said, "But

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



WHILE READING CONGRESSMAN H. R. GROSS'S LEGISLATIV NUMBER 1165 DATED APRIL 19TH, I CAME ACROSS THE FOLLOWI CERPT WHICH CAUGHT MY ATTENTION:

HEADLINE IN WASHINGTON POST (APRIL 13): "CHAPPAQUIDICK, A BILL TO THEREAFTER FOLLOWS THE STORY THAT SENATOR EDWARD M. KENNEDY, OF MASSACHUSETTS, HAS INTRODUCED A BILL (S. 3485) TO MAKE THE SAVE IT. ISLAND OF CHAPPAQUIDICK A NATIONAL PARK AT A COST OF \$20 MILLION IN FEDERAL FUNDS. THE BILL SAYS THE LEGISLATION AND FUNDS ARE NECESSARY TO "PRESERVE AND CONSERVE THE UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS OF A UNIQUE AREA."

He was requested to furnish b6 a copy of the communication and when this was received a check was. b7C made of records at Bureau Headquarters and no record of the communication could be found. subsequently was contacted and asked if Secret Service might also have the original. He subsequently reported back that they had found the original in their office, adding that there was no indication as to how it was received. He was requested to return the original document to Mr. In the meantime telephonically contacted in Senator Kennedy's Office and advised her of the contents of the communication. She stated is known to the office and has done part-time work in the past in the Kennedy Office in Boston. She implied that the letter in all probability was written because of personal spite, perhaps on the part of other employees in the office, although she did state that "does have a problem." She was advised that the FBI was taking no further action concerning this matter. On 12/18/72, the enclosed communication dated 12/13/72from James J. Rowley, Director, Secret Service, was received enclosing the original copy of the anonymous communication. Secret Service has taken no action on this matter. 



Dear Sir:

It has been some time since you have told the panel of the Association of American Law School, but it had motivated enough to come about with the enclosed information that thus far has not been in the front pages of the "news-media".

At any rate it does point out to you and others in the "system" of judicial affairs, that this is still "omitted-news". And yet it was indeed earth-shaking at the time it came out of the old Pentagon with many appropriations "cut" by the Senator Edward M. Wennedy of Massachusetts, to whom I wrote as you can see by the dates upon the enclosed xerox copy.

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Judge urges understanding by press, law

CHICAGO

CHICAGO (AP) — A Washington State Supreme Court justice says journalism and law professors must share the responsibility for fair trials and a free press in America.

Justice Robert C. Finley told a panel of the Association of American Law S c h o o l s' annual meeting Monday night, "The mon-key's on everybody's back."

"The news media could use some in-depth information and understanding" in the nature of the judicial process, Finley said.

But he noted, "Accuracy and quality of news reporting concerning the courts and the administration of justice has been substantially improved."

Representatives of The Associated Press Managing Ed-itors Freedom of Informa-tion Committee, the Ameri-can Newspaper Publishers Association, the Association for Education in Journalism and Sigma Delta Chi, the professional journalistic society, attended the panel session and agreed with law school professors that communications between the two groups must be improved.

Greater contact urged

The APME representative, Hu Blonk, managing editor of the Wenatchee World, Wenatchee, Wash., said he thought progress could be made through greater contact and cooperation be-tween law students and journalism students while still in school.

A committee of law and journalism professors was selected to continue a study to determine how students in both professions can relate to each other.

Scot Powe Jr., a professor of law at the University of Texas, told the group he be-lieves in the absolutism of freedom of the press but added: "This talisman can't be tossed out any time the press is attacked."

Newton Minow, former chairman of the Federal Communications Commission and a professor of law at Northwestern University, s a id the law-journalism group might undertake a study to determine exactly what effect pretrial publicity had on verdicts in legal cases.

Courses initiated

A representative of the University of Washington Journalism school said he attempted to initiate exchange courses with law school deans but was told law students are not interested.

Other journalism spokesmen suggested that legal experts be asked to lecture at journalism schools on specific problems.

Justice Finley said one area in which journalists could aid the lawyers was in dispelling myths of American justice.

"An example," he said, "is the presumption of innocence. It is a fiction and should be treated as such."

To date, Senator E.M. Kennedy has done nothing because he is a untrusted public-servant though elected for another term by the scople of Massachusetts, but that is a different matter.





THE KENNEDYS

As untidily and unsatisfactorily as it began, the legal inquiry into the incident at Chappaquiddick came to an abrupt end last week. After a few hours of fruitless probing, a grand jury appointed to investigate the death last July of Mary Jo Kopechne adjourned in frustration without clarifying any of the mystery that still surrounds her death.

