Reference is made to memorandum captioned as above
and dated February 1, 1968, at Omaha.

[REDACTED] there was on
that date posted on the bulletin board in the Student Union
at the University of Nebraska a notice from the Students for
a Democratic Society (SDS) that anyone interested in going to
Omaha on February 2, 1968, should sign up. The source believed
this notice pertained to a demonstration to be held at Creighton
University during the visit of Vice President Humphrey.

On February 2, 1968, Special Agents of the FBI observed
26 persons, male and female, in the vicinity of Creighton
University during the arrival and departure of Vice President
Humphrey. They displayed signs reflecting "End the War",
"De-escalate, Negotiate, Extricate", "Both Sides are Guilty",
"Support Our Boys - Bring Them Home" and "Stop Bombing -
Negotiate".

The demonstration was peaceful, no incidents occurred and
it lasted from 10:30 a.m. until 12:15 p.m.

The SDS is characterized in the appendix attached
hereto.

THOSE OF US WHO HAVE ASSEMBLED HERE TODAY WISH TO MAKE
clear that we are in no way protesting the presence of Vice-President
Johnson, nor do we question his right to address the people of Oregon.
We do express our concern regarding the conduct of the war in
all those questions in regard to the quality of the statements which have
been issued concerning this conflict and related matters.
WE DEEPLY REGRET THAT THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT
of the war have widened the "credibility gap" to the point where, we feel, the
break in the responsible communication which a democracy needs
people. More specifically, we cite the following instances:

"We are not about to send American boys 8 or 10 thousand
miles away to die what Asian boy should be doing for
these places." President Johnson, 1964

The failure of our government to inform the public of the
extremely high rate of civilian casualties in both North
and South Vietnam.

The failure of the government to adequately state the historical
background of the political-historical events which led to the
commencement of hostilities.

Secretary Rusk assured the American people that the
bombing of North Vietnam was limited to military
objectives --- the major cities of the North, with the
exceptions of Hanoi and Haiphong have been devastated,
causing untold suffering and necessitating the dislocation
of much of the populace.

The denial by our government that peace offers were
made by Hanoi when it was later revealed that such
offers were indeed expressed but denied as being
unopportune.

WE JOIN WITH POLITICAL AND RELIGIOUS LEADERS, AND INDI-
viduals of great number of men throughout the world, in expressing our sorrow
and concern, placing our heavy emphasis on the need of peace to attempt
the preservation of a world which has shown great loss of life. It is
reasonable to demand more candor on the part of the government on an a-
ppropriate level of the adequate involvement of this and other nations.

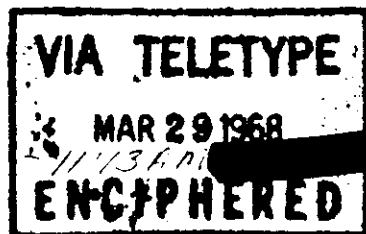

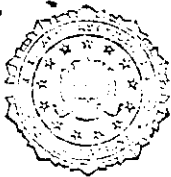

Reference is made to memorandum prepared at Charlotte, North Carolina, dated March 29, 1968, entitled "Demonstrations Planned at Appearance of Vice-President HUBERT HUMPHREY, Raleigh, North Carolina, March 28, 1968, and Winston-Salem, North Carolina, April 12, 1968."

On April 11, 1968, at 10:32 a.m., Vice President HUBERT H. HUMPHREY arrived by airplane at Smith Reynolds Airport, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, at which time he was greeted by a crowd of several hundred people, including two groups of young people. One of these groups consisted of nine male and female Negro and white college age youths carrying various signs indicating their support for presidential candidate ROBERT KENNEDY.

A second group consisted of 15 caucasian males and females carrying various signs and placards indicating their affiliation with Student Committee for Responsible Action of Wake Forest University. Signs carried by these youths indicated their support for the Kerner Report, for Open Housing and for winning the war on poverty.

Vice President HUMPHREY and his entourage left the airport at 10:41 a.m. en route to Wake Forest University, arriving there at 10:54 a.m., thereafter which the Vice President participated in the inauguration of Wake Forest University President JAMES RALPH SCALES.

At 1:53 p.m., the Vice President left Wake Forest University and traveled directly to the Hotel Robert E. Lee, downtown Winston-Salem, where he remained until 4:02 p.m., when he departed for Smith Reynolds Airport.

The Vice President and his party left Smith Reynolds Airport by jet aircraft at 4:25 p.m. on April 11, 1968, and there were no demonstrations during his appearance at Winston-Salem, North Carolina, on April 11, 1968.

The April 12, 1968, edition of the "Winston-Salem Journal," a daily newspaper of general circulation, contains an article entitled "Small Groups State Views at Airport", which states in part as follows:

"Two groups of students from Wake Forest University demonstrated peacefully yesterday during the arrival of Vice President Hubert Humphrey at Smith Reynolds Airport.

"The total of both groups was 35 people.

"One group is the Student Committee for Responsible Action.

"A spokesman for the group, Mary Ann Tolbert, said the demonstration was not anti or pro Humphrey. She said the intent of the demonstration was to urge more consideration of the report of the President's Commission on Civil Disorders.

"The other group demonstrated on behalf of Robert F. Kennedy for President.

"Gave Letter

"After Humphrey spoke at the inauguration of Dr. James Ralph Seales as president of Wake Forest University, the Student Committee for Responsible Action gave a letter to Humphrey.

"The letter stated the students concern for urban problems and expressed a desire for more consideration of the commission's report and its findings.

"Humphrey promised the students he would acknowledge the letter in about a week.

"Miss Tolbert said the group was organized a week ago after the death of Martin Luther King and urban riots which followed. Yesterday's demonstration was the group's first project.

"The students carried placards saying 'Silence is Irresponsibility,' 'We Support the Kerner Report,' 'Justice' and 'We Are Our Brother's Keeper.' "
