WILLIAM DANZIGER, ESP-R. AUSA KILSHEIMER ADVISED TODAY THAT HE HAD RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM THE DEPARTMENT ADVISING HIM THAT THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS ON A PERJURY COUNT AGAINST DANZIGER WOULD RUN ON FEBRUARY SEVEN NEXT. THE DEPARTMENT ASKED KILSHEIMER IF HE INTENDED TO PROSECUTE DANZIGER FOR PERJURY. KILSHEIMER ADVISED THE DEPARTMENT THAT HE HAD NOT CHANGED HIS OPINION AND WOULD NOT PROSECUTE DANZIGER FOR PERJURY. THE DEPARTMENT ADVISED KILSHEIMER THAT IT WAS IN AGREEMENT WITH HIM AND WOULD PROBABLY ADVISE THE BUREAU OF THEIR DECISION. FOR INFO.