The grand jury, sitting in Edgartown, Mass., began its work with high hopes. Foreman Leslie Leland, a Vineyard Haven druggist, pledged a complete and independent investigation; many jurors were apparently in an indicting mood. Their ambitions were quickly dashed by State Superior Court Justice Wilfred Paquet, 67, a no-nonsense jurist with a reputation for running a tight ourtroom. Somewhat Churchillian of mien and manner, Paquet swore the jurors to secrecy, warning them that their the were "sealed not for a month, not to for a year, but torever." He also nar-rowed the scope of their investigation by informing them that they could consider only those matters brought to their attention by the superior court, the dis-trict attorney or their own personal

knowledge. Paquet's charge left the grand jury with few options. Only three charges were possible against Senator Edward Kennedy: manslaughter, perjury or "driving to endanger," a traffic offense that is generally combined with other charges, notably drunken driving. Citing a ruling by the state's Supreme Ju-dicial Court, the judge denied the jurors' request for a look at the transcript of the January inquest into the accident. District Attorney Edmund Dinis, who had access to both the transcript and the report on the proceedings by Presiding Justice James Boyle, told the jurors there was not enough evidence to indict Kennedy on any of the charges. The jurors themselves made no move to call anyone involved in the events surrounding the accident; four new witnesses,

who testified for less than 20 minutes in all, provided nothing useful in the way of evidence. Case Closed, With that, the grand

jury gave up. Accompanied by a sheriff in formal dress, the ten men and ten women assembled glumly before Judge Paquet in Martha's Vineyard's 112-yearold courthouse. The judge asked Foreman Leland if the jury had any presentments to make. "I have nothing to present," said Leland quietly. "Not you," snapped Paquet. "Does the grand jury have anything to present?" Startled, Leland said that the answer for the grand jury was the same. His reply came as a relief to Dinis, who has become an increasingly reluctant participant in the drama involving Massachusetts' most powerful political family. "The case is closed," he said.


JUSTICE PAQUET The jury had nothing to present.



Dinis' statement that no further action is planned clears the way for the release of the inquest transcript and Justice Boyle's report. All that stood in the way of the release was resolution of the kind of dispute that typifies courthouse politics in Massachusetts. Freelance Court Stenographer Sidney Lipman, following a wellestablished Bay State practice, made arrangements to offer the 764-page transcript for sale at \$1.05 a page, or \$802.20 a copy. He has sued to halt its publication by the court at the bargain-base-ment price of \$75 a copy. Rejecting his suit, the state has gone ahead with its plans to release the inquest documents this week. Few expect the transcript to produce any surprises or further clues to what really happened at and after the tragic party for the boilerroom girls.







> At 10:30 a.m. on June 19, 1973, Mr _______of the Intelligence Division, and I attended a conference at the request of Assistant Attorney General Dixon concerning the matter of disclosure of the FBI Manual of Instructions to Senator Kennedy. Also attending the conference were Mary Lawton, Deputy Assistant Attorney General, Office of Legal Counsel, and John Gallinger and Douglas Marvin, attorneys in the Office of Legal Counsel.

Mr. Dixon discussed the various alternative responses that might be given to Senator Kennedy and his suggestions ranged from general public disclosure of the manuals to denial of disclosure entirely. The manuals had been reviewed by Mr. Dixon's assistants who were attending the meeting and they offered the observations that the innocuous material in the manuals had scattered throughout references to sensitive material therefore full disclosure of the manuals could be detrimental to the FBI. Mr. Dixon indicated he was still looking for a means of resolving this matter.

I suggested to Mr. Dixon that the Attorney General might respond to Senator Kennedy in writing with an offer to allow the Senator to review pertinent portions of the manual under a written understanding that such review would not result in public disclosure of the material. I suggested that this offer, while not necessarily binding on the Senator, could provide an appropriate response by the Attorney General and the establishment of conditions guaranteeing security of the material would appear to be reasonable because of the need to avoid public disclosure of certain portions of the manuals. Mr. Dixon said he agreed that such

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a counteroffer would be an effective approach and he instructed his assistants to consider this possibility.

Mr. Dixon said that he would further consider this matter and that it would be discussed with the Attorney General at 6:00 p.m. this evening, June 19, 1973. Mr. Dixon suggested that you might wish to have me attend the 6:00 p.m. meeting.

