

Los Angeles has advised of organizational attempts by Kahane in at meeting where Kahane spoke. In soliciting new members Kahane asked for initial membership dues to be paid by check made out to J. O. Y., stating that such membership fees are tax deductible. This may prove to be another avenue of attack against JDL by Department of Justice in its current Grand Jury action against the organization. This facet should be fully explored and details obtained at earliest date for passing to Internal Revenue Service. Copy of memorandum reporting Kahane's statements has been furnished to Internal Revenue Service by transmittal form.







On January 20, 1971, the request made by the source was discussed with Departmental Attorney Jerome K. Heilbron, Special Litigation Unit, Department of Justice. Mr. Heilbron advised that it was his considered opinion and the opinion of Assistant United States Attorney Andrew Maloney, Southern District of New York, that any indoctrination on the part of FBI Agents or any other agency relative to explosive devices could be prejudicial in nature to any subsequent act which might involve explosives.

On the same date, the source was advised that the FBI could in no way indoctrinate him relative to explosives. He was also informed that he should in no way instigate conversations or activities which would in any way involve entrapment regarding any activity involving explosives on the part of JDL members.

A SOURCE, CONTACT WITH WHOM HAS BEEN INSUFFICIENT TO DETERMINE RELIABILITY, BUT WHO HAS KNOWLEDGE OF JDL ACTIVITIES ADVISED ON JANUARY FIFTEEN AND EIGHTEEN THAT RABBI MEIR D. AHANE AS OF SIX MONTHS AGO RESIDED AT SIX THREE TWO EAST FIFTH STREET, BROOKLYN, NEW YORK. THIS RESIDENCE WAS SELECTED VERY CAREFULLY AS IT IS WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE OF HIS FATHER AND HE CAN TRUST THE OTHER PEOPLE IN THE BUILDIN MIS RESIDENCE ADDRESS IS A CLOSELY GUARDED SECRET AS HE IS AFRAID OF REPRISALS FROM MILITANT LEFT GROUPS. KAHANE'S SALARY FROM JDL IS TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS PER YEAR PLUS HE KEEPS MOST OF HIS FEES FROM SPEAKING ENGAGEMENTS. USUAL FEE IS THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS. On January 29, 1971, Meir D. Kahane, National Director, Jewish Defense League, appeared as a guest on the Phil Donahue television show based in Dayton, Ohio. The show is a sixty minute live telecast and is primarily questions by the audience and answers by the guest. Kahane made no definite statement as to his future plans concerning militant activities, however, his major theme was to free the Jews in Russia, who are denied the right to practice their religion. The temperament of Kahane seemed to be to generate enthusiasm for younger Jews to become active in his cause.

On January 28, 1971, a confidential source, with whom contact has been insufficient to determine his reliability, advised that he has no knowledge of the purpose for Kahane's visit to the Dayton. Ohio, area.

On February 3, 1971, confidential source further advised that contact with members of the Jewish community revealed that Kahane came to Dayton, Ohio, mainly to appear on the Phil Donahue television show and he was not in Dayton to meet with any particular individuals.

Confidential source further advised that Kahane is not very well accepted by the Jews in the Jewish community in Dayton, Ohio, because of the manner in which he conducts himself and his theory of freeing the Jews in Russia.





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On January 11, 1971, SC reviewed the records of the Brooklyn Criminal Court and it contains Docket A10147 which pertains to an arrest on June 28, 1970. This docket reflected that the subject is to appear on March 3, 1971 in Brooklyn Criminal Court to answer to these charges.

Activities

of the files of the rassport Office, Department of State regarding subject and on December 15, 1970 was furnished the following information:

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A communication dated April 1, 1970, from United States Delegation to the United Nations (USUN) in New York to the Department of State stated that Rabbi MEIR KAHANE of the Jewish Defense League (JDL) and approximately 25 youthful followers presented themselves in the lobby of the U.S. Mission on April 1, 1970 stating they would "sit in" until they saw Ambassador YOST. Their purpose was to ask YOST to make a statement in support of the right of Soviet Jews to leave the United Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR) for Israel and more specifically for the family of one YASHA KAZAKOV to leave the Soviet Union. KAZAKOV, who recently came from the USSR, was in his eighth day of a hunger strike across the street from the U.N. on that date. He was demanding Soviet exit permits for his parents.

KAHANE had called local press, radio, and television and a considerable number of newsmen, complete with cameras, came to the Mission with the group. They did not notify USUN in advance, for request of appointment.

The group was peaceful, waited an hour, and were told YOST would see KAHANE and two others in his office.

KAHANE, for his group, said the JDL realized the U.S. had made statements in the past on Soviet Jewry but felt a high level statement, such as YOST could make at the U.N., would be helpful. KAHANE felt the US could exercise considerable leverage vis-a-vis the Soviet because of a number of separate negotiations involving the two countries. He felt the US had been unwilling to exercise its leverage fully. YOST replied the US has repeatedly raised questions of Soviet Jewry in the UN, and would continue to do so when appropriate. In the case of the KAZAKOV family, YOST pointed out the Israeli

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Government urged KAZAKOV to desist, since it was concerned that such activities by recent emigres from the USSR might hurt the chances of more Jews leaving there. YOST said he agreed with the Israelis and felt the US statement on the KAZAKOV case might be counterproductive. YOST said he felt KAHANE overestimated leverage available to the US in its various negotiations with the USSR. He said the Soviets have made clear they do not tie these things together, and that agreements come only as the result of common interests in specific areas.

The fifteen minute meeting concluded with KAHANE urging a general US statement on the plight of Soviet Jews and YOST repeating that the US would undoubtedly continue to make such statements at appropriate times, but stressing that a statement in the UN "out of the blue" would not be received favorably in the UN and would not help the cause of the Soviet Jews.

On October 5, 1970, advised that Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE, National Chairman of the JDL was scheduled to debate one WILL MASLOW on October 25, 1970, at a synagogue located at 713 Belleville Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey.

The 1970 Polk's City Directory for Trenton, New Jersey, shows that the Adath Israel Congregation is located at 715 Bellevue Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey.

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on December 1, 1970,

advised that the women's and men's groups of the Adath Israel Congregation have been sponsoring a series of speakers in order to generate an interest in Jewish matters. The program is known as the Sunday Omnibus Series. Rabbi KAHANE and MASLOW appeared as scheduled on October 25, 1970.

Bellevue Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey, on December 8, 1970, said Rabbi KAHANE of the Jewish Defense League and WILL MASLOW of the American Jewish Congress represent two opposing viewpoints. MASLOW spoke on the necessity of resorting to established procedures to obtain police protection. KAHANE made an emotional appeal to the pride of Jews to take steps

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to protect themselves from physical harm. said roving patrols in the New York area have successfully protected residents in areas lacking adequate police protection from physical harm and in doing so drew attention to the critical need of police patrols.

KAHANE, according to did not advocate a resort to violent methods. However, felt that if his emotional appeal successfully reached the audience, most of the listeners would, as practical and realistic men, temper the emotional with a practical approach to the problems faced by the Jewish community.

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had also advised KAHANE was to speak at the Brotherhood of Temple Sinai, Tenafly, New Jersey, on October 5, 1970.

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of the Temple Sinai on November 23, said the men's club of the Temple paid \$100 to hear BERT ZWEIBON, Chief Counsel of the JDL speak to them on November 25, 1970, at the Temple. to hear the JDL views.

PSIPUD

On October 19, 1970, advised that the subject will speak on some undisclosed ruture date in St. Louis in the morning and at a larger rally in Chicago in the evening. People from Milwaukee will travel to Chicago by bus for the rally there.

On November 30, 1970, Curnished the following information:

The source advised that Rabbi MEIR KAHANE of the New York Chapter of JDL spoke in Providence on the evening of November 4, 1970, at Temple Emanuel, the largest synagogue in Providence, Rhode Island. The Rabbi of this temple is Rabbi BOHNEN. Source stated that 700-800 people attended the lecture and that the general response of the audience was most favorable. KAHANE spoke concerning the background of JDL and its activities and the speech was delivered in the form of a membership request to initiate a new chapter of JDL in Providence, Rhode Island. KAHANE also mentioned that the JDL budget for last year was \$70,000 and that they aimed

for a much larger budget this year. KAHANE mentioned that one of the future aims of JDL would be to attempt to organize JDL groups on several campuses throughout the country. This then would be a student group of JDL and would be named after DOV GRUNER, an Israeli martyr who was hung the the British during the struggle for Israeli independence.

