

THE MAJORITY OF THIS REPORTING INDICATES A POTENTIAL FOR ATTACKS AGAINST U.S. TARGETS ABROAD. ON 6/22/01, THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE {USDS} ISSUED A WORLDWIDE CAUTION WARNING AMERICANS TRAVELING ABROAD OF THE INCREASED RISK OF A TERRORIST ACTION FROM EXTREMIST GROUPS. THE USDS CAUTION EXTENDS THROUGH 9/22/01.

THE FBI HAS NO INFORMATION INDICATING A CREDIBLE THREAT OF TERRORIST ATTACK IN THE UNITED STATES. HOWEVER, GIVEN THE HEIGHTENED LEVEL OF ANTI-U.S. THREAT REPORTING, THE RECENT LIFE SENTENCE HANDED DOWN FOR MOHAMMED RASHED DAOUD AL-OWHALI IN CONNECTION WITH THE 1998 U.S. EMBASSY BOMBINGS, THE CONVICTION OF AHMED RESSAM AND THE ONGOING TRIAL OF MOKHTAR HAOURI IN RELATION TO THE 1999 MILLENNIUM BOMB PLOT, AND THE INDICTMENTS RECENTLY FILED IN U.S. DISTRICT COURT AGAINST 14 INDIVIDUALS SUSPECTED OF INVOLVEMENT IN THE 1996 BOMBING OF KHOBAR TOWERS, THE POSSIBILITY OF ATTACK IN THE UNITED STATES CANNOT NOT BE DISCOUNTED. THE APPROACHING INDEPENDENCE DAY HOLIDAY ON 7/4/01 MAY FURTHER HEIGHTEN THE POTENTIAL THREAT IN THE UNITED STATES AND AGAINST U.S. TARGETS ABROAD.
