Considerable information concerning this character has been submitted in various crime survey memoranda and in the CAPGA and BENJAMIN "BUGSY" SIEGEL cases. As has been stated in those sections of this report entitled JACK IRAGNA and [REDACTED] has been spark-plugging the wire service among Los Angeles book makers recently. He has hired a body-guard, a former Los Angeles Police Lieutenant now retired, [REDACTED] called upon the Chief of Police in Los Angeles recently and informed the Police Department that it was being placed on notice to the effect that [REDACTED] was staying out of the City of Los Angeles and that he, [REDACTED] had knowledge of the fact that the Police Department intended doing away with [REDACTED] and that if any act befell [REDACTED] the Police Department would be held responsible.

As a result of this Chief of Police HORRALL called in several officers who are working on [REDACTED] and advised them to be armed at all times. Consequently, a "feud" of a sort has developed and the Police Department seems thoroughly enraged at this turn of events.

The JEWELRY ROBBERY

The following information reflects a jewelry robbery which occurred at the Sunset Plaza Apartments at 1220 Sunset Plaza Drive, Hollywood.

On the night of November 16th, between 8:15 p.m. and 1:15 a.m., the apartment of [REDACTED] was burglarized. Approximately \$20,000.00 worth of jewelry was taken. Among items taken was one very rare dark blue star sapphire, 25 carats, set in platinum mounting, heavy man's type, valuation \$7500.00; also a set including a pair of cuff links, four vest buttons and two shirt studs, set in square shape with bagette diamonds on surrounding edge and blood ruby in center, value \$2500.00. On November 21, 1946, by teletype from the Salt Lake City directed to the Bureau and to Los Angeles information is set forth reflecting that [REDACTED] BEN SIEGEL's body guard and gunman appeared at Las Vegas, Nevada, with jewelry which answers the description of the jewelry taken from the Sunset Plaza and from [REDACTED] the victim of the burglary. Further information obtained from Las Vegas, Nevada, from confidential informant and other sources reflected that [REDACTED] had departed from Las Vegas to Los Angeles prior to the date of the burglary and had returned to Las Vegas shortly thereafter in possession of the jewelry. Further investigation and contemplation of arrests in regard to this violation is being considered.

who may have information relative to the payoff of Broward County, Florida, officials and other information concerning the seasonal plans of the gambling element there.

Inquiry revealed that there is no Hollywood News published in Hollywood, Florida, but that there are two weekly newspapers, one being the Hollywood Herald

and the other known as the "Sun Teller"

The Hollywood Herald is considered a sensational paper, more or less a scandal sheet. Both of these men are said to be middle age. There is no indication that they have in the past been close to the gambling situation in Broward County.

This information was furnished to the Salt Lake City Field Division by teletype January 7, 1947, suggesting that they might re-contact the informant for additional information.

With reference to the gambling situation mentioned in the Salt Lake City teletype, gambling activities have not ceased in Broward County and at that time were not opened in Dade County. Some of the gambling establishments did open on Saturday January 11, 1947, in Dade County.

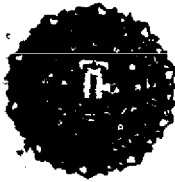

On January 3, 1947, three of the Trans-Pacific Air Service men were arrested signalling that the Santa Anita case was to be held in the immediate vicinity and these three suspects were booked on suspicion of criminal conspiracy. Information concerning the arrests which is reported elsewhere in this report was of much concern to JACK DRAGNA and others interested in the wire service. It was ascertained from [redacted] that [redacted] when contacting JACK DRAGNA assured DRAGNA that the arrests were made outside of the track house where "they" [believed to be the Security Police] had no jurisdiction.

On the same date [redacted] in contacting [redacted] Los Angeles bondman in an effort to locate the three men in any of the jails in the metropolitan area so that they could be bailed out, inquired [redacted] whether he talked to [redacted] [redacted] stated that he did and [redacted] stated that the D.A.'s office had made the arrests. From the same source, it was ascertained that [redacted] telephonic contact with BEN SIEGEL stated that the arrests were made on the outside of the track, indicating that the arrests were exclusively the work of the D.A.'s office and not the security track office.

ACTIVITIES OF [redacted] FROM DECEMBER 20, 1946 to JANUARY 9, 1947:

It was ascertained from [redacted] that [redacted] was going to leave for Las Vegas on the morning of December 26, 1946 and attend the opening of the Flamingo Casino there. From the same source, it was ascertained that prior to his leaving [redacted] had been in contact with [redacted] GEORGE RAFT, and many other Hollywood celebrities, inviting them in behalf of BEN SIEGEL to attend the opening of the Flamingo Casino.

