

X. z Kahane is the charismatic leader of the Jewish Defense League (JDL) which has emerged in the last two years as the most militant and terroristic pro-Jewish organization in the U.S. He exercises absolute leadership over the organization and our sources have revealed their opinion that he passes personally on plans for the terrorist activities carried ou by his organization directed against foreign diplomats of Soviet and Arab bloc countries and more recently against leftist and rightist organizations in the New York area. His place of residence is a well-guarded secret from other members of JDL and long-distance telephone traffic from his residence is considerable. Kahane has succeeded in keeping his place of residence unknown to the majority of even his closest lieutenants in JDL headquarters in New York where we have other sensitive coverage. Only through cooperation Long-distance toll calls charged to his residence in past months are well in excess of those normally attributed to the telephone traffic of a private residence and included calls to major cities in easiern and central U.S. New York Office has recommended tolephone surveillance be instituted and has noted such coverage is feasible and can be made with full security assured() 1 APR 15 1971 We have recently received information of Kahane's plans to lead a summer march on Washington which he hopes will equal the impact of the Poor Peoples' March on Washington in 1969, and requested coverage could provide essential and otherwise unobtainable information regarding (2) Enclosure 105-207795 SEE ADDENDUM PAGE 2. The coverage could additionally assist us in pinning down allegations of JDL involvement in acts of bombing and destruction received in the past in New York City and Washington, D.C. Kahane's frequent travel to other cities in U.S. for organizational purposes of JDL could also be revealed, assisting us to additionally learn identities of individuals outside New York City in whom we should have investigative. interest due to their JDL connections (**)

We currently have 35 telephone surveillances in operation with nine additional awaiting installation, including one for the General Invatigative Division. Approval of this coverage would not exceed our quota of 50. ()

DECOMMENDATION:

That telephone surveillance of the residence of Meir Kahane be approved. If approved, attached letter to Attorney General will be sent.

ADDENDUM OF W. B. SOYARS, JR.

This memorandum asks Attorney General approval for a new telephon surveillance on the residence of Rabbi Kahane, leader of the Jewish Defense League. It is recognized that such a surveillance would undoubtedly produce pertinent and valuable information for us; however, if Federal prosecution of Rabbi Kahane is taken at a later date, undoubtedly demand would be made and we would be forced to admit to this coverage. The Bureau would then be placed in the position of having to admit to a wiretap on a religious leader. In such case the news media would have a field day

The <u>Southwest Jewish Press Heritage</u> under date of April 2, 1971, Herb Brin, editor, carried the following editorial under the captioned title, Kahane:

"Rabbi Meir Kahane will speak 11 times in Los Angeles and San Diego on a five-day journey to the West.

"His group has opened headquarters on Fairfax Ave. (where a couple of years ago a few old men clobbered a bunch of Nazis who had come there to taunt Jews.)

"There are those who think that before Kahane there were no fighters for Jewish survival, that the struggle for Soviet Jewry wasn't an on-going passion until Mike King came along with his chain swingers and clubsters.

"Kahane can never say that he is not being given platform.

"Let him answer all the questions: his stand on Vietnam; his hanky-panky publicity organizations under assumed names; the bombings, and the filthy words hurled at wives of Russian diplomats—heroic deeds indeed.

"It might be well for our people to know that the struggle for Soviet Jewry does not begin nor end in a publicity nightmare cooked up by a Meir Kahane.

"And if a hero in the struggle does emerge, it will be a man or a woman or child in Russa who puts his name on the line and demands of the Kremlin oligarches: "Let my people go!"

On April 5, 1971, the morning edition of the San Dieco Union carried an article concerning the fact that 300 people marched on April 4, 1971 (Sunday) from downtown San Diego to Balboa Park demanding that the Soviet Union release Jews who wanted to emigrate to Israel. Jewish community leaders waited for the group at the park and messages of support were read from the local Roman Catholic Bishop and the Director of the San Diego Ecumenical Conference.

The April 6, 1971, morning edition of the <u>San Diego</u>
<u>Union</u> covered the appearance of Rabbi Meir Kahane at an airport news conference and also at the auditorium of Hoover High School the previous evening.

