

DeBerry, a Brooklyn house painter and active in labor circles, said: "We welcome the formation of the Organization of Afro - American Unky by Minister Malcolm X and other black militants, as a glant step toward the real black revolution in America."

DeBerry made his comments Tuesday night in addressing street rallies in lower Manhattan where he defended black nationalism. The 39-year-old native of Holly Springs, Miss., is the first Negro to run for President on a minor party ticket.





Malcoim X has gone to Cairo, according to the news services, asse if he can persuade the participants in the Conference of African States to bring before the United Nations the diagracetul racial situation in the United States. Many Negroes feel this is not a had idea. Certainly, it would further bring to the attention of the world what is happening in some parts of our country, particularly the pistol-toting sections where to blow a man's head off in the middle of the night on racial grounds is as nothing, a where our law enforcement officials are strangely ineffective in bringing the guilty to justice.

m bringing the guilty to justice.

Malcolm X, like James Baldwin, has come to fame through peaking loud, long and roughly on Negro-white relations in the U.S. A. in terms which some segments of our population consider vulgar, rade and impudent. As nearly as I can gather from his pronouncements, Malcolm X considers white folks themselves not only vulgar, rude and impudent in speech, but in almost sverything else they do in relation to their black compatriots. He hinks their behavior is execrable and that, therefore, they should be denounced not only to their face, but behind their backs in far off places like Mecca and Cairs.

Malcolm X and Namer are about the same complexion, physically. In Mississippi they might both be taken for colored—and ambushed if out in the dark of night on some magnolia-acented road. And I am sure it is much easier for Malcolm to find a public place to eat in Cairo than it would be for him in Birming ham. Such things probably prey on his mind when he journeys to the capital of the United Arab Republic.

It is such states as Alabama and Mississippi that, I presume, Malcolm X would like the African delegates to the United Nations to mention on the podium of that august body, just as they have already mentioned the State of South Africa where apartheld is another name for Jim Crow, and where whites mistreat blacks with impunity, too. Of rourse, in South Africa the powers that he don't even pretend to wish to change. They do not pass civil zights hills, only hills of suppression and repression. Life for blacks there must be worse than in our own rescally henighted areas. But maybe not, for there the people of color are under ne Missions. Here Negroes keep thinking things will get better and better that is, some Negroes think so. But not Malbolm X. He thinks they will get worse and worse. So he has gone to Caire to tell the Africans how he feels and, in turn, he wants the Africans to tell the world. Some of the newly liberated ones just might do it, too. Then Adial Stevenson would have to

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of their civil rights to that of their human rights," Meleaim X is quoted as saying. "We want the United States charged with violation of human rights." He knows it might strench the average American mind a bit to equate Negro rights with human rights. But since Adlal Stevenson is not an average American, but a liberal, he could wrestle with that dilemms quite well. He would, no doubt, be careful not to call any African kettle black since they would hardly take the word figuratively. But the Iron Curtain countries as usual would probably get a tangential tongue lashing—as if Birmingham had fewer walls than East Berlin. On this nuance the UN, after applauding Stevenson, would, willy nilly, be left pondering.

M, however, the Negre problem should be brought let's year before the United Nations, it would not be the first time. Hardly had that organization been formed when the National Negro Congress filed in 1946 a petition with the Economic and Social Council asking its influence in sliminating racial discrimination in the United States. A decade later, in a carefully prepared "Statement on the Denial of Human Rights to Minorities in the Case of Citizens of Negro Descent in the United States of America and Appeal to the United Nations for Redress," the National Assufor the Advancement of Colored People presented its petition to the Department of Social Affairs of the UN, and Dr. W. E. B. DuBois, in his introduction to the document, pointed out that the submerged American Negro population then numbered more than the total population of Scandinavia, more than that of Canada, Hungary or the Netherlands, and was twice as large as Greece. "In sheer numbers," the NAACP petition stated, "we are a group which has a right to be heard."

