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Attached Atlanta teletype advises that since 7/20/79, fifteen black children, aged seven years through fifteen, have been reported missing in Atlanta, Georgia. Eleven of these children have been discovered murdered.

A special task force comprised of officers from the Atlanta Police Department and Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) Agents has been formed to investigate these murders. The Atlanta Division of the FBI has covered numerous leads outside the State, and the facilities of FBIHQ, including the Laboratory and the Behavorial Science Unit, have been utilized to provide assistance in the investigation.

The Mayor of Atlanta, Maynard Jackson, is of the opinion that the FBI should have a legal basis for entering this investigation and has contacted the White House and the U. S. Department of Justice (DOJ) regarding this matter.


On 11/3/80 George Napper, Chief of Police (COP), Atlanta, Georgia, contacted the SAC of the Atlanta Division, John D. Glover, to request additional investigative assistance. SAC Glover advised the COP the facts to date have not determined a Federal violation; therefore, no additional FBI assistance could be forthcoming at this time.


SAC notes that political pressure has prompted local leaders to react to this tragic situation in an emotional manner. As a result, they are creating the impression that the FBI is being less than cooperative in this matter.

The U. S. Attorney, Northern District of Georgia, is attempting to schedule a meeting on 11/4/80 or 11/5/80 with the Atlanta City Attorney, the Public Safety Commissioner and the COP to once again explain the position of the FBI and the DOJ in this matter.

FOR THE INFORMATION OF THE BUREAU, SINCE JULY 28, 1979, FIFTEEN BLACK CHILDREN, RANGING IN AGE FROM SEVEN THROUGH FIFTEEN, ELEVEN OF THESE WERE REPORTED MISSING IN ATLANTA', GEORGIA. CHILDREN HAVE SUBSEQUENTLY BEEN DISCOVERED MURDERED. THE LATEST THIRTEEN OF THE VICTIM WAS DISCOVERED ON NOVEMBER 2. 1988. OF THE PLEVEN DEATHS CHILDREN WERE MALES AND TWO WERE FEMALES. ONE WAS DUE TO GUNSHOT WOUNDS. TWO WERE STABBED, TWO ASPHYXIATED FOUR WERE STRANGLED. TWO BODIES WERE BADLY DECOMPOSED AND THE CAUSE OF DEATH COULD NOT BE DETERMINED THERE DOES NOT TO BE ANY EVIDENCE OF SEXUAL MOLESTATION

OFFICERS AND GEORGIA BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (GBI) AGENTS

ACADEMY, HAS BEEN IN ATLANTA ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS ASSISTING THE TASK FORCE WITH POSSIBLE PROFILES AND MOTIVES OF THE KILLER OR KILLERS. ON NOVEMBER 3, 1980, GEORGE MAPPER, CHIEF OF POLICE, ATLANTA, TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED SAC, ATLANTA, TO REQUEST FBI ASSISTANCE ON A FULL-TIME INVESTIGATIVE BASIS. HE INDICATED THAT TECHNICAL SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE WITH OUT-OF-STATE LEADS WERE OF SOME HELP; HOWEVER, HE WANTED FBI INVESTIGATIVE ASSISTANCE. ADDITIONALLY, CHIEF NAPPER REQUESTED THAT SA ASSIGNED TO THE TASK FORCE ON A FULL-TIME BASIS. HE WAS ADVISED BY SAC, ATLANTA THAT GIVEN PRESENT FACTUAL SITUATIONS REGARDING THE MISSING AND MURDERED CHILDREN, NO ADDITIONAL FBI INVESTIGA-TIVE ASSISTANCE COULD BE FORTHCOMING AT THIS TIME. HE WAS COULD PROBABLY PROVIDE SOME FURTHER ADVISED THAT SA ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE, BUT DUE TO THE NATURE OF HIS ASSIGNMENTS AT THE FBI ACADEMY, HE COULD NOT BE PERMANENTLY DETAILED TO THE WAS CONTACTED AND CONSENTED TO RETURN TASK FORCE. TO ATLANTA ON NOVEMBER 5, 1988 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL AID TO THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR A DAY OR TWO. THIS INFORMATION WAS PROVIDED TO CHIEF MAPPER.

