

Meyer Lansky, FBI No. 791783, was born 7/4/02, Grodno, Poland.



Lansky reputed to be one of top hoodlums in country and held such position since prohibition days. Has been closely associated with other notorious hoodlums, such as late Benjamin "Bugsy" Siegel, Charlie "Lucky" Luciano, Joe Adonis, Abner "Longie" Zwillman, the late Charles Fischetti, Santo Trafficante, and others. He has been connected with numerous so-called legitimate enterprises.

Lansky now spending most of time in Havana, Cuba, where he has interests in gambling enterprises concerning which the extent of his holdings have been variable.  he has been connected with race track and gambling casino operations in Havana since at least 1938. He may have considerable political influence as indicated by fact was able to obtain appointment for son, Paul, to U.S. military academy.

In view of fact Lansky is alleged to have participated in or ordered killing of several other hoodlums in past, he should always be considered as possibly armed and dangerous.

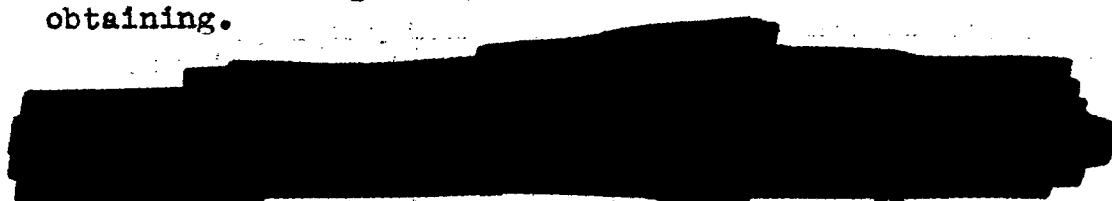

A. PERSONAL HISTORY AND BACKGROUND

MEYER LANSKY was born on July 4, 1902, at Grodno, Poland, according to the files of the Immigration and Naturalization Service and arrived in the United States on April 4, 1911. He was naturalized on September 27, 1928, in the Eastern District of New York, and is presently a United States citizen although the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York is still attempting to deport him.

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The "New York Times" for August 16, 1951, carried a news item wherein Representative ARTHUR G. KLEIN from the House of Representatives and representing New York City, admitted that he obtained a West Point appointment for PAUL LANSKY, son of MEYER LANSKY. The article reflected that KLEIN stated he got the appointment for PAUL LANSKY in 1949, and that he had been informed that LANSKY had been making excellent grades in West Point.

LANSKY also has a son, BENJAMIN, also known as "Buddy", who is approximately 28 years old and a daughter, SANDRA, age about 20, who is married to MARVIN RAPOPORT, co-owner of the Spindletop Restaurant.

DOROTHY KILGALLEN, in the "New York Journal American" for January 11, 1957, in reporting the above, advised that SANDRA was then separated from her husband.

The records of the Bureau of Criminal Identification and the Bureau of Special Services of the New York City Police Department were reviewed, and it was learned that all records prior to June of 1936, have been destroyed by that Department for records other than fingerprint cards and the bare records of the arrest as set forth in the aforementioned criminal record.

The records of the New York State Division of Parole, 320 Broadway, New York City, were reviewed by [redacted] on December 12, 1956, and he advised there is no record of LANSKY in those files.

