Reference is made to my telephone calls on June 28, 1966 and July 1, 1966 to you and to the Los Angeles Office furnishing information relating primarily to BENJAMIN "BUGSI" SINGEL, which information was obtained in connection with our investigation in the case untitled "VIGE COMDITIONS, Las Vegas, Nevedas RESEARCH MATTER".

The information contained in this communication was furnished to Special Arent
Les Vegas,

BENJAKIN BUSST SIRGKL, by the year 1931, because of his brains, temper and ability to earry out threats, had assumed leader-phip of a group of them small-time headluns in New York. He had previously aligned himself with the underworld in the prehibition because of his ruthlesumess and legging racket and had climbed rapidly because of his ruthlesumess and ability to headle men. About this time he associated himself with NEYER LAFSET and their gang skyrodaeted into prominence and underworld respect as the "Bugs and Neyer Neb", SIRGEL acquired his mickname of "BUGS" because he was regarded by his intimate acquaintances he incame along sertain lines.

Open gang warfare broke out among the New York gangs and the Bergs and Meyer Mob was responsible for the killing and reserved at many powerful rival gangles figures. SIRGEL and LARSEY shared the distance at the gang but SIRGEL was responsible for the terroristic practices of their group. They had many gummen at their powered that



At 8:45 a.m. today I spoke with at the Bureau in the absence of Assistant Director ROSEN. I advised that at Los Angeles had informed us that in connection with the construction of the Flamingo Hotel in Las Vegas the construction had reached a point only where there were a few stakes in the ground when the Civilian Production Administration order freezing building was put into effect; that, thereafter, a sum of money was made available to who, in turn, made money available to Senator PAT MC CARREN. Thereafter, an order came through permitting the construction of the Flamingo Hotel to go ahead.

I pointed out to that I would recommend an open and thorough investigation of this matter on both the Bribery and Fraud Against the Government theory; that this would enable us to examine the books and records concerning the construction of the Flamingo Hotel; would permit us to examine witnesses under oath and we could trace back every cent of money that has been put into the construction of this Hotel. I said that besides possibly developing a violation through which we could put SIEGWL in jail, it would also have the effect of virtually bankrupting him and his associates if our investigation should result in the stoppage of construction.

I advised that technical surveillances have indicated that SIEGEL in a conversation stated that as of today they have \$1,162,500 in the Flamingo Hotel and that they are tyring to make a loan of \$500,000 and a \$600,000 loan from a Utah Corporation. I also pointed out to the front-page article in the LAS VEGAS TRIBUNE which criticized the construction of the Flamingo Hotel at a time when materials are needed for the construction of homes for veterans. I advised him that independently of our own investigation such a newspaper article might bring about an investigation either by ourselves or some other Government agency, and I felt that we should take the opportunity to move into the picture. ment had been agreed upon per a contract made June 20, 1946, and the plaintiff offered this as exhibit "A" in the proceedings, and asked that the terms thereof be adopted in the divorce decree. The complaint alleged that the defendant had been guilty of extreme cruelty, mental in nature, and the prayer of the complaint was that an absolute divorce be granted, with the custody of the children given to the plaintiff, but with a right of visitation by the defendant "at all reasonable and seasonable times." Mrs. SIEGEL was represented by DONNELL RICHARDS, a Reno attorney.

The file contained an "Appearance and Waiver" signed by BENJAMIN SIEGEL and acknowledged at Los Angeles, California, July 2, 1946, before ANNA TAYLOR, Notary Public, in which he in effect consented to a default decree.

The decree granted an absolute divorce, gave the custody of the children to the mother, with a right of visitation as set out in the complaint. The property agreement was approved and fully adopted by the court.