Should Malcolm X at Cairo be successful in persuading the Afro-Asian bloc to present a petition to the United Nations on behalf of American blacks, certainly now with a semblance of international power behind it, the Negro cause might be heard more strongly today than ever before. The third petition, as the saying goes, just might be "the charm" that would have some effect. At least there is no harm, Negroes think, in Uying



These three, along with several well known negroes, were invited by LITTLE to this OAAU formation meeting to apparently lend some notoriety to the event. Nothing has been determined by the NYO which indicates that the above are members of or material supporters of the OAAU. It is noted that at this meeting the name of MY State CP leader WILLIAM PATTERSON (NYfile was also called out as an invited guest but he was not present.

Information has been received by the NYO that the SWP is apparently lending moral support to LITTLE and the OAAU.

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advised on 7/2/64, that in a conversation with other SWP members on 7/1/64, it was alleged that SWP members BOB FRANKLIN (NYfile Bufile Bufile by both negroes had joined the SAU. Also SWP member THADD BEEBE (NYfile Bufile by a negro, wanted to join the OAAU, but did not have the \$2.00 fee.

The 7/13/54 edition of the SWP paper
"The Militant," contains a front page article announcing
the formation of the OAAU at the 5/28/64 meeting. On
the second page is set out the aims and purposes of the
OAAU, a statement previously obtained by a Philadelphia
source. Also on the second page there is an article
on the NY campaign of SWP presidential candidate
CLIFTON DE BERRY, in which the latter is quoted as saying:

"We welcome the formation of the Organization of Afro-American Unity by Minister Halcolm X and other black militants, as a giant step toward the real black revolution in America."

This support from the SWP, and the failure of WILLIAM PATTERSON to accept LITTLE's invitation, tends to confirm information set out in the report of SAME LANGE LA

Information has also been received from and indicating that CLARENCE JONES (NYfile Bufile likes the OAAU statement of principles as given by LITTLE, and JONES offered his support to LITTLE by having the latter's statements and speeches printed free of charge (See NYairtel and LHM dated 7/1/54, captioned "CPUSA, NEGRO QUESTION, COMMUNIST INFLUENCE IN RACIAL MATTERS; IS-C.")

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This latter LHM also indicated that negro author JOHN O. KILLENS (NYfile Bufile Bufile III is interested in LITTLE and the OAAU. Information indicated that the OAAU was seeking three persons to incorporate the group, and in addition to LITTLE and OAAU official LYNN SHIFFLETT (NYfile the name of KILLENS was suggested. However, on 7/10/54 advised that in a conversation between SHIFFLETT and LITTLE's wife, the former said that JOHN KILLENS had "chickened out" on signing for the incorporation.

Except for the above mentioned article in the SWP paper "The Militant," file reviews fail to reflect any public source information linking the above individuals or organizations to the OAAU which could be used in a counterintelligence operation. Since the above article may have some potential in this regard, a copy of the paper is enclosed herewith for the Bureau.

The NYO feels that it is apparent that to further his own ends, LITTLE will associate with and seek any form of support from almost any element in the US, subversive or otherwise. He also will seek support from any foreign nation or group, particularly African and Hoslem nations with which he is attempting to identify himself and his organizations.

At this time the NYO is not considering an interview with LITTLE since he is out of the country and the exact extent of assistance from subversive groups and individuals solicited or received is not yet fully determined. It is felt, however, that LITTLE's views regarding his association with subversive elements are best expressed in his reply to a question at the news conference he held in NYC on 3/12/54, when he announced the formation of the Mil. When asked if he would accept support from a known Communist group, he answered by telling a story in which he indicated that if he were a prisoner of a wolf, he would accept release from any source. When the newsmen exclaimed his answer meant "yes," he denied it and stated "I only told you a story about a wolf," (see above mentioned MMI report, page 30.)

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The NYO will continue to thoroughly investigate all phases of LITTLE's activities to determine the extent to which he has in fact enlisted the aid of subversive elements in the US and elsewhere. It is noted that NY informant coverage of the OAAU and the NHI is outlined in NY letter to the Bureau, dated 7/15/64. As pointed out in reBuairtel, the past activities of LITTLE clearly show that he will go to any length to further his own selfish aims.