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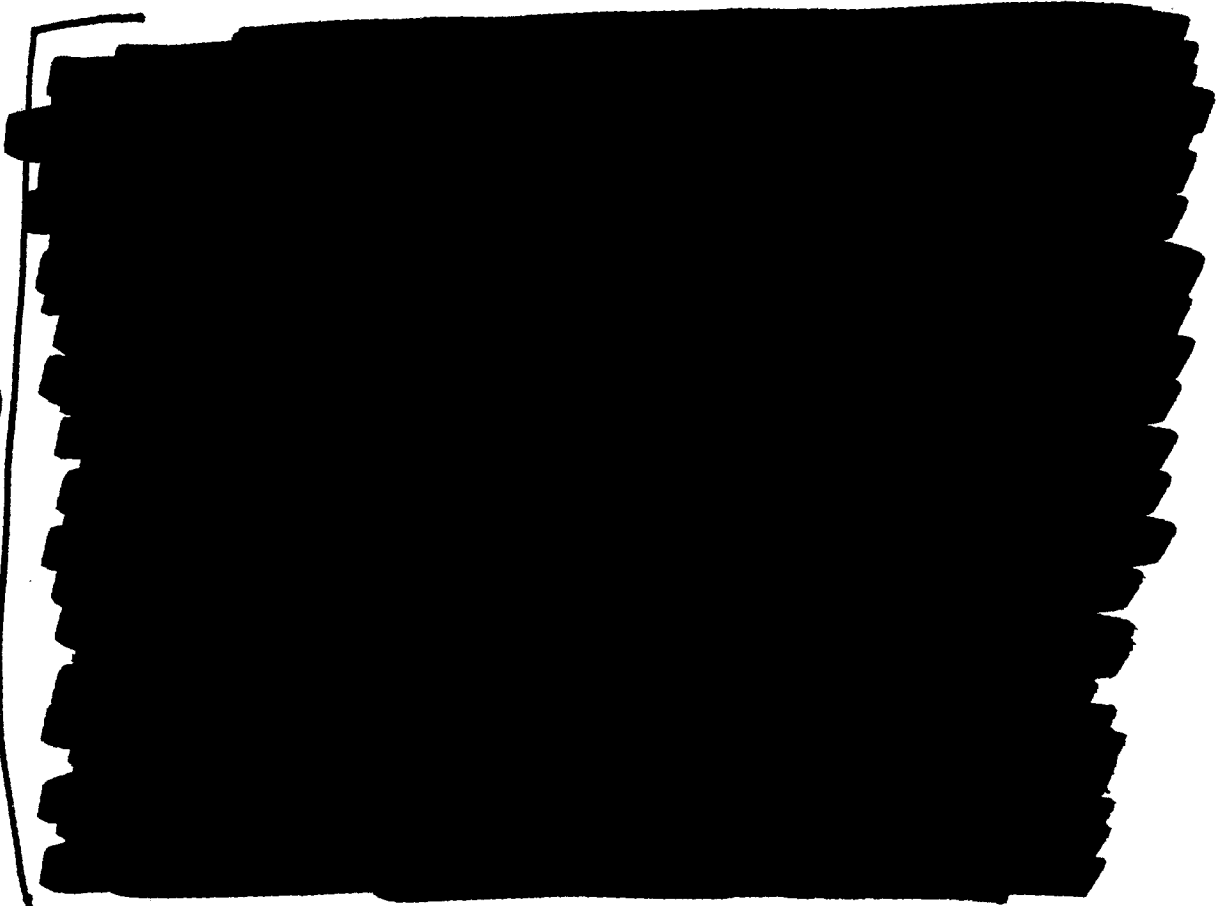

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As a result of testimony given at public hearings of the so-called Kefauver Committee in Miami during May and July of 1950, Sheriff WALTER CLARK of Broward County, Florida, was removed from office by Governor FULLER WARREN and his successor was AMOS HALL. As a result of these hearings, the grand jury for that county undertook an investigation of gambling activities and indicted 22 persons for violation of the statute.

The Grand Jury found that the Colonial Inn was the largest and most successful gambling casino that Broward County has ever had and in scope of operation it is said to compare with or exceed any gambling establishment known. The club was operated by the same LANSKY group which has also operated Club Green Acres with a few additions. Principal new partners in the current operation were MERT WERTHEIMER and RUBY MATHIS, of Detroit, HENRY RENO, of the "Miami Herald," has listed the principal new partners of this operation as FRANK COSTELLO, JOE ADONIS, FRANK ERICKSON, JACK and MEYER LANSKY, BUGS SIEGEL, JOE MASSEY, LEFTY CLARK, MERT WERTHEIMER, WILLIE MORETTI, and a man named DERNSTEIN from Detroit. One BURT BRIGGS and other lesser employees have claimed an interest in this place

LANSKY and WERTHEIMER were the actual operators of the club. An elaborate floor show was presented which WERTHEIMER alleged cost \$40,000.00 to costume and which featured such stars as HARRY RICHMAN, BERT WHEELER, JANE FROMAN, JOE E. LEWIS, CARMEN MIRANDA, and XAVIER CUGAT.

The New York "World Telegram" of February 17, 1953, under a Ballston Spa dateline, carried an article, announcing that the Russian-born MEYER LANSKY, big-time gambler, former bootlegger and associate of deported vice czar, CHARLES "LUCKY" LUCIANO, pleaded guilty in Supreme Court to five misdemeanor charges of conspiracy and gambling.

