

Psychological Assessment

The Colombian Government's (GOC) campaign to locate and apprehend Pablo Escobar has had a very detrimental impact on Escobar's health and judgement. Escobar's behavior and appearance has taken a visible turn for the worst since about a year ago. The breakdown of "peace talks" with the GOC has contributed particularly heavily to this.

Prior to President Bush's visit to Cartagena, Colombia early this year, Pablo Escobar and President Virgilio Barco had reached an agreement to call-off the "war." This agreement was reached through their intermediaries:

_ The agreement was

reached with the following conditions on Escobar:

- Turn in and/or destroy the laboratories;
- Dismantle the Escobar organization;
- Discontinue all cocaine production.

In return, President Barcos had agreed to:

- Not extradite Escobar or his lieutenants;
- Hold their criminal trials in Colombia only; and,
- Escobar's family would be allowed to keep its wealth.

Escobar had already begun to meet his end of the agreement before President Bush's arrival to Colombia. He had turned over several large laboratories to the GOC. But as soon as President Bush left Colombia the GOC went back on its word and started up again. Since then, Escobar "has not cared" and is out of control and demoralized. He has become more aggressive rather than weak in resolve.

The pressure of the campaign has caused him to become more conscious about his personal security arrangements, but his thinking is less rational. In the past he was more calculating and he considered consequences. Now he is reacting more like a caged animal. He trusts very few people because of an increasing paranoia. His circle of trusted friends has shrunk from hundreds to no more than fifteen or twenty. Among them are:

Because Escobar has dedicated himself to the organization's "war strategy" he has left the business to and his staff, who manage laboratories (production), transport and sales. Nevertheless, Escobar would immediately negotiate if he got word that the GOC was disposed to.
Physical Health
Several signs of worsening health are evident in Escobar: weight gain, loss of concentration, nervousness, anxiety and gastritis since about a year ago. These maladies and the pressures of being on-the-run over a prolonged time period have caused him to develop bad sleeping habits, and he has aged very quickly lately. His health is deteriorating. The friendly, social person of the past has disappeared. Now he is frequently tired. (not further identified) and a second unknown individual.
Personal Security

The bustle he enjoys and previously had with the large entourages and free reign of Antioquia are now replaced with a small circle of movement and desolation: no
crowds, no luxurious beds, not much liquor or women, and very ordinary surroundings.
local
Custom in Antioquia is to wear casual street clothing for business. If in the mountains, jeans are in order. Before the GOC's campaign, Escobar had control of all of Envigado and Medellin, and much of the Antioquia Province, and moved infrequently. As enforcement efforts intensified his circle of movement became restricted to Envigado, parts of Medellin and some parts of Antioquia.

Rumors that Escobar has altered his physical appearance are untrue beyond the normal changes and disquises he can don
without surgery.
Many people in Medellin and Envigado used to support and help Escobar. But because of the indiscriminate deaths by bombs he has lost about two thirds of his supporters. Those who continue to assist and protect him are largely from the low class. Most people in Antioquia are tired of the "war:" Some are openly saying they wish Escobar would be killed to put an end to the war.
Whereabouts
One of Escobar's worries about traveling to other countries is that an ordinary person will give him away without knowing who he is. In Colombia, particularly in the Province of Antioquia, people know and fear him; he has control and enjoys their protection. In a foreign country he could be turned in to authorities as just another Colombian.
Most recently, several weeks ago, the false news
was that he was in Cocorna (near Las Mercedes and Puerto Triumfo). Escobar has not travelled out of Colombia in two years.
Communications
They also make use of a network of public telephones and telephone company employees who verify that callers are group members and connect them between public telephones. Since the "La Colina" communications center fell to authorities they have had a poor communications system. They have been unable to set up



The purpose of the REI is to obtain information concerning the nature, structure, composition, and activities of the Medellin Cartel operations operating in the United States, particularly in the Miami Division's jurisdiction. The Cartel groups targeted by the Miami Division are those consisting of at least two or more persons engaged in a continuing pattern of illegal drug trafficking for the purpose of obtaining profits through their racketeering activities. The long range objective of this effort will be the detection and prosecution of the criminal members of the enterprise, as well as the identification and seizure of their assets.

The Miami Division's Medellin Cartel - REI is designed to consolidate information on Medellin groups previously collected under the Colombian/South American Drug Trafficking Organizations - REI. It will also continue to collect and update the identity of the members of the respective organization or enterprise and the role these individuals play in furtherance of the criminal enterprise. The REI will also serve to gather, collect, and analyze the financial enterprise and develop a comprehensive investigative strategy based on the past and current activities of the organization. These intelligence efforts will result in the opening of substantive drug cases based on a substantial predicate and cause a more efficient use of FBI resources.

SYNOPSIS

Practically all Colombian/South American drug trafficking organizations with operations in the South Florida area are affiliated with, or subcontract their services to one of the Medellin Cartel members.