A San Diego source advised on April 6, 1971, that postcards were mailed out to members of the Jewish community announcing the appearance of Rabbi Meir, Director of the Jewish Defense League, on April 5, 1971 at the University of California at San Diego Auditorium and at Crawford High School auditorium. The postcard was sent by unidentified individuals who signed themselves "concerned citizens". Source attended the open meeting at Crawford High School auditorium where Rabbi Kahana delivered a speech after first denouncing the so called leaders of the San Diego Community for not going along with his thinking. He was poorly received by the approximately 500 people in attendance and failed to answer all questions from the floor. He was accompanied by approximately 20 - 30 young people from the Los Angeles area which included and Who were identified as Western coordinators of JDL. A local address for persons interested in JDL was furnished on a handbill as

a deep interest in Middle East afficies.

The NYO has noted that articles appearing in local press on 4/16/71 contain information that on 4/15/71 an explosion occurred at the Soviet Trade Delegation building in Amsterdam, Holland, and an American Jew (not identified) who had resided in Holland for a number of years, had been arrested in connection with this explosion. At the scene of the explosion, according to the press reports, a message was found, "Never Again! Let My People Go!"

It is noted that "Never Again" is the slogan of the JDL. It is also noted that disruption of relations, including trade; with the USSR is one of the aims of the JDL to force the USSR to release Soviet Jews who desire to immigrate to Israel.

On April 9, 1971, who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that Rabbi Meir Kahane, the leader of the Jewish Defense League (JDL) arrived in Los Angeles, California, on March 31, 1971, at Los Angeles International Airport via Trans World Airlines Flight 87. At the airport Kahane held a news conference and explained that he was in Los Angeles to conduct a series of speeches explaining the purposes of JDL and to enlist support for the organization.

Source learned that during Kahane's stay in Los Angeles he was staying at the Beverly Carlton Hotel, 9400 West Olympic Boulevard, Beverly Hills.

Source advised that at 9:00 p.m., March 31, 1971, Kahane spoke at Temple Stephen S. Wise, 15500 Stephen S. Wise Drive, Bel Air, California. Source stated that Kahane was the main speaker and spoke on the principles and philosophies of the JDL. He solicited funds and support for JDL and was well received by the approximately 700 persons who had paid a minimum of two dollars a seat.

Source stated that on April 1, 1971, at 11:00 a.m. Kahane spoke for nearly one hour in the free speech area at Los Angeles Valley Junior College, Van Nuys, California. Some 200 persons listened as he sought to explain the purposes of JDL At one point he was disrupted by a small group of agitators who raised clinched fists and shouted "power to the people". This group had little effect and Kahane kept full control of the audience. Source added that there were approximately 15 JDL people acting as guards for Kahane.

Source added that at 8:00 p.m. in the evening of April 1, 1971, Kahane addressed approximately 500 persons at Temple Akiba, 5249 South Sepulveda, Culver City, California. Source stated that Kahane outlined the principles and philosophies of JDL and was well received.

Source stated that at noon, April 2, 1971, Kahane spoke for two hours in the open forum area at San Fernando Valley State College to approximately 300 persons, again explaining JDL's purposes and soliciting membership and support. Source stated that Channel 28, KCET was present and provided television coverage.

Source continued that on April 3, 1971, at 8:15 p.m. Kahane addressed a receptive audience of approximately 700 persons at Temple Beth Jacob, 9030 West Olympic, Beverly Hills, California. He, as in other talks, explained the purposes of JDL and aksed for support.

Source stated that on April 4, 1971, at 10:00 p.m. Kahane again spoke as above to approximately 800 persons at Temple Leo Baeck, 1300 North Sepulveda, West Los Angeles.

He was well received and spoke of the purposes of JDL.

Source stated that on April 5, 1971, at 12 noon Kahane spoke at the Student Union Hall on the campus of the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA). Source said that Kahane spoke of the purposes and philosophies of JDL and was well received. At one point an agitator sought to disrupt the speech, but was put in his place when Kahane stated "Sit down Arab."

During his speech Kahane announced that JDL members would participate in a peaceful demonstration on behalf of the Soviet Jews at the May Company, 6067 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, at 12 noon on April 7, 1971.

Source stated that on April 7, 1971, approximately 25 representatives of JDL led by one who source described as the West Coast Coordinator of JDL, did in fact stage a sit-in at the above mentioned May Company, lasting approximately one and one half hours.

Source stated the main point of this demonstration was to protest against the May Company's arranging tours to the Soviet Union.

No arrests or violence attended this activity.

Source stated that Kahane traveled to San Diego during the late afternoon of April 5, 1971, and returned to Los Angeles late in the evening of April 6, 1971. Source added that Kahane departed for New York City, New York via air at 12:10 a.m. on April 7, 1971.