On July 5, 1964, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished information that Clarence Jones contacted Dora (Dora Mc Donald, Martin Luther King's secretary) on that date. Jones indicated that he had been working on a speech which King is scheduled to give to the Platform Committee of the National Republican Convention (which is scheduled to begin on July 13, 1964 in San Francisco, California). According to Jones, the speech will mention the activities in the civil rights field over the past four years such as boycotts, sit-ins, and other protests, and it says that these have not been sufficient. According to Jones, the speech goes on to say that these events were given legislative recognition in the passage of the Civil Rights Bill, and that the success of the Civil Rights Bill will depend on the compliance or degree of compliance and how much the economic condition of the Negro is improved.

According to Jones, in his speech King will suggest that the Republican Party consider the following: compliance with the Civil Rights Bill, police brutality and the harassment of civil rights workers, and automation and unemployment. Jones stated that King will suggest under compliance with the Civil Rights Bill that the President make use of his powers by appointing United States Marshals to observe in the offices of voter registration in any problem areas and to accompany to the office of voter registration any group of five or more persons who have been threatened, and supplementing this he will recommend that the powers of the United States Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) be more vigorously and creatively employed.

Continuing, Jones mentioned that King, in his speech, will say if the Communist Party (CP) and other subversive organizations can be successfully infiltrated why cannot an intelligence surveillance be maintained on the terroistic groups and persons subverting the United States Constitution by arson, murder, and bombing. According to Jones, King will further recommend that the right to vote be guaranteed by creative use of the Executive power and the use of every power at the disposal of the FBI to expose the activities of the igilantes and white citizens council groups which are terrorizing Negroes.

On July 4, 1964, the same confidential source furnished information that Clarence Jones contacted Ruby (Ruby Dee) on that date. Jones mentioned that he had spoken with John (Killens; the Negro author) and he mentioned that he understood there was a possibility that she might come to John Killens' home that night. In regard to this, Jones indicated that there would be a meeting at Killens' home with Malcolm (Malcolm X. Little, who is the founder and leader of the Muslim Mosque, Inc., and is Chairman of the Organization of Afro-American Unity). The same confidential source furnished information that Clarence Jones spoke with a man whom the source was unable to identify.

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

A confidential source in June, 1964, advised that during an FOI meeting held by Muhammad's Temple (MT) No. 2; 5335 South Greenwood Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, on June 16, 1964, FOI Lieutenant Louis 3X Carr announced there were more deceptive members among them and they were being seduced by defected members who had supported Malcolm Little; that Malcolm's group numbered about 20 and was holding meetings in Washington Park on Sundays; that the dissident members of MT No. 2 were followers of Malcolm Little and consisted of Wade X, Robert 18X Edmunds, Arthur 3X (10X), and others. The source stated he had no knowledge, other than the above, that there was an organized group following Malcolm Little in Chicago. The source continued that he believed Lieutenant Louis and other officials of Mr No. 2 would brand any person or group of persons who had deviated from the teachings of Elijah Muhammad as followers of Little whether they were, in fact, followers or not.

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

On June 23, 1964, an individual who stated he was Hassan Sharrieff telephonically advised a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that he was a grandson of Elijah Muhammad and was the son of Raymond Sharrieff, whom he stated was the "Head of the FOI".

Hassan advised he had disassociated himself with his grandfather's organization because of certain "fregularities", which he refused to discuss further. He continued:

His father had announced at a meeting held by the organization on June 21, 1964, that Wallace D. Muhammad, whom he stated was one of Elijah Muhammad's sons, and himself, Hassan, had deviated from the teachings of Elijah Muhammad and were, therefore, hypocrites. As he was at one time a lieutenant in the organization, he knows that they, Wallace and himself, will now "get a whuppin" as this is what happens to the members who deviate.

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

Hassan stated he felt he was in danger of bodily harm and stated he was considering getting a gun for protection. Hassan stated he had had no specific threats made against him but added he "knows how some of those people are" and some will react to his father's announcement.

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

The first confidential source advised in July, 1964, that John 21X is a Judo and Karate instructor for the FOI at MT No. 2 and is a member of that temple; that Walter 4X Jones was formerly the first officer in the FOI at MT No. 2 and is presently managing one of the temple businesses in Chicago; and that Elijah Muhammad, Jr., one of Elijah Muhammad's sons, was Assistant Supreme Captain of the FOI and, as such, a national leader in the NOI.



