



Attached Atlanta teletype advises that the body of Larry Rogers was recovered on 4/9/81 in apartment 17 at 460 Temple Street, N. W., Atlanta, Georgia.

A fiber recovered from the head area of the victim may be similar to a fiber recovered from previous crime scenes; however, a definite conclusion has not been made by the Georgia State Crime Lab (GSCL).

Other evidentiary items include fibers, hairs, shoe prints, and possible latent fingerprint impressions on two doors and one cabinet.

A green four-door 1972 Buick was recovered near the front door of apartment 17, which is being processed by the GSCL.



RABBI MORRIS SKOP RABBI ALFRED WAXMAN The Rabbinical Association of Greater Miami has issued a Statement expressing its deep concern for the murders of Black children in Atlanta. The Statement was issued in the name of the Association by its President, Rabbi Simcha Freedman of Temple Adath Yeshurun and its Executive Vice president, Rabbi Solomon Schiff, Director of Chaplaincy, Greater Miami Jewish Federation. The Statement reads:

"The members of the Rabbininical Association of Greater Miami view with overwhelming concern the terrible and tragic murders of Black children in Atlanta. We feel a sense of outrage at the perpetrators of these horrendous and savage crimes. Our hearts go out to the families of these innocent victims and we share the sense of frustration and anguish of all the good citizens of Atlanta and our great country over the failure of apprehending those responsible for these heinous acts.

We urge, in the strongest way possible, that no effort be spared by governmental and law enforcement authorities to apprehend those responsible for these despicable acts. We urge them to continue and to redouble their efforts in order to stop these outrages. Only through their apprehension can life be returned to normalcy and peace of mind and security be returned to the community of Atlanta once again.

As Americans and as human beings we state that it is our children who are dying and our brothers and sisters who are suffering the anguish of bereavement.

We urge our co-religionists and all men and women of goodwill to pray for the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Atlanta as well as all in our great country and the capture and punishment of those evil individuals who know not the meaning of friendship, brotherhood and love."

Copies of this Statement are being communicated to the President, Ronald Reagan; Georgia's Governor, George Busbee; Atlanta's Mayor, Maynard Jackson and FBI Director, William Webster.