Activities

Special Agent (SA) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) advised that on March 17, 1971, Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE, JDL, was scheduled to lecture before members of the congregation of Temple Beth Shalon, East Mount Pleasant Avenue, Livingston, New Jersey. The lecture was scheduled for 8:15 PM; however, Rabbi KAHANE did not arrive until 9:05 PM. and started to speak at 9:10 PM. The audience consisted of approximately 450 people, mostly middle-aged. Rabbi KAHANE was apparently accompanied by four or five "security" men in their early 20's. A few of those "security" men arrived before he did. Rabbi KAHANE spoke in a calm, precise manner, presenting a pleasant and neat appearance.

He recounted a brief history of the Jews in the United States and throughout the world since World War II, and attempted to described how Jews have been content to receive the sympathy and consolation of the world rather than obtain definite results. Drawing a parallel to the Negro problem in the United States and their militant measures initiated to obtain equality, he stated that Jews have now started to take similar measures. He indicated that for many years Jews have been willing to accept verbal consolation and compassion with very little results. Referring to the recent militant action of the JDL, Rabbi KAHANE indicated that this was the reason more Soviet Jews were allowed to leave Russia, in recent weeks than ever before. He felt it was about time Jews received their priority.

He maintained that, "If one comes to slay you, slay him first". He indicated that the JDL gives young Jews a cause and a reason to want to be Jewish. He thought the present leaders of Russia were weak and that through internal pressure within Russia, and by the action of Jews outside of Russia, that country could be forced to permit Soviet Jews to leave Russia for Israel.

Rabbi KAHANE said, "There is nothing wrong with violence if there is no other way for a Jew. to live." He maintained, however, that violence should not be used if the change desired could be obtained in a nonviolent form. He advised that next Sunday, on March 21, 1971, there would be a march on Washington, D. C., to draw attention to the plight of Soviet Jewry. Rabbi KAHANE claimed that in New York, the JDL is frequently contacted by Jews in various sections of New York City when protection is needed because of intimidation by other groups. He advocated that Jews should demonstrate for anti-racism and felt that Jewish organizations should initiate legal maneuvers to obtain objectives.

When the lecture was terminated, Rabbi KAHANE conducted a question and answer period. Many of the individuals asking questions indicated they agreed with many of his aims but were against violence. He said he advocated certain measures to help pressure Russia into permitting Jews to leave for Israel. These measures included demonstrations, boycotting Russian goods, and all business with Russia. Also, he stated that all types of exchange, such as cultural, scientific, economic, progress, etc., with the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR) should be terminated. He stated the JDL hoped to obtain the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all Russian officials in the United States and harass them through telephone calls and by following them, hoping by these means to pressurize their government into releasing Soviet Jews.

The Rabbi terminated his lecture by stating that his organization was small but determined and that they were looking for new members. He said the JDL had a few non-Jews in the organization and welcomed them for members. The JDL, he stated, was definitely a nonpolitical organization and did not care whether a member was leftist or rightist, as long as he was interested in the goals of the JDL.

On page 26 of the April 13, 1971 issue of the "Daily News", there appeared an article captioned, "JDL IN BATTLE ON MUGGERS". This article reflected that the subject spoke to 300 persons in the auditorium of Public School 103 in Boro Park, Brooklyn, New York. The article advised that plans to post nightly patrols to cut down on muggings in Boro Park, were launched by the JDL at the urging of the subject. After his talk, the subject led a march to the Boro Park Station House where: 300 JDL supporters were kept behind barracades and the subject was invited inside where he announced his plans to police officials. Upon emerging, the subject stated the police would work with the JDL patrols.

In April, 1971, advised that the subject was scheduled to speak on April 14, 1971, at Wayne State University and later at the University of Michigan, at 8:00 PM.

The April 19, 1971 issue on page 3 of the "Daily News", contained an article captioned, "BOMB RIPS TEMPLE EXPECTING KAHANE". According to this article, a bomb ripped through the Jewish Center of West Orange, New Jersey, early yesterday. While police were trying to determine a motive for the blast, it was determined that Rabbi MEIR D. KAHANE, head of the JDL in New York, was scheduled to address the Men's Club at 8:00 o'clock last night. Because of the blast, the speech was cancelled. It was also reported there was a large demand for tickets for KAHANE's talk and that emotions were running high over his appearance.

