WINCHELL SAID:

He was invited last night to a reception for Adlai Stevenson at the Biltmore Hotel but did not get to meet Mr. Stevenson. He suspected it was because he had made the statement to Carmine DeSapéo, Secretary of New York State, and Campaign Manager Finnegan, when he learned that Mr. Eisenhower had turned over the intelligence reports to Mr. Stevenson, "It made me sick to my stomach." "I only hope Mr. Stevenson will never show any of those Secret U.S. intelligence reports to the former communist who will not get off his team."

WINCHELL SAID:

Attention: Mr. John Edgar Hoover -- An American woman, named by Congressional committees, as an active member of Red spy rings in New York, purchased recently an \$80,000 home off lower Fifth Avenue, New York City, right on Eleventh Street.

COLKENT:

A check with NYO and logical Bureau supervisors has failed to definitely establish the identity of this woman. However as he has resided to since approximately 1948.

Index and has appeared before the House committee on Un-American Activities and the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee. Before both committees she was uncooperative and invoked the Fifth Amendment. In 1948 she was cited for contempt before the House Committee on Un-American Activities but was acquitted in the District Court, Washington, D.C.