A sixth confidential source on June 24, 1964, advised that Lottie Muhammad stated that Wallace Muhammad and two carloads of the "plotters" were holding a meeting and she could see it. She indicated the meeting was held in front of her residence at 17143 South Indiana Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. (It is to be noted that this is also the residence of Hassan Sharrieff).

The first confidential source in July, 1964, advised Lottie Muhammad was one of Elijah Muhammad's daughters.

The sixth confidential source on June 25, 1964, advised Lottie Muhammad stated Wallace Muhammad had been going around contacting various members of MT No. 2, Chicago, trying to get them to leave the temple.

On June 25 and June 26, 1964,

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had contacted him on June 23, 1964, had stated him if he and and his friends should carry a gun for protection as they had left Elijah Muhammad's organization.

Malcolm X was so heavily guarded they could not get to him. These men had used the pretext of visiting Detroit, Michigan, to see a sick relative. These men are still trying to get Malcolm.

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The second confidential source advised in July, 1964, that Herbert Muhammad was one of Elijah Muhammad's sons, was the Public Relations Director of the NOI, as well as the Circulation Manager for "Muhammad Speaks" newspaper, the official NOI publication, and, as such, was a national leader in the NOI. This same source also advised that MT No. 2 operates the South Park Bakery at 370 East 71st Street, Chicago, Illinois, and Elijah Muhammad, Jr. is the manager thereof.

The sixth confidential informant advised on July 5, 1964, that Ethel Sharrieff commented Lottie Muhammad had told her that Wallace Muhammad and the others had come to Hassan Sharrieff's house and Hassan Sharrieff had been carrying a gun.

The second confidential source advised in July, 1964, that Ethel Sharrieff was one of Elijah Muhammad's daughters and was the Supreme Captain of the MGT and also a national leader in the NOI.

The sixth confidential source on July 6, 1964, advised Whel Sharrieff stated that all of the "boys", with the exception of Nathaniel Muhammad, now had guns. Ethel stated that Raymond Sharrieff would not bring one into the house and had told Hassan Sharrieff to get out of the house with his gun.

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telephonically conversed with the land stated the meeting he had attend that the land stated the meeting he had referred to on July 6, 1964, were not being held in Vallace Muhammad's home. He stated that, as a matter of fact, they were not meetings at all and merely consisted of some men coming to the home of Vallace Muhammad's mother-in-law for the purpose of purchasing a dinner on Saturday nights. He stated that during this dinner hour, these men would discuss problems they had run into since leaving to seek a perspective and discussions recently had centered around smoking and drinking. During the course of the conversation, the stated that Vallace Muhammad had started operating a run cleaning service from his residence and he was working with his uncle.

The fifth confidential source advised on Fully 7, 1964, that Albert 8X Thompson and Joseph 15X Smith were brought to trial at Circuit Court, Branch 35, 61st and Racine, Chicago, Illinois, Judge Sidney Jones presiding, on charges of assault

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and battery against Arthur 10X Squalls. Albert SX and Joseph 15X were accompanied by five Muslim men who were wearing the FOI lapel pins. They had no legal representation. Arthur 10X appeared in the company of some six or seven men. Squalls charged he was assaulted in the hallway of the apartment building where he lives by the two defendants. Willie 19X Wytch testified he had seen the two men enter the pertinent apartment building shortly after Squalls had entered same and shortly before he was assaulted. Wytch testified that, since he and Squalls and the others had left MT No. 2, they had made it a practice of following each other home for protection purposes. During the trial, Hassan Sharrieff volunteered in court to testify on behalf of Squalls. He testified he had talked to his father, Raymond Sharrieff, about the fact Samuel 3X was also going to get a beating and said his father had told him the Samuel 3X beating would be stopped until the Squalls case blew over.

Judge Jones sentenced Albert 8X and Joseph 15X to six months at Bridewell City Jail, Chicago.

Squalls, after the trial, indicated he was going to follow this up with a civil action suit against MT No. 2, Chicago.

The first confidential source in June, 1984, advised' Albert SX and Joseph 15X were lieutenants in the FOI at MT No. 2, Chicago.

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The "Chicago Daily Defender", a daily newspaper published on the South Side of Chicago, Illinois, in its issue of July 8, 1964, carried headlines, "Muhammad's Son Says Muslims Threaten His Life". The article, which appeared on page three, was as follows:

"Wallace Muhammad, son of the leader of the Muslims, told the DEFENDER that 'the leadership in Chicago is ruthless and frantic' and that 'they will kill you.'

