The GORENS were interviewed and proved to be an elderly couple born in Russia who are naturalized citizens and who have been operating a cleaning shop in Los Angeles for approximately 15 years. Mr. and Mrs. GOREN disclaimed any knowledge of the letter and Mr. GOREN claims he is unable read or write the English language while Mrs. GOREN demonstrated some ability to read English, but claimed some of the words in the extortion letter were unknown to her. The penciled phone number WE 1-8663 on the envelope of HARRY L. GOREN was placed there by

The laboratory is requested to conduct the following examination:

l. Process the extortion letter for latent fingerprints and compare the results with the elimination prints submitted herein.

Also compare latent print results with any fingerprints found in file on HARRY LOUIS GOREN, born 1/15/1897 in Russia, 5'10" tall, 185 pounds, blue eyes and naturalized in U. S. District Court, Minneapolis, Minnesota in 1933. GOREN was arrested in Los Aggeles 6 months ago for drunk, by the Los Angeles Police Department, probably on 4/2/54.

- 2. Conduct type examination to establish the make of the typewriter used to write extortion letter and draw conclusions as to whether type was done by a trained typist or a hunt and peck typist.
- 3. Examine paper for any conclusions concerning the make, watermarks, etc., and information concerning description and use of paper this unusual size.




It is believed possible these letters have a connection with the letter previously submitted on 10/11/60, noting that the first typewritten letter above, contains use of "etcetera" spelled "ect" which also appears in the letter previously submitted. The characteristic is also noted that the writer makes only one space between sentences, contrary to the usual typing practice. It is also observed that each of the letters submitted herewith make reference to "Butcher Boy" although one is typewritten and one hand printed.

It is requested that the Laboratory attempt to identify the kind of typewriter used in writing the letter dated 10/6/60. Comparison should be made between this typewriting and that of the previously substitted letter. The submitted items should be examined for any identifying water marks. These items should also be examined for latent fingerprints, bearing in mind that they were previously handled by the personnel of STEVE ALLEN's office, who are mentioned in referenced airtel and whose fingerprint: cards were submitted for elimination purposes.

It.was concluded the typewriting on specimens Q14 through Q19 was prepared on the typewriter used to prepare the specimens previously received except specimens Q8 through Q10 regarding which a definite conclusion could not be reached due to the limited nature of the typewriting or the fact that some of this material is in upper-case letters and is therefore not comparable with the typewriting on specimens Q14 through Q19.

It could not definitely be determined whether or not the handwriting on specimens Q12 and Q13 was prepared by the individual or individuals responsible for the handwriting on specimens Q4 and Q19 and the hand printing on specimens Q3 and Q4 because of the limited amount of comparable material available.

Specimens Q12 is a white bond envelope which measures approximately 6.5 by 3.6 inches and bears no waterwark. Specimen Q13 is a sheet of white ruled, three hole, notebook paper with rounded corners. This specimen measures approximately 8.5 by 10.9 inches and bears no waterwark. This specimen is similar to specimen Q4 except that it is slightly smaller in size.

Specimen Q14 is a white envelope similar to specimen Q1. Specimen Q15 is a sheet of pink bond paper which measures approximately 8.5 by 11.0 inches and bears no watermark.

Specimen Q16 is a white bond envelope with a printed return address form in the upper left-hand corner. This specimen measures approximately 6.5 by 3.7 inches and bears no watermark. Specimens Q17 through Q15 are sheets of yellow bond paper which measure approximately 8.4 by 10.4 inches and bear no watermarks.

Specimens Q12 through Q19 will be returned separately. Photographs are retained.







