1/26/81 CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION By attached teletype, Atlanta advises that on 1/23/81, at 7:23 am, Officers of the Rockdale County Sheriff's Office, Conyers, Georgia,

located the body of a black male approximately 14 years of age. Victim apparently strangled and had been dead only a short period of time.

The body was not that of Lubie Geter, the most recent black child to disappear, or any other missing children known in the ATKID investigation.



THE PURPOSE OF THIS TELETYPE IS TO REQUEST BUREAU AUTHORITY
TO EXTEND THIS MAJOR CASE INVESTIGATION AN ADDITIONAL SIXTY DAYS
AT CURRENT STAFFING LEVEL.

THE FOLLOWING IS A CASE BY CASE SYNOPSIS OF INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED TO DATE IN EACH OF THE SIXTEEN SUBCASES COMPRISING THIS MAJOR CASE:

CASES ONE AND TWO - ALFRED JAMES EVANS AND EDWARD HOPE

SMITH: ALFRED JAMES EVANS, BLACK MALE, AGE THIRTEEN AT TIME

OF DEATH, WAS LAST SEEN JULY 25, 1979, IN A VEHICLE DRIVEN

BY ONE

EVANS WAS INITIALLY REPORTED AS A RUNAWAY TO THE DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA, POLICE DEPARTMENT, ON JULY

27, 1979. EVANS' BODY WAS RECOVERED ON JULY 28, 1979, IN THE

SEVENTEEN HUNDRED BLOCK NISKEY LAKE ROAD, SOUTHWEST, ATLANTA.

THE CAUSE OF DEATH WAS PROBABLE ASPHYXIA DUE TO PROBABLE

STRANGULATION. WHILE CONDUCTING CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION,

THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT (APD) DISCOVERED THE BODY OF

EDWARD HOPE SMITH APPROXIMATELY 150 FEET FROM THE BODY OF

EDWARD HOPE SMITH, BLACK MALE, AGE FOURTEEN AT TIME OF

PAGE THREE AT (7A-1835) U N C L A S

DEATH, WAS LAST SEEN AT TWELVE MIDNIGHT ON JULY 20, 1979,

AFTER LEAVING A SKATING RINK IN SOUTHWEST ATLANTA. HE WAS

INITIALLY REPORTED AS A LOST CHILD ON JULY 21, 1979. THE

CAUSE OF SMITH'S DEATH WAS LISTED AS GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE

BACK.

INVESTIGATION HAS CENTERED ON A HOUSE LOCATED AT 1881 NISKEY
LAKE ROAD, SOUTHWEST, ATLANTA, ALMOST DIRECTLY ACROSS THE STREET
FROM WHERE THE TWO BODIES WERE FOUND. THIS HOUSE COULD HAVE
POSSIBLY BEEN THE PLACE WHERE VICTIMS WERE MURDERED. INVESTIGATION
HAS REVEALED THAT PRIOR TO HIS DEATH, SMITH FREQUENTED THE NISKEY
LAKE ROAD ADDRESS WHERE HE PRACTICED KARATE WITH THE RESIDENTS
THERE. THE RESIDENTS OF THE HOUSE,

A ND

ALL

WHO HAVE SINCED MOVED FROM THE RESIDENCE, HAVE BEEN INTERVIEWED.

ADDITIONALLY THE HOUSE HAS BEEN SEARCHED AND PROCESSED FOR LATENT
FINGERPRINTS AND OTHER EVIDENCE OF VALUE. NOTHING OF EVIDENTIARY
VALUE WAS FOUND IN THE SEARCH OF THE HOUSE.

CASE THREE - MILTON HARVEY: MILTON HARVEY, BLACK MALE, AGE
FOURTEEN AT TIME OF HIS DEATH, WAS LAST SEEN RIDING HIS BICYCLE
IN AN INDUSTRIAL AREA OF SOUTHWEST ATLANTA, ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1979.