On page M-l of the April 21, 1971 issue of the "Daily News", there appeared an article captioned "THREE COPS FELLED; SEIZE: KAHANE AND SIX MARCHERS". This article stated that the police seized militant Rabbi MEIR KAHANE

and six other men last night after three cops were bowled over at a demonstration in front of the head-quarters of the Iraqui Mission to the United Nations.

According to the article, before his arrest, the subject had told a "mass rally on behalf of the Iraqui Jewry" that the JDL would employ the tactics it has used to harassed Russian diplomats against Iraqui diplomats beginning next week.

In April, 1971, advised that the subject was scheduled to speak on April 27, in Columbus, Ohio, which was arranged through a (Phonetic), presumably of Columbus, at Toledo, Ohio, on the evening of April 28, 1971, and at the University of Illinois on May 6, 1971.

Miscellaneous

In April, 1971, and advised that the subject was involved in a car accident on April 18, 1971, and the front of the car he was driving, which was a 1970 green Rambler, was pushed in and the car will have to be towed. The automobile is at 75th Avenue between 112th and 113th Streets, Queens, New York. The source also advised that the car which the subject was riding was a leased car which was leased in the name of Jewish Organization for Youth.

The Jewish Organization For Youth is a tax exempt foundation affiliated with the JDL.





This speech was sponsored by the Collingwood Avenue Temple Brotherhood as part of a semi-annual lecture series provided by Mr. and Mrs. ALFRED CILLSTEIN. Questions asked of MEIR KAHANE after his speech appeared to be pre-arranged so that no controversial subjects would arise

"The Blade", a daily Toledo, Ohio newspaper of general circulation, published an article in the April 29, 1971 issue entitled "Violence Can Be Helpful, JDL Founder Contends." In this article, MEIR KAHANE stated in part that "violence is always bad but sometimes necessary".

Rabbi KAHANE said the JDL had not been involved in several bombing incidents "however, we have applauded enthusiastically those who have". Rabbi KAHANE asserted that moderate Jews could not get planeloads of Jews out of Russia until now and that the difference has been JDL action.

Rabbi KAHANE said the JDL is not "respectable" that "respectability is the last refuge of frightened people". contended that too many Jews have gauged their actions on CONFIDENTIAL

On April 27, 1971, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, as well as a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, were in attendance at a public appearance by Rabbi Meir Kahane at Beth Jacob Synagogue, 1223 College Avenue, Columbus, Ohio, sponsored by Beth Jacob Brotherhood.

The audience was estimated at approximately 700 persons, and Kahane spoke from approximately 9:20 P.M. to 11:00 P.M.

The confidential source and the Special Agent of the FBI ascertained the following:

The evening program commenced with the playing of the National Anthem.

The speakers were introduced by Rabbi David Stavsky of the Beth Jacob Synagogue. Leonard Quinn was introduced as President of Beth Jacob Brotherhood. Bernard Polloch, an Ohio State University student, spoke briefly regarding the mezuzah as a symbol of Jewish identity and defiance of oppression. Ben Greenblatt, identified as a former inmate of a concentration camp, talked about his treatment in the concentration camp while a ceremony involving lighting memorial candles in commemoration of six million Jews, who died in concentration camps, was undertake

Following that introductory program, Rabbi Meir Kahane, the leader of the Jewish Defense League (JDL), delivered his speech.

Kahane indicated that during World War II, President Franklin D. Roosevelt, Jr. was aware of the extermination of

Jews in concentration camps, but his response to requests by American Jewish leaders to bomb rail lines leading to Auschwitz was sympathy, not action. The President's statements were taken at face value, but if Jews had chained themselves to the White House then, Jewish lives would have been saved.

For 47 years, according to Kahane, the world has ignored the plight of the Soviet Jew, but because of the actions of the Jewish Defense League (JDL), the problem was made front page news and everyone was aware of the problem. President Nixon is not interested in Jewish problems, but because of JDL actions, the Government is worried. Kahane stated that violence is evil, but it is sometimes necessary. Kahane also stated that a Jewish spirit survives because of a Jewish fist.

Jews need to be loved, according to Kahane, but when Israel attacked the Beriut Airport and destroyed a few planes, they lost the sympathy of the world. Kahane stated that Jews do not need sympathy, they need to live. Jews need to achieve self respect, but one does not get it by asking for it.

