

Humphrey, Democratic Vice Presidential nominee, is scheduled to arrive at Spaatz Field, Reading, Pa., Airport, 9:15 a.m., October 15, 1964, making a campaign speech in Penn Square (outdoor platform on Penn Street in the heart of Reading's business district, between Fifth and Sixth Streets) from 9:30 a.m. to 10 a.m., thereafter departing Reading Airport about 10:30 a.m.

On October 13, 1964, when New York Senator and Republican Vice Presidential nominee William Miller spoke in Reading, was "grabbed" by the Reading Police as he pushed his way up to Miller on this same Penn Square stand, as Miller was speaking. was carrying, at that time, a medium-sized wrapped package. This was subsequently determined to contain a two-way radio. This radio was valued at approximately \$180, which wanted to present to Barry Goldwater, and subject was thereafter released.

AMERICAN NAZI PARTY OF THE WORLD UNION OF FREE ENTERPRISE NATIONAL SOCIALISTS, aka THE GEORGE LINCOLN ROCKWELL PARTY

In his book "This Time The World", copyrighted in 1961, George Lincoln Rockwell identified himself as Commander, American Nazi Party of the world Union of Free Enterprise National Socialists (ANP-WUFENS), Arlington, Virginia.

The April 4, 1963 issue of "The Richmond News Leaders", a Richmond, Virginia daily newspaper, reported that George Lincoln Rockwell had, on the previous day, again applied for the American Nazi Party to be chartered in the State of Virginia, but this request was turned down by the Virginia State Corporation Commission. This action was taken pursuant to an act of the 1962 Virginia Assembly which prohibits the use of "Nazi" or "National Socialism" in a Virginia charter. This article further pointed out that Rockwell's party is presently chartered in the State of Virginia as the George Lincoln Rockwell Party.

by George Lincoln Rockwell at his residence in Arlington, Virginia on February 26, 1959 as an international "National Socialist" movement based on the German Nazi Party headed by Adolf Hitler. He added that Rockwell is the dominant force and personality in this party; that he is espousing a "line" of hatred against the Jews and Negroes; and that he is seeking, through speeches, distribution of literature and picketing, to establish a cohesive and dominant political party in the United States and in foreign countries.

the ANP initiated the Fighting American Nationalists (FAN) as a front group for the ANP, although it has never been a separate organization. He said the FAN name is merely used on occasion instead of the ANP name and there are no separate officials for FAN, the FAN officials being identical with the ANP officials.

He added that the ANP has operated under the FAN name throughout the country with the exception of a group operating under the FAN name in Baltimore, Maryland. He said the FAN group in Baltimore is now, and always has been, a separate organization and not a part of the ANP.

On October 3, 1963

organized in the Spring of 1961, has no official connection with the ANP, although until December, 1962, it received all its literature from George Lincoln Rockwell's ANP.

According to the "Stormtrooper's Manual", an official publication of the ANP, the phases of ANP struggle for power are fourfold, namely, first "to make ourselves known to the masses"; second, "the dissemination of our program and the truth about the Party"; third, "organize the people who have been converted to our propaganda"; and fourth, "that attainment of power through the votes of the newly-won masses."

At 3:20 p.m. today, SAC Soyars of the Phoenix Office telephonically advised as follows:

connection with public appearances of Senator Humphrey, were in Tucson, Arizona. At 11:20 a.m. this morning (Phoenix time), Chestnut appeared on Channel 4 at Phoenix, speaking for six or seven minutes. At 11:30 a.m. a call was received for at the TV station. When being advised Chestnut was not then available and the caller's identity requested, caller refused to reveal his identity and stated as follows: "You better dissuade Humphrey from coming to Tucson or there is going to be an assassination attempt" and hung up.