On January 4, 1970, furnished the following information:

The subject spoke on November 29, 1970 at a JDL rally which was held at the Mather High School, Chicago, Illinois. There were approximately 350 people in attendance at this meeting. In his speech, the subject made the following remarks:

- 1) When the American Jews first heard about "Auschwitz" they called President FRANKLIN ROOSEVELT's attention to the movement of the cattle cars that were intended to be used for transporting the Jews to the camps. He was asked to have the United States bomb them. Herefused. The Jews were apathetic in their protest. The JDL would have taken to the streets and put it on page 1.
- 2) When the blacks were denied their civil rights they took to the streets. Why didn't the Jews go into the streets? Because they have hang-ups "respectability" for one. He is tired of "respectable" organizations who do nothing.
- 3) The JDL is founded on "Love of the Jews". Three-thousand Jews in the Soviet Union want to be free and we should do everything to help them.
- 4) It took the students to show the way with active protests. Put our story on Page 1, and if it takes a bombing of the Soviet Embassy as occurred in New York, to be put on Page 1 fine. He referred to the story of a student Soviet protest rally landing on Page 38 in the "New York Times" but, the Bombing Story made Page 1. The JDL was then called "Vigilantes".
- 5) Dr. EISENDRATH, the American Jewish Committee are too rich and too fat to understand the Jewish pain.



- 6) The ADL leaders' concepts are not Jewish concepts they are assimilated liveral concepts.
- 7) The second hang-up is "Love". The Jews seem to think that the whole world must love us. More important is to gain respect by earning it. JDL believes that the time has come to have Jewish pride. Self respect stand up and fight.

Jewish problems must come first:

- 8) The Jewish Federation in New York raised \$24,000,000 from the Jewish people's pocket-books, but allocate it for non-sectarian causes. The so-called Jewish hospitals should be supported by all ethnic groups which they serve not by monies raised in the name of Jewish Charities.
- 9) The JDL is the fastest growing Jewish organization in the country, in spite of the criticism from B'nai B'rith leaders not the BB members. Appealed to the youth to join only \$5 and if you don't have it, join anyway. We want quality not quantity.
- 10) In New York, Jews were being forced out of government jobs to make room for other minorities and the B'nai B'rith and other "respectable" organizations did nothing about it.
- 11) At the Lincoln Hospital in New York, Jewish doctors were being forced out to make openings for other minorities. The JDL took over the administrative offices. In two days Dr. ARNOLD EINHORN was reinstated.
- 12) In the New York Williamsburg District, where thousands of poor Jews live, a Chassidic Jew accidently ran over a Black girl with his truck. The court freed him of responsibility. In spite of the court's decision, the Blacks went on a rampage against the Jews. Calls came into the JDL headquarters for help. Why did the poor Williamsburg Jews call the JDL instead of B'nai B'rith? Because they know they would come down They did come down and conquered. The Blacks stopped their terrorism.
- 13) Chicago does not have the Jewish problem that New York has. However, now is the time to organize --- when you don't need it---so that you will be ready when needed. Also, you should be organized to help other areas where they have Jewish problems.

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- 14) We are concerned with the climate that is being created by our country's problems: The Radical Right, the Radical Left, social, political and economic, as evidenced by the actions of the blue collar workers being laid off. Fascism is a distinct possibility. "Never Again". It must not happen here.
- 15) Invited everyone to join the JDL, but to be sure to stay in the organizations of which they are members. See to it, from within the groups, that they fight for the Jewish causes to prevent what happened in Germany. No anti-Semitism has been activated by a Jew who has fought back.

Violence is always bad but sometimes necessary.

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On December 18, 1970, advised that Rabbi MEIR KAHANE, who is self described as the Founder and Executive Director of the JDL, held a news conference at the Century Plaza Hotel, Los Angeles, California, on December 1, 1970.

The November 26, 1970, issue of the "Los Angeles Times" contained an announcement setting forth that "Rabbi MEIR KAHANE, Founder and Executive Director, of the JDL", would speak at the Century Plaza Hotel on December 1, 1970, at 7:30 p.m.

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stated that KAHANE discussed the JDL at the December 1, 1970, meeting and made an announcement that an organizational meeting of the JDL would be held in Los Angeles on the evening of December 2, 1970. Individuals who were interested in attending this meeting were invited to contact KAHANE at the conclusion of his talk.

Source stated that he learned that the organizational meeting mentioned above was held on December 2, 1970, from approximately 8:00 to 10:30 p.m. at the residence of

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The local telephone Criss Cross Directory reflects a listing for

This meeting was attended by approximately 45 persons who appeared to be for the most part middle aged Jewish couples.





KAHANE stated that he was seeking members for JDL and hoped to establish this organization in Los Angeles. said that existing leaders in the Jewish community in the United States have not done a proper job in protecting Jews from Anti-Semetism, teaching Jewish youths facts of their heritage or instilling in them a sense of Jewish pride. of his points was that Jews should not be involved in establishing Jewish hospitals and that such money could be put to better use in protecting Jews from Anti-Semetic violence. KAHANE appealed to those present to join JDL and as a consequence approximately thirty persons signed up for membership. Many of those who joined paid the \$18.00 membership fee at the time. KAHANE stated that checks should be made payable to J. O. Y., which source understands is the Jewish Organization for Youth. KAHANE advised those in attendance that such membership fees are tax deductible.

KAHANE stated that JDL has operated on a budget of \$70,000 over the last two years and mentioned that members of the National Rifle Association have been giving rifle training to JDL members in New York.

KAHANE stated that he intended to return to Los Angeles in February, 1971, in furtherance of JDL and added that at that time he will speak at various Jewish Synagogues.

continued that on December 3, 1970, he attended a speech delivered by KAHANE at Haines Hall, on the camput of the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA). Source stated that KAHANE spoke under the auspices of the Associate Students Speakers Program.

KAHANE explained the aims and purposes of JDL and was extremely well received by the approximately 125 persons in attendance. Source stated that KAHANE is a dynamic speaker who has touched a responsive nerve in the Jewish community, particularly when he asked what success the moderate Jewish leaders and organizations have achieved in combating Anti-Semetism and bombing of synagogues and temples.

Source continued that KAHANE stated during his Los Angeles visit that he intended to take up permanent residence in Israel in September, 1971.

Source concluded by stating that KAHANE indicated that he plans to travel to Tuscon, Arizona on the evening of December 3, 1970.


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On December 29, 1970, the records of the New York City Police Department (NYCPD) revealed that the subject who gave his address as 440 West 2nd Street, New York City, was one of several individuals who were arrested on December 27, 1970 in connection with a demonstration held by Jewish groups in the vicinity of the Soviet Mission to the United Nations, New York City. Subject was charged with Rioting and Resisting Arrest.

On January 11, 1971 issue of the "New York Times", a daily newspaper published in New York, New York, on page 1 contained an article captioned "Jewish Defense League Plans to Harass Russians". This article stated that the subject said on January 10, 1971 that the JDL was forming groups to follow, question and harass Soviet diplomats in New York City and the purpose of this harassment would be to publicize a crisis in Soviet-American relations that would stop their countries from "building bridges over Jewish bodies". According to this article, United Press International reported that the subject also said these groups would "assault" Soviet diplomats. The subject, according to the article through the League's General Counsel BERTRAM ZWEIBON, denied last night that the subject has used that word. According to the article, the subject's remarks followed a series of recriminations, bombings and demonstrations that have exacerbated Soviet-American relations.

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On January 8, 1971, advised that KAHANE was expected to return to the United States on January 8, 1971. Subsequently, advised that KAHANE had contacted the JDL on January 8, 1971, and arranged to meet with him and others on January 10, 1971. Also, reported that KAHANE has advised that the person who went with him is staying "there" and learning "good things". Also KAHANE was interviewed in Israel on January 7, 1971, but this source could furnish no further details concerning this.