THE BICYCLE WAS RECOVERED ON SEPTEMBER 8, 1979, BETWEEN HIS HOME AND THE AREA WHERE HE WAS LAST SEEN. ON NOVEMBER 11, 1979, SKELETAL REMAINS OF HARVEY WERE FOUND OFF A ROADWAY SEVERAL MILES FROM HIS LAST KNOWN LOCATION.

AN INDIVIDUAL, HAD BEEN DEVELOPED AS A POSSIBLE SUSPECT, BUT THROUGH INVESTIGATION WAS ELIMINATED. LINE THERE ARE CURRENTLY NO SUSPECTS IN THIS CASE.

CASE NUMBER FOUR - YUSEF BELL: YUSEF BELL, NEGRO MALE,
NINE YEARS OF AGE AT TIME OF DEATH, WAS FOUND DEAD IN AN
ABANDONED SCHOOL ON NOVEMBER 8, 1979. AUTOPSY INDICATED THAT
BELL HAD BRUISES ON HIS BODY, HAD BEEN STRUCK TWICE IN THE HEAD
WITH A BLUNT OBJECT AND DIED AS A RESULT OF STRANGULATION. BELL
WAS LAST SEEN ALIVE AT ABOUT 4:30 P. M. ON OCTOBER 21, 1979, AFTER
HE HAD MADE A PURCHASE AT A LOCAL GROCERY STORE. HE WAS LAST
SEEN TALKING TO A BLACK MALE SITTING IN A BLUE CAR. WITNESS
WHO OBSERVED BELL TALKING TO BLACK MALE NOTED THAT THE BLACK
MALE LOCKED LIKE

HAS BEEN SUBSTANTIATED. INVESTIGATION HAS SUBSEQUENTLY DEVELOPED

ONE INDIVIDUAL BY THE NAME OF SUSPECT IN THE DISAPPEARANCE OF BELL.

THE LAST PERSON TO HAVE SEEN BELL ALIVE,
TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED FOR HYPNOTIC INTERVIEW ON JANUARY 15, 1981.
BACKGROUND CURRENTLY BEING DEVELOPED ON

CASE NUMBER FIVE - ANGELA LANIER: ANGELA LANIER, BLACK
FEMALE, TWELVE YEARS OLD AT TIME OF DEATH, WAS REPORTED MISSING
ON MARCH 4, 1980. SHE WAS LAST SEEN ALIVE AT 7:30 A. M.,
MARCH 4, 1980. LANIER'S BODY WAS DISCOVERED ON MARCH 10, 1980,
APPROXIMATELY THREE BLOCKS FROM HER RESIDENCE, IN A VACANT LOT.
LANIER'S HANDS WERE BOUND WITH AN ELECTRICAL CORD AND THERE WAS
EVIDENCE OF SEXUAL MOLESTATION.

AS A VERY STRONG SUSPECT IN DISAPPEARANCE AND DEATH OF LANIER.

WAS INITIALLY ARRESTED IN JULY, 1988, IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD

WHERE LANIER'S BODY WAS FOUND AND CHARGED WITH GRABBING A CHILD.

AT THE TIME OF HIS ARREST, WAS WEARING A BELT FASHIONED FROM

ELECTRICAL CORD SIMILAR TO THAT USED TO BIND LANIER'S HANDS.

HAS BEEN INTERVIEWED AT LENGHT ON FIVE SEPARATE OCCASIONS
BY FBI AGENTS. IN THESE INTERVIEWS, LAPSES INTO A DREAM

LIKE STATE AND DESCRIBES A DREAM THAT HE HAS HAD. HE SAYS IN

THIS DREAM HE SEES HIMSELF WALKING IN THE WOODS WITH A GIRL

WHO HE CALLS ANGEL. THEN SAYS THAT HE DREAMED THAT FOUR

BLACK MALES CAME UPON HE AND ANGEL IN THE WOODS, THAT THEY KNOCKED

HIM UNCONSCIOUS AND THEN RAPED AND MURDERED ANGEL. IN ALL

OF THESE INTERVIEWS, HAS STOPPED SHORT OF ADMITTING THAT

HE IS IN FACT THE MURDERER OF LANIER.

