On 12/17/74, [REDACTED]
U.S. Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pa., advised [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] is currently an inmate at the U.S. Penitentiary.
He stated [REDACTED] has written a number of letters to
Federal Judges and other persons complaining about
his being illegally incarcerated and any number of other
things. He said [REDACTED] is extremely unstable emotionally,
and has been treated at the Medical Center for Federal
Prisoners at Springfield, Mo., during the past year.
He said, however, he did not believe this had been of
any help to [REDACTED] who continues to act in a very strange
manner, although he is rational to talk to.

It is noted that [REDACTED] formerly
[REDACTED] U.S. Penitentiary, was transferred to
a new facility during 1974. However, this was [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] and not connected to any prostitution
ring as alleged by [REDACTED]

In view of [REDACTED] current psychiatric condition,
no further investigation is being conducted by Philadelphia
in captioned cases and they are both being closed.

Enclosed for the Bureau are an original and three copies of an LHM regarding captioned matter.

For the information of the Bureau, on 12/22/86, an unknown female caller contacted the Newark Office and made numerous general type threats against captioned individuals. Caller used extensive profanity and provided no identifying data. U. S. SECRET SERVICE (USSS) Special Agent [REDACTED] was immediately notified and arrangements were made [REDACTED]

To date no additional calls have been received. U.S. Attorney, Newark, advised that threat, as presented, did not constitute violation and declined federal prosecution.

Inasmuch as all logical investigation has been completed at Newark, this matter will be closed.

On December 22, 1986, the FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI) switchboard at Newark, New Jersey, was telephonically contacted by an unknown female who spoke wildly and sounded emotionally unstable. During the three phone calls, the caller demanded that, "the press" give "equal time" to white persons in general and to the KLU KLUX KLAN to defend against claims of racism and bigotry. Among the statements made by the caller were, "We give our county away to the f---ing niggers and the f---ing Jews....We're called racist if we fight back"

With regard to "Mr. [REDACTED] and other "liberals" -
"They are the racists, the scum of the earth."

"We're constantly called racists by [REDACTED] the
Supreme Court and all the rest."

The caller then stated, "We're going to kill [REDACTED]
That's a threat."

The caller then proceeded to curse "the liberals" whom she blamed for the country being given away and the affirmative action program.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

b7c [REDACTED] The caller, during the third call to the FBI stated, [REDACTED] hates whites. I charge that [REDACTED] is a racist. I'm tired of the Jews, of [REDACTED]

"We're tired of being treated like second class citizens. We are ready to burn the f---ing nigger lovers."

[REDACTED] ain't gonna win that election. We're gonna bomb it. He's gonna get killed."

The caller identified other liberals and/or oppressors whom she considered guilty of "draining the nation." These included [REDACTED] the JEWISH DEFENSE LEAGUE and United States Supreme Court Justice BRENNAN. Attempts to secure the caller's phone number on a pretext were unsuccessful.

b7E The information regarding all three telephone calls was provided to the UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE, East Orange, New Jersey, immediately upon receipt. Arrangements were made [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] To date, no additional calls have been received.

United States Attorney, Newark, was apprised of the situation and advised that the facts, as presented, did not merit federal prosecution.
