The trial pertaining to those subjects arrested subsequent to the start of the first trial will begin in September, 1960. One of the last remaining fugitives was arrested in July 12, 1960, in the Santa Cruz Mountains.

At the present time, the FBI is not conducting an active investigation of the HAMC which has been named in the current indictment, inasmuch as such investigation must be predicated upon specific violations of federal law that have been committed or contemplated by the organization and since such investigation may conflict with the case pending against the HAMC in U.S. District Court, at San Francisco.

Other than information set forth in this communication, the FBI is not in receipt of any specific information indicating a threat to Judge Conti or his family. It is noted, however, that the HAMC has displayed a potential for violent reprisals against anyone who has opposed the organization in the past and the possibility of such reprisals against Judge Conti and family cannot be precluded.

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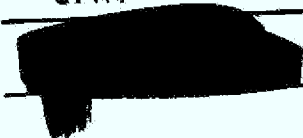

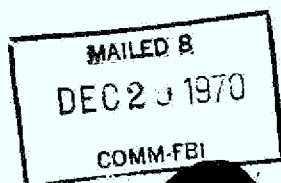

B. APPROX

The Cleveland "Plain Dealer", February 29, 1968, edition, carried an article captioned, "Cycle Gang War Ends in Death of Innocent Victims". This article stated that ROOSEVELT BROWN, age 38, a Negro, and JAMES O. TILLET, age 38, a white, were shot down in the early morning hours of February 28, 1968, at Barto's Cafe, 3344 East 93rd Street, Cleveland, Ohio. The article stated that they were innocent victims of a blossoming gang war between members of the Hell's Angels and God's Children. The article went on to say that the two victims were shot by members of the Hell's Angels gang who were out looking for members of the local chapter of God's Children. According to the article the cause of the gang war was the effort of the Hell's Angeles to organize a Cleveland Chapter of the gang, which is headquartered in California, and is supposedly militantly anti-Negro. The God's Children gang, an interracial gang which supposedly claims the Eastern United States as its territory, is violently opposed to the organizing efforts of the Hell's Angels in Cleveland. D

B. APPROX

The article stated that the Hell's Angels chapter was organized in Cleveland about two or three months ago and they have been attempting to recruit additional local members. Conflict between the Hell's Angels and God's Children reached the boiling point after a fist fight between two representatives of the gangs after a cycle show on February 18, 1968. The Hell's Angels man lost the fight and talk of retribution began immediately, adding fuel to the territorial fight. Both gangs

were out on the night of February 27, 1968, looking for each other, but they never met. Members of both gangs were armed. The Hell's Angels reportedly gathered at Barto's Cafe in the early morning hours of February 28, 1968, after their fruitless search for God's Children. They beat up a Negro piano player, ROBERT WILLIAMS, age 30, at the Cafe but stopped when the barmaid intervened. For a time the 15 or 16 members of the Hell's Angels were orderly, did not cause any trouble, merely played pool and drank beer. U

Then a group of the Hell's Angels gathered around ROOSEVELT BROWN and they began to break beer bottles over his head. JAMES O. TILLET attempted to intervene and was shot. BROWN broke away from the group and ran behind the bar, where he was followed by one of the gang who shot him in the back. U

Source who are familiar with the racial situation in the Cleveland area were contacted on February 28, 1968, and directed to ascertain whether the gang war between the Hell's Angels and God's Children would result in racial disturbances in this area because of the possible racial overtones involved. These sources advised that they had determined that no unusual racial tensions existed in Cleveland because of the above-described incident. U

Bimonthly Summary

Enclosed for the Bureau are eleven (11) copies of an LHM regarding captioned matter. One copy is being furnished Cincinnati per request and copies are also being furnished to local military intelligence agencies, Secret Service, and the USA, Cleveland.

Assignments which are specific in nature are given to all appropriate informants in the criminal security and racial fields to report any information developed indicating possible future racial violence. Our liaison program with the Cleveland, Ohio Police Department, which has proven to be a most effective one, continues on a daily basis. Every effort being made to develop additional sources within groups such as Black Nationalist extremist groups which have the proclivity toward violence.
