It is further noted that on another occasion furnished information regarding an who was allegedly a girlfriend of Subject MORRIS and who supposedly was working as a barmaid in New Orleans and frequenting bars on Decatur Street. Again New Orleans conducted extensive investigation regarding such a person, including direct inquiry in the Decatur Street area and contact with both but again with negative results regarding such a person.

Consequently, careful consideration should be accorded to any other information may furnish in the future. It is noted that information furnished by this person regarding any New Orleans investigation has never been substantiated and, in fact, has been directly refuted regarding his allegedly observing with Subject approximately a year ago.

This matter was reactivated from a pending inactive status in December, 1966, for the purpose of recontacting relatives, associates, and sources as to whether escapees were alive and as to their whereabouts. These inquiries have been completed and no information has been received that escapees are alive. This matter is being placed in a pending inactive status for one year.