As much as possible must be done for the Soviet Jews, who have cried out for help for 54 years. The American Jewish Leadership is bankrupt since all they are worried about is their own positions in society. As soon as the bomb went off at the Russian Airline Office in New York City, Jewish leaders ran to Washington, D. C. and told Government leaders to get the JDL people if they were responsible.

Kahane stated that he speaks on four to five campuses a week, and he sees Jews changing from the radical left to the radical Jew. These young Jews finally have a cause to fight for themselves.

The JDL wants to instill two things:

- 1. Love of Jews.
- 2. Jewish pride.

In the 1920's, a Jew spoke to Jewish youth and said, "If you are being beaten, hit back - if you are being shot at

shoot back." This is the type of pride Jews need in this country.

Jewish education must take prededence over everything and Jewish money must be spent for this purpose.

Jewish identity centers must be created on the campuses of the United States.

In 1953, the death of Stalin saved hundreds of thousands of Jews from death in Siberia, but who is to say that the Russian leaders would not try to do this again. Soviet Jews would not wait for us; they are desperate.

Kahane stated that he recently traveled to a world Jewish conference in Brussels, Belgium, not to disrupt the conference, but Kahane knew they were not going to do anything about the Soviet Jews; thus he made his statement.

Kahane stated that the following actions are necessary against the Soviets:

- 1.. Embargo and boycott of Soviet products.
- 2. Ban travel to Russia.
- i. Step cultural exchange program since Soviets use this for propaganda purposes.
- 4. Boycott of firms who deal with Russia.
- 5. Begin campaigning to ban USSR from participating in olympics.
- 6. Legal harassment of Soviet diplomats, such as recent 100 phone calls each day to five Soviet diplomats homes, whose private numbers were obtained by JDL.

Kahane stated that the world would not give a damn about the Soviet Jews, until it becomes a world problem.

The JDL must organize non-violent civil disobedience. Jews went to Selma, Alabama and everywhere else to help the Negro and others, but when the Jew had a demonstration in

Washington, D. C., it was 1300 Jews arrested for sitting in the street. Only Jews will fight for other Jews; thus we must have a non-violent show of togetherness.

Kahane stated that the JDL is opposed to bombing.

Following Kahane's speech, he answered a few questions from the audience. Kahane responded to a question as to whether JDL was opposed to bombings entirely. Kahane stated that the JDL does not bomb places, but when the only way the world listens is when you do something like bombing, then the JDL will back that means.

Kahane responded to a question about how sit downs help the Soviet Jews by saying that every action helps to awaken the conscience of the world.

Kahane stated that young Jews find "right on" Jewishness in the JDL, something they have been seeking.

In the past 15 months, there have been 44 JDL chapters formed on 44 different campuses. Kahane stated that the Berkley California campus accepted the JDL and a recent speech drew 1500 people to see Kahane.

On April 19, 1971, as Special Agent of the FBI obtained a leaflet announcing the speech by Rabbi Meir Kahane, which leaflet was available to the general public in the Ohio Union Building, Ohio State University.

"Sometimes · the Jewish spirit survives because of a Jewish fist," he said. As the Jewish Bible says, 'There is a time for war and a time for peace.'"

Time for peace past

Rabbi Kahane believes the time for peace is past.

On 5/6/71, the subject was the main speaker at a meeting sponsored by the Yewish Liberation Organi zation on the campus of the University of Illinois, Chicago Circle Camous (UICC).

advised that approximately On 5/18/71, 150 persons attended this rally and that KAHANE gave his usual JDL speech concerning the apathy of the main population including the "Jewish Establishment" toward those Jews who are "struggling to be themselves." He stated that the Jewish extablishment was afraid to become involved in the support of anything or anyone which might hurt their image. The prognosis for the future was presented as "bleak" due to the current economic situation and the unwillingness of both Jew and non-jew to become involved with an unpopular cause. KAHANE stated that "violence is an evil thing, yet at times it is an abomination not to use violence." Examples of several biblical heros were presented to illustrate this point. The speech ended with a pitch to start a JDL chapter on the UICC campus.

The source was unable to provide any further information concerning this appearance.

This investigation is continuing in Chicago. Further appearances of the subject in the Chicago area will be reported as they occur.



Rabbi Meir D. Kahane continues to function as National Director of the Jewish Defense League (JDL) with headquarters at New York City, New York.

> The JDL, founded in 1968, is composed primarily of young Jewish militants who consider themselves defenders of "Jewish Rights". Demonstrations attempting to dramatize the Jewish problem in Russia and similar demonstrations against Arab establishments have often resulted in violence. Rabbi Meir Kahane, founder and National Director, has stated publicly on many occasions that violence is sometimes necessary to accomplish the aims of the JDL.

