

MALCON: X appeared on WPIX-TV, Channel 11, New York City on 2-2-65 from 9:30H; until 11:00H.

This program was taped by the New York Office. A review of the tape reflected that L.13011 I made statements about the conditions of the Negroes and that he will use any means necessary to change these conditions. He admitted that he was head of the MAT and worked with the OAAU.

Inview of the fact that MALCOLM X was shot and killed on 2-21-65 the contents on the tapes will not be transcribed.

Said tapes are being forwarded to Section 1h for reuse.

MY FIRST JOB didn't last long. I guit before they could fire me.

Back in New York, stone broke, I went over to Small's Paradise. One of the bartenders called me aside.and

said that if I went downstairs right away to the office, I hight be able to replace a by waiter who was about to into the army.

Ed Small and his brother, Charlie, had seen me in the place so much that it made it pretty easy. They also knew I was a railroad man, which, for a waiter, was the best kind of recommendation. It was in 1942, just past my 17th birthday.

With Small's practically the center of everything happening, waiting tables there was seventh heaven seven times over! Charlie Small had told me not to be late! Why, what was he talking about?

I was so anxious to be there, I'd arrive an hour early! Inside of a week f don't know who liked me most, the cooks or the bar-



side" things about the perticular form of hostling that he bursted.

Plain clothes detectives were quietly identified to me, by a nod, a wink. Knowing the law people in the erea was elementary for the bustiers, and, like them, is time. I would learn to sense the presence of any police and agent types. And added to the civilian ones in 1942, each of the military services had civilian-dressed "eyes" and "ears."

Every day, all of my tips—
as high as \$10 s day—I.
would gamble on the numbers, and dream of what I
would do and buy as soon as
I "hit." The straight number chances of hitting were a
thousand to - one, but your
chances could be increased
by what was called "combinating." For example, 6 cents
would put one penny on each
of the six possible combinations of three digits. Take the
sumber \$40, say. "Combinated," it would cover \$40, 804,
048, 408, 400 and 084.

"timers" each got 10 per cent of the money they timed in, along with the bet slips, to their "controlers." [And if you hit, you gave the runner a 10 per cent tip.] A controler might have as many as 50 runners working for him, and got 5 per cent of what he turned over to the "bankers," who paid off the hits, paid off the police, and, off the balance, got rich.

I should stress that Small's wasn't any haven for criminals. I dwell upon hustlers because it was their world that fascinated me. Actually, for the night-life crowd, most of which the hustlers regarded as "square," Small's was one of the two or three most decorous night spots that Harlem had. It was formally recommended by the New York City Police department to white people who would ask where it was safe to go in Harlem.

When I had been ground Hariam long enough to show signs of permanence, it was inevitable that I was going to get a nickname that would identify me beyond any continuous with two after yed to a ked and well-known "Reds" who were around.

I HAD mot them both One was it Louis Red." a prefemional armed rebber. When I was sent to prison, he was doing some time for trying to stick up a diningcar steward on a train between New York and Philadelphia. The other one was "Chicago Red." In a speakeasy where I was a walter later on, he was the fundest dishwasher on this earth, and we became good buddies. Now he's making his living being funny as a nationally known stage and nightchib comedian.

Anyway, before long, it happened. Different people, knowing I was from Michigan, would asle me what lify. Since most New Yorkers never had heard of hick-pwn Lansing, I would say "Detroit"—and it stuck.

One afternoon early in 1943, before the regular 6 p. m. hustling crowd had gathered at Small's, this real Georgia-looking black soldier sat drinking at one of my tables by himself. He looked dumb and pitiful, and it was because of this that I did one of the dumbest things I ever did in those years. The next drink that I served this soldier, I bent over close wining the table, and asked him if the wanted a woman.

WASN't only Small's Paradislaw, it was every tavern's law, it was every tavern's law, at least if you wanted to stay in business, not to get involved with anything that could be interpreted as impairing the morals of servicemen, or any kind of hustling off them. Big trouble had been caused by this for dosens of places. Even some wellknown places had been put off-limits by the military and some even had lost their state or city licenses.

And I had suckered myself right into the hands of
one of those military "spies."
Why, this black tool of the
white man said he sure
would like a woman, so gratefully; he even had a dumb
Georgia accent! And I gave
him the phone number of one
of my best friends among
the prostitutes at the rooming

I didn't even go back out to the bar. I just went straight to Charlie Small's office. "I just did something, Charlie," I said, "I don't know why I did &-- And I to I d him what I'd done.

CHARLIE lesked at me. "I wish you hadn't done that, Red." We both knew what he meant.

