Reference is made to Bureau letter dated July 20, 1944, stating it is satisfactory to use the services of the subject organization according to terms previously outlined in a letter to the Bureau.

Dr. De LASARTE, head of this organization in Argentina, recently requested that the monthly amount paid to him be increased from \$2,000 to \$3,000 (U.S.) per month. He was advised that this request would be transmitted to Washington, and that the decision must be made there. He was told that in connection with this request it would be advisable to submit a detailed list of expenditures presently being made by him in connection with investigations for this office and a further detailed explanation be made as to how he proposed to spend the additional sum. He has indicated an unwillingness to do this and has submitted only a general statement as to investigation performed to date and his proposal for increasing investigative facilities in the future. Dr. De LASARTE stated that he does not wish to reveal details concerning his organization for security reasons, thinking that the information might possibly fall into other hands enroute to Washington or here.

It is known that De LASARTE proposes renting at least two more offices for our investigative purposes but other details concerning how he intends to spend the increase are unknown. Inasmuch as the information being submitted by this organization has not yet reached the value of \$2,000 per month, it is recommended that the increase not be granted.

There are being forwarded with this letter two envelopes containing private correspondence between [redacted] and JOSE A. [redacted]

Reference is made to Bureau letter of May 3, 1944, in connection with the above matter.

This is to advise that the writer has contacted [REDACTED] and has delivered the letter forwarded with the Bureau communication of May 3. In connection with financial arrangements, the writer was advised that the organization in Chile had been receiving \$400 per month, forwarded by the Basque Government in exile, but that during recent months this has not been sent. That this money is no longer being sent is, no doubt, due to the change in financial arrangements which was mentioned in the Bureau letter. The writer advised that he was ready to continue the financial aid but he would first like to have some idea as to expenditures so that a reasonable sum could be arrived at. [REDACTED] said that he would, of course, be glad to receive any amount which the writer might think could be expended, but it was evident from his manner that he would be disappointed if he were not to continue receiving the \$400 monthly or substantially that amount. It did not seem to the writer that the breakdown as to expenditures of the organization in Chile showed a necessity for an amount that large considering that this money is reimbursement for actual expenses of the organization. However, in view of the Bureau's desires in this matter, it is felt that rather than cause any hard feeling between the Basque leaders and this office, it would be well not to be too exacting in demanding an accounting. Accordingly, the writer intends to reach an agreement calling for the expenditure of \$400 or somewhat less per month and the writer will endeavor to tactfully review the manner in which this money is being spent toward the end of eliminating any unnecessary expenditures.

With regard to the usefulness of this organization as informants, it should be stated that there is a fairly large Basque Colony in Chile and [REDACTED] They can be used locally in connection with Communist matters and maritime matters, but it has been noted that their information is usually rather sketchy and not thorough. In their favor it must be said that the Basques appear to be sincere and their reports are not written for mercenary purposes.

Reference is made to the Santiago letter of July 25, 1944 in connection with the above-captioned matter. This is to advise that the writer has been in conference with [REDACTED] and it has been decided that since the Basque Organization during June and July had been expecting to receive its quota of \$400.00 per month, this sum be paid for those two months. The amount to be paid in the future will be determined on the basis of a trip which a member of the Office of the Legal Attaché will make in the company of a Basque Agent throughout the South of Chile.

During this trip the various Basque local representatives will be contacted and the value and performance of each such representative will be estimated. It is felt that after this trip is completed a new figure can be arrived at which will be a fair reimbursement to this organization for its intelligence activities. At present since no member of the Office of the Legal Attaché has ever made a comprehensive survey of Basque Intelligence coverage, it is most difficult to state whether or not the funds heretofore utilized by the organization have been effectively and efficiently used in the intelligence coverage or not.

By letter from Buenos Aires to this Office dated June 7, 1944, it was learned that Dr. Jose Maria de Lasarte, Chief of the Basque Intelligence Service in Buenos Aires, was planning a trip to Montevideo and Santiago in the near future. The Buenos Aires Office informed this Office by cable dated July 10, 1944, that de Lasarte was proceeding to Montevideo within the next few days.

On July 12, 1944, Sr. de Lasarte was interviewed by the writer. He advised that his Organization had in the past been in close collaboration with the Office of the Military Attache in Montevideo and that he was desirous of establishing contact with the Office of the Legal Attache with a view toward developing close working relations in the future. Sr. de Lasarte advised that for the present it was desirable that contact be maintained with the Military Attache but that he was hopeful that close collaboration could be worked out between his Organization and this Office.