At the time of his arrest, the associates indicted with him were JOSEPH STACHER, alias DOC STACHER; JAMES LYNCH, alias PIGGY; HERMAN WEINER, GEORGE BROWN, CHARLES MANNEY, and JOHN COAKLEY. LANSKY'S attorney, MOSES POLAKOFF, surrendered LANSKY to the New York State Police on September 10, 1952, and February 18, 1953.

LANSKY pleaded guilty to five counts, all of which were misdemeanors, on May 2, 1953, he was sentenced to serve 40 days in the Saratoga County Jail and fined \$2,500. He was also placed on three years probation. During his incarceration, he was treated for a kidney infection in the Saratoga Hospital in July, 1953.

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On October 12, 1950, LANSKY appeared before the Senate Crime Investigation Sub-Committee, accompanied by his counsel MOSES POLAKOFF. He admitted associating with FRANK COSTELLO, JOE ADONIS, FRANK ERICKSON, and CHARLES FISCHETTI, but refused to elaborate on this association. He admitted travelling to Italy in 1949, but refused to admit whether or not he had contacted LUKY LUCIANO.

On September 15, 1952, DREW PEARSON in his syndicated column stated that FRANK COSTELLO had not been deported because he had friends in high places. He stated that COSTELLO'S lobbying tactics included the entertaining of Congressmen at various dinners and parties, and that MURRAY OLF, a former prison mate of GREASY JAKE GUZIK occupied a suite at the Congressional Hotel where he held court for Congressmen. In addition the nations top mobsters were alleged to use his apartment overnight and LANSKY utilized the hotel garage and charged his bill to OLF'S account.

The "New York Daily News" for December 2, 1954, reflected that LANSKY was with ADNER "LONGY" ZWILLMAN, EDDIE MC GRATH, ALBERT ANASTASIA, CORNELIUS "CONNIE" NOONAN, and others at the Riviera Motel in Fort Lee, New Jersey, to discuss current problems along the New York, New Jersey waterfront.

Senate Crime Investigating Committee. He testified that he had conducted an investigation of gambling places in Saratoga, New York, in 1947, and found that gambling was "wide open." He added that he had submitted a report concerning these conditions to his superiors. However, the report was not discussed with him afterward.

He then described some of the gambling equipment and gambling places in Saratoga. He described the Piping Rock Club, as one of the "plush places" which could not be patronized by the ordinary individual who desired to gamble.

He admitted that he had heard from various sources that MEYER LANSKY had an interest in the Piping Rock Club, but denied that he had ever heard that COSTELLO had any interest in the club. He also stated that he had heard through confidential sources that in 1947 JOE ADONIS and MEYER LANSKY did have interests in the Arrowhead Inn.