The following local prosecutive matters are pending against Kahane as a result of his activities in connection with the JDL. since April 8, 1971.

- 1) Disorderly Conduct arrest as the result of the sitdown demonstration on the evening of June 10, 1971, in the vicinity of the Soviet Mission to the United Nations, Third Avenue and 67th Street, New York City. It should be noted that the arrest of Kahane and over a hundred others on this occasion was pursuant to arrangements previously made between the JDL and the Police Department that persons wishing to be arrested would sit briefly in the street and thereafter be arrested for Disorderly Conduct only. There has been no disposition of this charge.
- 2) On the evening of April 21, 1971, Kahane and approximate: 100 JDL supporters demonstrated in the vicinity of the Iraqi Mission to the United Nations, 14 East 79th Street, New York City. In the course of this demonstration, in defiance of a Police order, Kahane and others attempted to break Police barricades and storm the Mission

Kahane thereupon was arrested and charged with Rioting, Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest. These charges, under Docket number B 10809/71 are pending in Criminal Court, Manhattan and presently scheduled for trial on June 23, 1971.

Kahane and twelve others are presently under indictment in Federal Court for the Eastern District of New York, charged with violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922 and 924 and Title 36, Sections 5861 and 5871 arising out of the illegal possession of certain firearms. Kahane is presently at liberty under \$25,000 bon with trial set down for July 6, 1971.

On June 11, 1971, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that Larry Fine, Executive Director of the Jewish Defense League (JDL) at New York City, engaged in a conversation with an individual known to this source only as (last name unknown) (LNU).

Under discussion on this occasion were the events of the evening of June 10, 1971, at which time the JDL, under the direction of Meir Kahane, held a meeting at the auditorium of Hunter College at Lexington Avenue and 68th Street, New York City. Thereafter, there followed a brief demonstration at the Iraqi Mission to the United Nations (UN) and the Soviet Mission to the UN. At the latter demonstration, approximately 130 JDL members or sympathizers were arrested for disorderly conduct.

It should be noted that on June 10, 1971, this same confidential source advised, even prior to the demonstrations mentione above, Rabbi Meir Kahane had worked out a deal with the Police Department of New York City under which JDL demonstrators would be arrested for sitting down in the street and charged only with disorderly conduct. This arrangement, arrived at following a conference with a police official and advance notification to the police, made it possible for the JDL demonstrators to avoid a charge of conspiracy and to assure that there would be no violence. Charges against the demonstrators, according to the source, were limited under this agreement, as mentioned above, merely to disorderly conduct. It should be noted that this is the first such arrangement attempted by the JDL in connection with any of its demonstrations at New York City.

The confidential source advised that discussing the Hunter College meeting of June 10, 1971, stated that Rabbi Kahane's speech on that occasion "was terrible, the worst he has ever made anywhere". (LNU), with whom he was speaking, characterized Kahane's speech as rambling and disjointed in every respect. It stated he had never heard the Rabbi so absolutely disgusted with anything, and replied that Kahane had good reason to be disgusted with the turnout. noted that the turnout of only about 300 individuals "was lousy" and much below the expected audience.

that many people are getting used to the Russian trials and just cannot be moved. He further noted that the small turnout and interest was commented upon on the Channel 2 news program, and that the JDL certainly does not need that kind of publicity. Also stated that Kahane is at a very low ebb and feels that the leadersh of the JDL is completely lacking. Volunteered the opinion that the entire blame should be placed on the chapter chairmen as they are "not worth a ... (vulgarity)". Was in agreement on this point. Stated that everyone of the chapter chairmen were told time and time again to get the membership out for the meeting but failed as usual.

According to the confidential source, stated that the Italian-American Civil Rights League (IACRL) had agreed to exist the JDL in any event. According to the IACRL would be undertaking certain printings free of charge, as well as the preparation of literature and press releases. Stated that he still did not like the tie-in with the IACRL, to which replied that the only thing the JDL was giving to the IACRL in return is a respectful image. Was in disagreement on this point, and commented that some day the JDL will have to pay a price - a large price - for this affiliation. 
MEIR D. KAHANE

A source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on June 10, 1971, that Rabbi Meir D. Kahane, Head of the Jewish Defense League (JDL), was to speak at the Temple in West Orange, New Jersey, on Sunday evening, June 13, 1971.

