ALFRED SARANT, WAS., ESP R. SARANT INTERVIEWED JULY TWENTYEIGHT LAST, NYO, RE DISCREPANCIES DEVELOPED AS OF THAT DATE. PRIOR TO INTERVIEW HE WAS PHYSICALLY OBSERVED BY FLOYD ELWYN, JR. AND BARNET BERENSON, SUPERINTENDENTS SIXTYFIVE MORTON ST. AND ONE ONE TWO EAST SEVENTH ST., NYC, RESPECTIVELY. BERENSON STATED THAT SARANT WAS NOT IDENTICAL WITH AN INDIVIDUAL NAMED WALTON /PH/ WHO HAD FORMERLY RESIDED AT ONE ONE TWO EAST SEVENTH ST., NYC. ELWYN NOW ADVISES THAT SARANT HAS BEEN OBSERVED AT SIXTYFIVE MORTON ST., SIX OR SEVEN TIMES BETWEEN THE PERIOD OF OCT., FORTYEIGHT AND FEB. ONE, FIFTY, AND ONCE SINCE THE SARANT APARTMENT WAS VACATED IN APPROX. APR. OF FIFTY. TO HYPOTHETICAL QUESTIONS HE ADMITTED THAT ROSENBERG MIGHT HAVE TOLD HIM THAT THE RUSSIANS OR THE SOVIETS WERE OUR ALL DURING THE WAR PERIOD AND THAT EVERY EFFORT POSSIBLE SHOULD BE EXTENDED TO THEM TO FURNISH AS MUCH INFO AS POSSIBLE AND AS FELLOW COMMUNISTS THAT HE SHOULD BE ONE OF THOSE WHO SHOULD ASSIST. HOWEVER, HE STATES THAT HE DOES NOT RECALL ROSENBERG HAVING SO STATED THIS. HE ADMITTED THAT HE COULD HAVE FURNISHED VITAL INFO PERTAINING TO AIR BORNE RADAR WHEN EMPLOYED BY THE WESTERN ELECTRIC CO. AND AT THE SAME TIME STATED THAT JOEL BARR COULD HAVE SUPPLIED THE SAME INFO BECAUSE HE TOO WAS EMPLOYED BY THE WESTERN ELECTIC CO. DURING THE SAME PERIOD. HOWEVER, HE SAYS THAT HE NEVER FURNISHED ANY INFO AND THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS