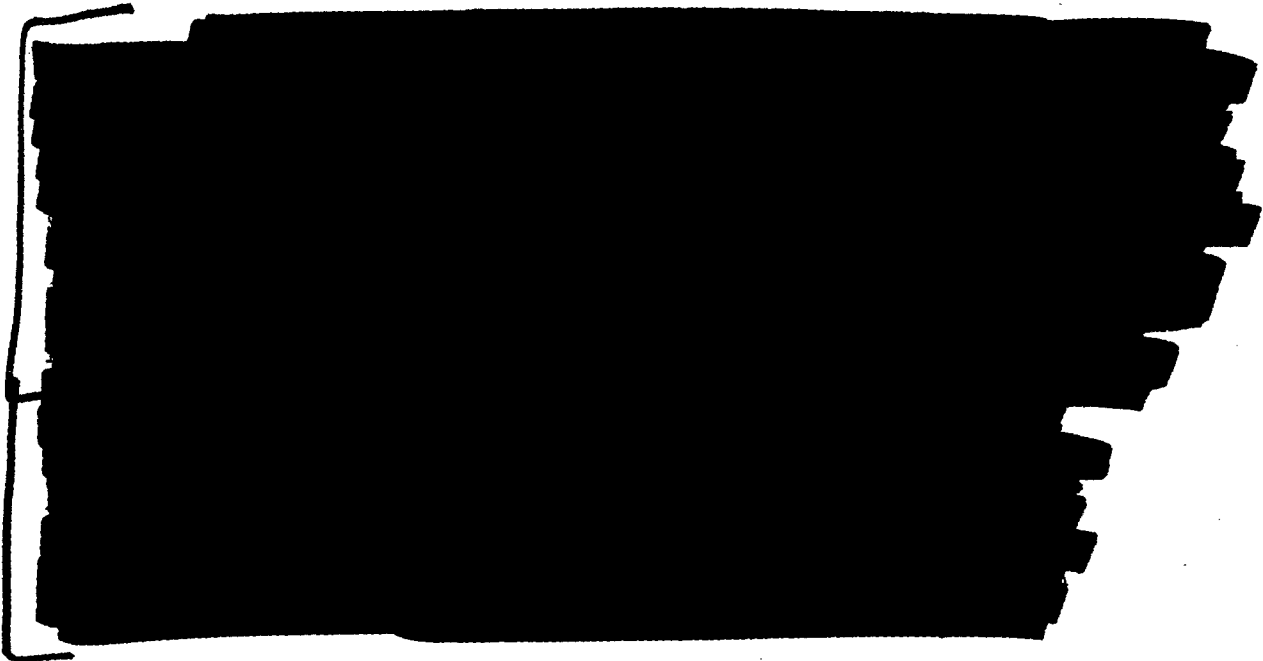

Information in rerep regarding the immigration to this country of Lansky and his family was obtained from the INS file. All of this information should be verified and complete details obtained. Verification should be obtained from an actual examination of the entry and court records of each step of the naturalization process.

CRIMINAL RECORD

It is noted that rerep sets forth items contained in local law enforcement agency records concerning Lansky which do not appear in the FBI identification record. All such items should be submitted to the Identification Division so that the records there on this top hoodlum will be complete. *77*

LEGITIMATE ENTERPRISES

Numerous so-called legitimate enterprises which Lansky has been engaged in the past are set forth in rerep. Records and persons connected with these enterprises may form the basis for investigation which will lead to present and past illegal activities on the part of Lansky. As you are aware, successful hoodlums, such as Lansky, carry on their associations as clandestinely as possible and conduct all of their illegal activities in a surreptitious manner. Therefore, it is often necessary to begin a probative type of investigation from a starting point which at first glance appears to be remote, both as to time and place. An example of the value

The file reflected that LANSKY applied for a Passport on June 10, 1949 in New York City, New York, and was issued Passport Number 104123, on June 15, 1949. He indicated he wanted to depart from New York City on June 28 for a two months' pleasure trip to Italy, France, Switzerland, and Belgium. LANSKY indicated his date of birth was July 4, 1902 at Grodno, Poland. He came to the United States on April 11, 1908 and lived from then until 1949 in New York City. He indicated that on September 27, 1928, he became a United States citizen receiving Certificate of Naturalization Number 2517814. His permanent residence was 40 Central Park South, New York City; The application reflected that LANSKY's father was MAX LANSKY who was born in Grodno, Poland and was deceased. The subject's mother was YETTA LANSKY also born in Grodno, Poland, in 1880 and who was residing at 240 Ocean Parkway, Brooklyn, New York. The mother was a United States citizen according to the application.

LANSKY's application also indicated on December 16, 1948, he was married to THELMA SHEER SCHWARTZ who was born in New York City on November 18, 1907. The wife was residing with the subject and she was the identifying witness on the application and indicated she had known the subject for three years.

The file reflected a clipping of the "New York Sun" newspaper of June 28, 1949, which reflected a picture of MEYER LANSKY and the article was captioned, "LANSKY Sails in Luxury for Italy; Expected to Confer with LUCIANO."

The Passport file contained another application for a Passport which the subject submitted on June 8, 1956, at Miami, Florida and for which he was issued Passport Number 135541 on July 10, 1956. This Passport was good for three months due to a suit which was pending and which was in connection with the cancellation of his naturalization.

On the application LANSKY indicated that he came to the United States in 1910 and lived from 1910 until 1956 in New York City, Boston, Massachusetts, and Hollywood, Florida. His permanent residence was 3800 South Ocean Drive, Hollywood, Florida. LANSKY indicated that he wanted to depart from Miami, Florida, on July 20, 1956, for a trip that was to last from one month to six weeks and was for the purpose of sightseeing in Brazil, Argentina, Venezuela, and Chile. He indicated that his mother was still living at 240 Ocean Parkway, New York City. On the application, LANSKY indicated that on December 16, 1948, he was married to THELMA SCHEER. He indicated that she lived with the subject.

