Unburm Sulyer ELA - R At 5:57 p.m. of this date Mr. Art Rolander, Security Office, Atomic Energy Commission, telephonically advised Supervisor Robert A. ..... Collier that his office had determined additional information regarding Gerhardt Norval Wollan. This individual was employed as a physicist by a contractional firm Ford, Bacon and Davis which firm helped build the K-25 plant designed by the Kellex Corporation at Oakridge. Rolander stated that their files reflect that on the basis of a letter dated 2-5-44 hofrom the M.E.D. Intelligence Office in New York City, Wollan's employment was terminated. The substance of the letter from the Intelligence Office is not known inasmuch as it has not been located. One reference which Wollan had at the time of his employment is known to be William Karl -Rolander also furnished information concerning Charles Joseph Greenspan. That individual was employed by Keller in June 1943 and left Kellex October 25, 1945. Rolander stated that the Atomic Energy Commission master reference list reflects that Greenspan had sympathy or membership in the Communist Party and based upon that information his employment was terminated. Rolander advised that additional data concerning these individuals is being secured and will be furnished to the Bureau as soon as possible. On February 4, 1950, Mr. C. A. Rolander, Jr., Security Division, Atomic Energy Commission, telephonically advised Special Agent Ernest J. Van Loon that the Commission had been endeavoring to obtain all available information from its various offices concerning Gerhard Norval Wollan, a suspect.

Rolander advised that at the Oak Ridge installation a card on Wollan had been found in the MED Central Indices. This card reflected Wollan was born at Glenwood, Minnesota, June 27, 1910. His Social Security number was shown as 093-071-740. The card referred to New York MED file No. 508. It did not show any place of employment but indicated that Wollan had been terminated February 9, 1944. The card also reflected that Wollan's name had been placed on the Master Reference List which was said to be a watch list of persons on whom derogatory information was available.

The Atomic Energy Commission records at New York were checked, but the File No. 508, mentioned above, was not located. The New York Office had a card merely indicating that Wollan's name was in the Master Reference List.

At los Alamos the records reflected, according to Rolander, that Wollan had applied for employment in 1943 and had been denied clearance in February, 1944, because of information developed in a clearance investigation. Rolander stated the clearance apparently was denied because of FBI checks which indicated that Wollan had been engaged in Communist activities since 1938.

At Washington, D.C., the Atomic Energy Commission records reflect, according to Rolander, that Wollan wrote a letter dated December 16, 1943, to Dr. M. H. Trytten, National Roster of Scientific Men, 2101 Constitution Avenue, Washington, D.C. This letter was on the letterhead of the U.S. Navy Yard, New York, New York, and read as follows:

Dear Dr. Trytten:

"When I talked to you here in New York there was some slight possibility that I might have some difficulty in getting a release. That has been cleared up. I have obtained my release from the Navy Yard and I am available for your job as of today.

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
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Rolander stated that the Atomic Energy Commission records at the Seat of Government also reflected that Wollan's name was on the Master Reference List and that the New York FBI files revealed Communist activities on the part of Wollan, and reported Communist meetings in his home.

On February 6, 1950, W. A. Burke in Mr. Rolander's Office, telephonically contacted Special Agent E. J. Van Loon and advised that they had learned that one Ernest Omar Wollan, born November 6, 1902, Glenwood, Minnesota, is presently working at the Oak Ridge installation. The records on this Wollan indicate that he listed only two brothers, namely Abner and Ralph Wollan; the former was in Columbus, Ohio in the early part of 1948, and the latter was at Oak Ridge, Tennessee, as of 1948. While this Wollan was born at the same time as Gerhard Wollan, there is no information of record showing relationship.

June 29, 1944 to January 3, 1945. During that period MEBER was absent from work on three days, namely Angust 29, Moyember 14 and Movember 27, 1944.

It will be noted that August 29, 1944 and Hovember 14, 1944 are both pertinent dates to this investigation. On those dates activity by the unknown subject is believed to have taken place. Moreover, both of these days fell on Thesdays in 1944, Also the date August 1, 1944, another pertinent date, fell on a Thesday in 1944. According to Kellex records WEBER was on duty on August 1, 1944e

The Kellex records further show that WEBER apparently worked on legal holidays, such as, July 4th, Thanksgiving Day, Labor Day and Christmas, on which days Kellex maintained a skeleton force.

The Keller records did not reflect WEBER'S whereabouts on the days he was absent from work. It was I-l's opinion that complete attendance records, including reasons for absence and whereabouts during absence, are now in the custody of the Records Distribution Office, Atomic Energy Commission Oak Ridges

The records of the Department of Licenses, New York City, reflected that WEBER is the owner of a 1950 black Buick Sedan, Motor number 55775184, which automobile bere 1949 tags 61-9864.

