NEW YORK, Dec. 20.-UP-The district attorney's office, trying to blow the lid off the hig town's sports gambling, today sought to determine whether a syndicate had manipulated the odds on last Friday night's Madison Square Garden fight in addition to trying to fix the Giant-Bears championship football game.

Sources close to Dist. Atty. Frank S. Hogan said that a close study was being made of the way the odds bounced up and down during the few days before the welterweight fight between Charley Fusari of Irvington, N. J., and Charley Taylor of Coalport, Pa.

The investigation centered on a man known as "Pete," mentioned in telephone conversations on a tapped wire to Alvin J. Paris, 28-year-old would-be playboy accused of trying to bribe two Giants players to throw the National Football Leavie championship same.

League championship game.

The trial of Paris, who was denied bail despite the attempts of a powerful legal battery to get him out of a Fombs jail cell, was scheduled to begin today in General Sessions Court here.

In their search for "Pete," police were checking on David Krakauer, a Bronx gambler with a police record dating back 26 years and including convictions for arson and counterfeiting. Krakauer was said to be in a New York hospital.

The cast of characters in the great football fix grew more bizarre by the moment. It already included five of young Paris' closest relatives, all with police records of one sort or another; a parade of Broadway party girls who allegedly were used to entertain professional football players; a high-powered criminal lawyer, Caesar B. F. Barra; and the most fabulous characters of all, the anonymous big-money gamblers of the syndicate for which Taris allegedly was a front.

Internal Revenue agents stepped into the case in New Jersey, where the gambling syndicate supposedly has its besiquarters. They were looking for income tax evisions, a favorite government device for nailing high-flying criminals who manage to evade local convictions.

The investigation was spiced yesterday by questioning of various Broadway cuttes whose names turned up in a little black address book found in the apartment of young Paris.

He was said to have entertained frequently, and detectives wanted to determine whether he supplied party girls for football players in order to win their friendship and confidence.

The telephone conversation which linked Paris and "Pete" to the Fusari-Taylor fight was reported by the district attorney's office to have gone like this:

Paris: "You are my partner and I'm looking to protect the effice." Pete: "He claims you are trying to throw the market around."

Paris: "What's he yelping about? He won \$10,000 on the fight last night."

The talk took place the morning after the Garden bout. Early in the week Fusari was a 2½-to-1 favorite. The odds dipped to even money, and went back up to 8 to 5 by ring time. Fusari won by a technical knockout.

Black Hand Gang Said Organized On A National Basis

NEW YORK (UP)—A new Mafia or black hand gang has been organized on a national basis and since the war has spread a trail of murder and wholesale drug peddling across the country from New York to California, Col. Garland H. Williams, district supervisor for the federal narcotics bureau, disclosed today.

Williams said the black hand activities were uncovered by the smashing of two huge. New York dope rings and the arrest of six east Harlem gangsters on information reaped from the investigation of the murder of a Republican political worker in the home district of Rep. Vito Marcantonio.

He said that the new Mafia is the 1946 version of the original Unione Sicilano, the black hand of Sicilly.

COVER ENTIRE U.S.

"The American born sons of the old Mafia," Williams said, "cover almost the entire United States, particularly the Florida New York, New Jersey, Kansas, Nevada and California areas, working in gambling and narcotics.

"They sneer at the outworn methods of the old Mafia. Where the older black handers worked with bombs, the young Mafia rely on 'connections,' bribery and political corruption."

He said "numerous murders" on the Pacific coast and slayings in other sections of the country had been traced to the Mafia.

Williams cited one murder in Chicago "where Carl Caramuse was on his way to church with his family when he was killed by a shotgun blast from a passing car."

. A. Cleaner War Figure Taken for Ride, Dumped in Ravine

(Photo on Page Three)

Maurice Malter, 54, whose sensational evidence in a 1939 "cleaners and dyers" war murder trial here sent five men to life imprisonment, yesterday was found slain in true gangland fashion near San Mateo.

Sprawled in a ravine two miles east of Oak Cove Park where he had been dumped after being "taken for a ride," he had been shot twice in the head and twice in the chest with a 38 caliber automatic pistol.

Formerly engaged in the cleaning business and a key figure in Los Angeles' murderous acid-and-bomb-throwing cleaners and dyers battle in 1931, of late he had operated a radio parts store at 1170 South La Brea avenue here.

MADE TRIP—

Identified through an airline receipt found in his pocket which gave his address as 5230 West Olympic boulevard, Wilshire, Station Detective Robert Swan learned from the slain man's widow that on Saturday he flew to Oakland to purchase radio parts.

Callously dragged from an automobile and tossed over a barbwire fence, the body flatt no doubt that Malter had been taken for a ride by his one-mies," Sheriff McGrath said.

On April 27, 1939, after Malter gained immunity and subsequent freedom from a murder charge by turning state's evidence and testifying against six other defendants, five of the six were sentenced to life imprisonment for the slaying of John Stockman, watchman in an east-side reasing shop, who was shot and killed December 15, 1931, seven years before, during the cleaners and dyers war.

TESTIFIED

Malter testified concerning the pistol used to slay the watchman and told the court that Ed. Rollins, one of those found guilty, had threatened:

"If you ever tell police what you know about that gunyou'll have a bullet put through your head."

Those sentenced to life imprisonment were Ed Rollins, Chicago hoodlum; Ed Freedman and Frank Fisher, ex-convicts; and Robert Cowan and George Gartler, wholesale cleaning plant proprietors who, according to Malter's testimony, hired the first three in an effort to monopolize through terror the cleaning and dyeing industry here.

Freedman, who was serving a term for the jewel robbery of Actress Mae West when convicted on the murder charge, is still in San Quentin. The others have been paroled. Fisher is serving a six months' sentence on a narcotics charge in the county jail here.

JACK DRAGNA, local head of the MAFFIA and number one man of the Transamerica, the new wire service, is closely allied with SIEGHL in this enterprise; and BUGSY's henchman, is actively lining up bookmakers and working with DRAGNA in the dissemination of racing news information. Through technicals it has been determined that DRAGNA met with SIEGEL and recently; apparently at this meeting discussions concerning the T.A. were gone into.

Any investigation of SIEGEL will naturally involved by New York mobster and hoodlum, who has been associated with SIEGEL for many years. This character is moving to Southern
