Humphrey, Democratic Vice Presidential nominee, is scheduled to arrive at Spaatz Field, Reading, Pa., Airport, 9:15 a.m., October 15, 1964, making a campaign speech in Penn Square (outdoor platform on Penn Street in the heart of Reading's business district, between Fifth and Sixth Streets) from 9:30 a.m. to 10 a.m., thereafter departing Reading Airport about 10:30 a.m.

SENATOR HUBERT H. HUMPHREY**

On October 13, 1964, when New York Senator and Republican Vice Presidential nominee William Miller spoke in Reading, [REDACTED] was "grabbed" by the Reading Police as he pushed his way up to Miller on this same Penn Square stand, as Miller was speaking. [REDACTED] was carrying, at that time, a medium-sized wrapped package. This was subsequently determined to contain a two-way radio. This radio was valued at approximately \$180, which [REDACTED] wanted to present to Barry Goldwater, and subject was thereafter released.

A characterization of the American Nazi Party is attached hereto.

Information from source received terminating 11:20 p.m., October 14, 1964. At 11:22 p.m., October 14, 1964, [REDACTED] Reading, Pa., was advised of the foregoing. At 11:27 p.m., October 14, 1964, [REDACTED] was advised. At 12:02 a.m., October 15, 1964, [REDACTED] Philadelphia, was advised. b7c

At 7:32 a.m., October 15, 1964, [REDACTED] presently attached to Senator Humphrey's staff and who is [REDACTED] was advised. [REDACTED] will meet Senator Humphrey when he arrives at Reading Airport and immediately advise him of these facts.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] around the review stand, both indicated they know subject by sight and will "probably detain under a suitable pretext and in no circumstances allow him near the reviewing stand."

**AMERICAN NAZI PARTY OF THE WORLD UNION  
OF FREE ENTERPRISE NATIONAL SOCIALISTS,  
aka THE GEORGE LINCOLN ROCKWELL PARTY**

In his book "This Time The World", copyrighted in 1961, George Lincoln Rockwell identified himself as Commander, American Nazi Party of the world Union of Free Enterprise National Socialists (ANP-WUFENS), Arlington, Virginia.

The April 4, 1963 issue of "The Richmond News Leaders", a Richmond, Virginia daily newspaper, reported that George Lincoln Rockwell had, on the previous day, again applied for the American Nazi Party to be chartered in the State of Virginia, but this request was turned down by the Virginia State Corporation Commission. This action was taken pursuant to an act of the 1962 Virginia Assembly which prohibits the use of "Nazi" or "National Socialism" in a Virginia charter. This article further pointed out that Rockwell's party is presently chartered in the State of Virginia as the George Lincoln Rockwell Party.

[REDACTED] a source advised that the ANP-WUFENS was organized by George Lincoln Rockwell at his residence in Arlington, Virginia on February 26, 1959 as an international "National Socialist" movement based on the German Nazi Party headed by Adolf Hitler. He added that Rockwell is the dominant force and personality in this party; that he is espousing a "line" of hatred against the Jews and Negroes; and that he is seeking, through speeches, distribution of literature and picketing, to establish a cohesive and dominant political party in the United States and in foreign countries.

his source advised that in about September, 1960, the ANP initiated the Fighting American Nationalists (FAN) as a front group for the ANP, although it has never been a separate organization. He said the FAN name is merely used on occasion instead of the ANP name and there are no separate officials for FAN, the FAN officials being identical with the ANP officials.

He added that the ANP has operated under the FAN name throughout the country with the exception of a group operating under the FAN name in Baltimore, Maryland. He said the FAN group in Baltimore is now, and always has been, a separate organization and not a part of the ANP.

[REDACTED] advised that the Baltimore FAN, which was organized in the Spring of 1961, has no official connection with the ANP, although until December, 1962, it received all its literature from George Lincoln Rockwell's ANP. b7d

According to the "Stormtrooper's Manual", an official publication of the ANP, the phases of ANP struggle for power are fourfold, namely, first "to make ourselves known to the masses"; second, "the dissemination of our program and the truth about the Party"; third, "organize the people who have been converted to our propaganda"; and fourth, "that attainment of power through the votes of the newly-won masses."