SAC, ATLANTA, HAS REPEATEDLY INFORMED MAYOR JACKSON,
COMMISSIONER BROWN AND CHIEF NAPPER THAT THE FBI LACKS JURISDICTION IN THIS MATTER AND THEREFORE, IS UNABLE TO PROVIDE THE
KIND OF INVESTIGATIVE ASSISTANCE THEY REQUEST. SAC, HAS MADE
IT CLEAR THAT IF THEY COULD PROVIDE INFORMATION THAT WOULD
INDICATE FBI JURISDICTION, THEY SHOULD PRODUCE SAME. TO DATE,
NO SUCH INFORMATION HAS BEEN DISCLOSED. UNFORTUNATELY, POLITICAL
PRESSURE HAS PROMPTED LOCAL LEADERS TO REACT TO THIS TRAGIC
SITUATION IN AN EMOTIONAL MANNER. AS A RESULT, THEY ARE CREATING THE IMPRESSION THAT THE FBI IS LESS THAN COOPERATIVE IN
THIS MATTER. CONSEQUENTLY, SAC, ATLANTA, AND UNITED STATES

Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI), Division of Forensic Sciences, report dated 7/15/80, case \$80-15919, regarding Anthony Carter, reveals two test tubes containing blood which was submitted by investigating officer for examination with the request of BA blood alcohol. Results were positive for ethyl alcohol, 0.15 grams. Results were noted as unreliable, due to putrefaction.

Technician, GBI, Division of Forensic Sciences, has advised that when blood samples of Carter were received, samples were in extreme state of putrefaction and therefore, could not type. She also advised that no swatches from Carter's blood samples were prepared.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to examine the enclosed scrapings and also the stains on the heating vent, which is being submitted under separate cover, to determine if these stains are blood. If determined to be blood, determine if it is human blood. Conduct ABD Grouping, Rh, MN and enzyme typing systems, if determined to be human blood.

The Atlanta office will conduct logical investigation through school, birth, etc., records in an effort to locate medical records and blood types for Anthony B. Carter.





### ADDENDUM: CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION (CID)

It is CID's view that it is premature at this time to commit the amount of Agent manpower from other field offices as requested by SAC, Atlanta. It is noted that although it will undoubtedly be necessary to conduct investigations into those cases where the victims have been found, the initial scope of this FBI commitment is a "preliminary investigation" to determine whether a Federal kidnaping violation exists with regard to the four missing children. Therefore, at the outset it should not be necessary to assign the number of Agents to the murder investigations as envisioned in SAC, Atlanta's plan of attack.

Given the foregoing, CID makes the following recommendations:

1. That a total of eight Special Agents be temporarily assigned to the Atlanta Division to aid in the investigation of the four missing children. SAs Newark Division, and

The Department of Justice announced today the initiation of a preliminary investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation to determine whether four black children missing in Atlanta are being held in violation of the federal kidnapping law.

Attorney General Benjamin R. Civiletti said he is authorizing the step after a review with his advisors of the disappearance of 15 black children, 11 of whom were subsequently found dead during the past 15 months.

Mr. Civiletti stressed that his decision to involve

FBI agents directly in the investigation was designed not

to supplant or duplicate but rather to supplement and

reinforce the local investigation. He said the federal

investigation was being launched at the request of Atlanta

Mayor Maynard Jackson and Public Safety Commissioner Lee Brown.

Since August, the FBI has been providing Atlanta investigators with a variety of technical and expert assistance to ensure that the federal government was fully supportive of their efforts to solve the crimes.

More specifically, the FBI's Behavioral Sciences Unit, forensic laboratory and fingerprint data bank have been at the disposal on an expedited basis to the City of Atlanta. The FBI has arranged for the Atlanta Police Department Task Force to use the services of an expert in visual investigative analysis, a technique that uses visual display media to chart investigators' progress in handling leads and other aspects of a complex case.

The FBI also has assigned an experienced agent to assist in the investigation in a liaison capacity.

"It is my sincere hope," Mr. Civiletti said, "that the initiation of an official federal inquiry will hasten the day when the person or persons responsible for these shocking actions are identified, arrested and prosecuted."


