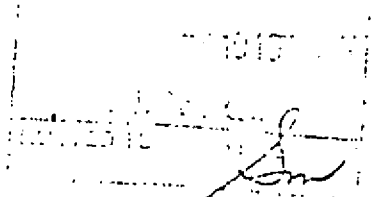

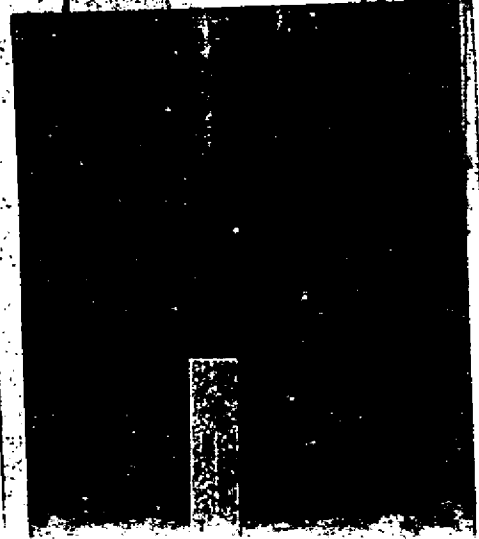

I VIVIAN GLASSMAN make the following statement to RICHARD T. HRADSKY and ROBERT F. ROYAL, who have identified themselves as Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, U.S. Department of Justice. No threats, promises, or duress of any type has been used against me to obtain this statement. I know that it could be used against me in a Court of law. I have been informed that I do not have to make this statement and it was voluntarily given.

I live at Apartment 4A, 131 East 7th Street, New York City and I am currently employed at the United Service ~~of~~ for New Americans, 15 Park Row, New York City. I was born on January 30, 1919 in New York City.

On Friday - July 21, 1950, during the

evening hours at approximately 7³⁰_{PM}, an unknown man knocked on my door and identified himself as a friend. I admitted him to my apartment and he stated that he would like me to do something for him. I questioned his identification as well as why he had come to see me. He was not too specific in his answers, but he asked if I knew "John". When I said no, he made reference to a previous friend by the name of BARR. I said JOEL BARR and he said yes. He then asked me to go to Cleveland to visit my friend, whom, he identified as an aeronautical engineer and someone who was interested in my sister. I believed that he was referring to my sister, ELEANOR GLASSMAN who currently resides at apartment 4B, 343 East Eight Street New York City. I knew that one WILLIAM PERL, an aeronautical

engineer had been seen by my
sister on several occasions