Gonfidential Informent 7-2 advised on January 11, 1950 that WEBER directed a letter to his wife which was postmarked January 4, 1950 at Cleveland, Ohio and which bore return address, e/o ROBERIS, 2801 Hathaway Road, Dayton, Ohio.

Confidential Informant 7-3, of known reliability, stated that he First became acquainted with WEBER in 1942 at which time WEBER and ABRAHAN BROTHMAN were engaged as consulting engineers for the International Engineering, Inc., Dayton, Ohio. 7-3 stated that after WEBER terminated his services with International Engineering, he continued to see WEBER whenever he visited New York City. Approximately three wonths ago WEBER contacted a Mr., SAUMENICHT, New York representative for International and informed SAUMENICHT that his job with Keller was about to be terminated and that he was desirous of obtaining work with a private organization. Thereafter 7-3 advised WEBER was hired as a technical director in International Engineering, Dayton, Ohio, and placed in charge of engineering and sales. WEBER officially began this employment on December 15, 1949,

W 65-15186 According to T-S, one of WEBER'S daties was to contact all manufacturing representatives of the company throughout the United States. WEBER the refere traveled to Boston, New York, Philadelphia, Wilmington, Pittsburgh, Akron, Cleveland, Detroit, Chicago, St. Louis, Tulsa, Houston and New Orleans, During the Christmas and New Year's Holidays, WEBER was in New York visiting his femily.

T-8 knows that it is WEBER'S intention to purchase a home in Dayton and move his family there in the very near future. He also advised that WEBER'S duties will entail his contacting representatives in the above. cities from time to time in addition to his duties is the engineering field in Dayton, Chies

T-5 agreed to immediately advise the Cincipnati Office when WEBER next travels to New York. He stated that WEBER neually travels by train, He also stated that WEBER is presently rooming in a private residence at 2801 Hathaway Road, Dayton, Ohio.

Confidential Informant T-8, of unknown reliability, advised that WEBER and his family moved in Apartment 508, 25 West Broadway, Long Beach, Hew Tork, on Movember 15, 1949, and have a lease which expires April 80, 1950.

Confidential Informant T-9, also of unknown foliability, advised that WEBER is presently in Dayton, Chio, and that Mrs. WEBER and their two children live in Apartment 508 at 25 West Broadway, Long Beach, New Yorke T-9 stated that occasionally WEBER comes to Hew York on week-ends.

Further Analysis Regarding WEBER as a Suspect

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Further it is noted in connection with WEBER that Angust 1, 1944, WEBER'S wife, JEAN, opened a Special Checking Account, Number 1098, at the Mational City Bank, Kings Highway Branch, Brooklyn, New York, On August 2, 1944, the bank account is the Mational City Bank was changed to a joint account in the name of ARTHUE P. and JEAN WEBER. Between August 1 and December 29, 1944 several small deposits were made to this account and several small checks were drawn against it. The largest deposit was made on Hovember 21, 1944-in the amount of \$148,55. The largest withdrawal was made by check on Hovember 27, 1944, a day on which WEBER was absent from work. This check was in the amount of \$75,00. As of December 29, 1944, the balance in the account was \$139,02,

A CHANGE TO SEE A SECTION OF THE SEC

Pith regard to the information furnished by the unknown subject on October 1, 1944, regarding BROTHMAN, it should be noted that around that time WEBER and BROTHMAN had a disagreement and both left the employ of the Chemurgy Design Corporation, New York City. It was the opinion of Confidential Informant 1-4

#### RE: ABRAHAM BROTHWAM

Confidential Informent T-5, of unknown reliability, has advised that BROTHMAN occupies office space on the twelfth floor of the building at 2928 elst Avenue, Long Island City, New York. This informant stated that BROTHMAN employs a girl secretary and a male assistant who is believed by T-5 to be a Hundu. T-5 is positive of the fact that BROTHMAN maintains irregular hours and at times is known to come into the building at two or three in the morning and work for the rest of the night in hisoffice. In addition T-5 reported that BROTHMAN makes periodic trips to Philadelphia for two or three days at a time during which there is no activity in his office.

The records of the License Bureau, New York City, reflected that BROTHMAN is the owner of a 1940 red Oldsmobile two-door sedan which bore 1949 tags 708492. From observation it was learned that this ear has four white side-wall tires.