CASE NUMBER SIX - JEFFERY LANAR MATHIS; MATHIS, BLACK MALE, AGE TEN YEARS OLD IS STILL MISSING. MATHIS WAS REPORTED MISSING BY HIS MOTHER ON MARCH 11, 1980, AFTER BEING SENT TO PURCHASE CIGARETTES. INVESTIGATION INTO THIS MATTER HAS PROVED NEGATIVE TO DATE. ALL LOGICAL INVESTIGATION HAS BEEN CONDUCTED, MEMBERS OF THE VICTIM'S FAMILY, PLAYMATES, SCHOOL TEACHERS AND NEIGHBORS HAVE ALL BEEN INTERVIEWED. VICTIM'S MOTHER HAS BEEN POLYGRAPHED AND PASSED POLYGRAPH EXAMINATION.

CASE NUMBER SEVEN - ERIC MIDDLEBROOKS; ERIC MIDDLEBROOKS, NEGRO MALE, AGE FOURTEEN AT TIME OF DEATH. MIDDLEBROOKS LEFT HOME ON MAY 18, 1980, AT 10:00 P. M. HIS BODY WAS DISCOVERED MAY 19, 1980, AT 7:00 A. M., APPROXIMATELY ONE QUARTER MILE FROM HIS HOUSE. DEATH WAS ATTRIBUTED TO BLUNT TRAUMA TO THE HEAD. HE ALSO HAD FOUR SUPERFICIAL STAB WOUNDS TO HIS CHEST.

INVESTIGATION TO DATE HAS INDICATED EITHER ROBBERY OR REVENGE AS POSSIBLE MOTIVE AND MEMBERS OF NEIGHBORHOOD GANG BEING INTERVIEWED IN RELATION TO HOMICIDE.

CASE NUMBER EIGHT - LATUNYA WILSON: LATONYA WILSON, BLACK FEMALE, AGE SEVEN AT TIME OF HER DISAPPEARANCE WAS REPORTED MISSING BY HER PARENTS ON JUNE 22, 1980. VICTIM APPARENTLY WAS TAKEN FROM HER RESIDENCE IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF JUNE 22, 1980. (HER REMAINS WERE SUBSEQUENTLY DISCOVERED ON OCTOBER 18, 1980, IN A WOODED AREA APPROXIMATELY ONE HALF MILE FROM HER RESIDENCE. LOGICAL INVESTIGATION TO DATE IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND INTERVIEWS OF EYEWITNESSES TO ABDUCTION HAS REVEALED TWO BLACK MALES LURKING IN THE VICINITY

OF WILSON APARTMENT MORNING THAT SHE DISAPPEARED. IDENTITIES

OF THESE TWO BLACK MALES HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED. POSSIBILITY

AND DEATH.

CASE NUMBER NINE - CHRISTOPHER RICHARDSON: CHRISTOPHER RICHARDSON, BLACK MALE, AGE ELEVEN AT TIME OF HIS DISAPPEARANCE, WAS REPORTED MISSING BY HIS MOTHER ON JUNE 9, 1980, TO DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA, POLICE DEPARTMENT. VICTIM WAS LAST SEEN ON THE AFTERNOON OF JUNE 9, 1980, WALKING TOWARD A LOCAL SWIMMING POOL.

ALL LOGICAL INVESTIGATION INCLUDING AREA SEARCHES AND OTHER LOGICAL INVESTIGATION HAS FAILED TO DEVELOP ANY SUSPECTS IN THIS MATTER. ON JANUARY 9, 1981, SKELETAL REMAINS OF TWO CHILDREN WHERE FOUND BY JOINT APD AND FBI SEARCH TEAM AND ONE OF THESE HAS BEEN POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED AS THAT OF CHRISTOPHER RICHARDSON.

CASE NUMBER TEN - ANTHONY CARTER: ANTHONY CARTER, BLACK
MALE, AGE NINE AT TIME OF DEATH, WAS LAST SEEN ON JULY 7, 1980.

