At the time of the interview, MARTIN had no knowledge regarding this matter, but said he had received numerous letters in the past of a similar nature when playing baseball in the Major Leagues, and he never concerned himself with them. He had no idea as to the identity of the person who prepared the letter and has received no other threats in the past.

As indicated by enclosures, this letter bore the postmark United Nations, New York, March 25, 1975.

The FBI Identification Division is requested to examine the enclosed letter for latent fingerprints. The only persons known to have handled the letter are





Mr. MARTIN advised that he had only heard about the threatening letter which was addressed to him at his temporary residence, the Surfrider Hotel, Pompano Beach, Florida, and he had not seen the letter. He said that his wife had opened the letter and was somewhat upset about it. She furnished the letter to who Mr. MARTIN believed was in possession of the letter at this time.

Mr. MARTIN said his wife has departed for Texas and he will join her there following this baseball game.

Mr. MARTIN said that during his "playing years," he has received numerous threatening letters, all of which he "tossed in the wastebasket" and paid no attention to them. He said he is not concerned about this letter and he considers it to be the work of a prankster or a nut. He noted, however, the Texas Rangers Baseball Team will be playing baseball in Flushing, New York, on May 23, 1975, which is the date, according to information received by him, that the threat was made against him.

Mr. MARTIN said he will immediately contact the FBI if any additional letters are received by him in the future of a similar nature.

MARTIN stated that he does not know the identity of the writer of this letter and has received no subsequent correspondence from this person. MARTIN advised he believes that the writer of this letter is a disgruntled New York Yankee baseball fan who was incensed at the fight between his baseball club and the New York Yankees at a spring training game in Florida in the recent past. MARTIN advised that he suspects this letter was prompted by the publicity which resulted from this fight and from his feud with New York Yankee ELLIOT MADDOX. a former Texas Ranger baseball player.

MARTIN advised he does not consider his life threatened by this letter but rather considers this letter to be a "crank" piece of mail from an unhappy baseball fan.

MARTIN stated that the events which are mentioned in this letter do not have any special significance to him since all were well publicized incidents in his career in baseball to which anyone who read the media would have access.

MARTIN stated that he does not believe that this piece of mail was sent by since he considers any previous misunderstandings he has had with to be things of the past.







The above-referenced defendant was arrested on a misdemeanor charge of Driving while Intoxicated following an automobile accident on December 25, 1989 in which a passenger in the vehicle, former New York Yankees manager V Billy Martin, died.


As I mentioned in my telephone conversation with Hair and Fibers Section Unit Supervisor on February 26th, the Western Regional Crime Laboratory of the New York State Police conducted an examination of the pick-up truck involved in the accident and secured hairs from the left or driver's side of the windshield. The hairs were then submitted to a second NYSP Regional Crime Laboratory for microscopic analysis and comparison with known hair samples from occupants of the truck. We were recently informed by that laboratory that, due to a backlog in case processing, the New York State Police would be unable to perform the requested analysis. A copy of the Western Regional Crime Laboratory's report concerning the examination of the truck is enclosed for your review.

The following items of evidence are being submitted herewith for your examination and analysis: (1)

One (1) sealed evidence bag, labeled "89B-2992 add. #3" containing head hairs of WILLIAM REEDY.

One (1) sealed evidence bag, labeled "89B-2992 add. #9", containing head hairs of BILLY MARTIN.

One (1) plastic specimen box, labeled "89B-2992 # 6A RKS" questioned sample of hairs removed from windshield of pick-up truck.

The evidence is being submitted in the hope that you will conduct an examination with a view toward rendering an opinion as to whether any of the hairs contained in the specimen box labeled "89B-2992 #6A RKS" are similar in microscopic characteristics to the head hair of either WILLIAM REEDY or BILLY MARTIN.

The above evidence has not been previously examined for this purpose.

Questions about the submission may be made to this investigator, Broome County District Attorney Gerald F. Mollen or Broome County Chief Assistant District Attorney Kevin P. Dooley at (607) 778-2423. Preliminary reports of your analysis also may be communicated to any one of the three persons named above.

New York State Criminal Procedure Law dictates that the prosecution must be prepared to proceed to trial within ninety days of the commencement of a criminal action. We have approximately thirty days remaining in that time period in the present case.

The above-referenced defendant was arrested on a misdemeanor charge of Driving while Intoxicated following an automobile accident on December 25, 1989 in which a passenger in the vehicle, former New York Yankees manager Billy Martin, died.

As I mentioned in my telephone conversation with Hair and Fibers Section Unit Supervisor the New York State Police conducted an examination of the Laboratory of the New York State Police conducted an examination of the pick-up truck involved in the accident and secured hairs from the left or driver's side of the windshield. The hairs were then submitted to a second NYSP Regional Crime Laboratory for microscopic analysis and comparison with known hair samples from occupants of the truck. We were recently informed by that laboratory that, due to a backlog in case processing, the New York State Police would be unable to perform the requested analysis. A copy of the Western Regional Crime Laboratory's report concerning the examination of the truck is enclosed for your review.

The following items of evidence are being submitted herewith for your examination and analysis:

One (1) sealed evidence bag, labeled "89B-2992 add. #3", containing head hairs of WILLIAM REEDY.

One (1) sealed evidence bag, labeled "89B-2992 add. #9", containing head hairs of BILLY MARTIN.

One (1) plastic specimen box, labeled "89B-2992 # 6A RKS" Questioned sample of hairs removed from windshield of pick-up truck.



The evidence is being submitted in the hope that you will conduct an examination with a view toward rendering an opinion as to whether any of the hairs contained in the specimen box labeled " 89B-2992 #6A RKS " are similar in microscopic characteristics to the head hair of either WILLIAM REEDY or BILLY MARTIN.

The above evidence has not been previoully examined for this purpose.

Preliminary reports of your analysis also may be communicated to any one of the three persons named above.


