





on Soptember 12. 1946 a spot surveillance of the DRAGNA residence by Agents

effected that DRAGNA left his residence and drove to the Pico Club, 2031 West Pico Boulevard, a night slub and bar which was in the process of being remodeled or redecorated, and which bears a sign indicating it was to open on Friday, September 20, 1946. DRAGNA remained in the Pico Club for a number of hours and when the surveillance was discontinued at 5:50 p.m. he was still in the Pico Club.

A physical surveillance was established at the DRAGNA residence by Special Legats at 9:30 a.m. September 13, 1946, at which time it was ascertained DRAGNA left his home in his 1940 two-tone soupe and drove to the residence of his brother 10M, where JACK's nephew LOUIS joined him. LOUIS drove JACK's ear and they preceeded out of the city of Los Angeles on U.S. Highway 1 to Del Mar. California. They made no stops on the way until they arrived at Del Mar. They arrived at the Del Mar Hotel at about 12:50 p.m., parked their car in the parking area in front of the Del Mar Hotel and entered the dining room. There they took a table and had lunch. During this time they were not joined by anyone. At about 1:50 p.m. they left the Dining Room and went into the lobby where they spoke briefly to an unidentified individual. They than re-entered their car and drove to the Del Mar Race Track, parked the car and entered the rack track stands. During the remainder of the afternoon surveillance by Agents and the agents from the San Diego Office reflected that JACK DRAGNA and his nephew LOUIS sat in a clubhouse box and left it only to place wagers and cash tickets. It was ascertained that the box bore the name plate

JACK and LOUIS remained in this box until the completion of the day's racing when they re-entered their ear, left the race track and drove in the direction of Jan Diego. At this point the surveillance was turned over to agents of the San Diego Field Division.

dvised on September 17, 1946 that JACK DRAGNA contacted a party whom he addressed as for tickets to the fights, but that told DRAGNA he was using his allotment of tickets as he was taking of New York City to the fights, on hearing this DRAGNA remarked: In they are friends of COSTELLO, they are friends of mine. Informant further disclosed that DRAGNA is not only attempting to purchase cases and night clubs in Les Angeles and Las Vegas, but is also interested in the bar and case located in the Maryland Botel in San Diego, which he stated could be purchased for \$25,000. In describing the location of the Maryland Bar, WRAGNA mentioned that it was not far from his place on 3rd Street.

On September 17, 1946 DRAGNA discussed the finances of the local wire service with an individual by the name of whose true identity has not yet been established. During this conversation, DRAGNA mentioned that he had invested \$5,000 in the wire service and that he wanted to know, how much money had been expended. In the conversation, it definitely appeared that was handling DRAGNA's money in sonnection with this venture. advised DRAGNA that everything that had been expended appears on the stubs with the exception of the "under-the-table. stuff", involving \$25, \$35 and \$50 to phone men for telephones and that with regard to this expenditure MAGNA would have to believe that the individuals received the monoy. received the monoy. advised DRAGNA that every phone was installed required a \$100.00 deposit and when DRAGNA asked how many had been installed FREDDIE replied that ten had already been placed and that he had just put down deposits on a couple of more phones on <u>Wormont Avenue</u>, which represents a total of \$1200 in deposits for 12 phones.