"Muhammad, 30, of 7914 S. Wabash Ave., in an exclusive interview, said he is spending his time 'counseling discontent members' of the Muslim organization, 'who come to me almost in shock after they find out what is really happening.'

"Muhammad said he had been threatened repeatedly by the 'officers' of the organization, which has headquarters in Chicago.

"The son of the Muslim leader said that his disenchantment with the movement began in Jan. 1963, when he was released from prison after serving a term for violation of draft laws.

"'When I came out, I was told by members of , the family that the organization was in "bad shape" and there was an "explosive situation" in the private quarters of my father, he said.

"Wallace said he wrote twice to the elder Muhammad, only to be told to 'stay out of my (Muhammad's) business.' The younger man said appeals to his father's 'basic goodness and decency' proved useless.

"He continued:

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"'After many lies and false promises, I began to oppose the corruption on my own. When someone came to me seeking consolation, I would tell them what was going on, not in detail, hoping that my father would put a stop to it.

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"'Then I began receiving my threats. They said they would beat me up. Then they began to make threats on my life. I know they are fanatics and will kill you.'

"Muhammad said he went to the FBI, his parole officer and the police. He also informed the Muslim leaders that he had done so.

"'The threats stopped,' he said.

"Muhammad said he was making it all public because he has been refused permission by his father to appear before the Muslims.

"'I never thought they could be this way,' he said. 'I do this now to free myself of the obligation that I owe to people, whom I have helped to influence.'

"Muhammad was assistant minister of the Chicago Mosque 12. 'I have influenced a lot of people into joining the organization, where they give time and money.'

"Muhammad is the father of two daughters, Laila, 4, and Bakerah, nine months old. He says they will not attend the Muslim school.

"Concerning the flood of accusations against the Muslim hierarchy, Muhammad said not only are they true, 'they are mild.'

"'The main laws of the organization are to refrain from adultery, fornication, smoking, drinking, lying and stealing.

"'The members of my father's staff are guilty of some or all of these evils. There have been beatings, lies and hypocrisy; they have presented my father as a holy image, and misused thousands of dollars.'

"Muhammad said his break with the Muslims is complete and that he will try to help others do the same."

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This same issue on page three also carried a column entitled, "Elijah's Kin Echoes Charge (Third of an exclusive DFFENDER series)", by DAVE POTTER, which is as follows:

"'My grandfather is a fake and a fraud!'

"A startling statement?

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"Yes. But it becomes even more startling when the utterer of these words is identified.

"He is Hasan Sharrieff, 21, of 7143 8. Indiana Ave.

"The grandfatter he so bluntly denounces is none other than Elijah Muhammad, leader of America's Black Muslims.

"Sharrieff's mother, Ethel, is Muhammad's daughter. His father, Raymond, is Supreme Captain in the cult's Chicago Mosque.

"'I come to the CHICAGO DAILY DEFENDER because many of the members of my grandfather's organization read this paper as I do. I dislike settling business of the brothers and sisters before the public, but I have exhausted all other means."

"'My hypocritical, two-faced relatives have falsely accused me and my uncle Wallace (Wallace Muhammad, the Muslim leader's custed son) of turning our backs on good principles, and imply that we no longer advocate, unity and economic progress for the so-called Negro. The truth is that we want this badly for the confused members of the Mosque, and even our confused relatives - if they had the decency to confess what they know."

"'I am not referring to any single individual's wrongdoings or corruption; I am referring to Mr. Muhammad and his whole staff. CONSTANTIAL



"Sharrieff, a heavy-set, bespectacled young man, told the DEFENDER that corruption runs rampant through the Nation of Islam. As the \$125-,- week circulation manager for the 'Muhammad Speaks' newspaper, he was close to the internal operation of the Black Muslims. And, since he is related to the Muslim's 'First Family,' this knowledge became more pronounced.

"Sharrieff re-affirmed his faith in Uncle Wallace, crediting the man with 'opening his eyes' and clearing up confusion he harbored about the techniques practiced by the elder Muhammad.

