(PA), telephone number 717-784-4100, was contacted at his
place of employment by Special Agent (SA)
Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Philadelphia,
PA Division.

Prior to interview was advised of the nature of the intended interview relative to the attempt to identify carpeting sample obtained from the residence of Wayne Bertram Williams, suspect in murders in Atlanta, Georgia, in an effort to identify or eliminate Magee Carpet Company as the manufacturer of Williams' carpet.

furnished the following information:

He advised that Magee Carpet Company presently, Localine June 1976, manufactures only auto fabrication and automobile carpeting. Prior to that date, Magee Carpet Company manufactured residential and commercial carpeting for approximately 90 years. Stated that Magee Carpet Company, in June 1976, sold the Magee Carpet name and rights to manufacture residential and commercial carpeting to Shaw Industries, Dalton, Georgia. In addition to the carpeting manufacturing plant located in Bloomsburg, PA, Magee Carpet Company operated a plant in Perry County from 1966 to closing in 1976.

was shown sample carpeting obtained from the residence of Wayne Bertram Williams, at which time he advised that he does not recall Magee Carpet Company ever manufacturing any residential or commercial carpeting identical to sample specifications. In addition he advised that he does not recall Magee Carpet Company ever making any carpeting that cheap.

furnished Magee Carpet Company voluminous records of carpet, product control specifications of all carpet

manufactured by that company from 1963 to closing of production in 1976, which was reviewed by SA

During review of Magee Carpet Company product control specifications, it was determined that that company never utilized Wellman 181-B, nylon fiber manufactured by Wellman Company, Johnsonville, South Carolina, in their production of carpeting. Magee Carpet Company manufactured various carpet lines utilizing 100% nylon strand fiber under the tradename of:

Dupont 501 Antron II Dupont Chemstran Cumuloft Caprolan

The majority of nylon fiber carpet manufactured by Magee Carpet Company was in the loop pile, carved or tweed pattern.

Magee Carpet Company records further reflect 99% of all carpeting manufactured by that company to be in the 20-ounce to 50-ounce per square yard pile weight category, which does not include the weight of any backing material used. Majority of carpet manufactured in the above category was determined to be within the 25-ounce to 35-ounce per square yard pile weight category. Cut pile carpeting as furnished in Williams' sample was of a small production category, and those listed in the carpet production control specifications did not compare to specifications listed of Williams' carpet obtained from his residence.

advised, and through verification of review of product control specifications for Magee Carpet Company, that Typar latex chemical bonding agent was utilized as a primary backing in the manufacture of carpeting by Magee Carpet Company on a small infrequent basis. Set estimates that Magee Carpet Company utilized the Typar primary backing only in approximately 10% of the company's total production. Jute secondary backing was used extensively by Magee Carpet Company in the 7-ounce, 9-ounce and 10-ounce per square yard weight. He indicated that Magee Carpet Company, on most occasions, utilized 9-ounce or 10-ounce jute backing as the secondary backing in the manufacture of their carpeting. Seven-ounce jute secondary backing is

considered standard throughout the carpeting industry. In addition Magee Carpet Company utilized, in approximately 50% of its later years of carpet production, Polyback secondary backing in its carpet manufacturing.

stated that while in the carpet manufacturing business Magee Carpet Company purchased considerable amounts of their yarn from both Integrated Products, Rome, Georgia, and Modern Fibers, of Calhoun, Georgia. Magee Carpet Company would then normally dye the fiber yarn to their own manufacturing specifications.

Examination of carpet samples manufactured by Magee Carpet Company with comparison of carpet sample obtained from Williams' carpet was determined not to be identical in color variation, pile height, finish weight and other specifications.

advised that carpeting manufacturing has diversified to the point that formerly manufacturing of carpeting and all processes which included the dying of the yarn, weaving and primary and secondary backing was done by the carpet manufacturer. He stated that today, other than the larger carpet manufacturers that these stages of production are subcontracted to various small companies who specialize in one stage of manufacturing.

after examination of Williams' sample carpet, stated that he felt that the sample carpet in question was of a relatively new manufacturing date. His feeling being that the jute backing had not had the opportunity to discolor with age, which is a normal occurrence.

Prior to interview, was advised of the nature of the intended interview relative to residential and commercial carpeting manufactured by Magee Carpet Company and its comparison with carpeting obtained from the residence of Wayne Pertram Williams.

furnished the following information:

was shown the sample of the carpet obtained from Williams' residence after which he stated he does not ever recall Magee Carpet Company ever producing any carpeting of this type or specification.

stated that the primary backing of Williams' sample carpeting is Typar which was also utilized in the carpet manufacturing by Magee Carpet Company; however, only in approximately 10% of total carpet manufacturing. In addition, he further advised that the Typar used in Williams' sample carpeting is of a lighter color than utilized by Magee Carpet Company.

He stated that Magee did manufacture carpeting utilizing seven-ounce, nine-ounce and ten-ounce jute secondary backing; however, approximately half of all production utilized Polyback as the secondary backing.

Magee Carpet Company did not manufacture 100% nylon strand carpeting in a solid color cut-pile weave. Most of

In addition stated that the sample of Williams' carpet obtained from his residence was of too light of a weight, either in finished weight or pile weight as to be manufactured by Magee Carpet Company.
