Summary:

On June 14, 1962, debris boat sweeping bay area one-half mile east of Alcatraz retrieved two packets fashioned from raincoattype material sealed in manner used in preparation of Mae West jackets by subjects. Packets contained photographs and papers connected with Anglin brothers. Also retrieved in the whirlpool were old innertubes and paddle-like pieces of wood. Debris boats, continuing sweeping operations, have located no additional objects or bodies. Coverage to trace any possible movement indicating presence of the escapees is continuing.

SAC Price, San Francisco, called at 8:23 p.m., 6-15-62, and advised of the following developments in the Alcatraz escape case.

A man and his wife approximately 3:30 p.m. PDT, were walking along a section called Cronkhite Beach, an area approximately 3 3/4 miles west of the Golden Gate Bridge, outside the Golden Gate on the Pacific in Marin County. saw an object floating in the surf approximately 50 feet from the shore. Approximately 10 minutes later the object washed ashore and was noted to be a life jacket which was taken by him to the Sausalito Police Department who in turn called the San Francisco Office.

The San Francisco Office has the jacket and an SA working on this case has identified it as identical in makeup and composition and similar to the other life jacket which the San Francisco Office had obtained from subject The jacket is pretty much intact. It has a small tear in one seam which would be sufficient to allow air to escape. The paperclip which was designed to place on the tube of the jacket to hold the air in was missing. The jacket was not torn or cut up. Subject previously stated it was the intention of the subjects to cut and tear up the life jackets when they reached shore and throw them back into the ocean.

SAC Price advised that it still can't be concluded whether or not the subjects had reached shore.

The prison officials gained the impression that Pearson was not interested in the escaped inmates or the investigation to locate them. He appeared interested in the operation of the penitentiary and indicated that it should be maintained in better condition. It appears that Pearson will do one or more articles on Alcatraz Penitentiary.







This is in reply to the Director's inquiry as to whether the Anglin brothers were prosecuted in connection with the attempted escape from U. S. Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas, in 1960 or whether the matter was handled administratively by the Bureau of Prisons.

Our files indicate that on August 8, 1950,
Clarence Anglin attempted to escape by concealing himself
in a metal breadbox which was to be transported to the
Leavenworth Honor Farm. The facts showed that Jahn William
Anglin assisted his brother by pushing the breadboxes, including
the one in which Clarence Anglin was concealed, onto the
elevator from which point they were to be transported to the
Honor Farm. According to testimony of
Supervisor, Leavenworth Penitentiary,
Movement between the breadboxes and after receiving
assistance from the Assistant Food Supervisor, discovered
Clarence Anglin concealed inside, with an iron bar and a
knife in his possession.

Prosecution of Clarence Anglin was authorized of by the U.S. Attorney and on 12/19/60, upon a plea of guilty Anglin was sentenced to two years to run consecutively to the sentence he was then serving on bank robbery.

Assistant U. S. Attorney W. Ray Stewart, Topeka, Kansas, however, declined prosecution of John William Anglia on the basis that insufficient evidence for collusion with Clarence Anglin in the escape was present to serve as a basis for presentment to, the grand jury. The Bureau of Prisons, of course, was fully decised as to the facts of the attempted escape and the prosecutive action taken.

Memorandum to Mr. Evans Re: Frank Lee Morris - FUGITIVE, et al.

ACTION:

1. The Attorney General has been advised by memorandum of the previous Federal escape record of the Anglin brothers at Leavenworth in connection with the data furnished him concerning the Alcatraz escape.

2. Immediately upon learning of the escape from Alcatraz we instructed San Francisco to present the facts to the U. S. Attorney in order to obtain a warrant under the Federal Escape Statute to insure prosecution of these individuals for escape. Complaints charging the three escapees were authorized and filed June 13, 1962, at San Francisco, California.





SUMMARY

Life jacket similar to those reported fashioned by escapees washed up on beach. Drew Pearson made tour of Alcatraz on 6-15-62. He exhibited considerable interest in administration and physical condition of prison. Two expert swimmers sponsored by newspaper and television station swam from Alcatraz to Angel Island in 53 minutes but were taken from water by boats because of whirlpools and battering waves against rocks. Intensive investigation continuing.





With reference to SAC Price's call indicating a possible escape of three individuals from Alcatraz today, Price has now advised that a fourth prisoner has been located who was aware of the escape plot but decided not to risk the attempt. Identities of the escapees have now been established as Frank Lee Morris, Alcatraz No. 1441; Clarence Anglin, Alcatraz No. 1485; and John William Anglin, Alcatraz No. 1476.

The prisoner has advised that life rafts were to be fashioned of a raincoat-type of material and that the plan involved an attempt to go to a second island and thence to the mainland. Some physical evidence near the water's edge indicated activity in the area from which subjects had planned to depart and it, therefore, has been concluded that the prisoners left the Alcatraz Island.

James Bennett, Director, Bureau of Prisons, has advised Mr. Rosen's office of the escape and has stated that the Bureau of Prisons is getting an immediate press release to the effect the escape has taken place.

All-out investigation is being pressed to locate subjects.
