LOUGHNER posted a picture on his MySpace account of a Glock semi-automatic handgun sitting on top of a United States history book. Within the About Me section of his MySpace profile, LOUGHNER advertised a link to his YouTube page located at www.youtube.com/classitup10.

LOUGHNER appears to be associated with two YouTube profiles. The first profile, under the username "starhitshnaz" was created on 10/2/2010. This profile contains one 7-minute video of a hooded and masked individual who burns an American flag. A second profile, under the username "classitup10" was created on 10/25/2010, and was publicly identified as being Jared Lee Loughner's YouTube channel. The second channel contained five videos that appear to have been created and uploaded by LOUGHNER, discussing some of his theories. This channel also favorited the single video uploaded on the "starhitshnaz" YouTube channel.

The Classitup10 YouTube profile was created on 10/25/2010. The profile itself publicly stated "My name is Jared Lee Loughner! and listed his hometown as Tucson. Five videos were uploaded to the YouTube profile. On 11/22/10, a 2 minute video titled "How To: Your New Currency!" was uploaded to Classitup10. This video included ideas about creating his own currency system.

On 11/30/2010, a nearly 3 minute video titled "This Student At Pima Community College: An Unconstitutional Crime!" was uploaded to Classitup10. In this video, LOUGHNER attacks his teachers and fellow students as ignorant and argues the school is operating illegally because it is receiving and spending legal tender other than gold or silver. He mentions Article 1, Section 10 of the Constitution, believing that he was a victim of fraud.

On 12/6/2010, a nearly 1 minute video titled "How To: Mind Controller" was uploaded to Classitup10. This video contained nonsensical arguments about controlling peoples minds.

"Introduction: Jared Loughner" was uploaded to Classitup10. This video began with a slide "My Final Thoughts: Jared Lee Loughner!". In the video, LOUGHNER focused on dates and mentioned "B.C.E making the argument that because there is no earliest B.C.E date, then the C.E dates could never begin." LOUGHNER mentioned making one's own currency and his attempt to join the US Army. Toward the end of the video, there is anti-government language including, "You don't have to accept the federalist laws. Nonetheless, read the United States of America's Constitution to apprehend all of the current treasonous laws. You're literate, listener?" The video concluded with the following statement: "In conclusion, reading the second United States Constitution, I can't trust the current government because of the ratifications: The government is implying mind

On 12/15/2010, a nearly 1 minute video titled "Hello" was uploaded to Classitup10. The video accused government officials of being corrupt and "in power for their currency."

The Starhitshnaz YouTube profile contained one video which was uploaded on 10/2/2010. The video was approximately 7 minutes long and was titled "America: Your Last Memory In A Terrorist Country!" During the video, five comments by the uploader appear embedded in the video, several of which included language Loughner used in his videos on Classitup10 such as "B.C.E". The five comments, in order they appear within the video are:

- "You didn't know that B.C.E. isn't starting?"
- "I only have my right arm!"
- "Are you not seeing that rare bird on my shoulder?"
- "Are you watching this protest in reverese that's less than 1 second!"
- "I want you never fearing of wrongful incrimination by local police [cult leader]."

In addition, the 2001 song "Bodies," by the metal band "Drowning Pool", played over the first half of the video. The song's lyrics are as follows:
