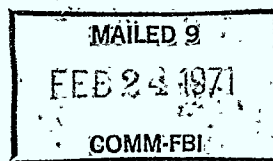

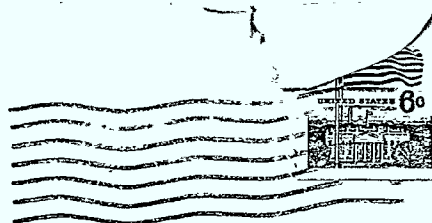

WASHINGTON — It was an excited young crowd that jammed the fourth floor room of the old Senate Office Building to hear Senator Edward Kennedy give his opinion of the publication of the material from the "top secret" Pentagon papers about the Vietnam War.

The tall and handsome 39-year-old senator is a celebrity in his own right now and it is no longer necessary to identify him as the youngest brother of the assassinated President or the young man who read the tribute during the memorial service for the late Senator Robert F. Kennedy that tragic day in June, 1968.

IT IS NO WONDER some of President Richard Nixon's key advisers view with alarm the number of Kennedy people flocking to the standards of Senator George McGovern of South Dakota and Senator Harold Hughes of Iowa.

For some, the presidential

bids of both McGovern and Hughes are regarded as mere holding operations until Teddy Kennedy can get his own bandwagon moving, even though Kennedy's press man, Dick Drayne, repeatedly has said Kennedy did not plan to be a candidate for president in 1972.



Few things could be more exciting to that young crowd on the morning of June 22, 1971, than a few words from the Massachusetts senator on the subject on every one's lips that week — publication of articles and documents from the "top secret" — sensitive 47-volume history of the Vietnam War.

The first segments appearing in the New York Times and

Washington Post had emphasized alleged deceptions by President Johnson in connection with his 1964 campaign against Senator Barry Goldwater.

IF YOU LISTENED to interpretations from Senator Goldwater, former Senator Wayne Morse (Dem. Ore.) or Senator Ernest Gruening (Dem. Alaska) the papers proved that President Johnson "lied us into war." Morse and Gruening also seemed to make a concerted effort to tie the papers on the period ending in 1968 to what they called a "continuation" of those policies by President Nixon.

Senator Kennedy appeared courageous in agreeing to publication of articles from the papers which discussed President Kennedy's role in the Vietnam situation. The Boston Globe had carried stories that morning which were headlined: "Secret Pentagon Documents Bare JFK Role in Vietnam War" and "Kennedy OK's Covert Action." Editorially, the Globe declared "the truth finds a way."

The editorial was published next to a Herblock cartoon blaming stern-visaged Richard Nixon and Attorney General John Mitchell for "attempted censorship" which was portrayed as "new figure on the American scene."

"WE ARE CONFIDENT that our own country will have no part in censorship, and that, in the end, our courts will uphold the people's right to know and the freedom of the press that is so essential to that right. As long as we have a democracy, the truth will find a way to emerge," the editorial said.

In keeping with the popular theme of the week in the nation's newspapers, Senator Kennedy gave his approval to publication of the 47-volume study even if it reflected unfavorably upon the Kennedy brothers. It was the "people's right to know," he told the group of young men and women crowded into the room to listen.

The question that followed broke up the meeting. "Then why don't you tell your lawyers to permit the Massachusetts

grand jury on the Chappaquiddick matter to be published?" asked one young man, referring to the investigation report which followed Edward Kennedy's auto accident which resulted in the crowning death of a young woman.

The serious, confident smile that usually plays around Kennedy's face vanished. Stunned, he turned white. His jaw froze. He stood there for a moment and then simply turned and walked out, without trying to answer.

A pall settled over the room. Then the students started buzzing. Some were disappointed that Kennedy had walked out; others resented the questioner who had broken up the gathering. Still others raised questions about how far a presidential bandwagon could roll without having the question raised again.

Many felt it a pertinent question particularly at a time when there was so much emphasis on "the people's right to know" about actions of public figures.

It will be asked as long as he has no answer.

On January 3, 1972, Captain [REDACTED], New Mexico State Police, Farmington, New Mexico, advised that in connection with an appearance at Farmington, New Mexico, of Senator Edward Kennedy of Massachusetts, on the evening of January 2, 1972, an individual, who identified himself as [REDACTED], presented two documents to a member of the Senator's party. These documents are appended hereto.

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After furnishing these papers, [REDACTED] merely went to a corner of the airport lobby and watched the events of the arrival and caused no problems to anyone.

Captain [REDACTED] advised that a photograph of [REDACTED] was taken in the lobby of the airport. This photograph is available in the office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at Albuquerque, New Mexico.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

# Are Unheralded Lyricist

PIERCE CITY — Honoring Mrs. Lucy Wight of nearby Wentworth, a pre-Mother's Day testimonial was set by her son Jason in the cemetery here last week and could possibly cause some controversy in the nation's song-writing circles.

Imprinted on the monument of Carthage marble are Wight's statements which say that Mrs. Wight is the author and origin of more than twenty lyrics which have become popular in the last forty years.

Most of these are listed by name on the monument and probably the most important is "White Christmas," a song which has had sales in the millions. Origin of many others is claimed for her by her son, including "Tumbling Tumbleweeds," "Old Spinning Wheel" and "Pennies from Heaven," among the more popular.

Mrs. Wight was born Jan. 1, 1894, on what is known as the "Old Crewse Place" at Manes, Mo., and for about all of her 76 years has shown a propensity for poetry.

First recollection of her poetical nature, she says, came when as a small girl she showed her father, Frank Farmer, a little poem she had written. "He called me his little poet," Mrs. Wight said, "and that just about thrilled me to death."

She then told how the lyrics of "White Christmas" came to be written. "I was writing my Christmas cards one day," she explained, "when I looked out the window and saw the snow coming down soft and white. Then the sun came out and the snow glistened in the treetops. One of the cards I was addressing had a picture of Santa Claus in his sleigh riding over a house-top."

"The words came to me naturally and I wrote them down."

Pausing in the work of setting the monument, son Jason added other information. "She had left her mark with other lyrics," he said, "even before those depression days of the 1930s with, for example, 'Paper Doll'. These lyrics went out sometime before the first copyright date of 1930."

Members of her family did little to encourage her in those early days, Mrs. Wight remembers, when they told her it was useless to send the lyrics to possible publishers and that she "would never get a dime for them."

She said she told them the lyrics would do no earthly good lying around the house and added "Maybe they'll make somebody happy."