On June 8, 1973, Assistant Attorney General Robert Dixon, Office of Legal Counsel, advised me that the Attorney General testified on June 5, 1973, before the Senate Committee on the Judiciary, Subcommittee on Criminal Laws and Procedures, concerning the "Law Enforcement Revenue Sharing Act of 1973." Senator Kennedy asked the Attorney General for access to the FBI's Manual of Instructions. The Attorney General answered in substance that he did not feel there would be any great problem in making such material available to Senator. Kennedy subject to appropriate limitations as to further use of the material. The Attorney General indicated to Senator Kennedy that in his opinion the only basis for denying access to the Manual of Instructions would m be claim of executive privilege which he felt would not be warranted in this Ď case.

The Attorney General has a conference each morning at 9:00 a.m. with Assistant Attorney General Dixon and at the conference immediately following his testimony, the Attorney General asked Mr. Dixon to obtain the Bureau's views concerning disclosure of the manual. Mr. Dixon said there is a great deal of urgency in this request as he must furnish a response to the Attorney General as soon as possible. Mr. Dixon advised that he would like to have the opportunity to review the manuals himself and to have them reviewed by his two Deputy Assistants, Leon 94-55752-Ulman, and Mary C. Lawton.

Legal Counsel in the Department. At that conference I advised Mr. Dixon and Mr. Lindenbaum of the concern the FBI has regarding any access to the Manual of Instructions by persons outside the FBI. I pointed out that the manuals contain material of a highly sensitive nature which, if made accessible to persons outside the FBI could result in a detriment to FBI operations. I pointed out to Mr. Dixon and Mr. Lindenbaum that while we had no reservations about the personal integrity of officials in the Department, our concern was based on the principle that any disclosure outside the FBI increased the possibility of inadvertent or unauthorized release of the material.


Mr. Dixon then asked me specifically whether I would be willing to authorize the Assistant Attorney General or the Attorney General to review the manuals and I advised him that if we were directed by the Attorney General to produce the manuals we would do so, but that in order of preference we would prefer: first, no disclosure outside the FBI, and if that were not possible, we would prefer disclosure only in the presence of an FBI representative.

Mr. Dixon said that he is tended to agree with my observation and that if he were to review FBI manuals he would like to have an FBI representative present who could certify that he did not remove or copy any material from the manuals.

Mr. Lindenbaum advised that he better understood the position of the FBI; but that he thought it would be essential for a persuasive case to be made to the Attorney General in order to convince him that the manuals should not be disclosed. At that point, Mr. Dixon specifically requested a summary statement of examples of materials contained in the manuals that should not be disclosed because of the harm that such disclosure would cause. He requested this statement be furnished him before Monday morning, June 11, 1973. Mr. Dixon said that he and Mr. Lindenbaum would confer with the Attorney General at 9:00 a.m. on June 11, 1973, and would discuss this matter in detail. He said that if it was necessary following that discussion, a conference would be held on Tuesday, June 12, 1973, at which time FBI representatives would be invited to appear and discuss this matter further.

On my return, I advised Mr. Felt of the results of the conference and he instructed that I begin immediately the preparation of an appropriate statement of examples in response to Mr. Dixon's request. I then advised Inspector Bassett of the results of the conference.

On the evening of June 8, 1973, I reviewed the four volumes of the Manual of Instructions and selected two or three items from each manual, the disclosure of which could be harmful to FBI operations. I described the items in general terms so as to indicate their scope, but not their specific contents. Attached is a statement listing the items.

At 7:54 p.m., June 8, 1973, I telephonically read the attached statement to Mr. Felt. He approved and authorized me to deliver the statement at once to Mr. Dixon. Delivered by SA $\omega/n/73$.

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This matter will be followed very closely with the Assistant Attorney General and should further conferences be requested, you will be immediately advised.





The first amendment was offered by Senator Edmund Muskie (D-Maine) and would require the courts to examine classified material in camera to determine if its classification was proper and the document should be withheld from disclosure. The White House and the Department of Justice in addition to CIA made an all out effort to defeat this amendment. Two White House legislative representatives were working personally on the Hill against this amendment while the Department had three of its representatives there, including Assistant Attorney General Vince Rakestraw, Office of Legislative Affairs. A letter from the Attorney General to Senator Roman Hruska in opposition to the amendment was circulated to every Member of the Senate. In spite of this effort the amendment was adopted by vote of 53 to 29.

The second amendment was offered by Senator Philip Hart (D-Mich.). This amendment would change and drastically weaken exemption number 7 of the Freedom of Information Act concerning investigatory files. The wording of this amendment follows.

"Investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such records would (A) interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, or constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (C) disclose the identity of an informer, or (D) disclose investigative techniques and procedures."

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We learned that this amendment was to be offered shortly before noon on 5-29-74 when Hart's staff first contacted other staff representatives seeking support. Efforts were made to contact Hart's staff representative but he did not return our calls nor did he return the call made to him by Rakestraw. Material prepared by Congressional Services Office and the Freedom of Information Unit in opposition to this amendment was furnished to more than 20 Members of the Senate and personal contacts were made with numerous Members and staff personnel seeking support of our position of opposition to this amendment. Two attempts were made on the morning of 5-30-74 by Inspector Bowers to talk with Senator Hart about the amendment but efforts to reach him were not successful. This amendment was adopted by vote of 51 to 33.

Shortly after this amendment was adopted Burt Wides, Legislative Assistant to Senator Hart who had not returned the earlier calls made to him, contacted Bowers at the Capitol. Some of the extreme difficult problems which this amendment will cause for Federal law enforcement agencies were pointed out to him, and he said he had not realized the amendment would have such an impact. He was told of the efforts made to contact both him and his Senator, and he claimed he had not received any messages concerning our calls. He then offered to possibly work with us in an effort to lessen the impact of this amendment when the legislation goes to conference.

Following action on the legislation, a discussion was had with Rakestraw, Tom Korologos and Pat O'Donnell of the White House staff. Both Korologos and O'Donnell stated they feel certain the adoption of these two amendments will insure a Presidential veto, and they pointed out the fact there were 33 votes against the Hart amendment indicates a veto can be sustained in the Senate. Four Members of the Senate who undoubtedly would have voted against the Hart amendment were absent on the 30th. It was the consensus of Korologos, Rakestraw, and O'Donnell that no serious efforts should be made to "clean up" this legislation in conference since both the Senate and House versions of this legislation contain many undesirable features. The initial conclusion is to delay final enactment and then recommend Presidential veto.

Rakestraw commented after the passage of this legislation that he realized now it had been a bad mistake to attempt to negotiate with Senator Kennedy and his staff concerning problems in this legislation. It was apparent Kennedy was not sincere in the compromise he had agreed to with the Departmental representatives since he, as floor leader of the bill, strongly endorsed both the Muskie and Hart amendments when they were offered on the Senate floor, thus abandoning his prior commitment to support the compromise version which had been worked out in Committee.

Dear Senator Eastland:

Recently, as a result of an interview I had with a representative of a national television network, I have discovered that an answer I gave to a question posed by Senator Edward Kennedy during my confirmation hearings was not entirely accurate.

The exchange in question appears on page 44 of the printed hearings. The matter concerns the alleged misuse of information obtained by the Lenexa, Kansas, Police Department from the computer network being operated by the Kansas City Police Department while I was Chief of that Department.

I stated during the hearings that it had been discovered a Lenexa police officer apparently was making inquiries over the computer network for a rental agency and some businessmen, and that he had been reprimanded and the Lenexa Police Department advised any further such violations could mean its terminal would be taken away. I now find that statement, which was based on my recollection of information furnished to me in 1970 by a subordinate command officer in Kansas City, was not entirely accurate. I had been told a letter was being sent to the Lenexa Chief of Police concerning this matter. I have learned now the contact with the Lenexa Chief of Police







Scalia said that a meeting had been arranged for 10:00 a.m. on November 14, 1974, with Assistant to White House Legal Counsel Buchen, representatives of the Department's Office of Legislative Affairs, and for the purpose of discussing the FOIA amendments and providing any information concerning the nature of FBI files. I told Mr. Scalia we were unaware of the time of the meeting until he had advised me of it and up until that time I had not been able to discuss the Deputy Attorney General's request with representatives of our FOIA Unit, but I would do so at once.

Upon my return to the Bureau, I contacted Supervisor James C. Farrington, Unit Chief of the FOIA Unit, and explained the problem to him. Mr. Farrington suggested that it would be possible for us to allow Sussman to review materials previously prepared for release in a Freedom of Information Act request involving Alger Hiss and organized crime figures. Mr. Farrington explained that these materials have been prepared for release and allowing Mr. to review them would not compromise FBI files.

At 3:55 p.m., November 13, 1974, I advised Assistant Attorney General Scalia that we had available sample material that had been prepared for release under the FOIA that would be representative of the problems of deleting identifying data and other material that would not be released under the Act and that such material could be made available at 10:00 a.m. on the morning of November 14, 1974 for the purposes indicated. He expressed appreciation for this and advised that he would make arrangements for the meeting in the Department, and he would advise us later of the time and place, but that it probably would be in Mr. Rakestraw's office.