On the following date, Sr. de Lasarte introduced the writer to [REDACTED]

In conversations with [REDACTED] it was ascertained that he presently has numerous potential contacts in [REDACTED] which up to the present time have not been fully exploited because of lack of financial resources. It is noteworthy that [REDACTED]

Arrangements were made whereby [REDACTED] will receive 300 Uruguayan pesos (approximately \$155 U.S.) per month on an experimental basis for investigative purposes in connection with this office. [REDACTED] will appoint 8 [REDACTED] of this sum to Basques who are in his employ. This arrangement, whereby [REDACTED] will receive 300 pesos per month, is on a temporary basis, however, subject to [REDACTED]

2. Political developments in Uruguay with particular emphasis on the activities of the Herrerista Party as they figure in the case entitled REVOLUTIONARY PLANS FOR LATIN-AMERICA SPONSORED BY THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT
3. Political developments in Argentina

With regard to the third topic, the possibilities will be explored for having this Organization develop an information channel from Argentina to Uruguay which could function effectively in the event an emergency arises. This arrangement would, if possible, supplement that worked out between the Buenos Aires Office and the Basque Organization in that city. X

Reference is made to Bureau letter dated July 14, 1944,
enclosing a letter from Special Agent in Charge E. E. Conroy of the
New York Field Division dated July 23, 1944, concerning the captioned
organization and a second enclosure to be delivered to [redacted]

This is to advise that the handling of the Basque organi-
zation has been assigned to Special Agent [redacted] who has
been in regular contact for the past two weeks with heads of the or-
ganization here and has worked out an arrangement for their coopera-
tion with this office.

It will be recalled from my letter to the Bureau dated
June 1, 1944, reporting the several conversations had with Mr. IRLA
on his recent trip through Mexico City that no satisfactory agreement
was reached at that time for a working arrangement with the Basques
and this office. The difficulties preventing such an agreement ap-
peared to stem from the refusal of this office to pay the flat sum of
\$750 to [redacted]

[redacted] but in turn to request that the Basques furnish five men
to be used as full-time investigators by this office at a monthly
salary of approximately 300 pesos each and all expenses. The apparent
failure of Mr. IRLA to work out a possible compromise arrangement
agreeable to the local Basque organization before his departure indi-
cated that he may have encountered difficulties with [redacted] co-
cerning the proposed arrangement and method of payment. This possi-
bility has been substantiated in subsequent conversation with [redacted]
at which time he has indicated a strong desire to continue
to receive the \$750 monthly.

Upon receipt of referenced letter from the Bureau, the en-
closure from President AGUIRRE was delivered to [redacted] as requested.
He seemed very much impressed by the letter and appeared to fully

I feel however, that the danger of falling for the time being under provisional regimes which would not be lacking in support, both within and without the country, would compel us to subordinate doctrinary aspirations to measures of public security of imperative urgency. The following points are therefore in my opinion of capital importance:-

1. The Unity of the Catalans.

I do not overlook the fact that this would have to be based on a far-reaching revival, difficult to achieve out-of-hand. Nevertheless the special characteristics of the Spanish problem, for which no automatic solution might be found with the Nazi collapse - the reverse of what will happen in the countries at war - impose upon the necessity for "speed" above anything else.

2. An active entente with the BALEARICS and CANARIANS and all who reject absorption into the unitary system. These will be as useful to us, or still more useful, tomorrow as they are today. This entente should be negotiated without going to the extent of accepting policies from them which might appear to us lacking in possibilities of realization.

3. An entente with all Spanish democrats fighting against Francoism; and opposed to any possible "pseudo dictatorial" regimes which are the greatest danger at the moment. I hope I shall not have to furnish proofs of our unwavering nationalist outlook, but I have no immediate pointer which permits me to believe that we shall find any external support. You will know best what support you have. I understand from hearsay that you are counting upon reasonable elements in the federal problem of Spain. I insist however that from here I cannot detect them. In other respects also the Spanish problem, taken as a whole, is traversing moments of such delicacy as to make it inadvisable to alienate the sympathies of our friends the Spanish liberals whom we need, or to run the risk of facilitating through lack of unity on our part the establishment of regimes totally unacceptable both from the Catalan and the liberal democratic point of view.

4. Unity has not to be static but dynamic - i.e. directed towards action in all fields.

I have every confidence in the Catalans citizen. I even believe that when the hour of peace strikes we shall have friends and adversaries as well. But it is not fair to place the onus for everything on the shoulders of the people over there. We also have to plan, as they expect of us, and if we are not prepared to act our problems are likely to be overlooked.