LANSKY indicated on his 1949 application for a Passport that he had lived in Cuba from December 1938 until March, 1939 and again from December, 1939, until March, 1940. He claimed that he had no previous Passport at that time. On the 1956 application, LANSKY indicated that he had made eight trips abroad in the preceeding twelve months, however, the file contained no information as to where he had been while he was on those trips.

The 1956 application reflected LANSKY was 5'6" tall, with brown hair and blue eyes. He had a scar on the right side of his face. He listed his occupation as executive. The file contained a photograph on the 1956 application.

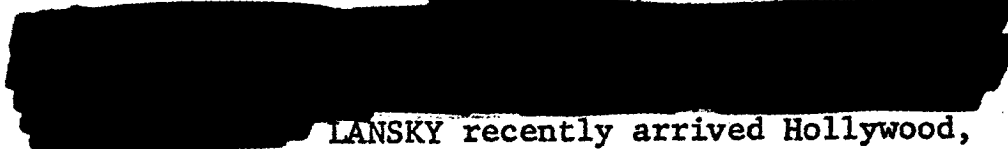

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2. Education

Records of [REDACTED] another governmental agency maintaining personnel-type records, reflect that the subject advised that he completed eight years of grammar school and was graduated. The school was not identified. 62

The subject was examined under oath on December 10, 1953, in the United States Attorney's Office, Southern District of New York, New York City, by Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) ROBERT W. SWEET, in the presence of MOSES POLAKOFF, Attorney for the subject. This examination was conducted in connection with the denaturalization proceedings then pending against the subject. Hereafter in this report,

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information attributed to this examination, will be referred to as the examination by AUSA SWEET in 1953.

In the above examination, the subject stated that he graduated from Public School 34 in the lower east side of Manhattan in 1916 or 1917. He attended this school under the name of MEYER LANSKY.

3. Employment

(a.) Current

The subject's other interest in various business will be set forth later in this report under the caption, "Legitimate Enterprises."

(b.) Previous

Subject, in examination in 1953 by AUSA SWEET, advised he may have been employed part-time as a grocery errand boy for some grocery store on the lower east side of New York prior to his graduating from grammar school. His first job was with the D. and L. Tool Company, as an apprentice machinist. This company was first located on Centre Street near Canal Street, which was then about 1917 until 1922 or 1923. The company employed about eight to ten persons. The only other employee he recalls was his supervisor, MAX LANSKY, who was also the subject's cousin. This company later moved from this location when World War I began and became a larger concern. He did not know the address to which they moved but it was located somewhere around Greenwich Street.

The subject related that after the war, he must have been "let go" because the die and tool business fell

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off. He later then worked in several other places as a machinist, but he does not recall these concerns names. He did recall that he later worked for the Sullivan Shipyards and the R. Hoe and Company. He did not recall when he worked for these two organizations but he worked for the R. Hoe and Company just before they left Manhattan.

The subject stated that sometime prior to his marriage, he was working in Brooklyn, New York, in the building trades, "down in the new sections of Brooklyn." He did not recall for whom he was employed, but added he acquired the job through some friend of his father's. He did not recall the friend's name or address. His job had something to do with hardware work such as handling tools like, "putting things on windows, locks." Sometime after 1928, he stated he was employed and had an interest in the Richard Mirror Company, also known as the Richard Mirror Works. They were located somewhere on Green Street, Manhattan.

The subject stated he later worked for the Lansky Food Corporation, whose address was about 500 Broad Street, next to Haines Department Store, Newark, New Jersey.

b2 Records [REDACTED] reflect that in about May, 1942, the subject stated his present job was that of Vice President of the Krieg S. Pector and Citron Company at 727 Monroe Street, Hoboken, New Jersey. He indicated he had spent seven years at this type of work, which he began in 1934. His duties of this position consisted of looking after operation of sales and the employment situation.

These records reflect that the subject stated that he had had four years experience as a machinist on lathe and shaper or drill press from 1917 ending in 1921.

b2 Records [REDACTED] also reflect that about July, 1942, the subject stated he was employed as a manager of a dog racing track. It is further noted in July, 1942,

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the subject stated he was connected with the Dodge Kennel Club, Council Bluffs, Iowa.