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On January 19, 1971, Reservations, El Al Airlines, 850 Third Avenue, New York, New York, furnished the following information:

KAHANE's name appears on a list of passengers for El Al flight 200, which was due to depart New York for Tel Aviv, Israel, on December 30, 1970, at 5:40 p.m. On this passenger list, his name was added to a tour group which was previously formed. KAHANE's name was removed from this list and added to the passenger list for E1 Al flight 242 which was scheduled to depart New York for Tel Aviv, Israel, on December 30, 1970, at 11:40 p.m. However, this flight was delayed and did not actually depart New York until 10 a.m. on December 31, 1970, arriving at Tel Aviv January 1, 1971. No other names were added to this flight other than KAHANE. On flight 242, besides KAHANE and airline personnel, the only other passengers destined to Tel Aviv were four members of a family named , who are identified in El Al flight records as

and a diplomatic ourier.

On January 22, 1971, above, advised that El Al flight 459 departs Tel Aviv for Rome, Italy, and Paris, France. Flight manifests for this flight are maintained in Tel Aviv and are not available in New York.

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२१८ १८४ In January, 1971, advised that the subject was at a JDL meeting on January 10, 1971. On January 18, 1971, advised that JDL had contacted the United States Department of State on that date, in an attempt to get an appointment with Secretary of State ROGERS for MEIR KAHANE. She stated that KAHANE will be going to Washington, followed extensively by the press, and he will not leave the State Department until either he has seen Secretary ROGERS or until he comes out of the building. told the State Department that MEIR will be going to there and MEIR will see ROGERS. According to the informant, does not know exactly when KAHANE is going to Washington, D.C.

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On January 18, 1971, CHARLES D. SKIPPON, Jr., Domestic Operations Division, Office of Security. United States Department of State (USDS) advised SA telegram was received at USDS either January 17 or 18 from the subject indicating he would arrive in Washington, D.C. (WDC) January 18th to see Secretary of State ROGERS. USDS telephonically advised the subject the Secretary of State was not available and no one at USDS could see him. KAHANE indicated he was traveling to WDC Wednesday, January 20, 1971 to see the Secretary of State. He has no appointment.

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On January 20, 1971, advised that the subject and planned to leave New York on January 21, 1971 for Toronto, Canada from LaGuardia Airport at 7 p.m. They plan to return to New York the same evening.

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On January 25, 1971, and advised that the subject and plan to depart New York from LaGuardia Airport, New York City for Dayton, Ohio, on January 28, 1971 and plan to return on January 29, 1971.

The January 19, 1971 issue of the "New York Times" on page 1, contained an article which indicated that the subject and eight others of the JDL were indicted yesterday on charging including Assault, Inciting to Riot, Rioting, Criminal Mischief and Burglary. Seven, including the subject,

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pled not guilty and were released on bail in Manhattan Supreme Court. The eighth, who is 18 years old, will be arraigned in "Youth Court" of the same Supreme Court.

Before agreeing to set bail for the seven who pled before him, Supreme Court Justice GERALD P. CULKIN made each one promise not to engage in further "illegal activities". According to the article, the indictments handed up by the New York City Grand Jury involved incidents involving damage by JDL members outside two Soviet offices and inside the offices of the Action Committee on American-Arab Relations. The prosecuting Assistant District Attorney FRANK J. ROGERS said that other cases are still being presented. prosecutor said he would agree to continuation of \$2,500 bail of the subject by another judge if the subject would promise to desist from illegal activities including "encouraging people to break through and encouraging people to demonstrate not in designated areas". The judge told the subject he was free to accept or reject the prosecutor's offer. The subject agreed to the offer. According to the article, the subject was indicted on three counts, Rioting, Inciting to Riot and Unlawful Assembly.

The January 20, 1971 issue of the "New York Times" on page 1, contained an article which announced an "indefinite moritorium" in the organized campaign of harassing Soviet diplomats and members of their families.

The January 21, 1971 issue of the "Daily News", a daily newspaper published in New York City, on page 22, contained an article that according to the subject, the JDL has called for a boycott with all United States companies trading with the Soviet Union in an attempt to stop alleged Soviet harassment of Jews. The article stated 20 JDL members sat in at the office of Columbia Artists, which is a major firm in New York City which sponsors a tour of the "Siberian Dancers and Singers from Omsk". This article stated the firm had refused to cancel the tour.

The January 14, 1971 issue of the "New York Times" contained an article on page one entitled "Grand Jury Will Hear Charges Against Jewish Defense League." In the article, it was stated that yesterday the JDL announced the appointment of its counsel, Mr. ZWEIBON, as its new National Chairman, effective next August. The article pointed out that ZWEIBON





helped found the JDL in 1968, with the subject and a third man, identified as MORTON DELINSKY, now a resident of Israel. The article also pointed out that Mr. ZWEIBON's appointment will coincide with the subject's intended establishment of residency in Israel. The subject, according to the article, would not comment when asked if he intended to surrender his United States citizenship. The article also stated that the subject is scheduled to become chairman of an organization called the World Jewish Defense League. The subject, in the article, said yesterday that the organization had branches in France, England, the Netherlands and Mexico and expected the formation of others in Argentina, Brazil, Israel and possibly Venezuela.

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FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOIPA DELETED PAGE INFORMATION SHEET

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The "New York Times" in its issue of January 24, 1971, on page 1, contained an article captioned "The Complex Past of Meir Kahane". This article reflected that several years ago KAHANE was known as MICHAEL KING, resident of an East side apartment who spent time in Washington as a partner in a small company that sought government contracts for political research. Under the name of MICHAEL KING, he wrote papers and books and once organized a student movement to support the war in Vietnam. He said he first started using the name MICHAEL KING in 1962, more or less as a lark. According to this article, his father, CHARLES KAHANE, in commenting on the shaping of his son's political views, remarked that in 1952 after swastikas had been smeared on a number of synagogues, he, as head of the "Rabbinical Board of Flatbush," had many meetings with local officials. He recalls returning from one of these dejected and disspirited and unwittingly he said he mentioned it would be a good idea if Jews would organize an underground. According to CHARLES KAHANE, the subject took this seriously. According to the father, in 1947, the subject and some of his friends threw_tomatoes at ERNEST BEVIN, the British Foreign Minister, who was in the United States for a This article said the subject attended the Mirrer Yeshiva where he was ordained and began calling himself MEIR. This article said that according to the subject's mother, in 1963, the subject went to Israel, leaving his wife and four children, for a few months. A relative who did not want to be identified, according to the article, said at the time of his departure, the subject predicted he would soon become a member of the Israeli Cabinet. The article said from Israel, the subject wrote his parents that he "met with the chief Rabbis of Jerusalem" and he was the first Rabbi, American and so young, to be admitted among them. The article continued the subject served for three months as a Rabbi in a kibbutz and then returned home. The article said his mother stated he was very upset "at all the fighting among the Jewish factions in Israel".

According to the article, the subject had a close friend in Brooklyn, JOSEPH CHURBA and they went to the same school and both attended camp in the Catskills, run by Betar, the revisionist, Zionist organization. In May, 1969, the article said CHURBA rented a mailing address and a phone number under the name of Consultants Research Associates, 509 5th Avenue and when the subject started working with Consultant Research, he moved seriously in the identity of MICHAEL KING.



One of their first ventures was the July 4th Movement, an attempt to mobilize campus support in favor of the Vietnam war.

The January 18, 1971 issue of "The National Observer" a national weekly newspaper, on page 3, contained information concerning the JDL and background of KAHANE. This article stated at the age of 14, subject enlisted in the American branch of Betar, a Palestinian Jewish youth movement and spent his spare time at docks in Bayonne and Hoboken, smuggling guns on freighters bound for the rebels seeking to establish Israel as an independent state.