The members of the Medellin Cartel frequently use North Coast or other independent groups on an ad hoc basis for specialized tasks, such as transportation or money laundering. They began their drug trafficking with marihuana during the early marihuana. trading days. In recent years, the cartels have turned to trafficking the more lucrative and easier to transport drug—cocaine. They are currently expanding their markets into Europe, where demand is growing. The North Coast groups continue to traffic in marihuana as well.



Drugs involved. The principal drug imported into the U.S. by the Medellin Cartel is cocaine.



DETAILS



This cartel has been perceived in the past to be the most important and significant of the Colombian drug organizations. By far the most widely known and documented, it is now viewed as having set the pace for the other organizations, but no longer as powerful as it once was.

Pablo Escobar-Gaviria and other top leaders must continue to maintain a very low profile due to the pressure of American and Colombian law enforcement authorities. They have, in so doing, turned over the reins to other individuals who are managing their affairs. Now there are indications that they are not satisfied with what has taken place over the past couple of years.

Other traffickers from the Medellin area appear also to have become dissatisfied with the cartel's current leadership, saying that they have been forced into contributing to the cartel's "assessments," rather than voluntarily providing monies as in the past. A number of groups have reportedly started supporting the "Cali Cartel" in its turf war with the Medellin groups; they believe the Medellin traffickers have "robbed" many of their customer groups by falsely claiming that shipments were intercepted and then selling their client's cocaine in the U.S. and Europe.

Cartel Group:

This cartel operates principally out of Medellin, Colombia. The organizations which make it up maintain central "offices," which they utilize to make and receive long distance telephone calls (and occasionally, facsimile transmissions) from their representatives in cities in the United States, Western Europe and Asia.

The Medellin Cartel had established strong ties to former Panamanian strongman, Manuel Antonio Noriega, who used his power and influence to corrupt Panama into a heaven for Colombian drug traffickers. Noriega assisted the likes of Pablo-Escobar and others in the Medellin Cartel to evade Colombian and U.S. authorities by providing sanctuary in Panama. More importantly, Noriega's regime corrupted the Panamanian financial system into a huge money laundering operation at the service of drug traffickers.

The new government and social order in Panama will surely throw the Medellin Cartel's money laundering and banking operations for a tail spin—until the Cartel is able to replace lost Panamanian resources elsewhere.

ÖRGANIZATION

Pablo Emilio Escobar-Gaviria, together with are known throughout the Colombian underworld as "Los Pablos." Their organization is regarded by most observers to be among the most powerful, wielding political as well as economic power within the Republic of Colombia. Its representatives and distributors work primarily in Miami, New York, Chicago, Boston and Los Angeles. This organization controls production, transportation, and, with the and Rodriguez-Gacha groups, generally sets the prices for cocaine for the rest of the Cartels. Escobar-Gaviria's group was among the first to organize itself like a corporation, dispatching representatives or "managers" to the United States in order to serve in various cities for a one or two year period. These representatives are given sums of two and three hundred thousand dollars to purchase or rent "stash" houses in quiet suburban neighborhoods (preferably homes with an enclosed/attached garage), purchase a number of vehicles to move the group's cocaine, and recruit a number of individuals to serve as guards for the "stashes," along with couriers who travel between the various U.S. cities in which the group operates.

FINANCES

OPERATION

Escobar-Gaviria's group was also among the first to institute a system of internal audits, dispatching on an irregular basis trusted representatives (sometimes attorneys or professional accountants) who unexpectedly appear in the U.S. to check on each manager's performance and inventory.

POLICE/PUBLIC CORRUPTION

Escobar-Gaviria's group, as well as other Medellin cartel members, have established a network of contacts within the Colombian government enabling them to effectively avoid capture.

COMMUNICATIONS

Members and representatives of this organization have been utilizing public telephones, pagers and high frequency radio equipment to communicate among themselves and with principals in Colombia.



The Escobar-Gaviria group has a policy of transferring its U.S. based representatives from city to city as they either get arrested or attract the attention of law enforcement. A manager who gets in trouble in Miami, for example, can expect to return to Medellin for a short time to "cool off," and will subsequently be sent to another U.S. city to work for the organization.

ASSESSMENT

The Escobar-Gaviria organization had been extending its activities and scope on a broader international scale, seeking expansion into markets in Europe and Asia. Recent Colombian government operations directed against the Medellin Cartel membership has disrupted cocaine production, curtailing these expansion efforts and resulting in dissatisfaction and restlessness among its membership. It is not known at this time what effect these operations will have on the long term makeup of the cartel membership.

BASIS OF INFORMATION

Information for this REI will be collected from debriefing of new/established sources who have access to the leadership, members and methods of operation of the Escobar-Gaviria organization and other Medellin Cartel members.