The records [REDACTED] reflect that in November, 1943, the subject may have been connected with the Manhattan Simplex Distributing Company, Inc., the distributors of Wurlitzer Automatic Phonographs, 525 West 43rd Street, New York City. b2

The subject, in examination before AUSA SWEET, in 1953, stated he at one time had been employed by Embee Distributing Company.

During the examination, the subject referred to his Social Security Card number 109-03-8534, which reflected it was issued on December 17, 1936. On the back of this card was typewritten, Lansky Food Corporation, 100 Beacon Street, Boston, Massachusetts, which subject stated was where he once lived.

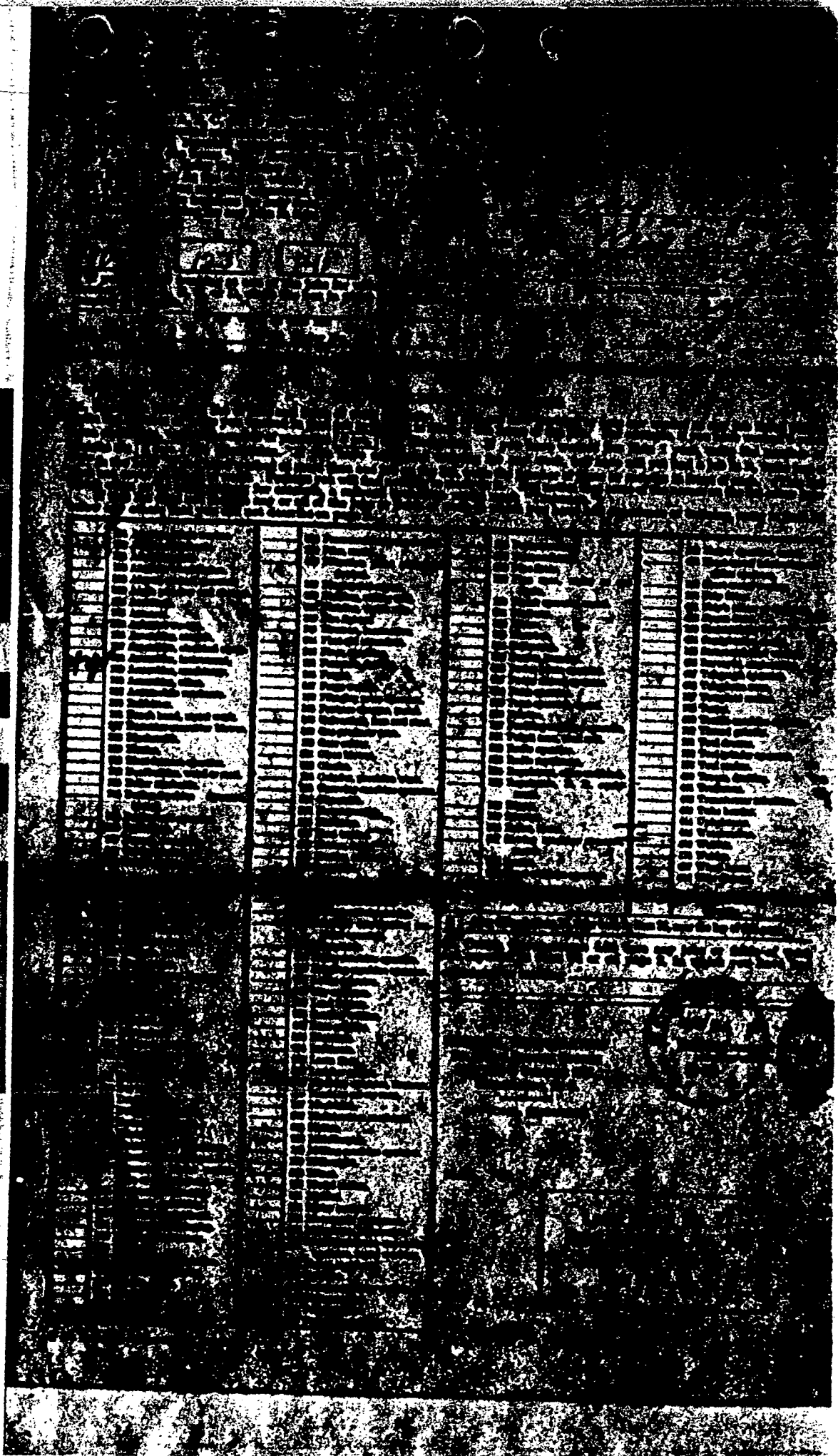

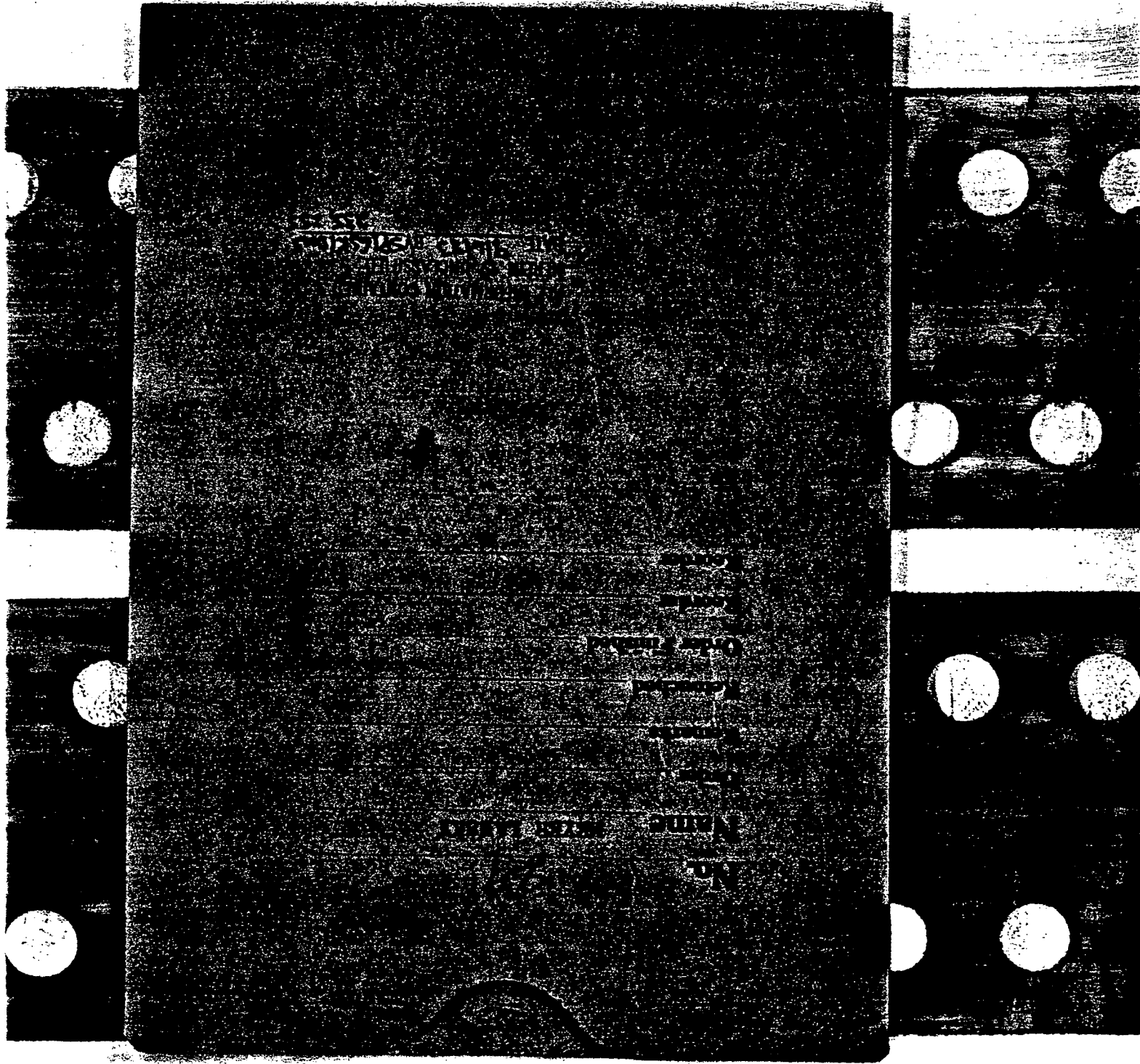