Personal Secretary to STEVE ALLEN, television personality and actor, advised 10/11/60, that during recent months ALLEN had received many letters of criticism concerning ALLEN's stand on both the death penality and the ban on nuclear testing. She said many of these letters were very abusive and accused ALLEN of being a Communist. Some of these letters were signed, while others were not. On 10/11/60, ALLEN received a one-page typewritten letter postmarked 10/10/60, at Los Angeles. This letter commences: "My name is HARRY GOREN. I live at 1802 Redondo Boulevard, Los Angeles." In this letter, the author says he has only a short time to live, so he This letter comlooked around to see what he could do before he died which would benefit society. He said he found he could exterminate some of the fifth column filth and out of a blue sky comes the name ALLEN. The writer then says, "That is why I write to you, Mr. Communist ALLEN....call it a joke if you wish....but let me tell you this: I have nothing to lose by taking my revolver, going down to your home and....to your office....and, on the whim, firing two or three bullets into the head of the biggest liar, cheat, humbug and Communist in this country..." The writer continues, "This is not a request, but a demand, that you abolish your Commie activities within the next FOUR DAYS. Repeat: FOUR DAYS. If you do not, you are going to be dead within

the next three weeks." Other letters containing similar abusive language have since been received by ALLEN. GOREN, as well as other persons whose names appear on these letters, have been interviewed, where it was possible to identify them, and they all deny writing above referred to letter. AUSA, Los Angeles, advised GOREN letter, in his opinion, constitutes violation of Federal Extortion Statute, and he will consider prosecution if identity of subject can be established.

Mr. STEVE ALLEN, suite 25, 15445 Ventura Boulevard, Sherman Oaks, California, advised that during the recent months this office has received many letters of criticism sent to Mr. ALLEN concerning ALLEN's stand on both the death penalty and the ban on nuclear testing. Many of these letters were very abusive, assusing ALLEN of being a communist, and most letters were signed although some were sent anonymously. This morning the following letter was delivered to the office and was opened by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ This letter and envelope are initialed by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and SA \_\_\_\_\_\_ It's contents are as follows:

"Mr. STEVE ALLEN Sherman Cake, Cal.

"Dear Mr. ALLEN"

"My name is HARRY GOREN, I live at 1802 Redondo Boulevard in Los Angeles. The reason I write to you, Mr. ALLEN, is because I have been informed by my doctor that I have exactly three weeks to live. In the next three to four weeks, I will die from the fatal disease cancer.

"When I first heard the news I became very frightened. Frightened, not because I was going to die, but because of what I made of my life --- nothing. Nothing at all. So, I began to think, in my last few days what could I really do to make up for all my sins. Just what was it that I could do for someone or some people that would help me die in peace, knowing that something good was done.

"Then, just the other day, I read a newspaper headline which was titled, "Communists Start Youth Movement". It was a story about the fifth column in this country, the poisonous Communist traitors who were attempting to dupe many of our kids, in order, of course, to destroy this country, which, naturally, is their main penchant.

Mr. HERRY GOREN who resides at 1802 Redondo Boulevard in Los Angeles and who owns and operates a tailor shop at 4476 West Adams Boulevard, Los ngeles, was interviewed at his tailor shop mentioned above.

After agents identified themselves and informed Mr. GOREN why he was being contacted, he was told he did not have to talk with Agents unless he so desired. He was also told any statements he made during this interview might be used in a court of law against him. He was also informed that he was entitled to have an attorney of his choice present during the interview.

Mr. GOREN after having had the purpose of the Agents contact explained to him, stated he did not know STEVE ALLEN. Mr. GOREN advised he is 63 years of age, was born in Russia on January 15, 1897, but is now a naturalized American citizen. Mr. GOREN stated he had very little education and could barely read and write English. He said that he is able to read and write his own name, read the newspaper so long as the words used are familiar to him. It was noted he spoke with broken English and when given the letter which was purportedly written by him to STEVE ALLEN, he could pronounce only a few of the small words used in the letter.

Mr. GOREN positively denied having writen such a letter stating he had no typewriter, did not use a typewriter and in view of his limited knowledge of English, could not have possibly composed the letter which was shown to him.

Mrs. GOREN who was present during the above interview, also denied any knowledge of the letter and when she was given the letter to read for her husband, she could not pronounce correctly a great number of the words used in this letter.

Both Mr. and Mrs. GOREN could offer no explanation as to any reason a person would have written a letter to STEVE ALLEN using Mr. HENRY GORENs name and correct home address. They both denied being members of any clubs or groups in which STEVE ALLEN had been discussed or where the subject of communism was discussed. They stated they attend meetings of a church group which primarily engages in playing cards and work for
