This is to advise you that by memorandum dated December 11, 1918, received in the Bureau on December 28, 1918, Mr. Payton Ford, the Assistant to the Attorney General advised the Bureau that it is the desire of the Attorney General that the Bureau conduct a thorough investigation concerning Arthur Louis Rugo Eudolph, with particular emphasis on the internal security aspects of the immigration of Eudolph into the United States for permanent residence.

For your information, a number of German scientists and specialists are presently in the United States, all of whom are under the protective custody and control of the Joint Intelligence Objectives Agency. These scientists are employed by the Department of the Army, repartment of the lawy, Department of the Air Force, and in some instances are assigned to private industry.

The Bureau has been furnished with the file of the Joint Intelligence. Objectives Agency which reflects that Rudolph is employed in the field of rocket research and development by the War Department, Ordnance Department, (Ordnance Research and Development Division, Suboffice Rocket), Fort Bliss, Texas.

There are attached hereto for the information of all offices receiving a copy of this letter two photostatic copies of the file of the joint Intelligence Objectives Agency concerning Eudelph which is self-explanatory.

The files of the Bureau do not contain any identifiable derogatory information concerning Rudolph. This information should be reported by the El Paso Office when submitting a report in this passes.

All investigation sust be completed and a report submitted up the Purcoun not later than 30 days from the date of this nem graphings like Bureau is the office of origin in this investigation.

The FI Pase Office and the San Fiego Office are requested to the Control all pertinent information concerning Endelph including his living of the Intelligent and all available derogatory information which would indicate whether Micholl and the presence in the United States is or might be a threat to the Internal security of the United States.



trustworthy and conscientious. He further advised that RUDOLPH has exhibited his ability to retain a confidence. He further considers him as being very serious in regard to future citizenship in this country and considers him a potentially good loyal American citizen.

trustworthy and reliable and knows of nothing which would reflect unfavorably in regard to his attitude toward this country. Further stated he believes that if Mr. RUDOLPH were allowed to become a citizen he would make a very loyal one.

RUDOLPH'S ability and further considers him to be very trustworthy and reliable. He stated he had no information which would indicate that Mr. RUDOLPH's presence in the United States is or might be a threat to the internal security of the United States and recommended him as a potentially loyal American citizen.

He also stated that he considers Mr. RUDOLPH to be a very capable, reliable, conscientious individual, who appears very interested in becoming a citizen of the United States and who, in his opinion, would make a very loyal one.

considers him of very high character and morals and to be a person who would make a very loyal American citizen. He stated in his mind Mr. RUDOLPH would never do anything which would be inimical to the best interests of this country.

impressed with the abilities of Mr. RUDOLPH and further stated that he considers him a very reliable individual and one who would not become a threat to the internal security of this country.

advised she considers Mr. and Mrs. RUDOLPH to be very reliable persons of high character and morals and also persons who, if given a chance, would make good loyal American citizens.

stated he considered the very honest, trustworthy and scholarly individuals. He further stated that in his opinion both Mr. and Mrs. RUDOLPH would make better than average American citizens if allowed to become citizens of the United States. He stated he highly recommended Mr. RUDOLPH for American citizenship. He added he did not consider him a potential threat to the internal security of the United States.

The records of the Merchants Central Credit Association, San Diego, contain no information in regard to Mr. ARTHUR LOUIS HUGO RUDOLPH.

The subversive and criminal files of the San Diego Police Department contain no information in regard to either Mr. or Mrs. RUDOLPH nor was any information available in the files of the San Diego County Sheriff's Office.

Dossier furnished by the Department of the Army, which consists of personal history questionnaire executed by RUDOLFH and the results of the investigation conducted by the Office of the Military Government of the United States in Germany.

According to the questionnaire RUDGLFH was born November 9, 1906 at Stepfershausen/Thuringia, Germany, is a German citizen, married and the father of one daughter. RUDOLFE and his family have recently moved from the military reservation at Ft. Bliss, Texas, where they resided for the past year and a half, to San Diego, California in connection with his official business as a liaison representative with the Solar Aircraft Corporation.