The JDL, founded in 1968, is composed primarily of young Jewish militants who consider themselves as defenders of "Jewish Rights." Demonstrations attempting to dramatize the Jewish problem in Russia and similar demonstrations against Arab establishments have often resulted in violence. Rabbi Meir D. Kahane, founder and National Director, has stated publicly on many occasions that violence is sometimes necessary to accomplish the aims of the JDL.

On June 14, 1971, West Orange, West Orange, New Jersey, Police Department, advised that Rabbi Kahane was the principal speaker at the West Orange Jewish Center, 300 Pleasant Valley Way, West Orange, on June 13, 1971. The Men's Club of the West Orange Jewish Center sponsored Kahane's appearance.

Rabbi Kahane was scheduled to appear at the West Orange Jewish Center on Sunday evening, April 18, 1971. During the early morning of April 18, 1971, the West Orange Jewish Center was extensively damaged as a result of a bomb explosion. No information concerning suspects has been developed by the West Orange Police with respect to this explosion to date.

advised there was indecision on the part of the Men's Club of the West Orange Jewish Center with regard to again inviting Kahane as a speaker and they decided in favor of it since they had previously committed themselves. They agreed to Kahane's appearance on June 13, 1971, but under the condition that this would not receive any publicity. The West Orange Pelice agreed to offer coverage of the Center on June 13. Only four hundred persons would be permitted in the audience.

said that the West Orange Police had approximately 45 police officers inside and outside of the West Orange Jewish Center on the evening of June 13, 1971.

Police Department, advised he was inside the Jewish Center during the aforementioned appearance of Rabbi Kahane. Only 400 persons were permitted in the audience and a number of persons were turned away at the door.

Kahane appeared at about 9:00 PM, escorted by several young persons dressed in green uniforms and all wearing the Star of David. These youths handed out JDL literature.

The entrance fee was \$7.50 per person.

Rabbi Kahane spoke for about two hours, which included a question-answer period. Although Kahane received some intermittent applause, the audience generally was not enthusiastic. During the question and answer period, a number of persons left. Kahane pleaded with these persons to hear him out. There were times during the evening when Kahane was jeered by members of the audience.

During the evening, Kahane sought new membership and asked those interested to register at the tables in the rear of the room.

Observed very few persons approach these tables at the evening's end.

Kahane mentioned that he obtains his finances primarily from membership dues and donations. He indicated he would accept support from any source who came to his aid. He praised Joseph Colombo, reported New York Mafia leader, for coming to his aid, and in the same breath denounced the Rabbis and the wealthy Jews, such as those who live in the plush suburbs of West Orange, who offerred him no support. He related that the wealthy Jews should help their own people such as the poor Jews in the Brownsville section of Brooklyn, New York. He mentioned that these same wealthy Jews will support other causes, many of which are non-Jewish, rather than to offer support to the poor Jews, or to offer his support.

He criticized those Jews who felt they should avoid becoming involved in wrong acts, stating that you cannot operate like that today. He said today you must draw public attention or fade away. He cited the Negro revolution and methods applied by Negroes to draw attention and get things done.

He criticized the wealthy West Orange Jew who wants the poor Jews in Brownsville to integrate with the Negroes in their schools and neighborhoods, but who reside in all white areas and whose children go to all white schools. According to remarks such as these did not hold much appeal for those in the audience.

Kahane dwelled on World War II and the fact that the Jews did not stand up for their rights against the Nazis. He criticized the Jews in other countries, particularly those in leadership for not coming to the aid of the depressed Jews in Germany. He criticized former President Roosevelt for not permitting the immigration to the United States of some 900 Jews who escaped Nazi Germany and who had to remain in Europe.

He made reference to his day camp for the youth. He said the best thing a Jewish parent could do would be to send his or her child to this camp where the youth would get the best training and education possible. He indicated they would come out better persons.

He said that after he is cleared of his criminal charge in New York City, he will live six months in Israel and six months in the United States. He remarked that every Jew should live in Israel.

He stated that non-Jews hate Jews and that the Jew should in turn hate the non-Jews. He does not believe in interfaith relations.

The above remarks did not appeal to the audience.

He said that Jews are highly intelligent and could do anything they desired. He wanted the Jews to stand up for themselves and fight for one another. He cited the JDL efforts against the Soviets in the United States as an example. He said that although he does not take credit for the JDL being responsible for the emigration of many Jews from the Soviet Union in the recent past, that their efforts undoubtedly helped their situation.