At 4:15 p.m., Mr. Scalia's secretary called my secretary and advised that the above meeting now would be held at 9:15 a.m. in Room 5214.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Supervisor James C. Farrington, accompanied by Inspector David W. Bowers and Supervisor Richard C. Dennis, represent the Bureau at the meeting with Mr. Scalia and representatives of the White House and of the Department to discuss the pending FOIA legislation and to review with them the sample material described above.

Dear Chief Faille:

In examining President Ford's proposed budget for fiscal year 1977, I have noted with concern his intention to eliminate federal funding of the Law Enforcement Education Program and to require State and local policy agencies to reimburse the F.B.I. for up to one-half of the cost of sending local police personnel to the F.B.I. National Training Academy.

I believe that such cuts, totalling over 45 million dollars, would prove most destructive to the future recruitment and training of qualified police personnel at the local level. I am sure you will agree that our local police departments are already operating on reduced budgets, and to require them to meet the additional costs of advanced education and police training will, I fear, result in the total elimination of such valuable programs.

The front line defense in the war on crime rests with the police officer patrolling our city streets. All police departments benefit from the opportunities afforded them by the L.E.E.P. and F.B.I. programs.

I will urge the Senate Appropriations Committee to eliminate this proposed budget cut from the President's budget and will, if necessary, pursue this matter on the Senate floor. I will continue to maintain close contact with the International and Massachusetts Chiefs of Police Associations as to this matter and will inform you of subsequent developments and in this effort, I hope I will have your suggestions and support.

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


Dear Senator Kennedy:

This is in response to your inquiry concerning the several aspects of the handling of Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests set forth in your letter of July 2nd.

The FBI does not "open a file" on requesters of information. All such correspondence, both the requester's letter and my rosponse, is filed in a general correspondence file, unless a file already exists on the subject matter of the request, in which case the correspondence is filed there.

As you noted in your letter, our files must be reviewed when a requester seeks access to our records concerning himself. When the request is for records other than those pertaining to the requester, however, the requester's name is searched through our indices only to determine whether or not we have had prior correspondence with him on the same matter, thereby avoiding wastefully duplicative effort. Only a limited search is conducted, sufficient to determine if we are currently, or have recently been, in correspondence with the requester.

No background check is conducted concerning any requester. As montioned above, the only "name-check Asset Dir._____process" which is conducted is done so only to avoid Dep. AD Adm._____ Wasteful duplication.



A number of persons who have requested or are requesting information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation under the Freedom of Information Act have voiced concern over newsstories suggesting that the Bureau "opens a file" or. such requesters of information.

While it is obvious that a file would have to be opened to facilitate the processing of a Freedom of Information request, the law clearly places no requirement on a requester to be directly or personally concerned with the matter about which he requests information (except, of course, when one is requesting access to his own file). Especially considering the large number of current requests for information being received by the FBI, it would seem an unnecessary diversion of attention from processing these requests for agents even to take time for background checks of requesters.

I would appreciate your explaining the precise procedures used by the FBI in filling Freedom of Information requests, including an indentification of the index, files or other lists against which the requester's name is checked and the purpose for such check.

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If you agree that this process is not only wasteful of time but also breeds continued suspicion of the FBI's commitment to faithful implementation of the Freedom of Information Act, then it would be desirable to suspend indefinitely this name-check process, at least until there is some basis to believe this process is justified.



On November 29, 1979, the Phoenix FBI Office was contacted by _____, News Director, KOY AM Radio, 840 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona, telephone number 258-8181, concerning a news release issued by Interworld Congress, which may have contained a threat to the life of Senator Ted Kennedy, who was to visit Phoenix that afternoon.

Investigation at KOY determined that a young woman, name unknown, had dropped off the press release at approximately 12:00 noon on November 29, 1979, and had immediately left the building. She had delivered two of the releases, one for the News Department of KOY and the other for the host of a talk show that ran every evening on weekdays at KOY. The person dropping the press release was further described as being short, in her early thirties, attractive, with dark brown hair, approximately 5'5" in height, slender build, wearing a black sweater over a dark colored blouse and a skirt. The woman may have worn glasses. A copy of the press release was obtained.

A copy of the press release was immediately furnished to U. S. Secret Service, Phoenix, at the front entrance of the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Phoenix, where Senator Ted Kennedy was due to arrive that afternoon.
