MOBILE, Ala., Sept. 25 (Monsignor Fulton J Sheen, ressor at Catholic University in Washington and bitter for of Communism, today said that Stalin's statements yesterday were issued "absolutely for expediency because of the hardening American policy" and that his rengrks were "insincere."

Monsignor Sheen also called for this nation to "restrict the freedom" of Russian representatives in this country just as "American citizens are curbed by the Soviets."

"Only by demanding absolute reciprocity with Russia in all matters can we break down the Russian restrictive policies," he declared.

"Today they have over 2,000 representatives in this country while we have only 30 to 40 in Russia and we permit the Ruskians to go about freely whereas our citizens are constantly watched and restricted."



Sheen, during the course of an address made by him at a Communium Breakfast of employees of the New York office, held at the Hotel Pierre in New York on Sunday, May 11, 1947. Monsigner Sheen stated that he has addressed thousands of Communical Breakfasts and that this was the finest looking group that he had ever spoken to at an affair of this nature. He also made this same remark to me personally, and it was apparent that he was deeply in-pressed with the clean-out look and wholesome appearance of those in attendance. There were a total of four hundred six persons present, consisting largely of Agents and their wives, and clerical employees.

Although it had originally been understood that Monsignor Shee: would probably only remain long enough at the Breakfast to make his talk, he arrived as breakfast was being served and remained for the entire occasion, obviously enjoying the affair enormously. He made a most interesting talk along spiritual lines. The only other speaker on the program was Ed Sullivan, Columnist for the New York Daily News, who read a column which he had written some years previously on "Nother's Day".

I am enclosing some photographs which were taken at the Communion Breakfast. This affair was planned and arranged by Miss Marcella T. Judge and Miss Gertrude E. Fouly, who appear in two of these photographs. I am also enclosing a clipping from the New York Times of May 12th, which contains a reference to Monsignor Sheen's talk.



### Msgr. Sheen Leaves C. U. Post To Head Pontifical Mission

The Right Rev. Msgr. Fulton J. Sheen has resigned from Catholic University to become national director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

In announcing his acceptance of the directorship yesterday, Msgr. Sheen said that he would continue his annual series of radio talks on the Catholic Hour, but would cancel all other speaking engagenents except those connected rith the society.

His resignation as professor of hilosophy at the university brings to an end a distinguished areer of 23 years here as priest, Searcher, speaker and author.
Beginning November 1, he will

head the organization officially known as the Pontifical Mission Aid Societies in the United States, which marshals the spiritual and material resources of American Catholics in behalf of missionary activities throughout the world.

The society, with headquarters New York, has about one milmembers in 121 dioceses in

He said his "appointment comes at a time when the world has sud denly become missionary minded. The two great missionary movements which campaign for many kind are communism and Chris-

"The secret of world peace," he said, "is conversion of the world to the Truth and Love of Christ. There is po danger from the atomic bomb; there is danger from atomic men. The 55-year-old priest was a preacher at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City for a long period. While on the NBC Cetho-lic Hour for more than two decades, his voice became familiar

to millions.

The announcement of his appointment came from His Eminence Pietro Cardinal Fumasoni-Biondi, head of the Sacred Congregation of the Propagation of the Faith, which directs the world efforts of the society from Rome. 