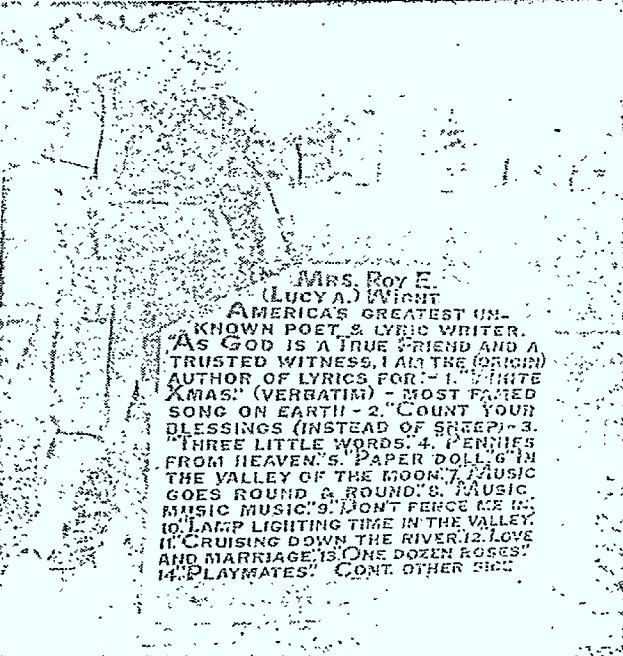
"They made a lot of people happy," son Jason said, "But

one thing's sure, in the history of the country's music no one has ever given so much and wound up with such an empty purse."

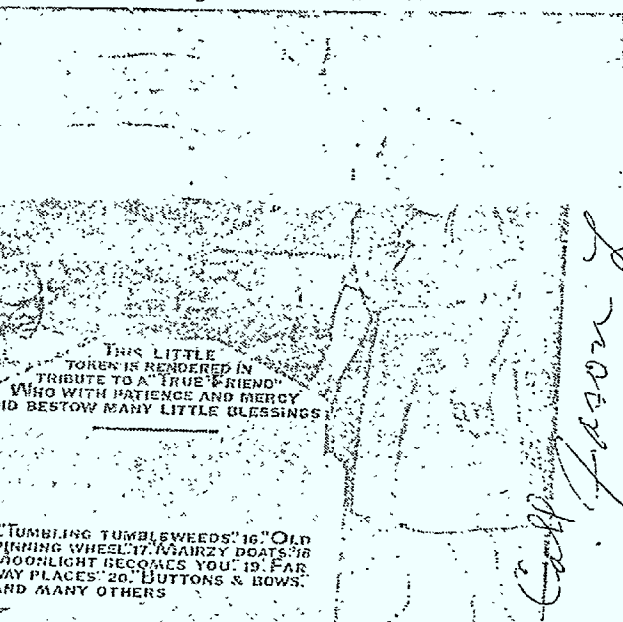
Mrs. Wight continues to write in the family homestead just outside Wentworth and now has in preparation a song she has entitled "The Flowers". That song is in its final draft and she hopes to complete it soon and

offer it for publication — and payment — to one of several music publishers who have asked to see some of her lyrics.

Son Jason is a construction worker employed on structural steel projects in various parts of the country, and work on permanently locating the monument on a concrete base will be undertaken as soon as he returns from Utah.