"'For all of my life, I was raised to believe that whatever the Messenger said was true...whatever he did was just. This is not so - now I know it. Whenever I had questions about Grandpa's techniques and practices, I was told, "Never question the Messenger."'

"'And, on rare occasions when I would ask him questions, he would go into his "Bible bag" and give me meaningless answers. I, as his follower, used to believe that Grandpa was raised by God and was minister to 22 million Megroes. This is not so.'

"According to Sharrieff, 'the making of the Messenger' came 35 years ago when W. D. Fard (pronounced Far-odd) to whom the Muslims attach a divine connection, proclaimed the senior Muhammad 'Messenger of Allah.' However, there were no witnesses to this so-called coronation, and Sharrieff's concept of God - or Allah - departs from followers of Muhammad.

"'To me, Allah is a supreme force with control over all, and his powers are not limited to those of a mortal man.' Fard dissappeared mysteriously after Muhammad became Messenger, Sharrieff added.

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"What are Sharrieff's motives in denouncing his grandfather and parents?

"Maybe the answer lies in the following excerpts from his dramatic letter of resignation from the nation of Islam.

"'I have always felt closer to the followers than many of my own family. The followers are dear to me, because if it were not for them, I would not have the interest that I have in people. We all have been fed, clothed and sheltered by these people, including myself.'

"'I am compelled to help these people."

"'The old Muslims who went to Prison with Grandpa, many of whom were much older than he and who are now slowly dying out are not reaching any material gain in the Mosque. Many never received Holy names. Grandpa said he could not give out these names and that it was up to Allah."

"'Yet, Secretary John (Ali) and Grandpapa's secretaries have Holy Names. Even Cassius Clay was blessed to receive a Holy name. What more have these people done than the old true followers?'

"'This is outright favoritism. Old brother Robert X lixed and died a true Muslim. What was his reward? He died lonely and never received any compensation from the nation. Yet he gave to the nation all of MY life.'

"Brother Robert was sick with no one to care for him. He was taken to Cook County Hospital where he died lonely and rejected. The nation did not even place poor Robert in a hospital where he could have received better help and may have lived years longer.

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"'He gave Grandpa his life, and yet he was buried in an old suit and another brother's shirt."

"These things I can't go with or forgive. I am very bitter.'

"In another segment of the letter, Sharrieff wrote, philosophically:

"'Any time you are taught that a tree is a man and accept this all your life, and when someone tells you that it's not a man, but a tree, you call them "crazy" and "hypocrite" but they are endeavoring to help you. You realize that the tree is a tree, but you won't let yourself confess it.'

"From all indications, the DEFENDER sources and ousted minister Malcolm X of New York are in the front rank of an exodus away from Elijah Muhammad.

"As Sharrieff put it, when he wrote to his parents:

"'You say I have deviated. You are correct. I deviated from the wrong direction. Now I am following the path to Allah. Uncle Wallace told me that conscience is the soft whisper of God in man. So let your conscience be your guide."

"'It has been rumored that my grandfather has been putting money away in foreign banks. I don't doubt this. I feel wary about a man who has a \$150,000 home with a built-in swimming pool in Phoenix, Aris., while too many of the people who look up to him have not the necessities of life.'

"'It makes me want to reach.'

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

Malcolm X announced the formation of the OAAU which will fight whoever gets in "our" way in seeking the complete independence of people of African descent. He state they would fight by any means necessary.

Malcolm X indicated that the O/AU would be open for membership to all people of African descent, and that headquarters of the OAAU would temporarily be at Mail head-quarters, Suite 128, Hotel Theresa, New York City.

According to Malcolm X, the aim of the OAAT is to eliminate differences between Negroes and to then get all Negroes to work together for their "Human Rights." The first objective of the OAAU is to internationalize the racial problem in America by taking it to the United Nations. He claimed that the United States Government is unable to solve the racial problem thus the problem is no longer one of civil rights, but one of "Human Rights" which can only be solved on an international scale. The OAAU has been formed to meet the needs of all black people independent of the white community, and is patterned after the Organization of African Unity formed by African heads of state at a meeting in Ethiopia in May, 1963.

According to Malcolm X, the OAAU will have the following departments:

1) Education, to teach the history of the black man and his contribution to the world.