HUDCLER indicates that he attended secondary school at Stepfershauser and attended the Technical School at the University of Berlin, from which he was graduated as a mechanical engineer, and the Institute of Dr. ISIE, in Berlin, where he studied higher mathematics for half a year. RUDOLPH indicates that he attended secondary school at Stepfershausen

> RUDOLPH states that he has a fluent command of both German and English. It is indicated that he received scholarships to study both at the Government school at Schmalkalden and the Technical School at the University of Berlin. In addition he states that he participated in rocket research and development since 1930 and from 1932 to 1934 conducted independent activity in rocket development.

He states that he was a member of various professional engineering societies in Germany, which he states he joined to broaden his technical knowledge and advises that he has published articles on jig and tool design, welding, forging and related subjects, between the years 1930 and 1935 for the Home Study School in Berlin. He indicated that he has been granted patents on *Process and devices for the rapid and continued uniform combustion of liquid fuels for rocket and sircraft. He states that these patents were declared secret and taken over by the German War Department in 1934 or 1935. It was indicated that RUDOLPH lost his papers concerning these patents during the war and cannot remember their numbers.

RUDOLPE lists his employment as that of a development and production engineer and states that from May, 1924 until December, 1934 he was employed by various private firms in Germany as a designer of special tools and devices. It is indicated that from December, 1934 until the end of the war in Germany in 1945 he was employed by the German War Department at various plants engaged in research and development of rockets and guided missiles.

RUDCIPH states in the questionnaire that he served in the German army from March to May, 1937 and from March to May, 1938 in a machine gum, company of the Infantry. He states that he never engaged in any campaigns or operations and was never a member of any organization affiliated with the military. It also indicated that he was separated from the army on each occasion at the termination of his course of instruction.

Under the heading of political affiliations RUDOLPH lists the following organizations of which he was a member in Germany:

MSDAP. 1931-1945. Member. Participation in party meetings, sometimes processions. Only occasional participation after 1932.

SA - Reserve. 1932. Member. Normal service.

NS-Kraftfahr-Korps. 1933-1934. Oberscharfuehrer. Normal service, sports, motor sports.

NS-Bund Deutscher Technick, Reickskolonialbund, Deutsche Arbeitsfront, NS-Volkswohlfahrt, Dates I cannot remember, no activities.

Reasons for joining the NSDAP: Until 1930 I sympathized with the social-democratic party, woted for it and was a member of a socialdemocratic union (Bund Techn. Agst. u.Beamt.)

After 1930 the economical situation became so serious that it appeared to me to be headed for catastrophy (Ireally became unemployed in 1932) The great amount of unemployment caused the expansion of nationalsoc. and communistic parties. Frightened that the latter one would become the government I joined the NSDAP (a legally reg. society) to help, I believed in the preservation of the western culture.

The following affidavit was exacted by RUDOLPH at Ft. Bliss, Texas on May 14, 1947 to explain the above memberships:

- "A) 1) From summer 1931 to the end of the war member of the RSDAP.

 Participation in the weekly party meetings and sometimes in
 the processions; occassional distribution of ballots up to the
 end of 1932. Only ocassional participation thereafter.
 - 2) Member of the SA-Reserve and participation in the normal SA-Reserve service during 1932.

- "3) From about summer 1933 to fall 1934 member of the NSKK (NS-Kraftfahr-Korps). Last rank: Oberscharfuehrer. Participation in the normal weekly service, sports, motorsports.
- 4) Nember of : KSBDT (KS-Bund Deutscher Technik), Reichskolonialbund, DAF (Deutsche Arbeitsfront), NSV (NS-Volkswohlfahrt), I can mot remember the dates. No activities except payment of the monthly fee of membership.