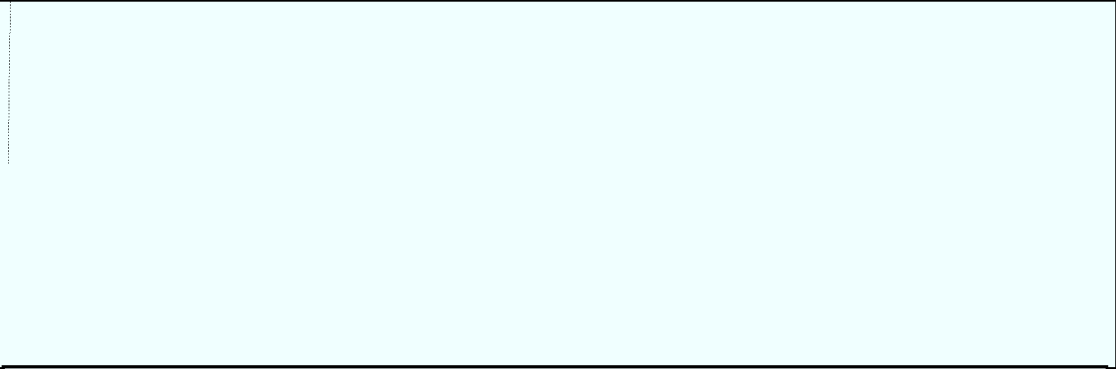

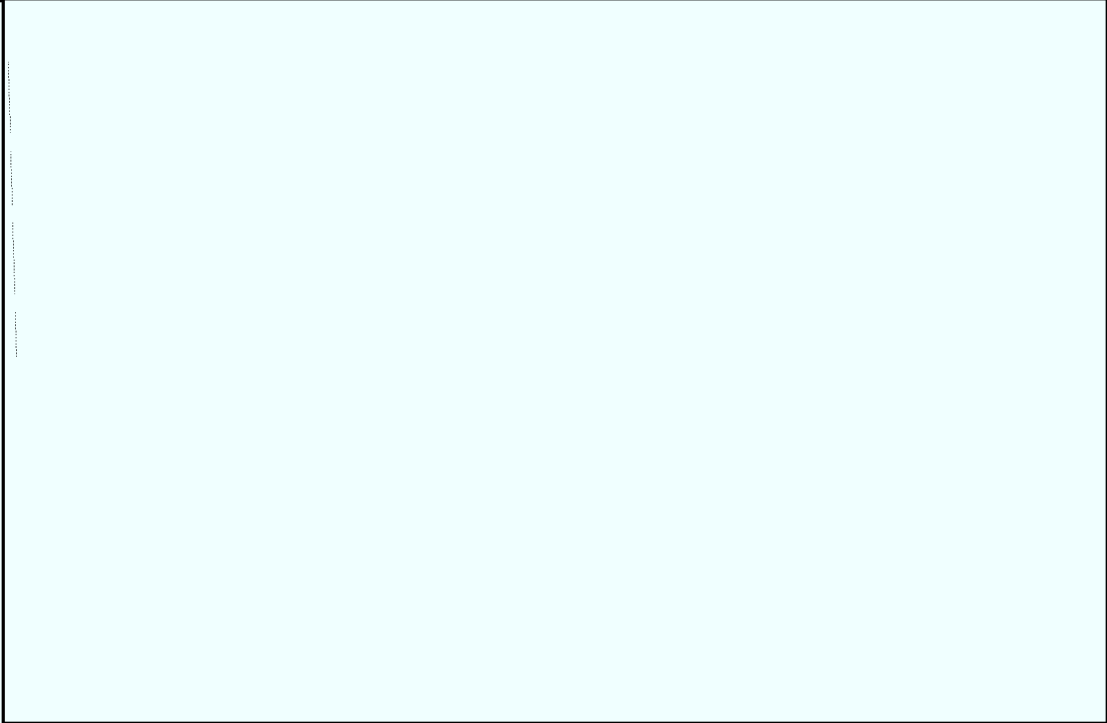

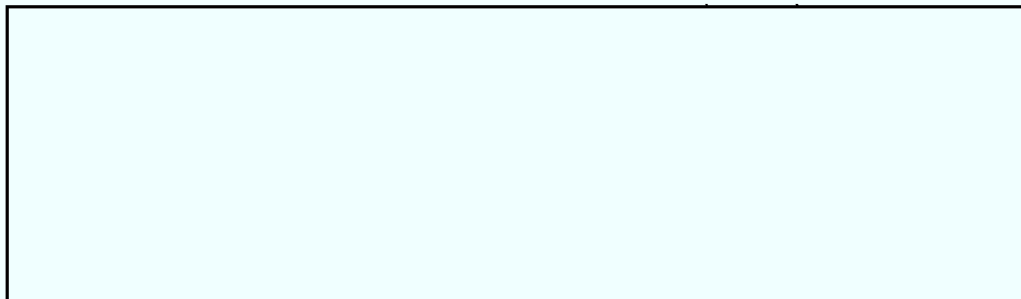

Investigation at Callahan and Fernandina Beach, Florida, by a special agent of the FBI determined [redacted] is a well known, respected, long time citizen of Callahan, Florida. No one by the name of [redacted] is known in Callahan, Florida; however, one [redacted] is reported to be a newcomer to Callahan and not well known in the area.

She is also involved in litigation with Silver Springs Shores over her residence and is disgruntled because Kennedy is being allowed to speak at Silver Springs Shores. Mrs. [redacted] has purchased radio time for spot announcements on WIMC radio, Ocala, in which she is encouraging people who are against Senator Kennedy to contact her. She plans a demonstration to take place during Kennedy's speech; however, her attorney, [redacted] [redacted] Ocala, advised her against such action. b6 b7C

The second woman is [redacted] Ocala, wife of [redacted] who is area coordinator of the John Birch Society, Ocala. Mrs. [redacted] has contacted Marion County Sheriff's Office and inquired as to rules concerning public demonstrations and picketing.

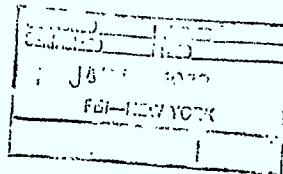

After reading subject letter, he advised that he would not authorize prosecution in this matter as the letter contains no viable threat; that the author of the letter expresses opinions rather than threats and therefore, this matter lacks prosecutive merit.

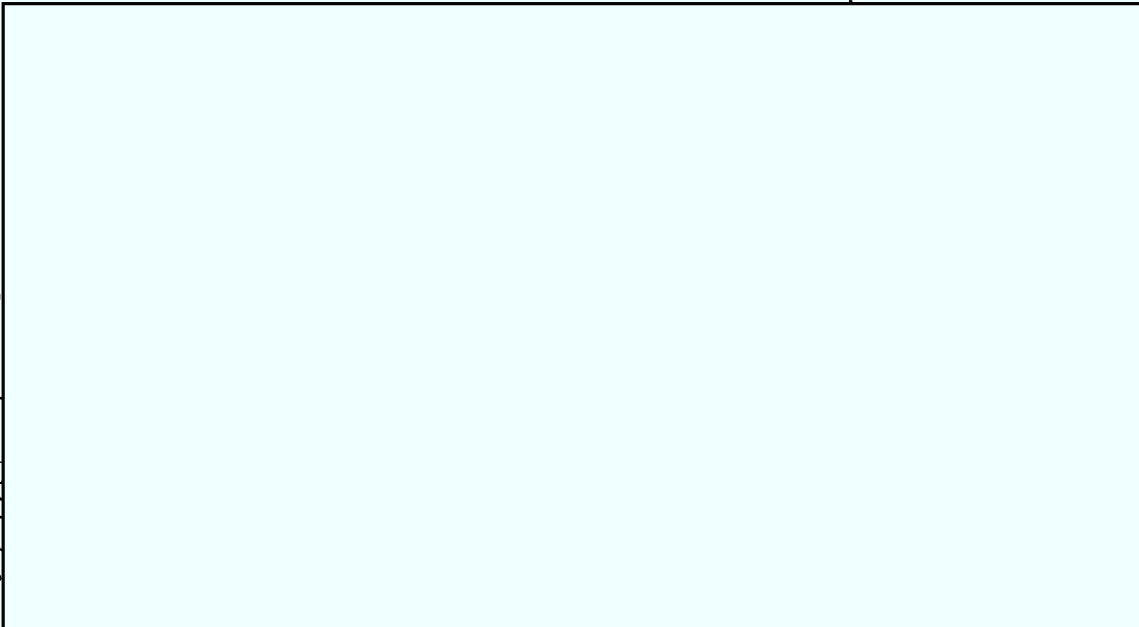

On 11/29/72, SA [REDACTED] of Secret Service Liaison telephonically contacted Inspector [REDACTED] and advised he had received a copy of an undated letter signed "Concerned Citizens" addressed to Mr. Gray stating that [REDACTED] believed to be employed in the Boston Office of Senator Kennedy (D - Mass.), "could render the Senator in a dangerous position," because of her unusual behavior. [REDACTED] inquired as to what, if any, action the FBI had taken concerning this communication. He was requested to furnish [REDACTED] a copy of the communication and when this was received a check was made of records at Bureau Headquarters and no record of the communication could be found. [REDACTED] subsequently was contacted and asked if Secret Service might also have the original. He subsequently reported back that they had found the original in their office, adding that there was no indication as to how it was received. He was requested to return the original document to Mr. [REDACTED]. In the meantime [REDACTED] telephonically contacted [REDACTED] in Senator Kennedy's Office and advised her of the contents of the communication. She stated [REDACTED] is known to the office and has done part-time work in the past in the Kennedy Office in Boston. She implied that the letter in all probability was written because of personal spite, perhaps on the part of other employees in the office, although she did state that [REDACTED] "does have a problem." She was advised that the FBI was taking no further action concerning this matter.