2) Political Action, to coordinate a voters registration drive for Negroes so they can control their own political future.

3) Economics, to improve the economic condition of Negroes and promote social reform.

4) Cultural, to inform Negroes of African culture . and provide African entertainment locally.

5) Youth, to indostrinate Negro youth in the above.

Also in his speech, Malcolm X condemned the non-violent civil rights movement and leaders, and stated that Negroes should be taught to protect themselves when and if necessary. He indicated that he would contact other Negro leaders and civil rights organizations informing them that if the Government will not protect them they can call on the OAAU for assistance if needed.

Malcolm X urged those in the audience to join the OAAU by registering at the tables in the rear, or by coming by MMI headquarters in the Hotel Therese during the week.

Membership fee is \$2.00, and dues are \$1.00 per week thereafter.

A leaflet entitled, "A Call For a Freedom

published by the National Committee For A
Freedom Now Party and reprinted from the
"New Yorker, June 15, 1963, identified
Conrad J. Lynn as Acting Chairman of the
National Committee For a Freedom Now Party.

"The Journal News," a newspaper published in Nyack, New York, issue of May 8, 1963, contained an article indicating that Lynn had appeared before the House Committee on Un-American Activities on May 6, 1963, concerning a trip to Cuba in 1962 in order to obtain a deposition from a client who had fled the United States.

At the hearing, Lynn stated he had been a member of the Young Communist League (YCL) from 1928 to 1931, and a member of the Communist Party (CP) from 1934 to 1937. He stated that he had been expelled from the CP. The article continued that Lynn characterized himself as "being on the left."

"YCL has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 1045C.

Wilbert Epton

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On October 30, 1962, Albert Jackson, a member of the CP from 1945 to 1952, and from 1958 to September 18, 1962, advised that Wilbert Epton was a member of the 13th Assembly District Club of the Harlem Region CP until the end of 1961, when he broke away from the CP to become a member of "Progressive Labor."

A characterization of Progressive Labor is attached and all sources therein have furnished reliable information in the past. Muslim Mosque, Incorporated

Ossie Devis end Ruby Dee

MY T-2, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on April 12, 1962, three Ossie Davis and his wife, Ruby Wallace, also known as Ruby Dee, are not known to be members of the CP; however, they have the reputation of supporting or aiding causes through personal appearances, which causes are also supported by the CP.

William Worthy

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In 1956, Worthy solicted State Department permission to travel in Red China, which was denied. In defiance to this Gerial, he traveled to Red China spending 41 days there, and as a result his passport was revoked. In an appeal of the revocation, the Court of Appeals, Washington, D.C., in June, 1959, upheld the right of the State Department to deny Worthy the right to travel to Red China.

On July 21, 1961, Worthy traveled to Cuba returning at Miami, Florida, on October 10, 1961. On April 24, 1962, he was indicted and on August 8, 1962, found guilty at Miami, Florida, for violation of Section 1185 (b), Title 8, United States Code, in that he traveled from Havana, Cuba to Miami, Florida, without a valid passport.

On September 17, 1963, Worthy appealed his conviction to the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals, New Orleans, Louisiana. On February 20, 1964, this latter court reversed the decision of the District Court and Worthy was acquitted.

Newark will remain alert for any information indicating the disposition of this matter in MM #20 and for any information furnished by the source concerning similar activity.


Inasmuch as this appears to be a matter of discipline within MM #20, no dissemination has been made to local police.

The same source on 7/4/64, advised Sister FRAN in Los Angeles asked a sister in Chicago to tell ELIJAN MUHAMMAD that her husband was out in the field with the papers and that the story that came out yesterday was not very good, and the people didn't believe it. JEAN stated that maybe the Messenger would like to make a statement for the paper out there and if so should call her. The sister in Chicago stated they were working on a press release now.