I did not participate in any violent action nor have I had any profit from my membership.

B) Reasons for joining the KSDAP:

Until about 1930 I sympathized with thw socialdemocratic party, voted for it and was a member of a social democratic union, the "bund Technischer Angestellter und Beamter - Butab.

After 1930 the economic situation became more and more serious and in 1931 appeared to me to be headed for catastrophy. I had to visialise myself as unemployed and that really occured in 1932.

The great amount of unemployment caused the expansion of both the national socialistic and the communistic parties. To me it appeared that the latter one of these organizations would become the government.

After a thorough consideration I-decided to join the national social istic party (a legally registered society) in order to help in the preservation of the western culture.

In the years immediately following it did not turn out that my decision had been wrong from a business standpoint. Most that happened seemed reasonable. At the end of 1934 I obtained a job.

During the last few years political developments became more and more serious, but I could not foresee this result when I entered the party.

I, the undersigned, hereby swear (or affirm) that the above statement and data are true and correct.

/s/ ARTHUR RUDOLPH

RUDDITH states that he resided in Germany continuously from 1930 to 1945 and he never traveled outside of the country. He states that he was never arrested and had no connection with the German government.

The following is RUDOLPH's stated reason why he desires to immigrate to the United States:

relieve army

"I believe that the United States as the greatest and most powerful country is the only one that will preserve the western culture and the peace of the world, so giving the people freedom and weal. Further I believe, that the United States with its sence for technical progress will guarantee the research and development of rocketry. I would like to co-operate in the above named tasks for the future, particularly as I have a contract with the United States Government.

RUDOLPH indicated that he will maintain contact with an uncle and a friend who remained in Germany and that at some subsequent date he will seek visas for his wife, MARIHA, age 43, and his daughter, MARIANNE, age 10.

The Office of the Hilitary Government of the United States reported that on the basis of available records RUDOLPH has no existing connection with the former German government and these records do not indicate any possible future participation in any German government not now in existence.

The records of the NSDAP as compiled in Berlin revealed that ARTHUR HUDOLFE was a member of the Party from June 1, 1931. The records of the German Foreign Office, the War Crimes Group and records maintained for use in Denazification proceedings, has failed to develop any further information concerning RUDOLFE.

According to the report, available records do not reveal that there is any indication that there are errangements between RUDOLPH and industries or other organization in Germany concerning his conduct in the United States or the submission of any information by him to organization in Germany.

The OMSUS report concluded that on the basis of available records HUDOLPH was not considered a war criminal, an ardent Nazi, nor in the opinion of the Military Governor likely to become a security threat to the United States.

The files of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D. C. do not contain any identifiable derogatory information concerning RUDOLPE.


At Ft. Bliss, Texas:

advised that RUDOLPH, in his capacity of Laision engineer to one of the sub-contractors, Solar Aircraft Corporation, at the present time was working and residing with his family in San Diego, California. He stated that RUDOLPH has shown excellent capabilities during the period that he was assigned to work at the project and had produced outstanding results in his work. He stated that he has spent some little time in his capacity as Laision man with the Solar Aircraft Company and most complimentary reports have been received from that concern regarding his work.

described RUDOLPH as a very agreeable man who has enjoyed excellent relations with all with whom he comes in contact.

stated that RUDOLPH's conduct since his arrival in the United States has indicated that he is a most responsible person and related that he had no reason to question his sincerity and desire to remain in the United States, and no reason to believe that his presence presents a potential risk to the security of the country.

stated that RUDULH, who is older than the average of the Germans assigned to this project, has an excellent engineering background and is considered a very key person in the production line.

advised that RUDOLPH was also agreeable and pleasant and indicated that in Germany he had lived a good life and was used to the better things. He stated that he could not recall that he had discussed life in Germany with RUDOLPH and did not know the extent of his activities in the Nazi circles. He stated, however, that he felt that RUDOLPH was the type of person who he believed would make a very good citizen.