At 3:20 p.m. today, SAC Soyars of the Phoenix Office telephonically advised as follows:

[REDACTED] in connection with public appearances of Senator Humphrey, were in Tucson, Arizona. At 11:20 a.m. this morning (Phoenix time), Chestnut appeared on Channel 4 at Phoenix, speaking for six or seven minutes. At 11:30 a.m. a call was received for [REDACTED] at the TV station. When being advised Chestnut was not then available and the caller's identity requested, caller refused to reveal his identity and stated as follows: "You better dissuade Humphrey from coming to Tucson or there is going to be an assassination attempt" and hung up.

SAC Soyars advised that Senator Humphrey is due to arrive in Tucson at 7:10 p.m. 11/1/64, will stay at the Remada Inn in Tucson until 9:00 p.m., then proceed to the Sports Center at Tucson where he is to make an address at 9:10 p.m. He is scheduled to leave Tucson at 10:15 p.m. on 11/1/64 by air for Los Angeles.

[REDACTED] advised the Resident Agent at Tucson that they had called [REDACTED] in Washington, D. C., and had advised him of the threat. According to [REDACTED] Short told them not to tell anybody but give the information to the FBI.

SAC Soyars stated that he advised [REDACTED] that in view of the threat against Senator Humphrey that the information was being furnished locally to Secret Service and was also being furnished to the Tucson Police Department and the Pima County Sheriff's office which covers the Tucson area.

This information is being furnished to Secret Service at Washington, D. C. and Senator Humphrey's office is being advised. Dissemination will be confirmed in writing.

On October 29, 1964 at 12:20 PM, [REDACTED] who advised they were [REDACTED] for the Democratic National Committee concerning arrangements for a visit by HUBERT H. HUMPHREY to Tucson, Arizona on Sunday, November 1, 1964, personally called at the Tucson Resident Agency of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and advised as follows:

At 11:20 AM on October 29, 1964, [REDACTED] appeared on television station KVOA, channel 4, Tucson, where he spoke for six or seven minutes. At about 11:30 AM, a telephone call was received by station KVOA from an unknown male requesting to talk with [REDACTED]. The caller was requested by [REDACTED] of station KVOA to identify himself, and declined, whereupon he was informed that he could not speak with [REDACTED]. The caller then instructed [REDACTED] to advise [REDACTED] that he should dissuade [REDACTED] from coming to Tucson the following Sunday inasmuch as there would be an assassination attempt against Mr. HUMPHREY if he does come to Tucson. b7c

[REDACTED] advised that he telephonically contacted [REDACTED] at the headquarters of the Democratic National Committee, 1730 K Street, Washington, D. C., who informed him [REDACTED] to immediately report this matter to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

[REDACTED] was informed that this matter would be immediately reported to the Secret Service in Phoenix, the Tucson Police Department, and the Pima County Sheriff's Office, Tucson.

On October 29, 1964 at 1:15 PM, [REDACTED] was informed concerning the above. Likewise at 1:20 PM [REDACTED] Tucson, and [REDACTED] of the Secret Service in Phoenix, Arizona were informed of the above.

PROTECTION OF THE PRESIDENT

Re San Juan radiogram to Bureau dated 11/2/64 and Burad to San Juan 11/3/64, both captioned as above.

For information of Bureau, I have been informed that Vice President Elect HUBERT H. HUMPHREY will be departing the Virgin Islands on the morning of 11/18/64. He will be flying from the Virgin Islands to San Juan, Puerto Rico, in the plane of Rear Admiral HENRY CALDWELL, Commanding Officer of the U.S. Naval Forces in Puerto Rico, and will arrive at San Juan International Airport at 11:30 AM that date. He will thereafter proceed to U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico, where he will remain from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM, on 11/18/64, and will thereafter return to San Juan. He will depart San Juan via chartered plane for the Continental U.S., presumably Washington, D.C., at 5:00 PM on 11/18/64.

ONI Agents stationed at San Juan have been requested by Secret Service to assist in furnishing protection to Vice President Elect HUMPHREY while he is in Puerto Rico on 11/18/64. No similar request has been made to FBI, San Juan.

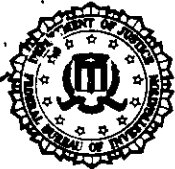

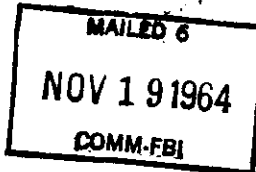

I asked Walter Jenkins, former Special Assistant to the President, on October 9, 1964, after referring to a letter sent to him by the Director dated September 30, 1964, and enumerating the details of a memorandum dated September 29, 1964, if Jenkins possibly had any knowledge of who the captioned individual might be.