When the West Indian plain ciothes detective, Charlie Barts, came in, I was waiting. When we got to the 135th street precinct, it was busy with police in uniform. I reflected that two things were in my favor: I'd never given the police any trouble, and when that black spy soldier had tried to tip me, I had waved it away and told him I was just doing him a favor. I saw some other detectives side - mouthing with Charile Barts, and I think that when these factors were discussed, they sort of agreed that Charlie Barts should just scare inc.

Evals more bitter to take than the just getting fired, they barred me from Small's. I could understand. Even if I wasn't actually what was called "hot" I automatically was going to be under surveillance now; the brothers had to protect their business. I wasn't a qualified hustier as yet, but I surely had become schooled in their code, I was broke and on my own again, 18 years old.

Both Sammy and I knew some merchant seamen, and others, who could supply me with loose marijums. Malcolm X Tells How 'Big-Head' Created 1st Race

rior to his assassination in New York on Feb. 2, Malcolm X, the black nationalist leader, had written the story of his troubles with the Black Muslims. He had been a Muslim leader and subsequently was expelled. Today's instalment relates how Malcolm learned of the Muslims.

BY MALCOLM X

MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS began sending me letters about a new, natural religion for the black man. One day Reginald wrote, "Don't est say more pork." I tried it and did it, and for the first time in a long while I began to get

a little feeling of self-respect, the I hardly knew even how to identify the feeling. Reginald wrote more, about the worship of Allah; and the American teacher of Islam, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad.

I learned that when Muhammad went to Detroit he actually stayed at my brother Wilfred's place. It was my sister Hilds who told me that

Muhammad himself had been in prison, for draft dodging, and she suggested that I write to bim.

And on one visit she explained to me the key lesson of Elijah Muhammad's teachings which I later learned was the "demonology" that every religion has. Called "Yacub's Histors," once it is accepted by any black man, he will never again see the white man with the same eyes.

First, the moon separated from the earth. Then, the first humans, Original Man, were a black people. They founded the Holy City Mecca.

Among this black race were 24 wind scientists. One of the scientists, at odds with the rest, created the especially strong black tribe of Shahazz, from which America's Negroes, do-called, descend to the state of the state

ABOUT 6,800 YEARS AGO, when 70 per cent of the peaple were satisfied, and 30 per cent were dissatisfied, was born a "Mr. Yacub." He was born to create trouble, to break the peace, and to kill. His head was unusually large. When he was 4 years old, he began school, on the way to becoming highly educated.

At the age of 18, Yacub had finished all of his nation's colleges and universities. He was known as "the big-bead



Malcolm X Tells How He Got Involved in Crime

Two weeks ago today, Malcolm X, Black Nationalist leader who had been expelled from the Black Muslim movement, was killed by gunmen in New York. He had expected attempts on his life. Prior to that Sunday, he had written an account of his troubles with the Black Muslims and about his earlier life in crime. Today's eixth instalment tells of his days on cocaine and his troubles with the law.

BY MALCOLM X

I SOLD REEFERS like a wild man. Every day I cleared \$30 or \$40. I felt, for the first time in my life, that great feeling of free! Suddenly, now, I was the peer of other smooth young hustlers around.

The narcotics squad detectives didn't take long to pick in that I was selling, and different ones would tail me once in while. One morning, the, I came in and found my room ransacked. It was then that I began carrying a little .25 automatic.

I carried it stuck right down the center of my back, pressed under my belt. Someone had told me that the cops never hit there when they gave you any routine patting-down. It was on the wire, finally, that the narcotics squad of Harlem had me on its "special list."

Now was when, every other day or so, and usually in some public place, some of them would come up, and flash the badge to search ma. But I would tell them right off, loud enough for others to hear me, people standing about, that I didn't have anything on me, and I didn't want to get anything "plented" on me, and then they wouldn't, because Hariam already thought little enough of the law, and they did have to be careful that some crowd of Negroes, figuring they had witnessed a "frame," could set off even a race riot.

A BOSTON draft heard, after I didn't respond at my sister Ella's, had contacted her, and then had contacted their New York counterpart, and, in care of my friend Sammy, I received Uncle Sam's "greetings." I had about 10 days to go before I was to show up at the induction center. And I went







Two Malcolm Aides Seized With Shotgum

Three men, two of them described as followers of the murdered Negro leader Malcolm X, were being held today on charges of violating the Sullivan Law.

Their arrest last night sparked short-lived rumors of a new break in the police investigation of the murder. But police said today the men were not suspects in the slaying.