SAC Soyars advised that Senator Humphrey is due to arrive in Tucson at 7:10 p.m. 11/1/64, will stay at the Remada Inn in Tucson until 9:00 p.m., then proceed to the Sports Center at Tucson where he is to make an address at 9:10 p.m. He is scheduled to leave Tucson at 10:15 p.m. on 11/1/64 by air for Los Angeles.

advised the Resident Agent at Tucson that they had called Washington, D. C., and had advised mm of the threat. According to Short told them not to tell anybody but give the information to the FBI.

hat in view of SAC Sovars stated that he advised the threat against Senator Humphrey that the information was being furnished locally to Secret Service and was also being furnished to the Tucson Police Department and the Piema County Sheriff's office which covers the Tucson area.

This information is being furnished to Secret Service at Washington, D. C. and Senator Humphrey's office is being advised. Dissemination will be confirmed in writing.



On October 29, 1964 at 12:20 PM. who advised they were Democratic National Committee concerning arrangements for a visit by HUBERT H. HUMPHREY to Tucson, Arizona on Sunday, November 1, 1964, personally called at the Tucson Resident Agency of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and advised as follows:

At 11:20 AM on October 29, 1964, appeared on television station KVOA, channel 4, Tucson, where he spoke for six or seven minutes. At about 11:30 AM, a telephone call was received by station KVOA from an unknown male requesting to talk with The caller was requested by of station KVOA to identify himself, and declined, whereupon he was informed that he could not The caller then instructed that he should dissuade to advise from coming to Tucson the following Sunday inasmuch as there would be an assassination attempt against Mr. HUMPHREY if he does come to Tucson.

advised that he telephonically contacted at the headquarters of the Democratic National Committee, 1730 K Street, Washington, D. C., who informed him to immediately report this matter to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

For information of Bureau, I have been informed that Vice President Elect HUBERT H. HUMPHREY will be departing the Virgin Islands on the morning of 11/18/64. He will be flying from the Virgin Islands to San Juan, Puerto Rico, in the plane of Rear Admiral HENRY CALDWELL, Commanding Officer of the U.S. Naval Forces in Puerto Rico, and will arrive at San Juan International Airport at 11:30 AM that date. He will thereafter proceed to U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico, where he will remain from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM, on 11/18/64, and will thereafter return to San Juan. He will depart San Juan via chartered plane for the Continental U.S., presumably Washington, D.C., at 5:00 PM on 11/18/64.





The letter, which is addressed simply to "Orlando Sentinel", no street address, city, state, or further identifying data being given, was handprinted with pencil throughout. The envelope is of the plain, white variety, measures $9\frac{1}{2}$ " by 4 1/8", bears no return address, and is postmarked October 31, 1964, at Orlando, Florida.

The two page letter is written on regular lined notebook paper, sixe 8" by $10\frac{1}{2}$ ", is unsigned, and reads as follows:

"This is not a joke. It's serious. There has been so much talk and wondering why Kennedy was killed I want people to know why Johnson gets it. I lost a son and daughter in Roosevelt's World War II, my friend lost two sons. I lost a grandson in Truman's Korean War, my friend lost a son in Kennedy's Bay of Pigs. We each have grandsons in Viet Nam war. Expect to hear any time that some of them have been killed.

"All these wars was unnecessary and the billions of dollars spent and given away was wasted. If the fool presidents had not given other countries money they would not have been able to make war. Wars go on and always will as long as they get free money.

on December 30, 1964, he was browsing in the

Michigan. He was approached by a man who he described as a white male, approximately 50 years of age, 6'3" or 6'4" tall, 200 pounds, wearing glasses with plain plastic rims, brown overcoat, scotch plaid scarf and dress hat. This man was mild in appearance and manner.

The individual approached him and said to the effect, "Do you have time to read in the evening?". replied that he read a great deal in the evenings and thereafter the man started discussing politics. According to the man appeared to have very severe rightist views and told him, to the effect President Roosevelt should have been assassinated in the 1930s, further that he was glad that President Kennedy was assassinated and he was also in the favor of assassinating Vice President Elect Hubert Humphrey. After approximately 45 minutes the discussion was terminated and the man left with a younger man.