On 12/18/72, the enclosed communication dated 12/13/72 from James J. Rowley, Director, Secret Service, was received enclosing the original copy of the anonymous communication. Secret Service has taken no action on this matter.

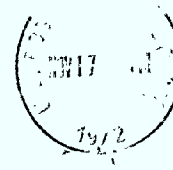

It has been some time since you have told the panel of the Association of American Law School, but it had motivated enough to come about with the enclosed information that thus far has not been in the front pages of the "news-media".

At any rate it does point out to you and others in the "system" of judicial affairs, that this is still "omitted-news". And yet it was indeed earth-shaking at the time it came out of the old Pentagon with many appropriations "cut" by the Senator Edward M. Kennedy of Massachusetts, to whom I wrote as you can see by the dates upon the enclosed xerox copy.

## Judge urges understanding by press, law

CHICAGO (AP) — A Washington State Supreme Court justice says journalism and law professors must share the responsibility for fair trials and a free press in America.

Justice Robert C. Finley told a panel of the Association of American Law Schools' annual meeting Monday night, "The monkey's on everybody's back."

"The news media could use some in-depth information and understanding" in the nature of the judicial process, Finley said.

But he noted, "Accuracy and quality of news reporting concerning the courts and the administration of justice has been substantially improved."

Representatives of The Associated Press Managing Editors Freedom of Information Committee, the American Newspaper Publishers Association, the Association for Education in Journalism and Sigma Delta Chi, the professional journalistic society, attended the panel session and agreed with law school professors that communications between the two groups must be improved.

### Greater contact urged

The APME representative, Hu Blunk, managing editor of the Wenatchee World, Wenatchee, Wash., said he thought progress could be made through greater contact and cooperation between law students and journalism students while still in school.

A committee of law and journalism professors was selected to continue a study to determine how students in both professions can relate to each other.

Scot Powe Jr., a professor of law at the University of Texas, told the group he believes in the absolutism of freedom of the press but added: "This talisman can't be tossed out any time the press is attacked."

Newton Minow, former chairman of the Federal Communications Commission and a professor of law at Northwestern University, said the law-journalism group might undertake a study to determine exactly what effect pretrial publicity had on verdicts in legal cases.

### Courses initiated

A representative of the University of Washington Journalism school said he attempted to initiate exchange courses with law school deans but was told law students are not interested.

Other journalism spokesmen suggested that legal experts be asked to lecture at journalism schools on specific problems.

Justice Finley said one area in which journalists could aid the lawyers was in dispelling myths of American justice.

"An example," he said, "is the presumption of innocence. It is a fiction and should be treated as such."

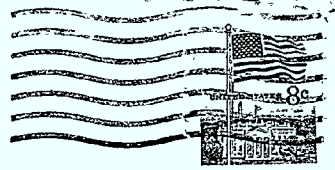

### Whose Money Built Kopechne House?

WASHINGTON.

THE PARENTS OF MARY JO KOPECHNE, who drowned in Sen. Edward Kennedy's car three years ago, will soon adopt a new, affluent life style.

Still not entirely recovered from their tragic loss, Joseph and Gwen Kopechne are pulling up stakes in the working class suburb of Berkeley Heights, New Jersey, where they have lived for 25 years.

They will leave their modest rented apartment and move into a custom-built \$75,000 rambler in a secluded area of the Pocono mountains an hour's drive from Mary Jo's grave in Larksville, Pa.



The Kopechnes

The Kopechnes' new financial security has revived curiosity about how much money they received as a result of their daughter's death. Observers have noted from the beginning that the bereaved parents have carefully refrained from criticizing Kennedy.

The new home, now nearly complete, is reached through winding private roads. It dominates a rise at a 1,900-foot elevation about 40 miles from Wilkes-Barre.

In the surrounding low-income mining communities, where the Kopechnes have roots and numerous relatives, talk is buzzing that the home "was built with Kennedy money."

The sum awarded the Kopechnes under the senator's automobile liability insurance, after the judge at the inquest found him guilty of "falshood" and "negligence," has been a closely guarded secret.

If an additional cash settlement were made, the parties involved have kept mum about that, too.

AT THE CAPITAL, SEN. KENNEDY said he is "aware" of the settlement, but suggested the figure could come from the Kopechnes' attorney in Wilkes-Barre.

"That was a long time ago. I am not familiar in detail with their plans," Kennedy said.

But Joseph Flanagan, the attorney, angrily refused to discuss the settlement or the house.

In the summer and fall of 1969, when Mary Jo's death dominated the headlines, Kopechne retained a battery of top-notch legal talent, despite his limited means.

Three attorneys from the well-known firm of Flanagan and Doran represented him at the hearing to block an autopsy on his daughter's body.

Sources in the area report the house is providing a new interest for Mrs. Kopechne, whose "nerves are shot." Kopechne reportedly is "down in the dumps at times."

In about a year he plans to retire from his job, selling insurance. Until then he and his wife will spend weekends in the new home.

The brick-and-siding residence is on 1/4 wooded acres. It boasts a breakfast room with fireplace, three bedrooms, two baths, a two-car garage, and glass-walled rear decks overlooking a splendid view.

After the tragedy the Kopechnes dropped out of sight. In the last year they have taken an unlisted telephone number.

Their new home was discovered by these reporters during an inspection of properties in the scenic Poconos, where the Kopechne's builder Isaac B. Miller owns 700 acres. He suggested a look at a house he had under construction and identified the owner.

"I think he got his insurance money for his daughter," Miller said, adding that Kopechne's Wilkes-Barre lawyer also "checked me out."

Family sources confirmed the facts about the house and the insurance settlement, though not the amount.

## THE KENNEDYS

### End of the Affair

As untidily and unsatisfactorily as it began, the legal inquiry into the incident at Chappaquiddick came to an abrupt end last week. After a few hours of fruitless probing, a grand jury appointed to investigate the death last July of Mary Jo Kopechne adjourned in frustration without clarifying any of the mystery that still surrounds her death.

The grand jury, sitting in Edgartown, Mass., began its work with high hopes. Foreman Leslie Leland, a Vineyard Haven druggist, pledged a complete and independent investigation; many jurors were apparently in an indicting mood. Their ambitions were quickly dashed by State Superior Court Justice Wilfred Paquet, 67, a no-nonsense jurist with a reputation for running a tight courtroom. Somewhat Churchillian of mien and manner, Paquet swore the jurors to secrecy, warning them that their lips were sealed not for a month, not for a year, but forever. He also narrowed the scope of their investigation by informing them that they could consider only those matters brought to their attention by the superior court, the district attorney or their own personal knowledge.