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

This morning I met with Deputy Attorney General Renfrew, Assistant Attorney General Drew Days and his staff to discuss the status of the Klan investigations, both by the FBI and ATF. The Atlanta situation was reviewed and Assistant Attorney General Days agreed to call Mayor Jackson. He later advised that Mayor Jackson was contrite about having been critical of the Bureau but stressed the urgent need for assistance.

I then called Mayor Jackson and went over the misstatements in the newspaper and also in the teletypes. He clarified his own statements and again reiterated that they are most appreciative of what the Bureau/done, but simply need more assistance. I then explained what we were going to do in terms of moving in under the kidnap statute as authorized by the Attorney General, but not to take over or supplant the Atlanta investigation. Mayor Jackson stated that he understood this and asked if I could tell him how many more Agents we were sending him. I told him that it was not our intention to simply put Agents in the street repeating or duplicating work already done, unless we found indications that such work could profitably be redone; that we would be reviewing much of the investigative work to identify new leads and opportunities for further investigation; that we would continue to supply laboratory and behavioral science assistance, and that wherever we established an appropriate avenue of assistance for the Bureau in these areas sufficient resources would be dedicated for those purposes.

I believe that we left on a positive, cooperative note. I did explain to him the problem of having inflamatory statements made from time to time by those who were not professionally engaged in the investigation and he volunteered that it would be better to keep the politicians out of it. I explained that I understood his responsibility as chief executive officer; that we would be working primarily with the Police Department, but that if he had any questions about the work we were doing or the sufficiency of our effort I would appreciate his calling me personally. He agreed to do so.

MEMORANDUM FOR WILLIAM H. WEBSTER, DIRECTOR, FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

During the past fifteen months, fifteen black children have disappeared in Atlanta, Georgia. Eleven of those children have been found dead, one most recently over the last weekend. I am aware of the support already being provided Atlanta officials by the Bureau in their attempt to solve these deaths and disappearances, I have concluded that a higher level of federal involvement is now appropriate.

More specifically, I am now authorizing and requesting that the Bureau initiate immediately a preliminary investigation, predicated on 18 U.S.C. 1201, to determine whether the four missing black children are being held in violation of the federal kidnapping law. In connection with that investigation, it is my expectation that the Bureau will, of necessity, be required to examine the circumstances surrounding the disappearances of the eleven children whose bodies have been recovered. You are authorized to devote whatever resources you deem appropriate, in addition to those presently assigned to this matter, to ensure that the investigation is conducted in an expeditious yet thorough fashion. FBI efforts in this regard should be designed, however, not to supplant or duplicate but rather to supplement and reinforce the local investigation.

DETAILS: Captioned case involved apparent abduction of 15 black children within the past several months in the city of Atlanta, Georgia. The bodies of 11 of these children have been recovered in Atlanta and four remain missing as of this The FBI has entered the investigation of the four missing children as possible kidnapings and it is presently being worked by eight Agents from other Divisions and six Agents from within the Atlanta Division. It has been assigned Major Case #30 and is being followed very closely by FBIHO,

On 11/17/80, a conference was held between Deputy Assistant Director Charles P. Monroe, Criminal Investigative Division (CID), SAC John D. Glover, Atlanta, and Section Chief Wayne R. Gilbert, Personal and Property Crimes Section (PPCS), CID, regarding the use of ISIS in this case. It was generally agreed that institution of ISIS at this point would be somewhat premature due to the lack of a data base at this time. has instituted the use of Visual Investigative Analysis (VIA) but SAC Glover expressed some concern that if a decision is made in the near future to enter the data from this case into. ISIS that it would not be in the proper format. He requested that FBIHQ send an appropriate individual familiar with ISIS to Atlanta in the near future to assess the suitability of ISIS application in this case, either on-line or off-line.

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We in the FBI share concern regarding the recent incidents in Atlanta. On November 6th the Attorney General instructed this Bureau to initiate a preliminary investigation to determine whether any of the four black children missing in Atlanta is being held in violation of the Federal Kidnaping Statute.

Also, since August, we have been providing Atlanta investigators a variety of technical and expert assistance such as the use of our fingerprint and laboratory resources. I want to assure that we are doing everything that we can in order that these tragic matters can be resolved.