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APPENDIX

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JEWISH DEFENSE LEAGUE

On June 9, 1969, a source advised the Jewish Defense League (JDL) was formed September, 1968, by Rabbi Meir Kahane, a writer for the newspaper "Jewish Press", an Anglo-Jewish weekly published in Brooklyn, New York.

According to the source, JDL is a militant organization dedicated to the struggle for democracy, freedom and Jewish rights. This militant attitude is reflected in the firearms and karate training afforded many of its members. The League regards its readiness to use force in certain situations as one of its virtues.

Public statements by Rabbi Kahane proclaim that the purpose of the League is to combat anti-Semitism wherever it exists in the world.

Another source advised on November 10, 1970 that the JDL is composed primarily of young Jewish militants who consider themselves through their militant involvement as the primary defender of "Jewish rights in the United States".

In an effort to dramatize and bring public attention to the plight of the Jewish community in Russia, JDL has engaged in many demonstrations, vigils and pickets against Soviet official establishments and personnel in New York, Washington and other cities of the United States. Several of these demonstrations have resulted in physical harm and property damage to Russian personnel and property and JDL members have been arrested and charged with this destruction.

Similar demonstrations have been conducted by the JDL against Arab official establishments, primarily in New York City and vicinity to dramatize what the League feels as Arab antagonism and injustice against the State of Israel. Several of these demonstrations have resulted in physical harm and property damage resulting in arrests of JDL members who were charged with this destruction.

According to this source, most well-known Jewish organizations are opposed to the JDL on both ideological and moral grounds.

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

Source One, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that approximately 1,000 people gathered at Norton Student Union, State University of New York at Buffalo (SUNYAB) for a speech by MEIR KAHANE on February 4, 1971 at 8:00 FM. KAHANE spoke for approximately two hours in an atmosphere during which he was cheered and heckled by the audience, some of whom, it is apparent, did not approve of his statements. His speech was generally regarding anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union and a call for a free state of Israel. It was difficult to actually hear many of the statements made during the speech because of the loud jeering among many dissident factions in the audience. Source One stated that there was a mixture of New Left, pro-Zionist and more passive type Jews in the audience and that this caused the mixed opinions regarding KAHANE's speech. which were so apparent. KAHANE was accompanied by what appeared to be body guards and as a result no trouble occurred during the course of the evening. It was announced that the appearance of KAHANE was sponsored by the Students for Israel as well as the SUNYAB Student Association.

Source Two, who has furnished reliable information in the past, corroborated the above information.

JEWISH DEFENSE LEAGUE

On June 9, 1969, a source advised the Jewish Defense League (JDL) was formed September, 1968, by Rabbi Meir Kahane, a writer for the newspaper, "Jewish Press", an Anglo-Jewish weekly published in Brooklyn, New York.

According to the source, JDL is a militant organization dedicated to the struggle for democracy, freedom and Jewish rights. This militant attitude is reflected in the firearms and karate training afforded many of its members. The League regards its readiness to use force in certain situations as one of its virtues.


Public statements by Rabbi Kahane proclaim that the purpose of the League is to combat anti-Semitism wherever it exists in the world.

Another source advised on November 10, 1970, that the JDL is composed primarily of young Jewish militants who consider themselves through their militant involvement as the primary defender of "Jewish rights in the United States".

In an effort to dramatize and bring public attention to the plight of the Jewish community in Russia, JDL has engaged in many demonstrations, vigils and pickets against Soviet official establishments and personnel in New York, Washington and other cities of the United States. Several of these demonstrations have resulted in physical harm and property damage to Russian personnel and property and JDL members have been arrested and charged with this destruction.

Similar demonstrations have been conducted by the JDL against Arab official establishments, primarily in New York City and vicinity to dramatize what the League feels as Arab antagonism and injustice against the State of Israel. Several of these demonstrations have resulted in physical harm and property damage resulting in arrests of JDL members who were charged with this destruction.

advised that approximately 860 or 906 persons attended KAHANE's speech, three-quarters of whom were students at Dickinson, KAHANE was introduced by Professor HERBERT ALEXANDER, Chairman of the Department of Psychology at Dickinson College. According to KAHANE arrived late for his engagement and addressed the group from 8:30 to 9:30 p.m., and then answered questions for approximately 30 minutes.

KAHANE stated the black people, having been oppressed in this country for a number of years, responded some 25 years later and went to the streets. Once in the streets, they got results. KAHANE questioned as to why the Rabbis were not in Washington, D. C., during World War II or why a hundred thousand Jews were not protesting in the streets of New York during that period. He stated the reason for this was due to the fact that Jews have a hang-up called, "Respectability."

KAHANE stated it was time that the plight of the Jews in the Soviet Union was taken off Page 40, where it has been put by the Jewish establishment and put on Page 1 where it belongs. He advised that the Jewish Defense League (JDL) put the question of the Soviet Jews on Page 1 for the past two months.

During his speech, KAHANE cited scriptures and Jewish teaching, saying that it was recorded that Moses once observed an Egyptian slaying an Israelite and Moses took up a weapon and slew the Egyptian. He therefore concluded from this Jewish teaching that violence was sometimes necessary

and when the life of a Jew was threatened, murder may also be demanded.


KAHANE stated the problem of the Jews in Russia is a very real one and that prior to the actions of the JDL, President NIXON was not losing any sleep over the problems of the Jews. KAHANE stated, in order to get the President of the United States to do anything about the Soviet Jewish problem, it was necessary to make their problem his problem. He pointed out harassing of Soviets in the United States has done this and a continued program of disrupting Soviet life in the United States may eventually bring results.

KAHANE pointed out "President NIXON, as well as past president," has been building bridges to the Soviet Union over the bodies of Jews." He advised perhaps the actions of the JDL will stop this deplorable practice. He also advised that he does not want an all out war with Russia but if the JDL continues to harass Soviets and to make their life uncomfortable, perhaps the Russians will say, "The Goddam Jews aren't worth the aggravation," and release a couple thousand Jews.

KAHANE stated the aim of the JDL was to attempt to disrupt the Strategic Arms Limitations Talks (SALT), by suspending them temporarily with emphasis on temporary suspension. He further advised that perhaps the JDL could upset the cultural exchange program also. He pointed out that because both these programs are vital to the Soviets in their maintaining contact with the United States, a disruption of those would be disagreeable to both the United States and Russia. The actions of the JDL could not possible make the oppression of the Jews in Russia any worse,

Advised that during the question and answer period following KAHANE's speech, KAHANE pointed out he planned to move from the United States to Israel, where he would set up an International Office of the JDL. He pointed out he would make this move in the very near future, taking his wife and children with him, but stated however he would frequently be in the United States on speaking engagements. He further advised the JDL has had numerous inquiries about its movement from concerned Jews all over the world and that this was the reason for opening an International Office.





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On February 5, 1971, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE, National Director of the Jewish Defense League, is scheduled to speak before the student body at Syracuse University on the evening of February 8, 1971.

The Jewish Defense League is self-described as a militant activist group dedicated to the struggle for democracy, freedom, and Jewish rights.

An acticle that appeared in the February 10, 1971, edition of the "Daily Orange," the official Syracuse University Newspaper, announced that Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE spoke before a group of students in Hendricks Chapel, Syracuse University, on the evening of February 8, 1971. The article related that KAHANE spoke first about the horrors of World War II and the Auschwitz death camp. He told how FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT refused to destroy the railroad lines that transported two million Jews into Auschwitz. This inaction by Government, KAHANE said, continues today as exemplified by President NIXON's "I sympathize fully but can't do anything about it" attitude toward Russia's persecution of Soviet Jews. KAHANE was further quoted as stating, 'What do you do when the Government says no?" "First," say KAHANE, "You make the world know there is a problem by getting page one publicity using whatever means are necessary." "The second step is to make the Soviet Jews' problem RICHARD NIXON'S problem."

The article also noted that tactics used by the Jewish Defense League to receive publicity and to produce a Soviet - United States diplomacy crisis have included harassment of Soviet Embassy and airline personnel and demonstrations in New York City.

