Seized pursuant to search warrants were approximately five ounces of cocaine, one ounce of heroin, small amounts of cannabis, three handguns and \$1,050 U.S. Currency.

These searches were handled as a local matter to afford security to the anticipated TF effort in anticipation of developing cooperative subjects.