This source continued on 7/4/64, that JOHN SMERKES (believed to be the minister of ELIJAH MURAMMAD'S mosque in Los Angeles, California) was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD from Oakland, California. JOHN asked ELIJAH if he knew about the story that was released in the papers, and MUHAMMAD stated he had just got it this morning. JOHN stated it will come up on Monday on the interview, and he wondered just how far he should go or what he should do. MUHAMMAD stated that he believed that Brother JOHN (JOHN ALI, Mational Secretary of the HOI) sent them a press release today, and they should have it. EUHAMMAD stated that all JOHN could truthfully say was to repeat only what he sees in the newspapers. JOHN asked MUHAMMAD for permission to have Minister HERNARD (believed to be BERNARD MOOHE, Minister of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD's mosque in Oakland-San Francisco) to be with him on the interview on Monday. MUHAMMAD asked if they told him what they wanted to talk about, and JOHN replied that it had to do with the progress of the businesses, etcetera. MUHAMMAD replied: "You can talk to them on that. If they happen to mention anything else, just tell them that we are true followers of Mr. MUHAMMAD and we do not discuss anyone's affairs of the believers to the public. Anyone do something like that is a hypocrit, and Mr. MUHAMMAD will not, as you have found."

MURAMMAD them mentioned that MALCOLM had been going all over the country trying to smear him (MURAMMAD). He stated that he, MURAMMAD, is the true messenger of God and leaves all of his enemies and hypocrits to God. He continued he will not publish anything in the public that is also disbelievers of God and Islam. He stated he will not take his people to be judged by other disbelievers. MUHAMMAD continued that the Holy Koran teaches a Muslim to never do

anything other than good and the Bible teaches that too. He stated they hever are to take their case or something like that to be judged by a disbeliever or the enemy as they are already against you, and they don't give you no justice. He added that anyway we don't have all our misunderstandings, you know, this jury stays: at the temple. He continued: "You can tell them that I am not taking up no such talk with you and you are not Muslims so why should I discuss anything of that nature with you when I don't understand it myself even though we are true believers and don't believe these things. The man is just suffering whatever the Muslims have to suffer, and he is just having to take it, so I have nothing else to say."

MUHAMNAD concluded by saying that he didn't think some would have much trouble with those people anyway.



Organization of Afro-American Unity Internal Security-Miscellaneous; Racial Matters

On July 6, 1964, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished the following information:

The Organization of Afro-American Unity (OAAU) held a public meeting from 8:35 p.m. to 10:35 p.m., July 5, 1964, at the Audubon Ballroom, Broadway and 166th Street, New York City, which was attended by approximately 350 persons. The featured speaker was Malcolm X Little, self-appointed chairman of the OAAU and founder and leader of the Muslim Mosque, Incorporated (MMI). Brief introductory speeches were also made by MMI members Banjamin Goodman and Shabbon Jagkson.

Characterizations of the MMI, Nation of Islam (NOI) and NOI Mosque #7, New York City, are attached hereto and all sources therein have furnished reliable information in the past.

In his speech, Little talked generally of the aims and purposes of the OAAU particularly the internationalizing of the American civil rights movement into one of human rights and of taking the problem to the United Nations. He also claimed that more racial demonstrations are not enough and that Negroes must be ready to die for their cause. In this regard he quoted Patrick Henry several times, "Give me liberty or give me death."

Little also talked of the OAAU planned voter registration drive indicating they would try "ballots before bullets." He praised Harlem Congressman Adam Clayton Powell as the only politician who is actually maintained by Negro voters.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

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

Information has also been received indicating that Little reportedly had contact with Cuban and Communist Chinese representatives while on his African tour.

All of the above indicates that Little may be associating himself with the subversive element within the United States primarily to further his own ends and in an offert to make himself the leading civil rights leader. His netivities in the past have clearly shound that he will go to any length to further his own selfiab aims.

New York and Philadelphia are instructed to thoroughly investigate all phases of Little's activities to determine whether he has in fact emlisted the aid of subversive elements in the United States and elsewhere. This investigation must be peasurating, thorough and complete with all logical lends being vigor-easily pursued. New Nork is also instructed to consider as interview of Little when sufficient information has been developed concerning the above for the purpose of determining his own views regarding his association with subversive elements.

Each effice is also advised that this matter is of extreme importance and all pertinent information must be furnished to the Bureau expeditiously by teletype or telephone if necessary and such communications should be immediately followed by letterhead memoranda suitable for dissemination. The importance of this matter must be thoroughly impressed on all supervisory and agent personnel handling this matter. Information requested above must be handled expeditiously and resolved immediately.

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