The article further related that KAHANE said that the United States Government is more concerned with "building bridges to the East," than the human problem, and that to change this "you attempt to knock those bridges down." He stated, "violence is either a two-way street or a no way street, but we never again will let it be a one-way street." KAHANE advised Jewish students to be proud, to be Jewish and to be unafraid of violence. He said that violence is always there and sometimes necessary.

The "Daily Orange" reported that in a question and answer period after the speech, KAHANE talked about his future plans. He indicated that he was leaving for Israel in the summer "to set an example for young Jews" and to begin Jewish Defense League Chapters in other countries. KAHANE indicated that there were 12,000 Jewish Defense League members and 44 collegiste chapters.

There were approximately 50 students present at KAHANE's speech.

On February 9, 1971, the above-mentioned confidential source advised that there is no chapter of the Jewish Defense League on Syracuse University campus. He noted that KAHANE's appearance on campus was sponsored by the B'Nai B'rith Hillel Foundation,

On February 17, 1971, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that captioned individual appeared before a group of students in the Memorial Chapel of Colgate University, Hamilton, New York, on the evening of February 16, 1971.

The source noted that the context of Rabbi KAHANE's speech generally was a plea for better treatment of Russian Jews in the Soviet Union.

KAHANE pointed out that Jews have been in the front of many causes but none of them have been Jewish causes and that Jewish young people are eager to march and fight for a cause, but there has been no Jewish cause for them to march for.

KAHANE said that he felt that the Jewish Defense League (JDL) has given Jewish youth the key to getting back to their Jewishness to do whatever needs to be done to allow Jews to be free.

(A characterization of the JDL is attached hereto.)

KAHANE cited Jewish history to show the Jews have always fought for their beliefs and said that he feels that the JDL is giving young Jews a chance to find themselves and their Jewishness by continuing to fight for what they believe.

JEWISH DEFENSE LEAGUE

On June 9, 1969, a source advised the Jewish Defense League (JDL) was formed September, 1968, by Rabbi Meir Kahane, a writer for the newspaper "Jewish Press", an Anglo-Jewish weekly published in Brooklyn, New York.

According to the source, JDL is a militant organization dedicated to the struggle for democracy, freedom and Jewish rights. This militant attitude is reflected in the firearms and karatetraining afforded many of its members. The League regards its readiness to use force in certain situations as one of its virtues.

Public statements by Rabbi Kahane proclaim that the purpose of the League is to combat anti-Semitism wherever it exists in the world.

Another source advised on November 10, 1970 that the JDL is composed primarily of young Jewish militants who consider themselves through their militant involvement as the primary defender of "Jewish rights in the United States".

In an effort to dramatize and bring public attention to the plight of the Jewish community in Russia, JDL has engaged in many demonstrations, vigils and pickets against Soviet official establishments and personnel in New York, Washington and other cities of the United States. Several of these demonstrations have resulted in physical harm and property damage to Russian personnel and property and JDL members have been arrested and charged with this destruction.

Similar demonstrations have been conducted by the JDL against Arab official establishments, primarily in New York City and vicinity to dramatize what the League feels as Arab antagonism and injustice against the State of Israel. Several of these demonstrations have resulted in physical harm and property damage resulting in arrests of JDL members who were charged with this destruction.

According to this source, most well-known Jewish organizations are opposed to the JDL on both ideological and moral grounds.

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

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

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

Jewish Concept of Violence' Detailed by Kahane

By FRED BARNES Star Staff Writer

As he stood before the well-heeled Jewish congregation at a synagogue in Potomac, Md., Rabbi Meir David Kahane looked every bit as radical as Spiro Agnew.

His pants drooped over his shoes and he wore a rumpled sport coat, a white cotton shirt and an unfashionably narrow tie. A few strands of gray flecked his close-cropped hair.

But looks can be deceiving, the crowd of about 300 at the suburban synagogue learned vesterday.

In an hour-long speech, the rabbi wavered not a scintilla from the outspoken brand of Jewish militance that has made him the bane of Soviet diplomats in New York, that city's police force, the State Department and many moderate Jewish organizations.

Kahane, 38, is national chairman of the Jewish Defense League, the group whose members have been hounding Soviet diplomats at the United Nations in retaliation for alleged mistreatment of Jews in the Soviet Union. JDL also has been blamed for damaging several cars of Soviet diplomats in Washington.

"To turn the other cheek is not a Jewish concept," Kahane explained. The message that comes from Jewish sources, he said, is one of meeting fire with fire.

According to Kahane, there is a "Jewish concept of violence" that is drawn from Moses ("a good Jew"), the Talmud and such historical Jewish groups as the Maccabees and the defenders of Masada in 72 A.D. The concept goes like this:

"A Jew should use as much violence as is necessary to survive. And if you can survive with no violence, then you should never use any violence. But if you can't survive without any kind of violence, then it's inexcusable for you not to use that kind of violence."

The essence of Indaism "is the spirit." the rabbi said, "but sometimes the Jewish spirit survives because of the Jewish fist. ... To be too humble and to let yourself be stepped on is not the Jewish way."

Kahane, who was convicted last week of

breaking through a police line during protest Dec. 30 at the Soviet mission in New York and is awaiting trial on charge of inciting to riot at a similar demonstration three days earlier, was scornful of more moderate Jewish leaders who have criticized JDL's activities

"I find it incredible for Jews who have watched as 53 years of violence have been perpetrated against Jews in the U.S.S.R. to suddenly go crazy because a Soviet car here was fire-bombed," he said.

The rabbi repeatedly called on members of the audience, almost all of whom wore yarmulkes, the traditional black skull caps, to participate in a mass protest March 21 at the White House. The demonstration is designed to pressure the government to cut off all talks with the Russians until they halt mistreatment of Jews.

"Each and every Jew is called upon to sacrifice for the Soviet Jewry," he said. On March 21, "you don't go visiting relatives, you don't go playing golf, you don't watch the NBA game of the week. On that day, you're at the White House."

After the speech, he told reporters that there are plans for "several thousand people" to stage a sit-down in Pennsylvania Avenue during the protest.

He also appealed in his speech for new JDL members. Already the group has signed up about 200 persons in the Washington area, he said, and two JDL representatives will come here in two weeks to weld the new chapter into an aggressive force.

At the end, Kanane got a standing ovation and a woman in the front row asked where she could get a JDL button like the one Kahane wore on his lapel. The rabbi smiled, unpinned the but on from his coat and gave it to her.





Rabbi KAHANE spoke in a calm, precise manner, presenting a pleasant and neat appearance.

He recounted a brief history of the Jews in the United States and throughout the world since World War II and attempted to describe how Jews have been content to receive the sympathy and consolation of the world rather than obtain definite results. Drawing a parallel to the Negro problem in the U.S. and their militant measures initiated to obtain equality, he stated that Jews have now started to take similar measures. He indicated that for many years Jews have been willing to accept verbal consolation and compassion with very willing to accept verbal consolation and compassion with very little results. Referring to the recent militant action of the JDL, RABBI KAHANE indicated that this was the reason more Soviet Jews were allowed to leave Russia in recent weeks than ever before. He felt it was about time Jews received their priority.

He maintained that, "If one comes to slay you, slay him first." He indicated that the JDL gives Young Jews a cause and a reason to want to be Jewish. He thought the present leaders of Russia were weak and that through internal pressure within Russia and by the action of Jews outside of pressure within Russia and by the action of Jews outside of Russia, that country could be forced to permit Soviet Jews to leave Russia for Israel.

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Rabbi KAHANE said, "There is nothing wrong with violence if there is no other way for a Jew to live." He maintained, however, that violence should not be used if the change desired could be obtained in a non-violent form. He advised that next Sunday on 3/21/71 there would be a march on Washington, D.C., to draw attention to the plight of Soviet Jewry. Rabbi KAHANE claimed that in New York the JDL is frequently contacted by Jews in various sections of New York City when protection is needed because of intimidation by other groups. He advocated that Jews should demonstrate for anti-racism and felt that Jewish organizations should initiate legal maneuvers to obtain objectives.

