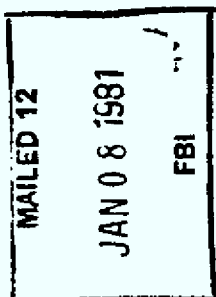

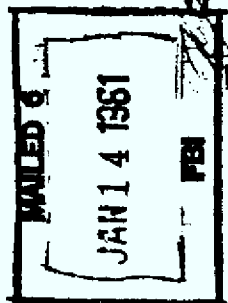

Enclosed for the Identification Division are three latent lifts of fingerprints taken off the bicycle last seen being ridden by the victim.

On 9/4/79, Mrs. Peggy Ellis, mother of the victim, reported Harvey missing to the Atlanta Police Department (APD). Harvey was last seen at the Citizens and Southern (C&S) Bank, Fulton Industrial Boulevard and Old Gordon Road, Atlanta, Georgia. Harvey was riding a yellow ten-speed bicycle when he was last seen.

On 9/8/79, a yellow ten-speed bicycle, identical to Harvey's, was discovered in a wooded area off Fulton Industrial Boulevard.

A crime scene was conducted in the area where the bicycle was found and three latents were lifted from the bicycle by APD Identification Technician Mallory. Harvey's skeletal remains were discovered on 11/5/79.

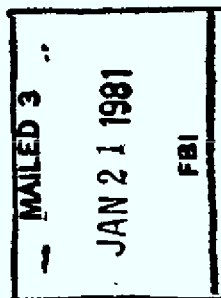

REQUEST OF THE BUREAU

The Bureau is requested to have its Laboratory, Technical Services Division, make a voice comparison of the two calls received from the unknown white male caller on 1/8/81, and 1/15/81 (Enclosure Number 2), and the recorded interview of [REDACTED] on 1/15/81 (Enclosure Number 1), and the test exemplars of [REDACTED] on 1/15/81 (Enclosure Number 2).

The Bureau is further requested to have its Laboratory prepare copies of the enclosed cassette tapes and furnish copies to the following individuals:

- 1) SA [REDACTED] Behavioral Science Unit, FBI Academy, Quantico, Virginia, so that the Behavioral Science Unit can make an analysis of the context of the recordings of the unknown caller and [REDACTED]
- 2) Dr. [REDACTED], via Syracuse Resident Agency of the FBI, Syracuse, New York, in order that a psycho-linguistic analysis can be made of the enclosed recordings.

By way of background information, the Conyers Sheriff's Office, Conyers, Georgia, received a call from an unknown white male on 1/8/81, claiming responsibility for the recent murders in the ATKID investigation. The unknown caller gave directions where the last victim, (Lubie "Chuck" Geter) was buried. The unknown caller did not refer to Geter by name.

A search by the Conyers Police Department and the Sheriff's Office was conducted on 1/9/81, in the area described by the caller with negative results.

Suspect, [REDACTED], was developed by the Conyers Sheriff's Office and interviewed on the morning of 1/15/81. Shortly after interview of [REDACTED] by investigators of the Conyers Sheriff's Office, the Conyers Sheriff's Office received a second call from an unknown white male saying the search was conducted in the wrong area. The unknown caller furnished additional directions where the search should have been made. The Conyers Sheriff's Office

advised that calls from the unknown caller were made from a local convenience store located approximately two blocks from suspect [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] admitted being in the store at approximately the time of the second call; however, [REDACTED] denied making the call to the Conyers Sheriff's Office. b7c

The unknown caller advised he was responsible for the child murders in Atlanta and made an additional threat to kidnap and kill a white child from one of the subdivisions off of Sigman Road in Conyers, Georgia. The unknown caller gave a 2/1/81, deadline in which he would carry out his threat.

