





Three Arrested in Signaling of Racing Results

Illustrated on Page 3, Part I

Three men were arrested and booked on suspicion of criminal conspiracy yesterday by members of Dist. Atty. Simpson's gangster squad in an investigation that uncovered what was believed to be a scheme to signal race results from the Santa Anita grandstand to a garage a mile distant.

Two of the men were picked up in the garage, where one was using a pair of binoculars. The third suspect was seized in the grandstand while signaling, unaware that his asserted associates had been taken into custody.

Could Detect Signals

Investigators Charles Hoy and Ellis Bowers reported they were able to detect the signaler from the garage and note his description with the aid of the special binoculars, a foot and a half long, that were in the place.

The men gave the names of Felix Luczak, 32, of Cicero, Ill., who was stationed on the lower level of the garage, Jack Moran, 28, of 2627 Monmouth Ave., who was found at the binoculars, and Stanley Sienkiewicz, of Pawtucket, R.L., who was stated to be in the top of the grandstand.

They were taken to the office of Dep. Dist. Atty. Joseph Carr for questioning.

Could Beat Wires


Information transmitted by the means uncovered could be used to beat booking agents, the investigators said, pointing out that unscrupulous persons armed with the signaled data could place bets on horses that that already won.

The garage in which Luczak and Moran were found was on the premises of Mrs. Ida Haynes of 452 Huntington Drive, Arcadia.

Mrs. Haynes said that she had frented the quarters two weeks ago at \$50 a week to men who professed to be working for a news service handling race results.

Scheme to relay Santa Anita race results from the grandatand to a garage a mile away was broken up today, following the arrest of three men by district attorney's investigators.

Booked on suspicion of criminal conspiracy and later released on ball of \$1500 each were:

Melix Luczak, 32, Cicero, Ill.; Jack Moran, 28, 2627 Monmouth Ave., and Stanley Sienkiewicz, & Pawtucket, R. 1.

Pinkerton detectives from the race track and district attorney investigators found Luczak and Moran operating high power binoculars from a garage at 452 Huntington Dr., Arcadia.

Through the binoculars, trained on a spot in the grandstand near the finish line, officers said, they saw Sienkiewicz.

Sienkiewicz, it was said, signaled the finish of each race to the two men at the garage by either tipping his hat, rubbing his

nose, stratching his ear, etc.

Each gesture, the raiding officers said, specified a number of a horse which was part of a prearranged code used by the trio.

Telephones found in the garage, arresting officers said, were used by the men to relay their information to a downtown nerve center.

The suspects denied that they were part of a post betting syndicate, explaining that they were merely employes. of a scratch sheet publication which sought the race results for its clients.

Mrs. Ida Haynes, who owns the property where the garage is located, told officers she had rented the quarters to the men two weeks ago for \$50 a week.

While making the arrest, a detective answered the phone, took at bet on Ike's Glory and Darby D-Day to win and show in the sixth race at Santa Anita.


The second horse won, paying \$5.60 to the dollar for place bets.

Savirino and Hassau are held on suspicion of robbery along with Elijah R. Soza, and Abel Soza. The last three deny connection with the robbery.