Paquet's charge left the grand jury with few options. Only three charges were possible against Senator Edward Kennedy: manslaughter, perjury or "driving to endanger," a traffic offense that is generally combined with other charges, notably drunken driving. Citing a ruling by the state's Supreme Judicial Court, the judge denied the jurors' request for a look at the transcript of the January inquest into the accident. District Attorney Edmund Dinis, who had access to both the transcript and the report on the proceedings by Presiding Justice James Boyle, told the jurors there was not enough evidence to indict Kennedy on any of the charges. The jurors themselves made no move to call anyone involved in the events surrounding the accident; four new witnesses, who testified for less than 20 minutes in all, provided nothing useful in the way of evidence.

**Case Closed.** With that, the grand jury gave up. Accompanied by a sheriff in formal dress, the ten men and ten women assembled glumly before Judge Paquet in Martha's Vineyard's 112-year-old courthouse. The judge asked Foreman Leland if the jury had any presentments to make. "I have nothing to present," said Leland quietly. "Not you," snapped Paquet. "Does the grand jury have anything to present?" Startled, Leland said that the answer for the grand jury was the same. His reply came as a relief to Dinis, who has become an increasingly reluctant participant in the drama involving Massachusetts' most powerful political family. "The case is closed," he said.

The doubts remain. Several grand ju-



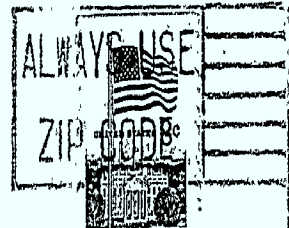
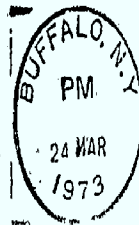

rors believed that Kennedy should have been brought before a court to answer for events that they still find inadequately explained. Many were disappointed at their inability to return an indictment against him. "Most of us felt Kennedy was morally responsible for the death of that girl," said one woman juror, ignoring Paquet's warning about sealed lips. Said a male juror: "I don't believe this will ever be resolved as far as some people are concerned."

The case is resolved, however, as far

as the courts are concerned. Dinis' statement that no further action is planned clears the way for the release of the inquest transcript and Justice Boyle's report. All that stood in the way of the release was resolution of the kind of dispute that typifies courthouse politics in Massachusetts. Freelance Court Stenographer Sidney Lipman, following a well-established Bay State practice, made arrangements to offer the 764-page transcript for sale at \$1.05 a page, or \$802.20 a copy. He has sued to halt its publication by the court at the bargain-basement price of \$75 a copy. Rejecting his suit, the state has gone ahead with its plans to release the inquest documents this week. Few expect the transcript to produce any surprises or further clues to what really happened at and after the tragic party for the boiler-room girls.

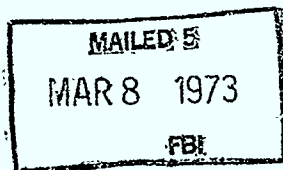

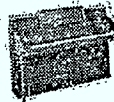

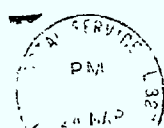

You and I attended a conference with the Attorney General in his office from 6:00 p.m. until 7:35 p.m. on June 19, 1973. During the discussion, I advised the Attorney General of our concern regarding disclosure of the FBI Manual of Instructions to anyone outside the FBI.

The Attorney General indicated he was willing to decline to furnish the manuals to Senator Kennedy and he may do so in person rather than by letter. The Attorney General indicated he believed the need to consider the question of the establishment of Congressional oversight committees concerning the FBI provides a reasonable basis for denial of FBI manuals pending resolution of that larger issue.

As a reminder, I note that a set of our manuals, plus prior versions of Section 87 of the manual, are still in the custody of Assistant Attorney General Dixon.

Nothing further appears to be necessary at this time pending the final action of the Attorney General concerning response to Senator Kennedy.

At 10:30 a.m. on June 19, 1973, Mr. [ ] of the Intelligence Division, and I attended a conference at the request of Assistant Attorney General Dixon concerning the matter of disclosure of the FBI Manual of Instructions to Senator Kennedy. Also attending the conference were Mary Lawton, Deputy Assistant Attorney General, Office of Legal Counsel, and John Gallinger and Douglas Marvin, attorneys in the Office of Legal Counsel.

Mr. Dixon discussed the various alternative responses that might be given to Senator Kennedy and his suggestions ranged from general public disclosure of the manuals to denial of disclosure entirely. The manuals had been reviewed by Mr. Dixon's assistants who were attending the meeting and they offered the observations that the innocuous material in the manuals had scattered throughout references to sensitive material therefore full disclosure of the manuals could be detrimental to the FBI. Mr. Dixon indicated he was still looking for a means of resolving this matter.

I suggested to Mr. Dixon that the Attorney General might respond to Senator Kennedy in writing with an offer to allow the Senator to review pertinent portions of the manual under a written understanding that such review would not result in public disclosure of the material. I suggested that this offer, while not necessarily binding on the Senator, could provide an appropriate response by the Attorney General and the establishment of conditions guaranteeing security of the material would appear to be reasonable because of the need to avoid public disclosure of certain portions of the manuals. On June 8, 1973, Assistant Attorney General Robert Dixon, Office of Legal Counsel, advised me that the Attorney General testified on June 5, 1973, before the Senate Committee on the Judiciary, Subcommittee on Criminal Laws and Procedures, concerning the "Law Enforcement Revenue Sharing Act of 1973." Senator Kennedy asked the Attorney General for access to the FBI's Manual of Instructions. The Attorney General answered in substance that he did not feel there would be any great problem in making such material available to Senator Kennedy subject to appropriate limitations as to further use of the material. The Attorney General indicated to Senator Kennedy that in his opinion the only basis for denying access to the Manual of Instructions would be claim of executive privilege which he felt would not be warranted in this case.

The Attorney General has a conference each morning at 9:00 a. m. with Assistant Attorney General Dixon and at the conference immediately following his testimony, the Attorney General asked Mr. Dixon to obtain the Bureau's views concerning disclosure of the manual. Mr. Dixon said there is a great deal of urgency in this request as he must furnish a response to the Attorney General as soon as possible. Mr. Dixon advised that he would like to have the opportunity to review the manuals himself and to have them reviewed by his two Deputy Assistants, Leon Ulman, and Mary C. Lawton.