When the lecture was terminated, Rabbi KAHANE conducted a question and answer period. Many of the individuals asking questions indicated they agreed with many of his aims but were against violence. He said he advocated certain measures to help pressure Russia into permitting Jews to leave for Israel. These measures included demonstrations, boycotting Russian goods, and all business with Russia. Also, he stated that all types of exchange, such as cultural, scientific, economic, progress, etc., with the USSR should be terminated. He stated the JDL hoped to obtain the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all Russian officials in the U.S. and harass them through telephone calls and by following them, hoping by this means to pressurize their government into releasing Soviet Jews.

The Rabbi terminated his lecture by stating that his organization was small but determined and that they were looking for new members. He said the JDL had a few non-Jews in the organization and welcomed them for members. The JDL, he stated, was definitely a non-political organization and did not care whether a member was leftist or rightist, as loon as he was interested in the goals of the JDL.

KAHANE of the Jewish Defense League (JDL) from New York City, New York, has been scheduled to speak at 4:00 p.m., on March 16, 1971, at the Student Union Ballroom, University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland. This speech is being sponsored by Hillel and Associates Students for Israel at the University.

# JDL head hits oppression

Rabbi Meir Kahane, founder and head of the Jewish Defense League, said yesterday his group "owes no one an explanation for our actions," including those involving violence.

Speaking to about 700 people in the Student Union ballroom, Kahane defended JDL activities, centered mostly in New York City against anti-Semitic attacks, as necessary to avoid the spread of anti-Semitism.

One example of anti-Jewish feeling is currently popular in the Soviet Union, he noted.

"The Russians don't know what to do," Kahane said of the 25 Jews per day being allowed by the Soviet government to emigrate to Israel.

"They are trying to buy us off cheaply."

Of the JDL actions for Soviet Jews, Kahane said, "Do you think it's an accident that 25 Jews a day are being let out of Russia? Do you think Russia wants to let Jews out?" Kahane explained, "There are other things Russia wants" than to keep its Jews. "They have a problem. It's called Chinese. Russia has an army on the Chinese border that costs billions and billions of rubles."

Kahane added that Russia also wants consumer goods, trade and peaceful coexistence with the West.

"If you threaten that, if you threaten that you are going to take it away," Kahane added, "they will pay your price for you to give it back to them."

Kahane said, "Soviet buildings are tombed and Soviet cars are firebombed, I read in the New York Times," adding, "we are going to peacefully picket at the private residences of Russian diplomats.

"The Soviet Union is an incredibly stupid government," Kahane said. "They will go nuts."

A leaflet distributed after Kahane's speech had the phone numbers of a number of Soviet diplomats and instructed, "If you get through, in-

quire as to the Jewish policy of the Soviet Union and ask why the Jews are discriminated against and are not allowed to emigrate.

"More than likely, the discussion will not be lengthy."

Kahane announced a rally will be held on Sunday, March 21 in front of the White House, on behalf of the Soviet Jews. He claimed it will be "one of the biggest rallies you'll ever see."

Concerning the problem of anti-Semitism in the United States, particularly in New York, Kahane noted, "In Brownsville (N.Y.), there are more than 2,000 Jews over 65 on welfare, who are so terrified that they don't even go out of their homes more than twice a week to buy food.

"When JDL formed a patrol to allow these people the elementary right to walk in the street, what is the word we get? 'Vigilantes'.'

Kahane went on, "Do you know who calls us vigilantes? All the Jewish leaders who don't live in Brownsville."

Kahane said the membership of JDL is "growing at an incredible rate."

Discussing membership, he estimated "about 13,000 people, with 5,000 of those below the age of 23." belong to JDL.

A sheet for sign-ups of those interested in becoming JDL members was also made available after Kahane's speech and was signed by scores of people.

He claimed, "The possibility for another holocaust is very real," in the Soviet Union.

He noted, "Jews have worshed for too long for every cause in the world except their own cause.

"You cannot march for any other cause until you march for a Jewish cause.

"When the chips are down and when the die is cast, who is going to help the Jews? No one except another Jew."

Speaking about Micratics movemeats, Kahana reserved, "Oten like Martin Laster Kurr went out on the "They marched where they were told 'You cannot march,' they sat down where they were told 'You cannot sit down,' they chained themselves to the White House, they got put in jail, but they fought and won.

"It is to their credit and our dishonor," Kahane added, because "rabbis went down and marched (with the Negroes) and got locked up.

"You couldn't find a rabbi in 1943 to chain himself to the White House when it was not a question of civil rights but of Jewish lives."

Kahane said, "There is a Jewish national liberation movement and it is called Zionism, and there is a Jewish state and it is called Israel." BA 105-16267

During the speech, the name of Apartment 101, Silver spring, Maryland, phone number was announced to the audience and indicated that a quiet demonstration would be conducted on the evening of March 16, 1971 at the above residence.



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

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

#### Arrest Record

The February 24, 1971 issue of "The New York Times" contained an article on page 6 captioned "Mahane is Guilty of Disorderly Conduct." This article reflected that the subject was convicted on February 23; 1971, on charges of obstructing governmental administration and disorderly conduct. The article said that the 6-member jury that deliberated three hours on the findings, dismissed a charge of resisting arrest. Criminal Court Judge INVING LANG set April 13, 1971, for sentencing. Obstructing governmental administration, a misdemeanor, carries a maximum sentence of one year in prison. and a \$1,000.00 fine. Disorderly conduct, a violation, is punishable by fifteen days in jail. The article stated that the verdict on February 23, 1971, arose from a December 30, 1969 demonstration at the Soviet Hission to the United Mations. The article stated that the subject was released in his own recognizance. According to this article, the subject told reporters he was to take an evening flight to Brussels to attend the Morld Conference of Soviet Jerry.

The article stated that the subject spoke to students at the University of Toronto and York University, where he was invited to speak by the Action Committee for Soviet Jewry.

On January 26, 1971, advised that Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE of the Jewish Defense League, New York City, planned to travel via Allegheny Airlines from New York City to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, in order to deliver a speech at 8:30 PM on January 26, 1971.

advised on January 26, 1971, that Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE spoke at Dickinson College on that day under the auspices of the Hillel Council, Jewish students organization, Dickinson College, Carlisle, Pennsylvania. Information concerning KAHANE's appearance on campus was made through a letter to parents, faculty, and friends on the Hillel Council stationery signed by MEL NAROL, President.

KAHANE questioned as to why the Rabbis were not in Washington, D. C. during World War II or why a hundred thousand Jews were not protesting in the streets of New York during that period. He stated the reason for this was due to the fact that Jews have a hang-up called, "Respectability."

KAHANE stated it was time that the plight of the Jews in the Soviet Union was taken off Page 40, where it has been put by the Jewish establishment and put on Page 1 where it belongs. He advised that the Jewish Defense League is a "radical organization" and they have made the news media put the question of the Soviet Jews on Page 1 for the past two months.

During his speech, KAHANE cited scriptures and Jewish teaching, saying that it was recorded that Moses once observed an Egyptian slaying an Israelite and Moses took up a
weapon and slew the Egyptian. He therefore concluded from this
Jewish teaching that violence was sometimes necessary, and when
the lifeof a Jew was threatened, murder also be demanded.

KAHANE stated the problem of the Jews in Russia is a very real one, and that prior to the actions of the JDL, President NIXON was not losing any sleep over the problems of the Jews. KAHANE stated, "in order to get the President of the United States to do anything about the Joviet Jewish problem, it was necessary to make their problem his problem." He pointed out harassing of Soviets in the United States has done this, and a continued program of disrupting Soviet life in the United States may eventually bring results.

KAHANE pointed out "President NIXON, as well as past president," has been building bridges to the Soviet Union over the bodies of Jews." He advised perhaps the actions of the JDL.

will stop this deplorable practice. He also advised that he does not want an all out war with Russia, but if the JDL continues to harass Soviets and to make their life uncomfortable, perhaps the Russians will say, "the Goddam Jews aren't worth the aggravation," and release a couple thousand Jews.