He commented that "If one comes to slay you, slay him first".

> During the course of a surveillance of MEIR KAHANE, National Leader, JDL, and two other individuals on the evening of 6/24/71, the operator of the vehicle in which KAHANE was traveling made a complaint to a representative of the Metropolitan Police Department. In substance, the driver,

claimed that the occupants of a Bureau car were Special Agents of the FBI who had pulled the driver from his automobile and struck him in the face. requested the police officer to arrest the occupants of the Bureau car who were in the proximity. was informed that the alleged offense was a misdemeanor, not subject to arrest unless committed in the officer's. presence or the subject of a complaint filed before the United States Attorney's Office.

The above was obtained from following a conversation between the driver of the vehicle in question and the officer at 16th and Q Streets, NW, at 11:10 PM. SAs who were in the process of conducting a surveillance of KAHANE, informed the police officer that the allegations were completely false. Officer determined that, in addition to Jewish Telegraph Agency, National Press Bulluing, was an occupant in the car.





The moving surveillance was reinstituted when KAHANE, et al, returned to downtown DC shortly before 11:00 PM.

The foregoing information is submitted to Bureau and interested offices to indicate the instability and mental conditions of KAHANE and Conduct of WFO Agents was proper in every respect and our investigation is continuing in order to discharge our responsibilities, particularly obtaining information on a timely basis concerning the extremism of JDL types.



Meir D. Kahane Internal Security - Nationalistic Tendencies -Jewish Defense League (JDL)

On August 19, 1971, a confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that he had ascertained that Meir Kahane, head of the Jewish Defense League (JDL), plans to travel to Israel in the near future in furtherance of the program of the JDL.

The JDL, founded in 1968, is composed primarily of young Jewish militants who consider themselves defenders of "Jewish Rights". Demonstrations attempting to dramatize the Jewish problem in Russia, and similar demonstrations against Arab establishments have often resulted in violence. Rabbi Meir Kahane, founder and National Director, has stated publicly on many occasions that violence is sometimes necessary to accomplish the aims of JDL.

According to the confidential source, at the present time Kahane is planning to depart the United States September 12, 1971, most probably aboard an El Al Airlines flight for Israel. Kahane intends to be in Israel for the commencement of the High Holy Days on September 20, 1971.

The source advised that it is Kahane's intention to remain in Israel for a period of one month or more, but that at the present time Kahane has no intention of remaining in Israel permanently, since he feels that his permanent settlement in Israel would lead to a decline in the JDL program

#### Kahane Threatens Russians Will Die If Prisoner Does

Special to The New York Times JERUSALEM Sept. 27 Rabbi Meir Kahane, leader of the militant Jewish Defense League, asserted here today that Jewish militants would kill two Soviet diplomates somewhere if Miss Silva Zalmanson died in a Soviet labor camp.

A Soviet court sentenced A Soviet court sentenced Miss Zalmanson last year to 10 years' imprisonment for participation in a plot to hijack a Soviet airliner. She is the wife of Eduard S. Kuznetson, one of two Jews sentenced to death in a Leningrad trial in connection with the plot. His sentence was commuted to a 15-year prison-camp term.

Miss Zalmanson's uncle, Avraham Zalmanson of Bat Yam, Israel, told newsmen that she had contracted tuberculosis and developed ulcers in prison

ind was dangerously ill.

"If anything happens to
Silva Zalmanson or another
Jew," Rabbi Kahane said at a news conference, "Soviet diplomats throughout the world will be open targets for Jewish militants." He recalled a slogan, "two Soviets for every jew." adopted by the Jewish Defense League when it was harassing Soviet diplomat in the United States, and said the militants intended to carry it out if necessary

Rabbi Kahane said he himself was not urging Jewish militants to take action because he was under a suspended fiveyear sentence in the United States for illegal possession of firearms and explosives. The court ordered him to refrain

from acts of violence.

The rabbi, who arrived in Israel last week as a settler, said he would not do anything that could embarrass Israel. He said he would spend some monoths abroad directing Jewish Defense League Affairs.

Rabbi Kahane, who is Orthodox, founded the league for self-defense, in 1968 in the wake of reported attacks on Jewish residents and storekeepers in the Crown Heights section of Brooklyn.

The league has demanded that the Soviet Government permit Jews to emigrate freely to Israel. Rabbi Kahana was arrested during the learning