I discussed this matter with Mr. Felt and pursuant to his authorization I met at 3:30 p. m. on June 8, 1973, with Assistant Attorney General Dixon, Sol Lindenbaum, Executive Assistant to the Attorney General, and Douglas R. Marvin, an attorney employed in the Office of

Legal Counsel in the Department. At that conference I advised Mr. Dixon and Mr. Lindenbaum of the concern the FBI has regarding any access to the Manual of Instructions by persons outside the FBI. I pointed out that the manuals contain material of a highly sensitive nature which, if made accessible to persons outside the FBI could result in a detriment to FBI operations. I pointed out to Mr. Dixon and Mr. Lindenbaum that while we had no reservations about the personal integrity of officials in the Department, our concern was based on the principle that any disclosure outside the FBI increased the possibility of inadvertent or unauthorized release of the material.

Mr. Dixon then asked me specifically whether I would be willing to authorize the Assistant Attorney General or the Attorney General to review the manuals and I advised him that if we were directed by the Attorney General to produce the manuals we would do so, but that in order of preference we would prefer: first, no disclosure outside the FBI, and if that were not possible, we would prefer disclosure only in the presence of an FBI representative.

Mr. Dixon said that he intended to agree with my observation and that if he were to review FBI manuals he would like to have an FBI representative present who could certify that he did not remove or copy any material from the manuals.

Mr. Lindenbaum advised that he better understood the position of the FBI, but that he thought it would be essential for a persuasive case to be made to the Attorney General in order to convince him that the manuals should not be disclosed. At that point, Mr. Dixon specifically requested a summary statement of examples of materials contained in the manuals that should not be disclosed because of the harm that such disclosure would cause. He requested this statement be furnished him before Monday morning, June 11, 1973. Mr. Dixon said that he and Mr. Lindenbaum would confer with the Attorney General at 9:00 a.m. on June 11, 1973, and would discuss this matter in detail. He said that if it was necessary following that discussion, a conference would be held on Tuesday, June 12, 1973, at which time FBI representatives would be invited to appear and discuss this matter further.

On my return, I advised Mr. Felt of the results of the conference and he instructed that I begin immediately the preparation of an appropriate statement of examples in response to Mr. Dixon's request. I then advised Inspector Bassett of the results of the conference.

On the evening of June 8, 1973, I reviewed the four volumes of the Manual of Instructions and selected two or three items from each manual, the disclosure of which could be harmful to FBI operations. I described the items in general terms so as to indicate their scope, but not their specific contents. Attached is a statement listing the items.

At 7:54 p.m., June 8, 1973, I telephonically read the attached statement to Mr. Felt. He approved and authorized me to deliver the statement at once to Mr. Dixon. Delivered by SA   6/11/73.

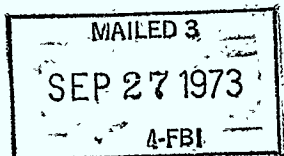

As you are aware, responses to the invitations extended are being received and a number of Congressmen and Senators are designating their aides to be present for the briefing. Today, 10/19/73, SA [redacted], Congressional Services Office, received a call from [redacted] a legislative aide to Senator Edward M. Kennedy (D-Mass.) and who works for Senator Kennedy on the Subcommittee on Administrative Practice and Procedure, Committee on the Judiciary, which is chaired by Senator Kennedy. [redacted] stated he had learned of the NCIC/CCH briefing on 10/25/73 from other congressional aides and wondered if it would be possible for an invitation to be extended to him as a representative of the Subcommittee chaired by Senator Kennedy. SA [redacted] advised that he felt certain that this could be arranged, and he explained to [redacted] that in respect to the Judiciary Committee, members of the Subcommittee on FBI Oversight had been invited along with Senators Tunney and Mathias who have expressed particular interest in the NCIC/CCH program. It was pointed out four other Senators on the Judiciary Committee in addition to Senator Kennedy had not been extended invitations inasmuch as a number of invitations were also sent to other Senators and House Members because of their committee assignments and/or interest in NCIC/CCH.

[redacted] was informed that the FBI would, of course, be most pleased to have him present at the briefing on 10/25/73. [redacted] said he could understand the FBI's inability to accommodate all who might like to attend the briefing and why all the Senators and Congressmen could not be invited. He was most appreciative when told that we would be pleased to have him attend and that we would be expecting him at 10 a.m., Room 3119, FBI Identification Building, Second and D Streets, Southwest, Washington, D. EDWARD M. KENNEDY

The Senate yesterday (5-30-74) adopted two amendments to captioned bill which greatly will adversely affect our operations and in all probability will insure this legislation will be vetoed.

The first amendment was offered by Senator Edmund Muskie (D-Maine) and would require the courts to examine classified material in camera to determine if its classification was proper and the document should be withheld from disclosure. The White House and the Department of Justice in addition to CIA made an all out effort to defeat this amendment. Two White House legislative representatives were working personally on the Hill against this amendment while the Department had three of its representatives there, including Assistant Attorney General Vince Rakestraw, Office of Legislative Affairs. A letter from the Attorney General to Senator Roman Hruska in opposition to the amendment was circulated to every Member of the Senate. In spite of this effort the amendment was adopted by vote of 53 to 29.

The second amendment was offered by Senator Philip Hart (D-Mich.). This amendment would change and drastically weaken exemption number 7 of the Freedom of Information Act concerning investigatory files. The wording of this amendment follows.

"Investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such records would (A) interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, or constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (C) disclose the identity of an informer, or (D) disclose investigative techniques and procedures."

We learned that this amendment was to be offered shortly before noon on 5-29-74 when Hart's staff first contacted other staff representatives seeking support. Efforts were made to contact Hart's staff representative but he did not return our calls nor did he return the call made to him by Rakestraw. Material prepared by Congressional Services Office and the Freedom of Information Unit in opposition to this amendment was furnished to more than 20 Members of the Senate and personal contacts were made with numerous Members and staff personnel seeking support of our position of opposition to this amendment. Two attempts were made on the morning of 5-30-74 by Inspector Bowers to talk with Senator Hart about the amendment but efforts to reach him were not successful. This amendment was adopted by vote of 51 to 33.

Shortly after this amendment was adopted Burt Wides, Legislative Assistant to Senator Hart who had not returned the earlier calls made to him, contacted Bowers at the Capitol. Some of the extreme difficult problems which this amendment will cause for Federal law enforcement agencies were pointed out to him, and he said he had not realized the amendment would have such an impact. He was told of the efforts made to contact both him and his Senator, and he claimed he had not received any messages concerning our calls. He then offered to possibly work with us in an effort to lessen the impact of this amendment when the legislation goes to conference.