On December 24, 1946 it was ascertained from [redacted] that [redacted] was in telephonic communication with BEN SIEGEL at Las Vegas at which time [redacted] stated the "kid" [redacted] asked [redacted] on the same date and the [redacted] wanted to find out about the furs and stuff. [redacted] subsequently contacted GEORGE RAFT and questioned RAFT concerning the purchase of furs [redacted] At this time [redacted] asked whether the furs were "warm" to which RAFT stated that they were not.

On January 3, 1947 [redacted] returned from Las Vegas and it was likewise ascertained on January 4, 1947 that VIRGINIA HILL was in the City of Los Angeles. Confidential source advised that [redacted] had contacted [redacted] advised that BEN SIEGEL was coming in Los Angeles from Las Vegas and he was eager to have a conference in an effort to develop publicity to boom the Flamingo Casino.

On January 4, 1947 [redacted] in conversation with [redacted] partner with BEN SIEGEL in the Flamingo Hotel and Casino, was advised that the new Flamingo Casino operations were not too successful and that BEN SIEGEL was acting like a prima donna. He further stated that the Flamingo did not have proper publicity in the line of entertaining. They further stated that lots of people were complaining about the Casino being filled with a "bunch of tight lipped gummen." [redacted] stated that "the atmosphere is not friendly and the boys

On this occasion DRAGNA on December 20, 1946 contacted [redacted] in Chicago, stating that he was having a great deal of trouble and had recently been arrested by the Los Angeles Police Department while attending the American Legion fight in Hollywood. DRAGNA told [redacted] that he was not suing them but later it had been ascertained that through his attorneys he had filed suit for \$100,000.00 against the arresting officers. DRAGNA advised [redacted] that he had no more money to which [redacted] replied that he was having trouble all over and suggested to DRAGNA that he cut down on the printing of his sheets. [redacted] informed DRAGNA that he was not the only one having difficulty but that this trouble was apparent in all sections of the country; further that none of the individuals connected with Transamerica had been paying him recently. DRAGNA stated that he had \$25,000 in the wire service and that he needs the shoe [redacted] reminded DRAGNA that he was costing him considerable money and that he was not in a position to carry everybody and told DRAGNA that it was up to the individuals connected with the wire service to pay him at regular intervals. [redacted] advised DRAGNA that they are unable to operate when they lose considerable money and suggested that they might have to close the West Coast because it was costing five or six thousand dollars a week.

It is noted that VIRGINIA "BUGSY" SIEGEL has been spending practically all of his time in Las Vegas, Nevada since last Los Angeles report in instant case, dated December 22, 1946, and the Salt Lake City Field Division will report SIEGEL's activities in Las Vegas, no information is being set out in this report concerning SIEGEL's activities except for that already covered by [redacted] under the above section, captioned [redacted]. Reference is made to Salt Lake City teletype to the Bureau, Los Angeles, and New York, dated January 9, 1947, reflecting that on January 8, 1947 SIEGEL requested [redacted] in Los Angeles to make reservations on the late TWA Constellation flight from Los Angeles to New York City on January 13, 1947. On January 10, 1947, [redacted] advised that [redacted] contacted SIEGEL, who was in Las Vegas, advising that he had SIEGEL's ticket for the 13th and SIEGEL requested [redacted] to get another and to get one for VIRGINIA HILL from New York City to Florida leaving New York City on January 15, 1947.

SIEGEL advised that [redacted] (phonetic) was at the Savoy Plaza Hotel in New York City and that [redacted] should have [redacted] call SIEGEL in Las Vegas, Nevada. After [redacted] several attempts to contact [redacted] at the Savoy Plaza Hotel in New York City, he ascertained that [redacted] was presently staying at the Commodore Hotel in New York City and sent [redacted] telegram, advising him to call SIEGEL by telephone at the Flamingo or the Last Frontier Hotel in Las Vegas. VIRGINIA HILL added that SIEGEL wanted to talk to [REDACTED] VIRGINIA HILL added that SIEGEL was very upset because [REDACTED] had sent a publicity agent to ask him information concerning the Flamingo Hotel. She added that SIEGEL had hired one [REDACTED] and had chased the agent [REDACTED] away from the hotel. In a gestic manner [REDACTED] stated that before long SIEGEL would be out in front of XAVIER Cugat directing the band. VIRGINIA HILL added that SIEGEL had been having much trouble signing up entertainers at the Flamingo Hotel. She added that SIEGEL had wanted to close the place, but VIRGINIA HILL and [REDACTED] had advised him not to. HILL stated that she had repeatedly told SIEGEL that he should bring a manager from New York City who knows how to run a night club in order to operate the Flamingo Hotel. She was certain that SIEGEL would not care very much about the Flamingo Hotel, but inasmuch as other interests were behind him in it "he had to care." In this connection she added that SIEGEL stated that he will probably have to kill himself in the end and she advised him that he would not have to because she would hide him. The exact meaning of this point of the conversation could not be determined by the informant, but it is believed that VIRGINIA HILL was referring to individuals who were backing SIEGEL.