5. No one doubts that action could be undertaken in London as well as in Algiers, and now in Paris and Perpignan and Washington. It is a pity you did not visit America. The means to do so would have been forthcoming.

Everything possible should be done to make our exiles shed that air "emigres - who-earn-their-bread-abroad" and who have greater hopes of returning to their native land than they have stomach to fight.

I also think that, unless you hold some master-card which I have not the means of knowing from here, an immediate understanding should be arrived at. It is more important that you should survive and that our values of experience and a truly renovating spirit should survive that to continue upholding policies which are ever receding further from each other without concrete advantage.

I do not ignore the diversity of factors which come into play. I am in correspondence with friends everywhere and am upholding the policy you may perhaps have read in "Germania" - the Catalan review in Chile - which has the virtue of sincerity and of saying what I think without fear of "compromising attitudes" which is another of the drawbacks of our exile. For me personally and the welcome I find there. I am desirous to continue it.

P.S. I see that MIRRI has just resigned his diplomatic functions in Madrid. I am watching with great interest

SYNOPSIS: On 6/9/44 the letter of instructions forwarded by the Bureau to Mr. [redacted] in Lima, Peru, from President JOSE ANTONIO DE AGUIRRE, representative of the Basque government in exile, New York, was delivered. This letter instructed [redacted] to cooperate exclusively with the office of the Legal Attache. [redacted] expressed his willingness and desire to do so. There are approximately 80 Basques in Peru, 30 of whom reside in Lima. [redacted] who was previously contacted by this office in December 1942, is known by the Informant Symbol [redacted]

COMMENTS: This office has maintained contact with the Basque organization in Lima, Peru, since 1942. During this time, information furnished by them has not been of particular value. There is set forth in instant report information regarding the scrutiny given the Basque group in Lima by the Peruvian Government and, for this reason, together with the fact that they are few in number and not well organized, it is believed they will not develop into valuable informants. [redacted] was advised that arrangements had been made whereby this office could reimburse him for expenses incurred in investigations on our behalf. However, he stated that such would not be necessary since he was receiving \$100 monthly for his expenses from his organization in New York. (S)

It is suggested that appropriate arrangements be made with the Basque organization in New York whereby a sum sufficient to meet the Basque administrative expenses in Lima be forwarded them. (S)

This report is being placed in a closed status. [However, regular contact will be maintained with the Basque group in Lima and the Bureau will be advised as to their development.] (S)

This report is not being made available to the American Embassy in Lima for obvious reasons.

On Jan. 2, 1944, a letter of instructions forwarded by the Bureau to [redacted] Lima, Peru, from President Jose Aguirre, representative of the Basque Government in exile, New York, was delivered. This letter instructed [redacted] to cooperate exclusively with the office of the Legal Attaché in Lima. At this time, [redacted] was advised that the office of the Legal Attaché could arrange for the immediate forwarding of Basque administrative matters via airmail to President Aguirre in New York, which material would not be examined by other Governmental agencies.

[redacted] expressed his willingness and personal desire to cooperate with this office in any manner in which his services could be utilized. He was first contacted by this office in December 1942 and his services, which have been specified in past reports in this Office as Informant [redacted] together with those of various other members of the Basque group, have been employed when the occasion arose since that time. [redacted] has been contacted frequently and has furnished information regarding members of the Spanish Embassy and Spanish nationals under investigation.

Regarding the Basque organization in Peru, [redacted] related that there are approximately 50 Basque nationals in Peru, of which number 30 reside in Lima and the remainder throughout the interior of Peru. This group has been represented in Peru for many years and the average stay of the individuals comprising the Basque organization here would be more than 14 years each, according to [redacted]. This group came to Lima without funds and the majority are small business and employees.

There is no Basque society in Lima or in the rest of the country. All Basques are organized in the Delegation of the Basque Government which depends directly on Jose Aguirre, JOSE ANTONIO DE AGUIRRE, in New York. The Delegation of the Basque Government in Lima, according to [redacted] is made up of the following individuals:

[REDACTED] advised that this Board of Directors and the Basque organization do not hold regular meetings inasmuch as the Peruvian Government would immediately quash such and take retaliatory measures. He explained this by relating that the Peruvian Government considered the Basque Organization Communist because of the Basque belief in the democratic form of government where individual members of society choose their own political affiliations and creeds and because of the Basque principles opposing all despotic forms of government. The Peruvian Government seems to take the view that a Basque or a Spanish Republican would necessarily be either pro-France or, to the other extreme, a Communist. Consequently, the Peruvian Government does not permit Basque and Republican Spanish immigrants to Peru although there are no immigration laws definitely prohibiting such. Thus, the same result is reached although the Peruvian Government does truthfully say that such immigration is not prohibited.