Following action on the legislation, a discussion was had with Rakestraw, Tom Korologos and Pat O'Donnell of the White House staff. Both Korologos and O'Donnell stated they feel certain the adoption of these two amendments will insure a Presidential veto, and they pointed out the fact there were 33 votes against the Hart amendment indicates a veto can be sustained in the Senate. Four Members of the Senate who undoubtedly would have voted against the Hart amendment were absent on the 30th. It was the consensus of Korologos, Rakestraw, and O'Donnell that no serious efforts should be made to "clean up" this legislation in conference since both the Senate and House versions of this legislation contain many undesirable features. The initial conclusion is to delay final enactment and then recommend Presidential veto.

Rakestraw commented after the passage of this legislation that he realized now it had been a bad mistake to attempt to negotiate with Senator Kennedy and his staff concerning problems in this legislation. It was apparent Kennedy was not sincere in the compromise he had agreed to with the Departmental representatives since he, as floor leader of the bill, strongly endorsed both the Muskie and Hart amendments when they were offered on the Senate floor, thus abandoning his prior commitment to support the compromise version which had been worked out in Committee.

Dear Senator Eastland:

Recently, as a result of an interview I had with a representative of a national television network, I have discovered that an answer I gave to a question posed by Senator Edward Kennedy during my confirmation hearings was not entirely accurate.

The exchange in question appears on page 44 of the printed hearings. The matter concerns the alleged misuse of information obtained by the Lenexa, Kansas, Police Department from the computer network being operated by the Kansas City Police Department while I was Chief of that Department.

I stated during the hearings that it had been discovered a Lenexa police officer apparently was making inquiries over the computer network for a rental agency and some businessmen, and that he had been reprimanded and the Lenexa Police Department advised any further such violations could mean its terminal would be taken away. I now find that statement, which was based on my recollection of information furnished to me in 1970 by a subordinate command officer in Kansas City, was not entirely accurate. I had been told a letter was being sent to the Lenexa Chief of Police concerning this matter. I have learned now the contact with the Lenexa Chief of Police

Reference memorandum of 4-8-74 (copy attached) recommending that a letter be sent to Senator Eastland concerning the testimony the Director gave regarding the Lenexa, Kansas, Police Department and the fact that he has now discovered his statement during the confirmation hearings was not entirely accurate. It was also recommended a copy of the letter be delivered to Senator Kennedy who had asked the questions during the confirmation hearings regarding the Lenexa Police Department.

On 4-11-74 Inspector Bowers delivered the letter to Senator Eastland. The Senator read the letter and said he saw no reason for concern. He said he would hold the letter but he personally felt Mr. Kelley did not need to make any explanation. The Senator was asked for his opinion concerning the advisability of furnishing a copy of the letter to Senator Kennedy. He recommended against this, saying that he saw no need whatever to give Kennedy or his staff an open invitation to possibly create an issue. He said he would hold the letter from Mr. Kelley and if anything ever came up on the matter in his Committee he could quell it.

In view of Senator Eastland's recommendation, the copy of the letter intended for delivery to Senator Kennedy was not delivered and will not be delivered.

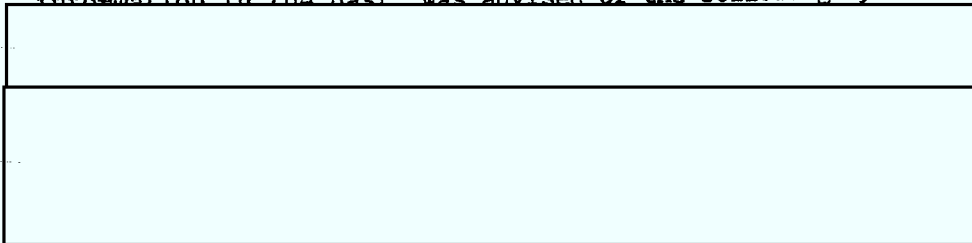

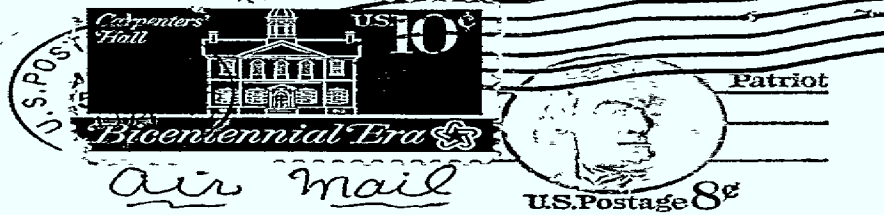

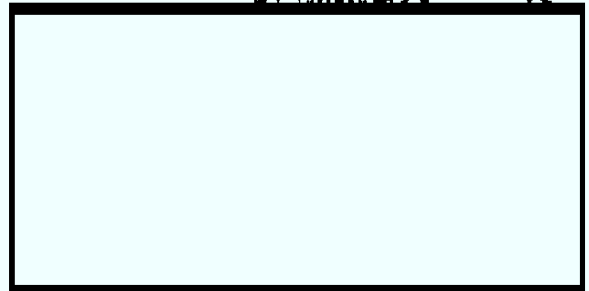

Smith to Wannall memo 10/1/74, captioned as above, reported that Mr. James Wilderotter, Associate Deputy Attorney General, would recontact the Attorney General concerning a proposal that we attempt once again to brief Senators Kennedy, Muskie and Ervin, without members of their staff present, concerning electronic surveillances. This briefing would be completely candid, with nothing held back if the Senators agree not to make a record of or publicize what they are told or shown.

On 10/3/74 Mr. Wilderotter advised that he has contacted the Attorney General, who has approved making another effort to conduct the briefing. He said also that Assistant Attorney General Vincent Rakestraw has obtained clearance for the briefing from Senator James O. Eastland. Wilderotter said that Rakestraw will now try to arrange the briefing by contacting the three Senators.

I suggested that Rakestraw contact the Senators personally rather than try to make arrangements through the Senators' staffs, since the staff members will obviously not feel inclined to be cooperative.

I told Wilderotter that I mentioned the matter of such a briefing to [redacted] one of Senator Kennedy's aides, during a luncheon conversation 10/2/74, and [redacted] voiced opinion that Kennedy would not be receptive to such a proposal. I told [redacted] that Kennedy should give a lot of thought to the matter since after such a complete, unvarnished briefing he would be in position to lay the wiretap myth to rest by appearing before the Senate and the American people and stating positively that he has personally examined what the FBI is doing with respect to electronic surveillance and he is satisfied that the FBI is



On November 13, 1974, I accompanied the Director to a conference with the Deputy Attorney General, and during the course of the discussion, the Deputy Attorney General received a call from [redacted] of the White House staff, who advised that [redacted] who represents Senator Kennedy and who is working on the current FOIA legislation, had indicated an interest in reviewing FBI investigative files so that he could be aware of their nature when he was considering the need for changing the statutory language from "investigatory files" to "investigatory records." The Deputy Attorney General told [redacted] that the Director of the FBI was at the time in his office and he would inquire as to whether it would be possible for [redacted] to be granted access to FBI investigative files in order for him to become knowledgeable concerning them. The Deputy Attorney General then asked whether it would be possible to grant access to our files for the purpose indicated. I told him it would not be possible to grant access to our investigative files.

