"These statements are patently false or misleading and they malign not only dedicated FBI agents but the community of Birmingham. No one has 'taken over' this city.

" We regret dissemination of such information about our city in any area of this state."

It is obvious that "The Birmingham News," in this instance, rallied to our defense and in language which is probably as strong as any newspaper normally sees fit to use for comment with respect to another newspaper, particularly in the same state. "The Birmingham News" endeavored to set the record straight.

It is my recommendation that the Director immediately send Mr. TOWNSEND a letter thanking him for his comments in the editorial.

Reference is made to Birmingham airtel of 9/28/63 concerning reporting procedures in this case.

Mobile has 15 persons on the bombing suspectlist. Immediately after notice of instant bombing on 9/15/63, investigation was conducted to determine their whereabouts. Thirteen of the suspects were eliminated through personal observation, neighborhood sources, and racial informants. The other two bombing suspects, of Mobile, and possible of Montgomery, were not completely eliminated through this investigation.

Inasmuch as the investigation concerning these bombing suspects was negative, the information is not being set forth in report form, but is recorded in Mobile files.



Racial informants and potential racial informants of the Mobile Office were contacted on 9/15/63, but could furnish no information concerning instant bombing. They were alerted to immediately report any information they may obtain in the future pertinent to this matter.

Interviews conducted with the persons on the Mobile bombing suspect list and members of Klan and hate type organizations, including former Klansmen, have been conducted, but no information of value to this case was developed through these interviews. In accordance with the suggestions of the Birmingham Office, the original FD-302s for these interviews are being maintained in Mobile file with copies of FD-302s in the individual case files of the persons interviewed, where such files exist. As the interviews were negative in results, the FD-302s are not being included in report being submitted by Mobile.

The persons in the above-mentioned categories who were interviewed by the Mobile Office negatively are identified below for the information of the Bureau and Birmingham:





AT ELEVEN TWENTYFIVE A.M. CST, OCT. EIGHT, SAC RAY L. FAISST RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL FROM

INQUIRED AS TO WHETHER THEY COULD GET TOGETHER SOMEWHERE OUTSIDE OF THE OFFICE. SAC FAISST ADVISED THAT WE HAD BEEN WORKING WITH OTHER AGENCIES. THAT IT DID NOT APPEAR FEASIBLE TO HAVE AND CLANDESTINE MEETINGS WITH ANYONE, AND THAT THE DEALINGS OF THIS OFFICE WERE OPEN AND ABOVE BOARD, AND THAT I DESIRED TO HAVE A MEETING HE SHOULD FEEL FREE TO DROP BY THE FBI OFFICE ON THE FOURTEENTH FLOOR OF THE TWENTYONE TWENTYONE BLDG. STATED HE FELT IT WOULD BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE CASE IF HE WERE OBSERVED BY ANYONE IN THE FBI OFFICE. HE WAS TOLD THAT SAC FAISST DID NOT CONCUR WITH THAT OBSERVATION. HE WAS ALSO TOLD THAT THIS OFFICE ENCOUNTERED THE SAME DIFFICULTY AS THE POLICE AND SO IN ENDEAVORING TO GET IN TOUCH WITH HIM THE NIGHT THE ALA. HIGHWAY PATROL PICKED UP A NUMBER OF PAGE SEVEN