Information has previously been furnished the Bureau in the report entitled "SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY OF THE SPAINISH ACTIVITIES," dated at Lima, Peru, August 8, 1942, in which, concerning Spanish immigration, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised that because of such an attitude on the part of the Peruvian Government no meetings of the Basque group are held; neither do they try to make themselves public politically since the Peruvian Government would take measures against them to further control their activities. To put it simply, according to [REDACTED] the Basque group is so small that they are afraid to have regular meetings, being practically assured that retaliatory action would be taken by the government. Also, [REDACTED] advised, the Basques in Peru had political persons to defend them.

Although the Basques do not hold regular meetings they do occasionally meet at small luncheons where some activity is carried on and a few social gatherings when the opportunity so affords.

b7C
b7D [redacted] continued that the Basque Delegation in Lima is in contact with the Basques in Arequipa, Cuzco, Cerro de Pasco, Trujillo, Chiclayo, Piura, Iquitos, Tacna, and Pisco. However, these groups are extremely small, often consisting of no more than two or three individuals. Inasmuch as most of these individuals move from one city to another frequently, the Basque groups outside of Lima are poorly organized.

[redacted] advised that he was cognizant of the cooperation given our organization by the Basque groups in other South American countries, especially in those cities where the Falange is active. He said that his group would endeavor to furnish the Office of the Legal Attache with all information coming to its attention regarding subversive activities. However, he stated that subversive activities were at a minimum in Lima at present owing to the fact that virtually all of the important Axis nationals had been deported for detention in the United States. Too, the Falange was practically non-existent. The Spanish nationals in Peru who formerly participated in Falange activities, fearing that restrictive action might be taken against them, are very careful to refrain from engaging in any activities for which they could be criticized.

[redacted] attention was called to the fact that the Bureau was interested in the investigation of Communist activities. He stated that he would try to ascertain what information he could relative to the Communist organization in Peru. However, he felt that it was not strong and that the strongest "People's Party" was the Aprista Party.

[redacted] was advised that arrangements had been made by which a payment could be made to his organization for expenses incurred during the investigations on behalf of the Office of the Legal Attache. He replied that he had been receiving \$100 (U. S. currency) monthly from the Basque Government in exile in New York and added that this was sufficient to meet his needs. For that reason, he advised, he would gladly lend any possible assistance.

Reference is made to a letter from this office to the Bureau dated April 25, 1944, entitled "Basque Organization in Venezuela -- Venezuela - Administrative," in which it was stated that contact had been established with [REDACTED] a Basque, [REDACTED]

This is to advise that, on September 26, 1944, the SS Cabo de Buena Esperanza again touched Venezuela at Puerto Cabello. Contact was made with [REDACTED] who was interrogated at length concerning the activities of the crew members of the aforementioned boat to determine the existence of couriers, smugglers, espionage agents and the transportation of radio sets. He was also questioned concerning the past and present contacts made by these crew members, including the ship's officers, in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

The information furnished by [REDACTED] was entirely negative. He was also questioned concerning the shipment of machinery, technical equipment, and similar apparatus from Spain to South America. He again stated that he had no information indicating such shipments. The interview covered the diversified fields of the Bureau's jurisdiction but no information of a positive nature was obtained.

Attached you will find a letter addressed to [redacted] written to him by President AGUIRRE of the Basque Delegation in New York City. This letter is being written to [redacted] in response to the Legal Attache's letter of September 14, 1944.

Substantially, the letter of President Aguirre's advises [redacted] that under no circumstances is he to pass on any information to members of the State Department in Havana or to any other Governmental agencies other than the Bureau's representatives.

For the confidential information of the Office of the Legal Attache in Havana, ANTONIO IRALA, Secretary, and JOSE ANTONIO DE AGUIRRE, President of the Basque Delegation, agreed substantially with the estimate of [redacted] as set out by the Office of the Legal Attache in Havana, Cuba. They have no faith in him and intend eventually to replace him with another political delegate. The reason he has not been replaced up to now is due to the unimportance of Cuba in the Basques' scheme of things politically. Both these Basque officials requested that if [redacted] conduct is not acceptable after his receipt of the attached letter and advised by Bureau representatives, they will take further administrative steps with respect to [redacted].