The Deputy Attorney General then asked whether it would be possible for us to find some alternative way of educating [redacted] as to the general nature of FBI files so that he would understand the problem we would face if the statutory language were changed requiring us to review line by line, each document in a Bureau file. I told the Deputy Attorney General that we would consider the request and if it was possible that we would make the necessary arrangements.

At a conference later in the day with Assistant Attorney General Scalia, Office of Legal Counsel, Mr. Scalia told me that the Deputy Attorney General had told him that arrangements were made by the FBI to permit Mr. [redacted] to have access to sample FBI investigative files. I told Mr. Scalia that this was incorrect. I had advised the Deputy Attorney General that we could not grant access to FBI files but that we were considering possible alternatives that would permit him to become aware of the problem

Mr. Farrington suggested that it would be possible for us to allow Sussman to review materials previously prepared for release in a Freedom of Information Act request involving Alger Hiss and organized crime figures. Mr. Farrington explained that these materials have been prepared for release and allowing Mr. [redacted] to review them would not compromise FBI files.

At 3:55 p.m., November 13, 1974, I advised Assistant Attorney General Scalia that we had available sample material that had been prepared for release under the FOIA that would be representative of the problems of deleting identifying data and other material that would not be released under the Act and that such material could be made available at 10:00 a.m. on the morning of November 14, 1974 for the purposes indicated. He expressed appreciation for this and advised that he would make arrangements for the meeting in the Department, and he would advise us later of the time and place, but that it probably would be in Mr. Rakestraw's office.

At 4:15 p.m., Mr. Scalia's secretary called my secretary and advised that the above meeting now would be held at 9:15 a.m. in Room 5214.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Supervisor James C. Farrington, accompanied by Inspector David W. Bowers and Supervisor Richard C. Dennis, represent the Bureau at the meeting with Mr. Scalia and representatives of the White House and of the Department to discuss the pending FOIA legislation and to review with them the sample material described above.

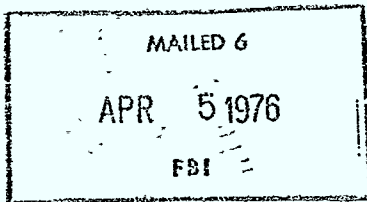

Dear Chief Faille:

In examining President Ford's proposed budget for fiscal year 1977, I have noted with concern his intention to eliminate federal funding of the Law Enforcement Education Program and to require State and local policy agencies to reimburse the F.B.I. for up to one-half of the cost of sending local police personnel to the F.B.I. National Training Academy.

I believe that such cuts, totalling over 45 million dollars, would prove most destructive to the future recruitment and training of qualified police personnel at the local level. I am sure you will agree that our local police departments are already operating on reduced budgets, and to require them to meet the additional costs of advanced education and police training will, I fear, result in the total elimination of such valuable programs.

The front line defense in the war on crime rests with the police officer patrolling our city streets. All police departments benefit from the opportunities afforded them by the L.E.E.P. and F.B.I. programs.

I will urge the Senate Appropriations Committee to eliminate this proposed budget cut from the President's budget and will, if necessary, pursue this matter on the Senate floor. I will continue to maintain close contact with the International and Massachusetts Chiefs of Police Associations as to this matter and will inform you of subsequent developments and in this effort, I hope I will have your suggestions and support.

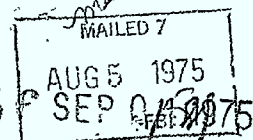
As you noted in your letter, our files must be

a limited search is conducted, sufficient to determine if we

No background check is conducted concerning

Dear Mr. Kelley:

A number of persons who have requested or are requesting information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation under the Freedom of Information Act have voiced concern over newstories suggesting that the Bureau "opens a file" or such requesters of information.

While it is obvious that a file would have to be opened to facilitate the processing of a Freedom of Information request, the law clearly places no requirement on a requester to be directly or personally concerned with the matter about which he requests information (except, of course, when one is requesting access to his own file). Especially considering the large number of current requests for information being received by the FBI, it would seem an unnecessary diversion of attention from processing these requests for agents even to take time for background checks of requesters.

I would appreciate your explaining the precise procedures used by the FBI in filling Freedom of Information requests, including an indentification of the index, files or other lists against which the requester's name is checked and the purpose for such check.

On November 29, 1979, the Phoenix FBI Office was contacted by [REDACTED], News Director, KOY AM Radio, 840 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona, telephone number 258-8181, concerning a news release issued by Interworld Congress, which may have contained a threat to the life of Senator Ted Kennedy, who was to visit Phoenix that afternoon.

Investigation at KOY determined that a young woman, name unknown, had dropped off the press release at approximately 12:00 noon on November 29, 1979, and had immediately left the building. She had delivered two of the releases, one for the News Department of KOY and the other for the host of a talk show that ran every evening on weekdays at KOY. The person dropping the press release was further described as being short, in her early thirties, attractive, with dark brown hair, approximately 5'5" in height, slender build, wearing a black sweater over a dark colored blouse and a skirt. The woman may have worn glasses. A copy of the press release was obtained.

A copy of the press release was immediately furnished to [REDACTED] U. S. Secret Service, Phoenix, at the front entrance of the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Phoenix, where Senator Ted Kennedy was due to arrive that afternoon.

Those in the know, those to whom the continuation of keeping the facts undisclosed is essential, will stop at nothing, not even murder to perpetuate the web of lies that protects a truth so horrible as to rock the American public from its hypnotic complacency. To them, Senator Kennedy is expendable.

"The fly in the ointment, however, is Edward Kennedy himself who will find it impossible to maintain his composure and to continue to spout a fabricated tale under the spotlight of pressurized interviews from an inquiring media and constituency. The whole truth about his brother John's assassination Senator Kennedy may not be in possession of but he does know what didn't happen at Chappaquiddick and it is an ironic set of circumstances that transports John Kennedy's caravan of death to Mary Jo Kopechne's cavalcade of horror.

"It is time for Senator Kennedy to stop compromising with the truth, as it is his own life that is in the balance."