As of October 15, 1964, while briefly visiting Jenkins with his [REDACTED] I told Jenkins this matter had not been clarified and asked him if he had pursued it any further. He stated that the President knew of this matter and had had him discuss it with Senator Humphrey. He mentioned that Senator Humphrey would undoubtedly advise [REDACTED] or the President if he could recall the individual who answered to the description of "John."

On 11/2/64 [REDACTED] advised me that Senator Humphrey had indicated to her office that he simply could not recall anyone answering this description. He stated he had no idea as to who the individual named "John" might be. Senator Humphrey thought that this was a fictitious set of facts.

It was, therefore, recommended that the White House be put on notice concerning this information. This was done in accordance with the Director's letter to Jenkins dated September 30, 1964, and as a result of my conversations with Jenkins.

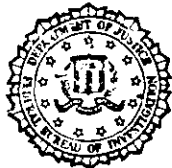

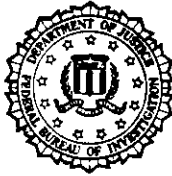

On March 30, 1965, an Agent of the Denver Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation contacted captioned individual at his place of employment, [REDACTED] Denver, Colorado, at [REDACTED] request.

At this time, [REDACTED], advised that he has corresponded numerous times with Senator "Bobby" Kennedy of New York and Martin Luther King concerning the well-being of King. [REDACTED] then furnished a copy of a letter dated March 26, 1935, which he wrote, and the original was apparently mailed to Senator Kennedy. This letter reads as follows:

"Dear Bobby,

"I believe that Dr. Martin Luther King and Vice President Humphrey are well guarded during these critical times but, I still fear for their lives because their violent death at the hands of southern racists would cause so much discredit to our beloved America.

[REDACTED] then stated that his main purpose in "talking to the FBI" is that he is desirous of expressing his fear and opinion to J. Edgar Hoover that Dr. Martin Luther King, due to his demanding attitude and his unawareness of communist infiltration and use of racial unrest and violence, is in danger of being assassinated by "racists, communists or Black Muslims." [REDACTED] stated that this is merely his opinion and he knows of no threat to the life of Martin Luther King.

[REDACTED] then set forth the following points which he feels the FBI should be aware of and should make Martin Luther King aware of:

1. FBI should discover the plot of communists to entice racists to assassinate King.
2. FBI should discover the plot by communists or Black Muslims to kidnap King.
3. King must be convinced of the danger of communist threats.
4. King is like a little boy with a deadly toy.

# Humphrey Gets a Base

Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey's Capitol office problem, more acute than when he was in the Senate, has been solved after a fashion.

Until something better turns up, the vice president will make an ornate room behind the Senate chamber his working as well as his ceremonial office.

The staff he will maintain in the Capitol, where he is required to spend much of his time, will be quartered across the visitors' lobby in a long and narrow office. It was released to him by Sen. Carl Hayden, D-Ariz., the president pro tem of the Senate, in one of those acts of generosity for which the Senate is sometimes noted and sometimes not.

That office once served as a reception room for President Johnson while he was vice president and before that while he was Senate majority leader.

The large office that Johnson used himself is held now by the Senate Democratic leader, Mike

Mansfield of Montana. Before it was taken over by Johnson several years ago, it was the Senate District Committee Room.

After Johnson as majority leader acquired it, the large room was redecorated in what some considered rather fanciful fashion. Some even called it the Taj Mahal.

If his Capitol quarters are a bit crowded—and separated to boot—Humphrey is not quite in the tenement class.

He also has a suite of six rooms in the New Senate Office Building. In addition, he has been assigned a suite of four rooms, reported as being quite nice, on the first floor of the Executive Offices Building, just across West Executive Avenue from the White House.

These are used when the vice president is wearing one of his several hats as the administration's coordinator of the poverty and civil rights programs and as chairman of the

Space Council and the Fair Employment Practices Commission.

Any day now, the vice president will surrender the Capitol offices he held as Democratic whip while in the Senate. They will go to Sen. Russell B. Long, D-La., who succeeded him in that position.

Aides reported that Humphrey, thanks to a quiet weekend, had fully recovered from "an executive cold" that afflicted high administration officials from the President down after the inaugural ceremonies.

Humphrey, the aides said, cancelled all social engagements over the weekend to throw off the cold that, while nagging, never forced him to go to bed.

The vice president has at least one trip ahead during the month. This is a visit back home to Minnesota for the Winter Carnival at Shattuck Military School at Faribault. His son Douglas, 16, is a student there.