CARTER WAS FOUND STABBED TO DEATH ON SAME DATE WITH HIS
BODY BEING LOCATED BEHIND A WAREHOUSE IN AN INDUSTRIAL AREA.

NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTIGATION AND OTHER LOGICAL INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED TO DATE HAS DEVELOPED

AS STRONG
SUSPECT IN CARTER'S DEATH.

POLYGRAPHED BY FBI. SHE HAS FAILED THE FBI POLYGRAPH EXAMINATION
AND HAS INDICATED TO POLYGRAPHER THAT SHE INDEED DID KILL
HOWEVER, SHE RECANTED THIS STATEMENT ON SUBSEQUENT INTERVIEW.

POLYGRAPHED REGARDING HER KNOWLEDGE OF CARTER'S DEATH AND HAS
ALSO FAILED THE FOLYGRAPH EXAMINATION. HOWEVER, NEITHER
NOR WILL PROVIDE ANY FURTHER INFORMATION TO INTERVIEWING
AGENTS.

CASE NUMBER ELEVEN - EARL LEE TERRELL: EARL LEE TERRELL,
NEGRO MALE, AGE TEN AT TIME OF DISAPPEARANCE. TERRELL WAS LAST

ON HIS WAY BACK FROM SUPERMARKET, JONES WENT OFF ON HIS ON TO PICK UP DISCARDED ALUMINUM CANS. ON AUGUST 21, 1980, AT 1:05 A. M., JONES' BODY WAS RECOVERED NEAR A TRASH CONTAINER IN THE REAR OF SHOPPING PLAZA.

CASE NUMBER TWELVE - DARREN GLASS: DARREN GLASS, NEGRO MALE, AGE TEN AT TIME OF DISAPPEARANCE WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM HIS RESIDENCE ON SEPTEMBER 14, 1980, AND IS STILL MISSING.

GLASS REPORTEDLY TOLD HIS FOSTER BROTHER THAT HE WAS RUNNING AWAY TO THE HOME OF HIS UNCLE. GLASS NEVER ARRIVED AT THE HOME

OF THE UNCLE. INVESTIGATION TO DATE HAS INCUDED THE IDENTIFICATION AND INTERVIEW OF FAMILY MEMBERS, FOSTER FAMILY MEMBERS, LOCAL POLICE OFFICERS, FAMILY SERVICE OFFICERS. ALL INVESTIGATION HAS PROVED NEGATIVE, NO SUSPECTS DEVELOPED. ON JANUARY 9, 1981, A JOINT SEARCH CONNECTED BY THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE ATLANTA FBI LOCATED, THE REMAINS OF TWO SMALL CHILDREN. POSSIBILITY EXISTS ONE OF THESE TWO REMAINS MIGHT BE THAT OF GLASS.

CASE NUMBER FOURTEEN - CHARLES STEPHENS: CHARLES STEPHENS, NEGRO MALE, AGE TWELVE AT TIME OF HIS DEATH, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM HIS RESIDENCE ON OCTOBER 9, 1980. STEPHENS WAS LAST SEEN AT A GROCERY STORE SEVERAL BLOCKS FROM HIS RESIDENCE (AT APPROXIMATELY 8:30 P. M., OCTOBER 9, 1980. STEPHENS' BODY

Attached Atlanta teletype advises the body of Lubie Geter was discovered 2/5/81 near Vandiver Road in the Southwest section of the city. The body, clad only in undershorts, had been mutilated by animals. An autopsy will be performed 2/6/81 to determine the cause of death. As in the other murder cases in this investigation, no evidence of sexual molestation has been determined.

For additional background information, Geter, aged 14 years, has been missing since 1/3/31. On that date, victim was driven to the Stewart Lakewood Shopping Center by his brother for the purpose of selling small cans of car deodorizer.

A crime scene search will be conducted during the daylight hours of 2/6/81. The results of the search and the results of the autopsy will be forthcoming.