KAHANE stated the aim of the JDL was to attempt to disrupt the Strategic Arms Limitations Talks (SALT), by suspending them temporarily with emphasis on temporary suspension. He further advised that perhaps the JDL could upset the cultural exchange program also. He pointed out that because both these programs are vital to the Soviets in their maintaining contact with the United States, a disruption of those would be disagreeable to both the United States and Russia. The actions of the JDL could not possibly make the oppression of the Jews in Russia any worse.

advised that during the question and answer period following KAHANE's speech, KAHANE pointed out he planned to move from the United States to Israel, where he would set up an International Office of the JDL. He pointed out he would make this move in the very near future, taking his wife and children with him, but stated, however, he would frequently be in the United States on speaking engagements. He further advised the JDL has had numerous inquiries about its movement from concerned Jews all over the world and that this was the reason for opening an International Office.

On January 29, 1971, MEIR D. KAHANE, National Director, JDL, appeared as a guest on the PHIL DONAHUE television show based in Dayton, Ohio. The show is a sixty minute live telecast and is primarily questions by the audience and answers by the guest. KAHANE made no definite statement as to his future plans concerning militant activities, however, his major theme was to free the Jews in Russia, who are denied the right to practice their religion. The temperament of KAHANE seemed to be to generate enthusiasm for younger Jews to become active in his cause.

ROOSHVILT refused to destroy the railroad lines that transported two million Jews into Luschwitz. This inaction by Government, KANNIE said, contimues today as exemplified by President HIMON's "I sympathize fully but can't do anything about it attitude toward Russia's persecution of Soviet Jews. KANTED was further quoted as stating, "What do you do when the Government says no?" "First," says WHAME, "you make the world know there is a problem by getting page one publicity using thatever means are necessary." "The second step is to make the Soviet Jews! problem RICH'RD MEXON's problem."

The article also noted that tactics used by the JDL to receive publicity and to produce a Soviet - United States diplomacy crisis have included harassment of Soviet Embassy and airline personnel and demonstrations in New York City.

The article further related that KANAME said that the United States Government is more interested with "building bridges to the East," than the human problem, and that to change this "you attempt to knock those bridges down." He stated, "violence is either a two-way street or a no way street, but we never again will let it be a one-way street." KANAME advised Jewish students to be proud to be Jewish, and to be unafraid of violence. He said that violence is always there and sometimes necessary.

The "Daily Orange" reported that in a question and amswer period after the speech, KUNVE talked about his future plans. He indicated that he was leaving for Israel in the summer "to set an example for young Jews," and to begin JDL chapters in other countries. KUNVEL indicated that there were 12,000 JDL members and 44 collegiate chapters.

There were approximately 50 students present at KAHAME's speech.

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On February 9, 1971, advised that there is no chapter of the JDL on Syracuse University campus. He noted that KUHUME's appearance on campus was sponsored by B'nai B'rith Hillel Foundation, an officially recognized Jewish

On February 17, 1971, advised that the subject appeared before a group of students in the Hemorial Chapel of Golgate University, Hamilton, Hew York on the evening of February 16, 1971. The speech was a plea for better treatment of Russian Jews in the Soviet Union.

KHAMI pointed out that Jews have been in the front of many causes but none of them have been Jewish causes and that Jewish young people are eager to march and fight for a cause, but there has been no Jewish cause for them to march for.

RHAM said that he felt that the Jewish Defense League has given Jewish youth the key to getting back to their Jewishness to do whatever needs to be done to allow Jews to be free.

KAHAME cited Jewish history to show the Jews have always fought for their beliefs and said that he feels that the JDL is giving young Jews a chance to find themselves and their Jewishness by continuing to fight for what they believe.

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He called for a sit-down at seven state capitols, including Albany, New York on March 14, 1971, and also announced that there would be a sit-down planned for March 21, 1971, at the White House in Mashington, D. C. to protest administration attitudes toward the plight of Soviet Jews.

On February 23, 1971, advised that the JDL office in MYC notified United Press International that the subject was leaving on this date aboard Sabena Belgium Morld Airlines, Flight 542, departing New York 5:45 PN and arriving at Brussels, Belgium 6:45 AM, Belgium time.

After having been barred from the meeting, he was detained ten hours by the Belgium Police for questioning and was then forced to depart on a plane to London.

The subject, according to the article, had been

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allowed into the front hall of the Palais des Congres, a convention hall, where he made a written request for an opportunity to speak. It was rejected as had been a request before the conference. The article said he left the hall stating he had not come "to destroy the conference" but wished to exert his right to speak.

The article further stated that the Ministry of Justice said it had been advised by the conference leadership that the subject had been barred from the proceedings and that in view of the possibility of a disturbance, he was being expelled.

On Page 13 of this same issue of "The New York Times", dateline London, February 24, 1971, there appeared an article that the subject on the arrival at London, stated he did not plan to return to Brussels to protest his expulsion. The article quoted the subject as saying "I think that anytime there is pressure to have someone whose views are not popular silenced, it is very bad not just for myself, but for the general process of democracy." The article continued that the subject would not say how long he planned to remain in Britain, but he did say that after he returned to the United States he would intensify his campaign to induce the Soviet Government to change its policies toward Jews.

A Special Agent (SA) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) advised that on March 17, 1971, Rabbi Meir D. Kahane, Jewish Defense League (JDL), was scheduled to lecture before members of the congregation of Temple Beth Shalom, East Mount Pleasant Avenue, Livingston, New Jersey. The lecture was scheduled for 8:15 P.M.; however, Rabbi Kahane did not arrive until 9:05 P.M., and started to speak at 9:10 P.M. The audience consisted of approximately 450 people, mostly middle-aged. Rabbi Kahane was apparently accompanied by four or five "security" men in their early 20's. A few of those "security" men arrived before he did. Rabbi Kahane spoke in a calm, precise manner, presenting a pleasant and neat appearance.

He recounted a brief history of the Jews in the United States and throughout the world since World War II, and attempted to describe how Jews have been content to receive the sympathy and consolation of the world rather than obtain definite results. Drawing a parallel to the Negro problem in the United States and their militant measures initiated to obtain equality, he stated that Jews have now started to take similar measures. He indicated that for many years Jews have been willing to accept verbal consolation and compassion with very little results. Referring to the recent militant action of the JDL, Rabbi Kahane indicated that this was the reason more Soviet Jews were allowed to leave Russia in recent weeks than ever before. He felt it was about time Jews received their priority.

He maintained that, "If one comes to slay you, slay him first". He indicated that the JDL gives young Jews a cause and a reason to want to be Jewish. He thought the present leaders of Russia were weak and that through internal pressure within Russia and by the action of Jews outside of Russia, that country could be forced to permit Soviet Jews to leave Russia for Israel.

#### MEIR D. KAHANE

Rabbi Kahane said, "There is nothing wrong with violence if there is no other way for a Jew to live." He maintained, however, that violence should not be used if the change desired could be obtained in a non-violent form. He advised that next Sunday, on March 21, 1971, there would be a march on Washington, D.C., to draw attention to the plight of Soviet Jewry. Rabbi Kahane claimed that in New York, the JDL is frequently contacted by Jews in various sections of New York City when protection is needed because of intimidation by other groups. He advocated that Jews should demonstrate for anti-racism and felt that Jewish organizations should initiate legal maneuvers to obtain objectives.

When the lecture was terminated, Rabbi Kahane conducted a question and answer period. Many of the individuals asking questions indicated they agreed with many of his aims but were against violence. He said he advocated certain measures to help pressure Russia into permitting Jews to leave for Israel. These measures included demonstrations, boycotting Russian goods, and all business with Russia. Also, he stated that all types of exchang such as cultural, scientific, economic, progress, etc., with the USSR should be terminated. He stated the JDL hoped to obtain the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all Russian officials in the United States and harass them through telephone calls and by following them, hoping by this means to pressurize their government into releasing Soviet Jews.

The Rabbi terminated his lecture by stating that his organization was small but determined and that they were looking for new members. He said the JDL had a few non-Jews in the organization and welcomed them for members. The JDL, he stated, was definitely a non-political organization and did not care whether a member was leftist or rightist, as long as he was interested in the goals of the JDL.



DETAILS:

It is to be noted that the subject is the National Director of the Jewish Defense League (JDL).