It is believed that this will meet the needs of the Legal Attache in Havana, Cuba with respect to the above captioned organization.

The foregoing information was brought about due to a conference between Jerome Doyle of the New York SIS office and ANTONIO IRALA, Secretary of the Basque Delegation, in New York City.

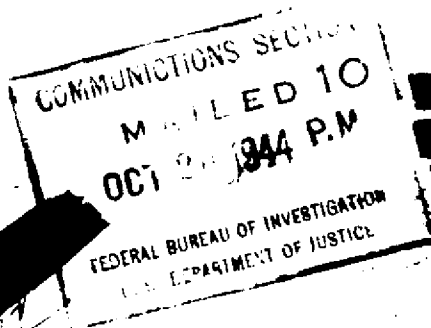

Reference is made to Santiago radiogram of September 16, 1944 and Bureau radiogram of September 18, 1944 both in connection with the above-captioned subject.

This is to advise that as a result of prolonged discussions with JOSE MARIA de LASARTE, Basque representative, it was agreed that beginning with September 1944 that organization would receive from this office 8,500 pesos per month, this being a reduction from the approximately 12,000 pesos per month which had been paid until recently. Since no payments had been made for four months due to the disorganization of the local Basque representatives and their desire to await the arrival of LASARTE, the past obligations of this office to the Basque Organization were settled for 15,000 pesos or a little bit more than one month's payment under the prior system. This reduced settlement figure was reached when the Basques were unable to show any satisfactory reason why they should receive more during the past few months of their relative inactivity.

The understanding was also reached whereby the sum of 8,500 pesos to be paid henceforward could be adjusted either up or down in keeping with the results obtained. This represents money for salaries of two men fulltime, for all entertainment done in Santiago, and also for certain operational expenses of the Basque Legation which LASARTE considered as the "cover" for operations.

It was also arranged that one of the two Basque Intelligence operators who is supposed to be working full time for this office should contact a Special Agent of this office on a daily basis, thus providing this office with a better idea of the activity or lack of activity of the Basque organization and also provide a means for giving them some apparently much needed instruction in the obtaining of intelligence information.

It was also agreed that the two full time Basque Intelligence Agents would be free to and would be expected to make such trips outside of Santiago as the leads given them might require, and for this they are to be reimbursed for actual expenses paid out. They had previously desired a flat sum per month for road trip expenses.

An Agent of this office will shortly make a trip to the south of Chile with the Basque operators in order to become acquainted with their local representatives, and in order to better inform this office of the possibilities of the Basque organization for coverage of small towns in the south. Although LASARTE was, of course, somewhat disappointed at the financial arrangements made, since he had hoped to considerably increase the prior payment of \$400 per month, he nevertheless appeared to understand that this figure was being entirely fair with him, and he also seemed quite grateful for a special luncheon given him and several of his local executives by this office on the last day of his stay in Santiago.

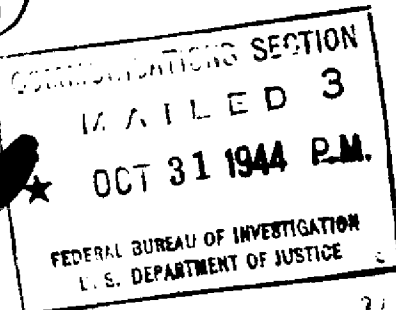

Conroy, Special Agent in Charge of the New York Field Division, concerning [REDACTED] and his relationship with the heads of the BASQUE ORGANIZATION in the United States. Referenced communication stated that [REDACTED] had expressed his interest in assisting the Bureau and it was requested that I submit to the Bureau my opinion as to whether I would deem it expedient to follow the suggestion of ANTONIO IRALA, Secretary of the Basque Delegation in New York City, to take the necessary steps while [REDACTED] is in the United States to place him in contact with the Bureau.

It is my opinion that [REDACTED] could be of considerable assistance to this office and to the Bureau in investigations of political and related matters in El Salvador and that it would be advisable to accept the offer of the Basque representatives in New York to place [REDACTED] in contact with the Bureau and to assist in facilitating his aiding the Bureau.

[REDACTED] I met and talked with him for a short while at the Embassy just prior to his first trip to the United States some [REDACTED] ago, but only had an opportunity to say a few words to him. If he is contacted in [REDACTED] prior to his return to San Salvador, I suggest that he be given my name and told that I will contact him upon his return here. Naturally, I should like to be advised of the steps taken and the commitments made to him by the Bureau in the United States.