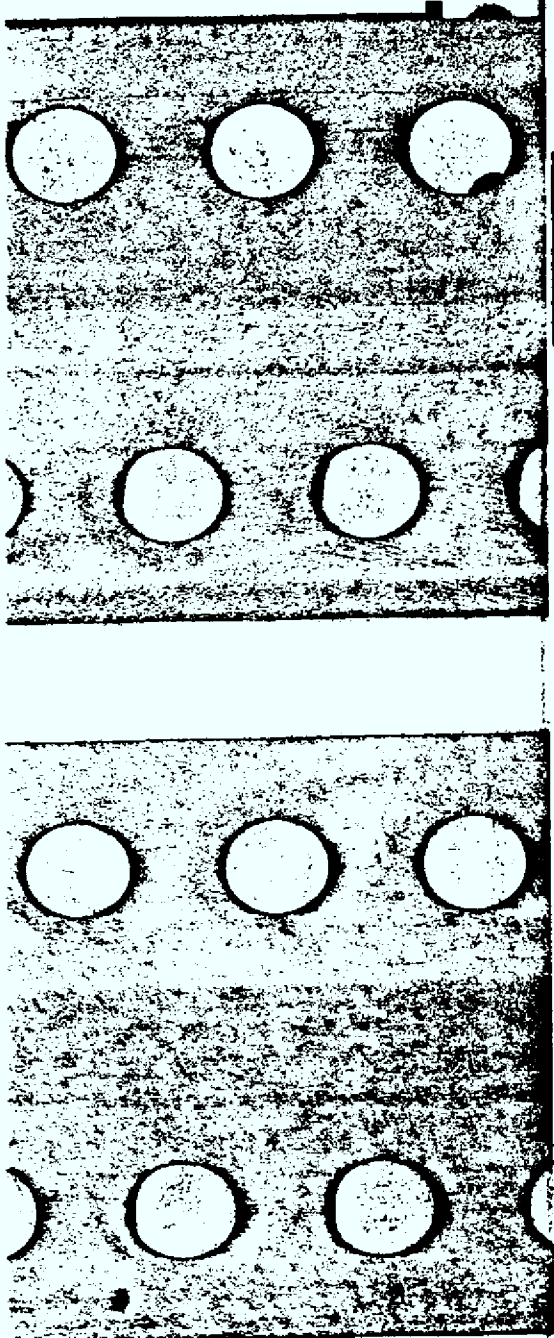

a pair of female panties stuffed in the victim's mouth. There are obvious blood stains on the panties; however, the victim's mouth, at time of discovery, was partially eaten away by rodents. Medical examiner also stated that blood found on panties may have come from purge while Lanier was being strangled.

SUBJECT: Citizen Call Regarding Atlanta Deaths

I recieved a citizen call from [REDACTED] on December 16, 1980. She resides [REDACTED] and can be located by calling [REDACTED] [UNLISTED] or [REDACTED]. She [REDACTED] claims to be psychic. She also claims to be receiving information concerning the deaths in Atlanta.

[REDACTED] has previously contacted the FBI in New York and the Police Department and Special Task Force in Atlanta. She has spoken extensively with Deputy Sheriff [REDACTED] (phonetic) and several unnamed detectives.

[REDACTED] feels that a white twenty-four year old male named [REDACTED] is responsible for all of the deaths of the children in Atlanta. She envisioned him traveling to Atlanta on October 19, 1980 to stay on a farm called the Half Moon in Augusta. She saw [REDACTED] go to the farm and arrest [REDACTED]. She called [REDACTED] and told him not to hurt [REDACTED] if they arrest him because he won't talk if they hurt him; he will talk if they don't hurt him. At this time [REDACTED] denied knowing anything about the farm or [REDACTED]. She now feels that because of telling [REDACTED] this, [REDACTED] was killed or done away with by a white male named [REDACTED]. She found [REDACTED] name in the telephone book at the library (after envisioning it) and saw that he was listed for Marietta, Georgia. She called the operator and was told that his number had been disconnected a few days previously.

[REDACTED] says that both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are klansmen and possibly others working on the Special Task Force on this case. [REDACTED] was killed to cover the klan conspiracy up.

[REDACTED] has also had extensive visions of where the children have been buried. She has passed all this information on to [REDACTED].

She has tried to speak with the Psychic who previously went to Atlanta to work on the case. The Psychic declined to speak with her.

I ran name checks on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] with negative results.

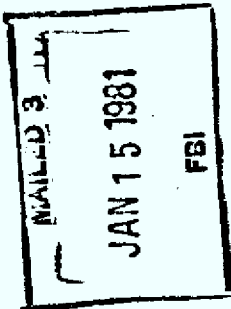

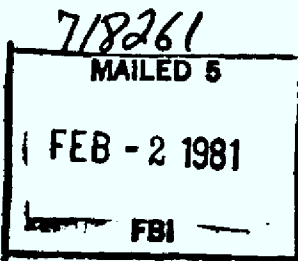