The JDL is self-described as a militant activist group dedicated to the struggle for democracy, freedom and Jewish rights.

#### Arrest Record

On March 31, 1971, SC searched the records of the courts of the City of New York, which contained the following information:

Docket Number B4763/70, pertains to the arrest of the subject on February 4, 1970, when he was charged with criminal trespass. These records show that this charge was dismissed on May 12, 1970.

Docket Number C34620/69, pertains to the subject's arrest on December 18, 1969, when he was charged with disorderly conduct. These records reflect that these charges against the subject were dismissed on March 30, 1971.

Docket Number A25089/70, pertains to the subject's indictment by the New York County Grand Jury on January 18, 1971. These records reflect the subject is to appear in the New York Supreme Court, April 12, 1971.

Docket Number B35190/69, pertains to the subject's arrest on December 29, 1969, when he was charged with conspiracy, criminal trespass and criminal mischief. These records reflect that on March 29, 1971, the subject's trial was postponed until March 30, 1971, jury trial, and that the Judge on March 30, 1971, declared a mistrial and set the date of April 26, 1971, for the subject to appear again on these charges.

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On March 31, 1971, SC searched the records of the Courts of the City of New York in Brooklyn, New York, which contained Docket Number AlOl47, which pertains to the subject's arrest on June 28, 1970. These records reflect that the subject appeared in court on March 3, 1971, and pled guilty to a charge of harassment on that date. He was fined \$100 on this charge. These records reflect that this fine was paid on March 8, 1971.

#### Activities

PVC

On January 11, 1971,
University of Arizona (UA), Tucson, Arizona, advised SA
that the subject appeared at Hillel House, a
Jewish Student Center, adjacent to the UA campus on the evening
of December 3, 1970. The subject spoke briefly to a group of
about 30 students concerning the origin and aims of the JDL.
There was no attempt to organize a JDL chapter at the UA, and
the subject's talk consisted mainly of criticism of Jewish
community leaders for not instilling pride of heritage in Jewish
youth and for not protecting Jews from anti-semitic violence.

On February 16, 1970,
Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Police Department, advised that two of his officers attended a meeting of the JDL which was held at Temple Beth Ami, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Approximately 250 people were observed entering the building where the principal speakers were ELT SCHWARTZ of the JDL Youth Movement, DOV\SPERLING, a member of the Soviet Jewish Underground, and the subject. The main emphasis of the speeches was on more participation by young people in the JDL, a discussion on the plight of Soviet Jewry, and the need for more militancy in the Jewish community.

that the subject would be in the Maryland and Virginia area on February 28, 1971, where he would talk at the Agudas Achim Congregation of Northern Virginia, Alexandria, Virginia, and later that day, at the Seven Locks Jewish Community Temple, Potomac, Maryland.

On March 1, 1971, "The Evening Star", a Washington area newspaper, on page B-1, carried an article captioned, "Defense League Chairman in Potomac." This article reflected the subject made an hour long speech concerning the Jewish militancy against Soviet diplomats in New York. The article quoted the subject as saying "a Jew should use as much violence as is necessary to survive. And if you can survive with no violence, then you should never use violence. But if you can't survive without any kind of violence, then its inexcusable for you not to use that kind of violence." He called upon the audience at the synagogue in Potomac, Maryland, to participate in a mass protest on March 21, 1971, at the White House, which is designed to pressure the government to cut off all talkswith the Russians until they halt mistreatment of, Jews.

SUC

On March 2, 1971, support on February 28, 1971, in Potomac, Maryland, and the article appearing in "The Evening Star" was correct as to the substance of the subject's talk. The subject passed a sheet of paper around for signatures in support of the JDL and his planned mass protest on March 21, 1971, at the White House, and he asked for contributions for the JDL. Stated he feels about 50 persons signed the sheet of paper for the subject and about that number may have felt sufficiently motivated by the subject's talk on the Soviet Jewry problem to have contributed small sums of money to the JDL.

Palpyo

On February 28, 1971, advised that some members of the JDL, in discussing the Brooklyn Chapter of the JDL, advised that active members attend rifle practice every two weeks besides attending most of the other functions. It was mentioned that the JDL was establishing karate classes and will hold seminars at their new "ID" Center at 40th Street and New Utrecht Avenue, in Borough Park, Brooklyn. It was mentioned that the subject usually speaks at these seminars which are held to instruct the leadership.

Palpyo

In March, 1971, advised that the subject would hold a press conference at the "Isaiah Wall" on First Avenue, at the United Nations at 3:00 PM on March 10, 1971. At the same time, the JDL would hold a hunger strike at the same location in sympathy with the 150 Jews from the city of Riga, who are holding a hunger strike at the Kremlin, seeking permission to emigrate to Israel.

On March 2, 1971, furnished the following information:

a member of the member of the stated that the subject wants to have a demonstration simultaneously in Ottawa, Canada.

is a demonstration in Ottawa, and one in Washington, it would appear that we are not an international organization as we are not having demonstrations in Paris, London or Brussels. He stated that if the subject insists on a demonstration in Ottawa, he, will go along with the subject's wishes.

PSIPJO

In March, 1971, advised that on March 15, 1971, the subject was in Montreal, canada, where a fight broke out as someone apparently tried to disrupt his speech. According to the informant, the subject was in Washington, D. C. area, on March 16, 1971.

bac

On March 16, 1971, University of Maryland (UM) Campus rollce, advised that the subject was scheduled to speak on March 16, 1971, at UM, which speech was sponsored by Hillel and Associate Students for Israel at the University.

The March 17, 1971 issue of the "Diamondback", the UM college newspaper, on page one, carried an article captioned, "Never Again JDL Head Hits Oppression". According to this article, the subject in his speech defended the JDL activities centered mostly in New York City, against anti-semitic attacks. He also spoke concerning the problem on Soviet Jewry, and he also announced a rally to be held on March 21, 1971, on behalf of Soviet Jews.

Pyc

On March 17, 1971, supra, advised that he had attended the talk given by the subject on March 16, 1971. He said that the article appearing in the "Diamond-back" was correct as to the substance of the subject's talk.

PSIPUD

In March, 1971, and advised that the subject wants demonstrations to be held in Canada, on March 21, 1971. He does not want the Canadian people to come to Washington, but they should demonstrate in Canada.

The March 22, 1971 issue of the "Daily News", a daily newspaper published in New York, New York, on page five, contained an article captioned, "Grab 800 in Jewish Protest At D. C. Embassy." This article reflected that the subject was the first of the 800 persons arrested in Washington, on March 21, 1971, who were there protesting the treatment of Jews in Russia. They were arrested for blocking an intersection, a block from the Soviet Embassy. Those arrested were among some 2,500 persons who marched from an early demonstration near the White House. According to the article, KAHANE and other speakers at a rally had urged continued demonstrations and harassment of Soviets in the United States until all Jews who want to, are allowed to leave Russia, and those who stay, are no longer persecuted. According to the article, those arrested were to be charged with disorderly conduct and released in lieu of \$10 collateral.

On March 25, 1971, advised that the subject gave a lecture on March 24, 1971, at Pembroke College, Brown University, Providence, Rhode Island. The program began with a speech by JOSEF SCHNEIDER, a former Soviet Jew, who, through an interpreter, described his experiences in the Unionof Soviet Socialist Republica (USSR). At 8:30 PM, a bomb threat was telephoned to the University and the Brown University Security Forces requested the audience to evacuate the hall. The subject urged everyone not to leave and to ignore the request to vacate the hall since he did not believe in the authenticity of the University Security Forces. The subject then spoke on the JDL policy of opposing Soviet treatment of Soviet Jews

in the Soviet Union and the JDL policy was succeeding and that the Jewish spirit lived because of the Jewish fist.

He stated that Jews were now getting out of the USSR, not because of B'nai B'rith, but because Soviet buildings were bombed. At approximately 9:30 PM, five students of the Maoist Rhode Island Student Movement, began to disrupt the subject's speech. According to the informant, 10 JDL members advanced upon the Maoist students and a fist fight ensued with some injuries being sustained by the Maoist Student Group, who then were forcibly rejected from the hall.