Periodic physical surveillances of BROTHMAN have been conducted and reveal that he parks his our in a parking lot at 14th Street and Skillman Avenue, Summyside, New York, about two blocks from his home. He parks the ear in a parking lot directly across the street from 2928 41st Avenue, long Island City. On Jamary 22, 1950 he was observed entering his car in the parking lot near his home in the company of an unknown man. They drove directly to BROTHMAN'S office and both entered the building. BROTHMAN was seen leaving the building at 2928 41st Avenue at 8:25 P.M., January 22, 1950, in the company of two unknown mene BROTHMAN drove directly from there to 8503 57th Street, Eluhnret, Long Island, which is the business site of feacook laboratories and which BROTHMAN apparently uses for experimental purposes.

March 28, 1949 that EROTHMAN operates A. BROTHMAN and Associates in Room 1215, 2928 41st Avenue. His partner in this business venture is MIRIAN MOSKOWITZ. The business was established in October 1946 and its net worth in March 1949 was in excess of \$15,000.00 On October 11, 1946 the firm was registered by BROTHMAN, MOSKOWITZ and OSCAR J. VAGO. On June 2, 1948 VAGO sold his interest to the remaining partners.

MIRIAN MOSKOWITZ is 32, single and a graduate of the College of the City of New York in 1942. From the Spring of 1942 to August 1944 she was employed as a secretary in the War Manpower Commission, New York Citye

The Firm is engaged in developing work for firms in the United States and foreign countries including the Chinese Government. They are experienced chemical engineers and maintain a laboratory at 8503 57th Avenue, Elmhurst, Mew Yorke

7-6 was unable to furnish any information on the Phoenix Service Bureau, which name is also listed on the doors

With regard to MENKI A. GOLWINE, a former business partner of MESKE and SEOTHMAN in the Chemical Design Corporation, Confidential Informat E-7 has advised that GOLWINNE is a British citizen who is a state in business matters and enjoys the friendship of a number of prominent businessmen in New York City. T-7 assumed that GOLWINNE'S income in 1944 was in the neighborhood of \$25,000 to \$30,000 a year. Concerning his past, Z-7 stated that GOLWINNE came to Toronto as a youth and in 1914 joined the Canadian Army, recigning in 1919 as a Major having received the decoration of the British Military Cross while in the

Service. For a number of years thereafter COLWINNE specialised in magnesia and magnesite. More recently he has been interested in a mineral Kynaite which is used in the making of high temperature refractory material. The COLWINNE Cuban company was formed in connection with the importing of Kynaite from Cuba. This material is sold to the Mullite Company of Shelton, Connecticut in which COLWINE has a quarter interest.

About October 7, 1944 COLFINE went to India on a mission for the Mar Production Board in connection with ascertaining Kynaite deposits located in that country.


2-6 reported in December 1941 that the Colwynne Chemical Company, 120 Lexington Avenue, New York City, was incorporated under the laws of New York State in July 1931 under the name Colmynne Magnesite and Magnesia Corporation. HKNRY A. COLWINE was President and Miss WINIFRED E. RESSELL was Secretary and Treasurer.

In 1941 GOLWINNE was 49, divorced, a mative of England and not a United States citizen. For a time prior to 1921 GOLWINNE was a purchasing agent in Toronto, Canada, for several foreign concerns and then started individually as an importer of magnesia and magnesite and also mice generally obtained from India. During 1925 he organised the Super Refractories. Corporation, the name of which was changed to HENRY A. GOLWINNE Corporation in 1926. GOLWINNE is also President of the Pulverised Metals Corporation which maintains headquarters in New York City at 420 Lexington Avenue, New York City, and which was incorporated under Connecticut laws on December 20, 1940. The particular business of the Henry A. Golwynne Corporation is the importation and distribution of magnesite throughout this country which is obtained through the Magnisite Syndicate of London, England and also from Cuba.

In 1941 BOLWYME resided at 45 Prospect Place, New York City, Prior to that he lived at 19 East 55th Street, New York City,

Another statement by FUCHS which would lend credence to this identification is that his contact was totally unknown to him, other than as a contact for the transmittal of espionage information. In line with a long established policy of the Soviet Intelligence Service to operate through means of "cutouts", this statement by FUCHS is consistent to what is known of their methods of operation.

It is therefore suggested that investigative efforts to develop additional suspects for the unknown subject GOOSE be directed to those individuals who are known to have been associates of EROTHMAN and who assisted EROTHMAN in the establishment of his laboratory, either financially or in obtaining contracts for him. It is also suggested that consideration be given to interviewing EROTHMAN in the event the circumstances so warrant.
