Dockers Mourn , At Funeral Hame; Bodyguard Quizzed

 Staff Writer.With the ghosts of men he had ordered violently dispatched to eternity outnumbering mourners at his funeral, Albert Anastasia today was buried quietly and swiftly in Brooklyn's Green-Wood Cemetery.
Only 14 members of the family of the former enforcer of Murder Inc, were at the graveside on a slight rise near 32 nd St. and 5 th Ave. as his body was committeed to non. consecrated ground. He had died as he lived-by assassi-nation-and the rites of the Catholic church had been denied him.

20-Minute CTeremony.
The entire ceremony took 20 minutes and the six-car cortege which had entered the comelery at 25 th St. and 5 th Ave. where about 100 curipus Aved gathered, sped out by anothen exit. The funeral was in sharp contrast to other gangland burials.

No Jong lines of cars, no profusion of Howers Mourners pecupled four cars, troopjed quielly to graveside by sigial, repfated prayers led byla funiral director and just has sileituy returned -to - their autos.

When inother Anastasia brother, Joseph, a dock hiring boss, died last year there was a mile-long cortege, $\$ 15,000$ in floral tributes and a burial casket worth $\$ 6000$. $\$ 900$ Casket.

The cortage left the funeral home at 9:50 a.m: after briel services there for the underworld kingpin said to have fbeen responsible for the death of at least 63 men. In the procession also were Abert's brothers, Anthony (Tough Tony) and Gerardo.
Another brother; the Rev. Salvatore Anastasia, was not at the funeral. But spectators at the cemetery said they rec-- ognized him as the priest who had visited the grave and apparently prayed earller in the morning.

The funeral parior opened at 8 a.m. avd received a steady stream of longshoremen in working attire who filed past the casket and paid their respects to Tony, Brooklyn dock boss. William Bradley, presi dent of the International Long. shoremen's Assn. (Ind.) and his general organizer, Thomas (Teddy) Gleason, were first to arrive. They left shortly there after.