Inspector Thomas Renaghan said the men had met at 557 E. 164th St., The Bronx, to "talk! about what had happened since Talmadge Hayer, 22, of Paterthe shooting" and were found son, N. J., who was arrested on there by detectives with an unloaded sawed-off shotgun.

Arrested were John 57X Grey, 29, of 2300 5th Av., * mailman; Cyril 2X James, 18, of 14 E. 118th St. a cleark for Haryou-Act, the anti-poverty agency, and Willie Hilton, 28, of 65 W. 127th St. a department store kitchen helped. They were to be arraigned today in Criminal Court.

Police said Cyril 2X and John 57X had belonged to the Muslim Mosque in Harlem and had left the movement when Malcolm did. Grey had been a judo instructor for Malcolm's Muslim Mosque Inc.





Malcolm X

THE ASSASSINATION of Malcolm X is an act of violence against the Negro freedom struggle. Such deeds of violence and terror would preclude free discussion in the market place of ideas Such discussion is essential to the Negro people's struggle for freedom. Our difference with Malcolm X on many points does not if any way qualify our condemnation of the brutal act of murder.

Ordinary Americans, both Negro and white, view such acts with shocked horror and as alien and harmful to the people's cause. It this connection, two facts must be kept in the forefront. First violence is the stock-in-trade of reaction — of the Dixtecrats — by which the Negro people are being denied their most elementary fights as human beings and as American citizens. Secondly, the Negro people are victoriously advancing towards equality through ever greater unity and non-violent mass struggles and increasing Negro-white unity.

One thing above all must be guarded against now. That is the effort that will undoubtedly be made by racists and reactionaries to try to divert and divide the people's forces, both Negro and white. The nation is faced with the need of implementing the Eivil Rights Act of 1984, and pressing the struggle for the right to vote which is reaching a climax in the black belt areas of Alabama, Miss wissippi and Louisiana. Similarly the struggles for jobs, school integration, for decent housing in all areas, both North and South must be advanced.

The Worker, fully and actively supports the mass struggles of the major civil rights organizations which unite the bulk of the Negro people and their white allies. This struggle must now be expended and intensified. This is the only road to victory in the struggle for full equality.

Express Shock at Malcolm X Slaying

CIVIL RIGHTS leaders reacted to the brutal slaying of Malcolm X, leader of the newly formed Organization for Afro-American Unity last Sunday with shock and appeals for unity in the Freedom fight.

James Farmer, national director of CORE, called for a Federal investigation into the assassination and criticized the N. Y. Police Department for not protecting the late ex-Muslim leader.

Roy Wilkins, executive secretary of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People stated that the "gunning down of Malcolm X

demonstration of the futility of resorting to violence as a means of setuling differences." In an obvious warning against incitements of bloody factional strife Wilkins emphasized that "violence is not the answer to disputes, either between warring factions within a group or between groups in the large society."

A similar note was struck by Rev. Martin Luther King as he led the struggle for voter registration in Selma, Alabama. The leader of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference stated that the murder of Malcolm X "revealed that our

society is still sick enough to express dissent through murder."

That Rev. King himself is threatened with a similar fate was revealed when the civil rights leader disclosed that he had received a telephone call from a "high official in the Federal Government" who told him that there was "authoritative evidence of a plot taking place in Selma and Dallas County to take my life."

Acting Manhattan Borough President Earl Brown expressed himself as "horrified that anybody would take this shocking and brutal action, regardless of

political or personal disagreement."

Farmer told a press conference Tuesday at CORE's office, 38 Park Row, that there seemed to be "international implications" to the assassination, citing the fact that Malcolm notified the State Department last week of the plot against his life.

"I am shocked at the lack of police protection after the threats against his life," Farmer said, alluding to the fire-bombing of Malcolm's home last week.

"How was it possible for someone to get a sawed-off shot-gun into the hall?" Farmer asked.

Farmer said that he and Malcolm rarely agreed, but that the assassination was a tragic occurrence in the nation's life.

"He was growing away from black racism and coming closer to the civil rights mainstream," Farmer said, "and I don't think it was a coincidence that he was killed at this time."

Farmer said that before he went to Africa he was visited by Malcolm who "told me he was changing his views and now was willing to accept people as his brothers based on deeds, not genes."

Farmer said that Malcolm might have become a constructive force in the civil rights movement.

Farmer said he wanted to see this case handled through "the force of law, not vigilante action."

"And I hope," he continued, "that this murder won't aggravate feeds which have existed" in and around the civil rights movement.

Farmer revealed that he and his family have received many threats via phone and mail, "but not in the past month."
