



By way of background investigation, the Conyers Sheriff's Office, Conyers, Georgia, received a call from an unknown white male on 1/8/81, claiming responsibility for the recent murders in the ATKID investigation. The unknown caller gave directions where the last victim was buried.

A search by the Conyers PD and Sheriff's Office was conducted on 1/9/81 in the area described by the caller with negative results.

On 1/31/80, a telephone call was made by an unknown white male to the principal of the Pine Street Elementary School, Conyers, Georgia. The caller advised the principal that he was going to abduct a white child from that school by 2/1/81.

No hairs or fibers of value for comparison purposes were found on specimens Q13 and Q14.

Specimens Q15 and Q15A consist of the head portions of two shotshell casings, both of Remington-Peters manufacture. Specimen Q15 is of 12-gauge and Q15A is of 20-gauge. Specimen Q15 contains some very limited microscopic marks of possible value for comparison purposes. Specimen Q15A does not contain any microscopic marks of value for comparison purposes.

Both Q15 and Q15A are badly corroded with their original paper body's disintregrated. Also, the headstamps in Q15 and Q15A have not been used by Remington for at least 20 years.

If the Q15 shotshells were subjected exclusively to natural environments, the metallurgical characteristics exhibited are indicative of relatively lengthy exposure to such environments.

No serological analyses were conducted upon the Q16 cigarette butt due to the potentially more valuable latent fingerprint request.



By attached teletype, Atlanta advises that on 1/23/81 the body of a young black male identified as Terry Lorenzo Pue, age 15, was found in Rockdale County, Georgia. Pue was last seen alive at 4:30 pm on 1/21/81 while enroute to a basketball game.

On 1/8/81, the Rockdale County Sheriff's Office received an anonymous call indicating that the body of Lubie Geter could be located on Sigmon Road. Two subsequent searches in the area described by the anonymous caller were conducted with negative results; however, Pue's body was located on Sigmon Road within a mile of the areas previously searched.

The Atlanta Division, in conjunction with the Atlanta Police Department, continue actively searching for Lubie Geter. In an additional investigative effort, a total of 15 separate shopping centers are under surveillance by four man teams to locate any Negro male and a young

Negro male who may be in the area.

Pue has been added to the list of murdered children in the Atlanta area, bringing the total to 17 Black children which have disappeared in the last 19 months. Fourteen of the children have been found murdered and three remain missing.







By attached teletype, Atlanta advises that on Friday morning, 1/30/81, a meeting was held in the Office of Maynard Jackson, Mayor, Atlanta, Georgia. In addition to Mayor Jackson, numerous city officials of Atlanta were present as well as Acting Deputy Attorney General (DAG) Renfrew and Ken Starr, Counsel to the Attorney General.

At the outset, Mayor Jackson indicated his pleasure with the cooperation he has received to date from the FEI toward solution of this investigation; however, Mayor Jackson requested assistance through the Federal Government in other areas relating to this investigation. He cited the areas of crime prevention, mental health, and funding of equipment as those areas in which he requests Federal Government assistance.

Acting DAG Renfrew informed the group that he was in Atlanta at the request of President Reagan and sees himself as a conduit for information which will be passed on to the Attorney General and subsequently, to other appropriate officials.

Following the 45 minute meeting, a brief press conference was held, after which Renfrew and Starr returned to Washington.







The results of the grouping tests conducted upon the human blood identified on Q12 were inconclusive.

No semen was identified on Q12. No analyses were conducted for the presence of saliva due to the location of Q12 when recovered.

There were no hairs of value for microscopic comparisons found on specimen Q12; however, one black head hair fragment of Negroid origin was found on this specimen. All foreign textile fibers found on specimen Q12 have been preserved. The elasticity of the waistband of this garment appears to be normal or near normal. Accordingly, there is no indication the garment was stretched beyond recovery limit.

No soil was found on or in the debris removed from specimen Q12 which could be compared with specimens K7 through K11.
